### CYCLONE QUICK HITTERS

- Iowa State qualified for its seventh-straight NCAA Regional, earning a spot at the Shoal Creek Regional (T13th)
- Iowa State ended the year ranked No. 25 by Golfweek.
- The Cyclones once again played a very competitive schedule, finishing in the top-five in seven of 11 tournaments.
- At the Mercedes Benz Collegiate, the Cyclones tied the school record for low 54-hole score at 857.
- The Cyclones later shattered that mark by posting a school-record 849 at the Hurricane Invite.
- Five different Cyclones placed in the top-10 12 times this season.
- Two Cyclones were named All-Big 12 First Team

and were ranked in the top-115 by Golfweek in Chayanit Wangmahaporn (#99) and Celia Barquin (#115).

- Barquin placed in the top-10 three times.
- Barquin was second on the team stroke average at 73.82 and has placed in the top-10 in eight career tournaments.
- Wangmahaporn led the team in stroke average at 73.66, the 2nd-best rookie mark in ISU history.
- Wangmahaporn, who led the team with four-top-10s, posted a career-low 210 at the Mountainview, tying for the second-lowest score in school history.
- Senior Cajsa Persson earned all-tournament honors at the Big 12 Championship for the third time in her career, tying for ninth.

# TOURNAMENT RECAPS AND SCORES

## Dick McGuire/Branch Law Firm

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. – The Iowa State Women's Golf team, ranked 39th nationally by Golfweek, posted a solid start to its season by tying for fourth at the Dick McGuire Invitational in Albuquerque, N.M.

The Cyclones fired rounds of 295-292-292 for an 879 tally to tie for fourth in the competitive field which featured eight teams ranked in the nation's top-30 according to Golfweek.

Stanford won the team title at 856.

The Cyclones were led by sophomore Celia Barquin, who recorded the sixth top-10 finish of her young career by tying for 10th at 216 (71-73-72). Barquin was 2-over through five holes in the final round today, but rallied to go 3-under in the last 13 holes en route to a 1-under 72.

True freshman Chayanit Wangmahaporn made an auspicious debut as a Cyclone by tying for 23rd at 219. Wangmahaporn posted the low score of the day for the Cyclones by firing a 3-under 70. She had five birdies on her card today.

Nattapan Siritrai and Parinda Phokan tied for 36th at 224 to help the Cyclone effort.

## Mercedes-Benz Collegiate Championships

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. – The Iowa State women golfers had three top-10 performers to help the Cyclones place third at the Mercedes-Benz Collegiate in Knoxville, Tennessee.

Iowa State tied its school record for low 54-hole team score by recording an 857 tally with rounds of 287-277-293. ISU's second-round 277 was one stroke shy of its school mark for low 18-hole team score.

Kent State was the team champion at 847, followed by Tennessee at 856, one shot better than the Cyclones.

Sophomore Celia Barquin led the Cyclones by tying for fifth place at 213 (71-70-72). It was Barquin's seventh top-10 finish in 13 career events.

The Cyclones received outstanding performances from their two freshmen Chayanit Wangmahaporn and Parinda Phokan. The duo each recorded their first career top-10 finish, as Wangmahaporn tied for seventh at 214 (69-69-76) and Phokan tied for ninth at 216. Phokan carded a 72 in the final round this afternoon.

WILMETTE, Illinois – The Iowa State women's golf team finished seventh at the Windy City Invitational. The Cyclones carded scores of 294-287-290 for a 54-hole 871 total.

Sophomore Celia Barquin tallied her third top-10 finish of the fall, tying for ninth with rounds of 71-69-73=213. Barquin, who has yet to finish outside of the top-10 in all three tournaments this year, has eight top-10 finishes in 14 career tournaments.

Freshman Parinda Phokan continued her consistent play, tying for 14th with rounds 76-68-70=214. Her second-round 68 was the first sub-70 round of her career.

## Stanford Intercollegiate

STANFORD, Calif. – The No. 14 Iowa State women's golf team finished in 12th place at the Stanford Intercollegiate after firing a three-round 893 total (300-294-299).

Stanford won the team title at 847.

The tournament was packed with the nine teams ranked in the latest Golfweek top-25 rankings (No. 1 USC, No. 2 Georgia, No. 3 Northwestern, No. 4 Arizona, No. 9 Stanford, No. 11 Arizona State, No. 12 UCLA, No. 14 Iowa State and No. 21 Washington).

Freshman Parinda Phokan led the Cyclones by placing in a tie for 33rd at 220 with rounds of 75-72-73. Phokan's freshman teammate Chayanit Wangmahaporn leaped into a tie for 54th at 225 after posting a 72 this afternoon. An eagle on the par-5 12th hole helped her card the low score of the day for the Cyclones at 1-over.

Nattapan Siritrai tied for 58th at 226.

ORLANDO, Fla. – The No. 15 Iowa State women's golf team wrapped up competition at the UCF Challenge, finishing in a tie for fifth after posting a three-day 892 total (301-287-304).

Houston was crowned the team champion at 885, one shot better than Tulane (886).

Cyclone freshman Chayanit Wangmahaporn posted her second career top-10 finish by tying for sixth in the medalist race at 220 (76-68-76). Sophomore Celia Barquin finished in a tie for 11th place after carding rounds of 75-72-74 for a 221 total.

## Lady Puerto Rico Classic

RIO GRANDE, Puerto Rico – The No. 18 Iowa State women's golf team finished fourth at the competitive Lady Puerto Rico Classic after carding a final-round 299. The Cyclones finished the tournament at 884. Georgia won the team title at 867.

The tournament is annually one of the most competitive in the nation, and this year is no different. This year's field features nine teams currently ranked in the nation's top-30 according to Golfweek. Cyclone rookie Parinda Phokan registered her second top-10 of the season by tying for eighth at 219 (74-70-75). Phokan has placed in the top-20 in four of her six career tournaments as a Cyclone.

Another Cyclone freshman, Chayanit Wangmahaporn, had the low round of the day for ISU with an even-par 72. Wangmahaporn jumped into a tie for 19th in the individual standings with her solid final round. She finished the tournament at 223 (78-73-72).

Sophomore Celia Barquin also tied for 19th, firing rounds of 73-76-74 (223).

## Hurricane Invitational

CORAL GABLES, Fla. – The No. 16 Iowa State women's golf team seized second-place at the Hurricane Invitational with a three-round 849 total, breaking its previous school record for team 54-hole score by eight shots.

Iowa State's strong showing was spearheaded by three Cyclones who placed in the top-10 in Chayanit Wangmahaporn (7th- 211), Parinda Phokan (T8th- 212) and Nattapan Siritrai (T8th- 212).

Two of ISU's 18-hole team scores during the week (first-round 281 and third-round 282) rank in the top-six on ISU's career record list.

No. 7 Northwestern won the team title at 828, as ISU was one of nine teams in the field ranked in the top-50 in the latest Golfstat national rankings.

Wangmahaporn, a freshman from Rayong, Thailand, was consistent all week, firing rounds of 71-70-70 (211) to finish seventh in the medalist race. Wangmahaporn's 211 tally ties for the fourth lowest 54-hole score in school history. It was also her third top-10 finish of the season.

Siritrai and Phokan registered their fourth and third career top-10 performances, respectively, by tying for eighth at 212, tying for the seventh-best 54-hole individual score in school history.

Sophomore Celia Barquin moved into a tie for 14th at 214 behind a final-round 68 today, the fifth sub-70 round of her career.

## MountainView Collegiate

TUCSON, Ariz. – The No. 16 Iowa State women's golf team closed out the MountainView Collegiate in second place after carding an 866. The Cyclones finished just seven shots behind first-place Georgia (859) at 5-under.

The Cyclones were led by freshman Chayanit Wangmahaporn, who closed the tournament second overall after carding a career-best 54-hole score of 210, which ties Chonlada Chayanun and Cajsa Persson for second in school history. Wangmahaporn recorded a 70 and 72 on Friday and finished off the tournament tying her career-best with a 68. The second-place finish was also Wangmahaporn's top-career finish and the fourth top-10 of the season.

Celia Barquin was the second top-finisher for the Cyclones as she fired a 54-hole score of 218 and finished tied for 13th.

Of the 15 teams in the field, Iowa State was one of six ranked teams and finished second only to fifth-ranked Georgia.

## Big 12 Championship

SAN ANTONIO – The No. 17 Iowa State women's golf team finished fourth at the Big 12 Women's Golf Championship, carding a final-round 296.

The Cyclones ended the tournament with a three-round 874 tally, one shot behind third-place TCU. No. 9 Oklahoma State was crowned the champion in its 11-shot deficit (856) over Texas.

ISU's fourth-place showing marks the seventh-straight season where the Cyclones finished in the upper-half at the conference meet.

Iowa State was led by senior Cajsa Persson, who tied for ninth after posting a 74 in the final round. Persson finished the tournament at even par, tallying rounds of 72-70-74 (216). Persson earned all-tournament honors for the third time in her career (2013, 2015, 2016) to join Punpaka Phuntumabamrung as the only Cyclones to finish in the top-10 at the Big 12 Championship three times.

Freshman Chayanit Wangmahaporn tied for 12th in her first appearance at the Big 12 Championship. Wangmahaporn fired rounds of 71-70-76 for a 217 tally.

Sophomore Celia Barquin made a move up the leaderboard after posting a final-round 1-under 71. Barquin, who was 2-under on the back nine, tied for 21st at 222.

The Cyclones fired a final-round 310 for a 54-hole 944 tally.

# THE COACHING STAFF

## CHRISTIE MARTENS, Head Coach



Through relentless hard work, determination and tireless recruiting, Christie Martens has firmly established the Iowa State women's golf program as one of the nation's best.

Postseason appearances, including a school-record five-straight NCAA Regional berths (2010-

14), and top-25 teams have become the norm in the Martens era. The Iowa State administration affirmed Martens' outstanding coaching abilities by signing her to a contract extension through 2015 in May of 2010.

In 2014, Martens led her ISU team to the pinnacle of collegiate golf when the squad advanced to its first-ever NCAA Championship. It marked the first time a team from the state of Iowa made the NCAA finals since the regional format was introduced in 1993.

The Cyclones placed 23rd at the NCAA Championship and were ranked in Golfweek's national top-25 at season's end.

Martens, who is in her 11th season as the head coach with the Cyclones, saw the first signs of her rebuilding project come to fruition in 2009-10. The Cyclones finished fourth at the Big 12 Championships and qualified for the NCAA West Regional, the school's first postseason appearances since 1996.

Martens and her Cyclones trumped the 2009-10 campaign with a record-shattering 2010-11 season, as Iowa State achieved its highest ranking in school history (No. 15), won three tournament titles and recorded 11 of the top-12 18-hole team scores in the program's history. The Cyclones as a team averaged 297.6 strokes per round in 2011, an average

of over five shots lower than the old school mark set the previous season.

Iowa State was the No. 1 seed at the 2011 Big 12 Championships, qualified for its second consecutive NCAA Regional berth and finished the season ranked in the nation's top-20 to cap off its record-setting season. Martens was rewarded for her efforts, earning 2011 Big 12 Coach of the Year honors and NGCA Central Region Coach of the Year accolades.

Iowa State qualified for its third-straight NCAA Regional in 2012, as the Cyclones tied for fourth at the Big 12 Championships.

In 2013, Iowa State made its fourth-straight NCAA Regional appearance and finished third in the Big 12 Championship, the best placing by a Cyclone team in Big 12 Championship history. ISU finished the season ranked in the nation's top-30.

One of Martens' star players, Pimpaka Phuntumabamrung, capped off her outstanding career by earning Big 12 All-Tournament honors for the third time by finishing runner-up medalist at the 2013 Big 12 Championship, the best individual placing by a Cyclone in Big 12 history.

The 2014 Cyclone team made it to the NCAA finals by tying for sixth at the NCAA West Regional. Two Cyclones - Sasikarn On-iam and Chonlada Chayanun - earned all-tournament honors at the Big 12 meet and were named First-Team All-Big 12 by the league's coaches.

Chayanun tied for seventh at the NCAA Championship to record the best finish by a Cyclone in NCAA postseason play and broke the single-season stroke average mark at 73.38.

A key ingredient to Martens' success at Iowa State has been her ability to surround herself with outstanding players. A total of 10 Cyclones have earned All-Big 12 recognition 14 times in her Iowa State tenure: (Louise Kenney-2005; Jessica Shin-2006; Pennapa Pulsawath-2010; Laurence Herman-2010, 2011; Phuntumabamrung-2010, 2012, 2013; Prima Thammarak-2011; Victoria Stefansen-2011, On-iam-2011, 2014; Cajsja Persson-2013 and Chayanun-2014).

The Cyclones have broken virtually every team scoring record under Martens' watch, including shattering the school mark for best 54-hole score of 857 at the 2011 Mountain View Collegiate. Her teams have won four tournament titles and produced three individual medalists in her ISU career while annually playing one of the nation's toughest schedules.

Martens has established herself as an outstanding recruiter on a national and international scale. Martens has been instrumental in getting highly touted international players like Pulsawath (Thailand), Phuntumabamrung (Thailand), Thammarak (Thailand), On-iam (Thailand), Chayanun (Thailand), Stefansen (Denmark), Herman (Belgium) and Persson (Sweden) to enroll at Iowa State.

Iowa State golfers have also succeeded in the classroom under Martens, as 15 Cyclones have gone on to earn academic All-Big 12 honors 31 times.

As an assistant at Purdue from 2001-05, Martens helped lead the Boilermakers women's team to a 22nd-place finish at the 2004 NCAA Championship. Purdue finished in 12th place in 2003 and 16th in 2002. In Martens' first season in West Lafayette, Ind., the Purdue women's golf team placed fourth at the 2002 NCAA Central Regional and second at the Big Ten Championship. The Boilermakers were fourth at the Central Regional and Big Ten Championships in 2003. In 2004, Purdue finished fourth in the Big Ten and sixth at the NCAA Central Regional.

Martens earned a bachelor's degree in learning and organizational change from Northwestern University in 2001. A three-time academic all-Big Ten honoree, she captained the 2000 Wildcat team, which was the first NU women's squad to advance to the NCAA Championships. The former Northwestern record-holder for 54-holes, Martens placed among the top-10 finishers at the 1999 Big Ten Championship. She received the Walter K. Smart scholarship at Northwestern, recognizing a student-athlete who achieves in both academics and athletics.

Martens, a native of Dixon, Ill., played in the 2000 U.S. Women's Amateur in Asheville, N.C. The former Christie Hermes, Martens and her husband Bobby, were married in Oct. 2005. They have a daughter, Norah and a son, Lucas.

## SARAH BUTLER, Assistant Coach



Sarah Butler, who was an assistant at Old Dominion in 2014-15, is in her first season as an assistant coach for Iowa State women's golf.

Butler helped mentor a pair of golfers (Maggie Simmermacher and

All-C-USA in her only season at ODU. Simmermacher was also named C-USA Freshman of the Year.

A native of Roseau, Minn., Butler was an assistant coach at Shattuck-St. Mary's in Faribault, Minn., for one season and was a tournament director for the American Junior Golf Association (AJGA) for two years prior to her stint at ODU.
