THE LEAD

No. 24 Iowa State (2-1, 2-0 Big 12), currently tied for first in the Big 12 and 2-0 in league play for the first time since 2002, remains at home to face Texas Tech (1-2, 0-2 Big 12). The Cyclones have never lost to the Red Raiders in the Matt Campbell era, as Campbell has won all four previous matchups. Iowa State is 11-1 in October since 2017, the most wins by a "Power 5" school during that span (Iowa State, 11-1; Alabama, 10-0; LSU, 10-1; Clemson, 9-1).

KEY STORYLINES

- Matt Campbell and the Cyclones exorcised more demons on Saturday, knocking off No. 18 Oklahoma (37-30) for their first win over the Sooners in Ames since 1960.
- The victory over OU was ISU's seventh vs. a rated foe since 2017 (7-7), as 29.1 pct. of ISU's 24 all-time wins vs. ranked teams have occurred in the last four years.
- Behind Big 12-rushing-leader Breece Hall, Iowa State ranks 14th nationally in yards per rush (5.32) and is tied for seventh nationally in rushing TDs (9). ISU has two or more rushing TDs in all three games.
- Hall leads the Big 12 and ranks third nationally in both rushing (132.0) and rushing TDs (6). Hall is the first Cyclone to reach the 100-yard rushing plateau in the first three games of the season since Ennis Haywood (2000).
- Brock Purdy is the winningest QB in ISU history against league competition. He is now 13-5 vs. conference teams with at least one victory over every member.
- ISU leads the Big 12 and ranks 12th nationally in sacks (3.67), registering at least two sacks in all three games.

- Broke an Iowa State record for Big 12 wins in a season (6 in 2018).
- Only coach in school history to defeat every league team in his career.
- Led ISU to three consecutive bowls for the second time in school history.
- Owns nearly 30 pct. (29.2%) of ISU's all-time wins over ranked opponents. Campbell has seven wins vs. rated foes as the Cyclone head coach.
- Registered three of the program's four wins against top-six ranked opponents.
- Led Iowa State to a spot in the College Football Playoff rankings in three-straight seasons (2017-19).
- Owns three of ISU's four winning conference records in Big 12 history.
- Member of five Division III national championships as a player and coach at perennial power Mt. Union (Ohio).

MIDAMERICAN ENERGY FIELD AT JACK TRICE STADIUM



MIDAMERICAN ENERGY FIELD AT JACK TRICE STADIUM

MidAmerican Energy Field at Jack Trice Stadium has proven to be one of the most outstanding football structures in the country in its 46-year existence. With its remarkable sight lines and numerous renovations throughout the years to enhance the game day atmosphere, the stadium ranks as one of the nation's best football venues.

The 61,500-seat stadium is the third-largest in the Big 12 Conference. Construction on the stadium started on Oct. 26, 1973 with the first game in the facility played on Sept. 20, 1975. It was officially dedicated as Jack Trice Stadium in 1997 in honor of Jack Trice, Iowa State's first African-American student-athlete who died tragically from injuries in a football game in 1923. Iowa State is the only FBS school in the nation to have a stadium name dedicated to an African-American.



WHO WAS JACK TRICE?

Jack Trice was born in Hiram, Ohio in 1902. Trice attended East Tech High School in Cleveland, where he was a star athlete. When his football coach, Sam Willaman, was named head coach at Iowa State, Trice and six other athletes followed him west, as Trice became the first African-American student-athlete in Iowa State history. Trice majored in animal husbandry and his goal was to settle in the South after his graduation and help the black farmers of that area. He was a very studious young man and despite his participation in intercollegiate athletics, Trice managed to pass 45 college credits with a 90 percent average. Because there were no athletic

scholarships granted in those days, he worked odd jobs to finance his education and support his wife and mother.

On the gridiron, Trice was a stellar performer in the interior line in 1923. His promising career abruptly ended, however. Trice played in the season-opener, a 14-6 win over Simpson in Ames. He traveled to Minneapolis the following weekend to face a strong Gopher squad. It was during intermission that Trice began to complain of a sore left shoulder, but nevertheless, returned to action in the second half. Midway through the third quarter, a frustrated Minnesota team ran a play off left tackle. Trice immediately saw that he wouldn't be able to reach the ball carrier, so he threw himself in front of the Minnesota interference in a roll block. He was toppled over on his back and trampled on.

Trice wanted to continue playing but never returned to the game. Doctors at a Minneapolis hospital allowed Trice to return to Ames with the team, which lost the game 20-17. They declared his condition not so serious. Trice rode back on a pullman coach. He rested his body on a straw mattress and was immediately taken to the university hospital upon his arrival in Ames. There, doctors discovered a broken collarbone Trice had sustained during the first half of the contest. His condition worsened as he developed respiratory problems Sunday afternoon, and a stomach specialist from Des Moines was summoned. Dr. Oliver Fay decided that surgery would be too risky, so no operation was performed.

At 3 p.m. on Monday, Oct. 8, 1923, Jack Trice died of hemorrhaged lungs and internal bleeding throughout the abdomen. The following Tuesday, classes

were postponed and a funeral service was held before 4,000 students and faculty members on the central grounds of campus.

A letter written by Jack Trice to himself on the eve of the Minnesota game was found in his coat pocket the day of his funeral. The contents of that letter were divulged before the 4,000 mourners. It read:

"My thoughts just before the first real college game of my life: The honor of my race, family and self is at stake. Everyone is expecting me to do big things. I will. My whole body and soul are to be thrown recklessly about the field. Every time the ball is snapped, I will be trying to do more than my part. Fight low, with your eyes open and toward the play. Watch out for crossbucks and reverse end runs. Be on your toes every minute if you expect to make good. Jack."

A memorial scholarship was created, and a memorial to Trice is located on the east concourse of the football stadium as you enter the Jack Trice Club. A statue in his honor was unveiled in 1987 and currently resides on central campus.

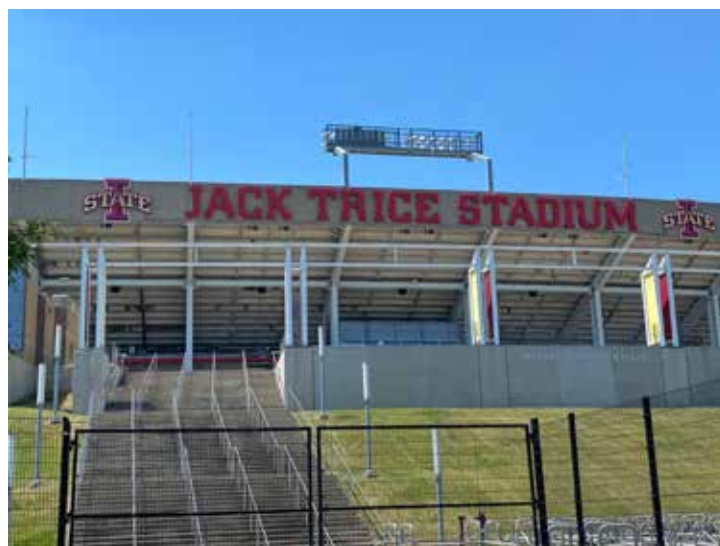
Iowa State unveiled its new stadium in 1975 and it was originally named Cyclone Stadium. Gradually, the Trice story started to become more prevalent.

A strong push from students and alumni to dedicate the stadium in honor of Trice gained traction in the early 1980s. Iowa State President Dr. Robert Parks announced the facility name would change to Cyclone Stadium at Jack Trice Field prior to the 1984 season.

A groundswell of support for Trice continued, however. Supporters felt Trice's name should be the primary focus of the stadium. Finally, in 1997, President Dr. Martin Jischke officially dedicated Iowa State's football playground as Jack Trice Stadium.

LAST TIME OUT

- Iowa State is 2-0 in Big 12 Conference play for the first time since 2002 thanks to a 37-30 victory over No. 18 Oklahoma on Saturday.
- It was ISU's first win over OU in Ames since 1960, ending a 24-game losing skid.
- The win was ISU's seventh vs. a ranked team since 2017.
- The victory propelled ISU's win total in October since 2017 to 11, the most by any FBS team during that span.
- The Cyclones staged a fourth-quarter comeback en route to the victory.
- Down 30-23 with 8:17 left in the game, ISU came up with a string of big plays.
- KR Kene Nwangwu took the ensuing kickoff 85 yards to set up a quick answer TD to tie the game at 30-30.
- ISU got a stop and scored quickly again, as Breece Hall had a 36-yard rush followed by a 8-yard TD run to move ahead 37-30.
- The ISU defense then came up with another huge play, as Isheem Young sealed the victory with 1:04 remaining by picking off a Spencer Rattler pass in the end zone.
- Hall was sensational, going over 100 yards (139), including 100 after intermission, for the third-straight game to become the first Cyclone to reach the 100-yard plateau in each of the first three games of a season since Ennis Haywood in 2000.
- Hall also had a pair of TD runs to give him six on the season to lead the Big 12 and rank third nationally.
- QB Brock Purdy improved to 13-5 against Big 12 teams by throwing for 254 yards (12-24) and one TD. He also rushed for another score.
- Purdy now has 45 career TD tosses to tie for second in school history.
- Purdy found Xavier Hutchinson for a 65-yard TD in the third quarter, as Hutchinson led the team with 83 receiving yards on three catches.
- LB Mike Rose led the Cyclones with 11 tackles and 1.5 TFL. He shared a sack with Will McDonald to force an OU punt on its second-to-last possession.
- McDonald registered 0.5 sack to give him 8.5 sacks in the last seven games dating back to 2019.
- ISU registered multiple sacks (2.0) for the third time this season.
- ISU outgained OU, 417-414 in the win.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- The Cyclone defense has improved dramatically since 2017. With the ability to use multiple formations without substitutions, ISU DC Jon Heacock has created a defensive master plan that other teams have mimicked.
- The Cyclones have limited opponents to under 300 yards of total offense 11 times since 2017.
- ISU's defense is allowing 24.6 points per game this season not including three non-offensive touchdowns.
- The Cyclones have been able to create pressure this season, leading the Big 12 and ranking 12th nationally by averaging 3.7 sacks per game.
- ISU has had 2.0 or more sacks in each of its first three games.
- Since 2017, ISU has tallied six or more sacks in a game five times, including a six-sack effort vs. TCU this year.
- ISU also ranks 20th nationally and fourth in the Big 12 in tackles for loss at 8.0 per game. ISU has recorded 7.0 or more TFL in each of the first three games of the season.
- The Cyclone defense has been stout against the run, limiting opponents to just 110.3 yards per game.
- ISU is holding opponents to 3.0 yards per rush, ranking 18th nationally.

- Iowa State tallied over 400 yards of total offense in each of its last two games.
- ISU reached over 400 yards of total offense in 12 of its last 16 games dating back to last season.
- ISU averaged 8.3 yards per play vs. TCU, gaining 423 yards on just 51 plays.

- With just 51 plays on offense vs. TCU, it marks the first time ISU won a game with that few of plays since San Diego State in 1978.

- Purdy, who is a member of five preseason watch lists, was a Second-Team All-Big 12 selection in 2019, the first Cyclone QB since Seneca Wallace (2002) to earn first- or second-team All-Big 12 accolades.
- In ISU's last 25 games (Purdy era), the Cyclones are averaging 421.8 yards of total offense (10,544) and 31.4 points (784).

KOLAR LEADS TALENTED TIGHT END UNIT

- Junior tight end Charlie Kolar made history in 2019 by becoming Iowa State's first All-American and Academic All-American, earning Second-Team All-America honors by the FWAA and First-Team Academic All-America accolades by CoSIDA.
- Kolar, who was one of eight semifinalists for the Mackey Award in 2019 and is on the preseason watch list for the award this year, led all Big 12 tight ends in receptions (51), receiving yards (697) and receiving TDs (7) in 2019. His 697 receiving yards broke ISU's season record for tight ends.
- Kolar missed the season-opener while nursing a lower body injury but returned and has nine catches for 93 yards in the last two games.
- Here is where Kolar ranks among tight ends on ISU's career record list: Receiving Yards (4th, 927), Receiving TDs (2nd, 10) and Receptions (5th, 71).
- Kolar is among a trio of outstanding tight ends contributing for the Cyclones. Along with seniors Chase Allen (34 catches, 369 yards, 2 TDs) and Dylan Soehner (10 catches, 125 yards, 1 TD), the Cyclone tight end unit has a combined 115 receptions, 1,421 yards and 13 TDs.

BAILEY IS ALL-TIME SACK LEADER

- Senior JaQuan Bailey will go down as one of the best DEs in Iowa State history. The two-time All-Big 12 choice is a member of the Nagurski Trophy watch list.
- Bailey is back for his fifth season after suffering a season-ending injury in the fourth game of 2019.
- His career 22.0 sacks is the best in school history and is second among active FBS players.
- Bailey is ISU's all-time leader in TFL with 37.5, the fourth-best total among active players.
- Bailey had a huge game vs. TCU, tying the school record with 3.5 sacks, all in the first half, to earn Big 12 Defensive PoW honors.

- He also tied the school mark with 4.0 TFL vs. the Horned Frogs.
- Bailey currently leads the Big 12 and 14th nationally in sacks (1.17) and fifth nationally and first in the league in TFL (2.0).

BREECE "THE BEAST" HALL

- Since Breece Hall took over as ISU's primary ball-carrier in the sixth game of the 2019 season, he has been one of the most productive running backs in the nation.
- During that span (11 games), Hall is averaging 109.9 yards (1,209), 135.4 scrimmage yards (1,489) with 16 TDs.
- This year, Hall has already proven a contender for the Doak Walker Award. He currently leads the Big 12 and ranks third nationally in both rushing (132.0) and rushing TDs (6).
- He is tied for the Big 12 lead in scoring with 36 points and is the only "Power 5" player in the nation with three 100-yard rushing games this season.
- Hall has seven 100-yard rushing efforts in his last 11 games.
- Hall tallied 154 rushing yards and tied a career best with three rushing TDs vs. TCU.
- Was instrumental in the Oklahoma win with 139 yards and two TDs. His eight-yard TD rush late in the fourth quarter was the winning score. He was the Big 12 Offensive PoW after the OU game.
- He has two 75-yard TD runs in his career (Texas Tech in 2019; TCU in 2020).
- Hall is the first Cyclone since Ennis Haywood in 2000 to begin a season with three-straight 100-yard rushing games.
- In 10 of the last 11 games, Hall has also gone over 100 yards from scrimmage.
- In 280 career touches, has just one fumble.

- Kene Nwangwu has been one of the most reliable kickoff returners since his rookie season in 2016.
- Nwangwu's career 26.8 kickoff return average is No. 1 in Iowa State history (minimum 20 returns) and is the third-best total among active NCAA players.
- Nwangwu returned a kickoff for a TD as a rookie in 2016 (West Virginia) and has 10 career returns of 40+ yards.
- Nwangwu, who has two rushing TDs this season, is averaging 31.8 yards per kickoff return this season to lead the Big 12.
- Nwangwu's 85-yard return in the fourth quarter vs. Oklahoma propelled ISU's comeback win.

PROGRAM IMPROVEMENT SINCE 2017

- Iowa State has registered three-straight winning seasons and appeared in three-straight bowl games for just the second time in school history (2000-02). It was the first time since 1976-78 that Iowa State reeled off three-straight winning seasons.
- Iowa State finished above .500 in conference play in three-straight seasons. ISU has just four winning seasons in league play in the Big 12 era (2000, 2017, 2018, 2019).
- Iowa State tied for third in the Big 12 Conference in the last two seasons, marking just the fourth and fifth time ISU placed third or better in conference play in the last 60 years (1959, 1977, 1978, 2018, 2019).
- Iowa State posted 23 wins from 2017-19, one win shy from the school-record three-year winning stretch (24 wins) from 1976-78.
- Iowa State has appeared in the College Football Playoff rankings in each of the last three seasons (2017-19), joining Oklahoma as the only two Big 12 teams to do so.
- Iowa State has appeared in the CFP rankings a total of 11 weeks since 2017, ranking third in the Big 12.
- Won 14 games in Jack Trice Stadium from 2017-19, tying for the most in stadium history in a three-year span (2000-02).
- Tallied seven wins over AP Top-25 opponents, tying for the 11th-most nationally since 2017. ISU has 24 victories over AP Top-25 opponents in the 128 years of the program.
- Owns three victories over teams rated in the top-6 nationally since 2017.
- Owns seven victories since 2017 where ISU trailed or was tied in the fourth

quarter.

- Has 10 victories on the road since 2017.
- Recorded three of Iowa State's nine all-time wins over ranked opponents on the road.
- Has a victory over every opponent in the Big 12 since 2017, marking the first time in school history that an ISU head coach (Matt Campbell) has beat every league team during their tenure.
- Ranked in the top-three in the Big 12 in scoring defense from 2017-19.
- Produced five All-Americans (Joel Lanning, David Montgomery, Hakeem Butler, Brian Peavy, Charlie Kolar) since 2017. ISU had just three All-Americans from 1997-2016.

KEEPING IT CLOSE

- With Matt Campbell at the helm, Iowa State has been able to have a chance for victory every Saturday.
- Since 2017, ISU has been defeated by over 14 points just twice (Notre Dame, Louisiana).
- In 8 of ISU's 17 losses since 2017, the Cyclones have led or were tied in the 4th quarter.
- ISU has played in 20 one-score games since 2017.
- The Cyclones have accumulated seven victories since 2017 where the game was tied or ISU trailed in the 4th quarter.

IF YOU BUILD IT, THEY WILL COME

- Iowa State has shattered virtually all attendance marks in this decade.
- Over 50,000 fans attended a game in MidAmerican Energy Field at Jack Trice Stadium a school-record 59-straight games until the 2020 season-opener when fans were not allowed to attend.
- The top-10 most attended games in school history have occurred since 2011.
- MidAmerican Energy Field at Jack Trice Stadium capacity was increased to 61,500 in 2015, making it the third-largest stadium in the Big 12.
- Iowa State ended the 2019 home season by averaging 59,794 fans per game, breaking the school record for best season average in school history.
- ISU tied a school record with six home wins in 2018 and has won 14 games at home since 2017, tying for the best three-year winning stretch in school history.

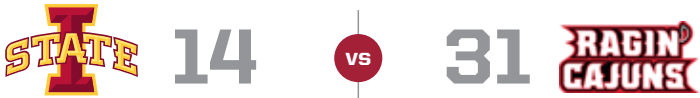
