1. The Iowa State women's basketball team (9-4, 0-2 Big 12) takes on Texas Tech (9-4, 1-1 Big 12) on Wednesday in a midweek showdown in Lubbock, Texas. The Cyclones are 16-13 all-time against the Lady Raiders and 4-9 in Lubbock. In the last meeting, Texas Tech upset the Cyclones in the first round of the Big 12 Tournament, 89-84.
2. Averaging 80.9 points per game, the Cyclones rank 18th nationally in scoring offense. ISU has surpassed the 100-point mark twice this season against Arkansas State (105-53) and New Orleans (100-63).
3. **SEANNA JOHNSON** currently ranks 14th in school history in points (1,394), fifth in rebounds (900) and is tied for third in double-doubles (30). She needs just seven points to pass Chelsea Poppens for 13th in school history. Her 900 rebounds rank eighth in the nation among active career leaders.
4. **JADDA BUCKLEY** currently ranks 10th all-time in Iowa State history with 382 career assists. Her 382 career assists rank 34th nationally and third among juniors. Buckley's 6.2 assists per game, also ranks first in the Big 12 and 22nd in the nation. Her 81 assists on the season rank 23rd nationally as well. She also ranks 22nd nationally with a 2.7 assist-turnover ratio.
5. Buckley needs just 35 points in her career to reach the 1,000-point mark. She would be the 29th player in school history to net 1,000 career points.
6. Iowa State ranks 10th in the nation in turnovers per game, averaging just 12.7 per contest. The Cyclones also rank 14th in the nation in assist-turnover ratio (1.32).
7. The Cyclones rank second in the nation in free throw percentage (81.9%) behind Stetson (81.9%). ISU led the nation in 2012-13 and 2013-14 at the charity stripe.
8. Buckley is currently first in the nation in free-throw percentage on the year (95.8). Her 87.8 career free-throw percentage also ranks second in the nation among active career leaders, just under Washington's Kelsey Plum's 88.2 percent. The NCAA record for free throw percentage in a season is 96.2 set by Penn State's Adrienne Squire in 2006. Johnson has a knack for getting to the free throw line as she ranks 27th in the nation in free throw makes, knocking down 63 at the charity stripe. Her 78 attempts also ranks 38th in the nation.
9. The 2016-17 season marks the 22nd in the tenure of Bill Fennelly. Fennelly has led Iowa State to 16 NCAA Tournament appearances, which is tied with Oklahoma as the most of any Big 12 team since 1997. Fennelly boasts a 456-227 record at Iowa State and a 622-280 record in his 28-year career as a head coach. His 622 career wins lists him in the top-20 in the NCAA among active coaches.

The dean of Big 12 women's basketball coaches, Bill Fennelly built Iowa State women's basketball into one of the nation's elite programs. He gained instant credibility with student-athletes, administrators and fans, establishing a solid foundation that was based on academics, athletics and character.

Fennelly is one of the nation's most respected coaches and his numbers bear witness to the success he has achieved in his career. He has accumulated over 600 career wins and averaged more than 21 wins per season over his 21 years at Iowa State. His teams have made 19 NCAA Championship appearances in his 25 seasons as a head coach and he ranks among the nation's top 25 active women's basketball college coaches in overall winning percentage.

Former ISU president Gregory Geoffroy and athletics director Jamie Pollard awarded Fennelly a lifetime contract following the 2006-07 campaign.

Fennelly invigorated the Iowa State women's basketball program from the first day he arrived on campus. He took a program that won just 237 games in its first 20 years and has guided it to 16 postseason appearances, a pair of NCAA Elite Eight berths, a pair of Big 12 Championship titles, a regular-season conference crown and 12 20-win seasons in his 19 years at the helm.

Three times the Cyclones have claimed a school-record 27 wins, including the 2009 Elite Eight squad. In just his second season on campus, Iowa State earned its first NCAA Championship berth and since that time the Cyclones have won 17 NCAA Championship games.

Iowa State shocked the women's basketball world when it knocked off top-seeded Connecticut to advance to the school's first NCAA Elite Eight in 1999. Ten years later, the 2009 Cyclones put their stamp on women's basketball history by overcoming a seven-point deficit with 1:30 left to defeat Michigan State and advance to the school's second NCAA Elite Eight. Under Fennelly, ISU has made five NCAA Sweet Sixteen appearances, including a streak of three straight from 1999 to 2001 and back-to-back berths in 2009 and 2010.

STREAKS AND TRENDS

- Iowa State hit 200 3-pointers in a season for an NCAA record 13-straight years (2003-04-present). Iowa State has netted 108 3-pointers so far this season.
- SEANNA JOHNSON** pulled in double-figure rebounds in 44 games in her career and 15 games last season. Johnson has also scored in double figures in 75 games in her career and 12 of 13 games this season.
- Johnson has started every game of her career, which puts her at 103-straight starts.
- Johnson has had a double-doubles in 30 games in her career.
- JADDA BUCKLEY** has dished five or more assists in 43 career games, including 10 of the last 12.
- Buckley has netted double figures in 52 career games, and 13 of the last 14 games of her career.
- ISU has shot 80 percent or better at the free-throw line in nine of its 13 games.
- The Cyclones hit at least five threes in 147 of the last 168 games, and have knocked down 10 or more triples in seven of the last 10 games.
- Iowa State has hit a 3-pointer in 686-consecutive games. In that time (since Feb. 18, 1995), ISU has hit 5,339 threes. That is equal to 7.78 three-pointers per game for the last 21 years.
- The Cyclones have finished in the upper half of the Big 12 in seven of the last eight seasons.
- The Cyclones have made nine of the last 10 NCAA Tournaments, one of just 15 teams nationally to do so.

SEANNA JOHNSON

– She is the top-returning scorer (17.0 PPG) and rebounder (9.4 RPG) in the Big 12 as she finished second in both categories to Brittney Martin last season.

- Ranks fifth in ISU history with 900 career rebounds and 14th in school history with 1,394 points.
- Only player in the nation in 2015-16 to average 17.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists.
- Johnson was the shortest player in the country to average over 9.0 rebounds per game.
- She ranks third in school history with 30 double-doubles in her career.



IOWA STATE TEAM QUICK FACTS

- Iowa State has 14 players on its roster from seven different states (Iowa, Texas, Minnesota, New York, Arizona, Wisconsin and Virginia) and five different countries (USA, Canada, Germany, Sweden and Montenegro).
- Iowa State returns four starters from last season in Johnson, Carleton, Buckley and Burkhal. In all, Iowa State returns 83 percent of its scoring, 70 percent of its rebounding and 92.7 percent of its assists for the 2015-16 campaign.
- Iowa State began the 2016-17 season with the Big 12's top returners in points, rebounds and assists as Johnson ranked second last season in both points (17.0) and rebounds (9.4), while Buckley averaged 6.0 assists. The Cyclones are the only Big 12 school returning three student-athletes who averaged over 10.0 points per game last season (Johnson-17.0, Carleton-12.0, Buckley-11.4).
- Iowa State is the only Big 12 school to have three student athletes returning who were named to the first-team, second-team, honorable mention or defensive team in 2015-16. (Johnson (first-team), Buckley and Carleton (honorable mention)).

LAST TIME OUT

- The Iowa State women's basketball team dropped its Big 12 home opener to No. 16 Texas. The Cyclones erased a 13-point UT lead in the fourth quarter to take the lead, but were unable to hold on down the stretch as UT won, 75-68.
- Iowa State was led by **JADDA BUCKLEY** who scored 19 points and dished seven assists while **SEANNA JOHNSON** added 17 and grabbed nine boards. **MEREDITH BURKHALL** (11) and **HEATHER BOWE** (10) rounded out the Cyclones in double figures.
- Iowa State became the first team all season to outrebound Texas as they earned a 36-34 edge on the boards.

SCOUTING THE LADY RAIDERS

- Texas Tech is 9-4 on the season and 1-1 in Big 12 play with a loss to Texas (47-67) and a win over Oklahoma State (70-65).
- Recee Caldwell leads Texas Tech averaging 18.1 points, 4.3 assists and 2.1 boards per game. Jada Terry (13.0) and Arella Guirantes (12.6) round out the Lady raiders averaging double figures.
- Head coach Candi Whitaker is in her fourth season with the Lady Raiders and holds a 43-62 record.

JOHNSON CLIMBING THE RECORD BOOKS

- Seanna Johnson is quickly climbing the Iowa State record books, ranking in the top-15 in career points (1,394) and the top-5 in rebounds (900). Johnson is also third all-time in rebounding average with 8.8 per rebounds per game throughout her career.

THE SHORT OF IT...

- In the 2015-16 season, Seanna Johnson ranked second in the Big 12 with 9.4 boards per game.
- In 2014-15, Johnson was the league leader in boards despite standing at just 5-10. Johnson secured 9.2 rebounds per game.
- Johnson was the shortest player in the country to average over 9.0 rebounds per game last year.
- Johnson is also the shortest player in Big 12 history to hold the Big 12 single season rebounding title (2014-15). Of all the players to lead the Big 12 in rebounding, 11 of 14 (draft eligible) players have played in the WNBA.

THE FASTEST TO...

- Seanna Johnson has been one of the fastest in school history to reach several rebounding milestones as she was the fastest to 500, 600, 700, 800 and 900 career rebounds. Johnson looks to yet again become the fastest player to 1,000 rebounds.

BUCKLEY MOVING UP THE RECORD BOOKS

- JADDA BUCKLEY** returns for her redshirt junior campaign with the Cyclones. She currently has 382 assists in her career and needs just eight to rank ninth in school history. Last season, Buckley's 179 assists on the year ranked ninth all-time in school history.

CARLETON RETURNS FOR SOPHOMORE SEASON

- BRIDGET CARLETON** returns to the Cyclones after spending the summer with the Canadian Senior Women's National Team and was an alternate for their Olympic roster. Last season, she ranked 13th in the Big 12 and second among freshmen with 12.0 points and 11th in the Big 12 and first among freshmen with 6.7 rebounds per game. She also ranked fourth in the Big 12 with 2.0 3-pointers per game.
- While Carleton was not named the Big 12 Freshman of the Year, she was the only freshman to be named honorable mention All-Big 12 and was one of just two unanimous selections to the All-Freshman Team.

REIGNING FROM THREE

- The 3-point shot continues to be a staple of Iowa State women's basketball in the Fennelly era, with Iowa State knocking down more 3-pointers than anyone in the nation over the course of the last 20 seasons.
- No team in the NCAA has attempted or made as many 3-pointers than Iowa State since the 1995-96 season and Iowa State's 5,324 3-pointers made and 14,988 3-pointers attempted reign supreme.
- Iowa State has also knocked down more 3-pointers per game than anyone in Division I, with 7.83 3's made per game, one more than second-place Villanova (6.83 per game).
- Even more impressive, ISU's 5,324 3's made is 380 more than second-place UConn's 4,938. However, ISU accomplished the feat in 113 fewer game than the Huskies.
- Over the last 20 seasons, the Cyclones rank seventh in all of D-I in 3-point percentage, making 35.7 percent of their shots from deep.
- The Cyclones own the NCAA's longest streak in NCAA Division I basketball of seasons with 200 or more 3-pointers made. ISU has made 200 3-pointers every year since 2003-04, which is 13 seasons.
- Since 1995-96, Iowa State has netted 200 or more 3's in 18 of its 21 seasons and over 170 schools in NCAA D-I have never hit more than 200 3's in a season.

#HILTONMAGIC

- The Cyclones have been phenomenal at home during Fennelly's tenure, compiling a 287-56 record (.840) in Hilton Coliseum, including a 146-4 (.979) mark against regular-season nonconference opponents. Iowa State has gone undefeated at home three times, most recently during the 2004-05 season.

FREE HOOPS

- Iowa State is 19-13 in overtime games under head coach Bill Fennelly and 26-22 overall. In its last overtime game, Iowa State fell to No. 6 Mississippi State, 85-81. ISU has won four of its last five home overtime games, but lost its last two on the road.

ONE OF THE FEW

- Very few women's basketball programs across the country have enjoyed the postseason success the Cyclones have enjoyed over the last 10 years. Iowa State is one of just 15 teams to make nine of the last 10 NCAA Tournaments.
