THE LEAD

The 23rd-ranked Iowa State women's basketball team continues its road swing to TCU as it opens Big 12 action against the Horned Frogs. The Cyclones are 16-8 all-time in Big 12 openers under head coach Bill Fennelly, but trail TCU in the all-time series 10-8.

KEY STORYLINES

- Head coach Bill Fennelly has entered quarantine protocol after being exposed to COVID-19. Associate head coach Jodi Steyer has assumed head coaching duties in his absence.
- Junior Ashley Joens is second in the Big 12 and ranks tied for fifth in the nation in scoring, averaging 30.5 points a game. Against SDSU, Joens dropped 36 points, which is tied for fifth all-time in a single game in school history.
- The Cyclones have three freshmen currently in the starting lineup, and are one of just

two power-5 teams to start three freshmen, joining California.

- Senior Kristin Scott earned preseason recognition of her own as she was named to the Lisa Leslie Award Watch List for the second-straight season. Scott was also an honorable mention selection for the Preseason All-Big 12 Team. Scott also needs just 17 points to reach 1,000 in her career.
- Iowa State dropped its first game of the season at South Dakota State on Saturday, 76-69. The Cyclones struggled from the field, shooting just 32.3 percent.

- Named the sixth head women's basketball coach in 1995.
- Has coached 10 Associated Press All-Americans in 25 years at ISU.
- Coached consensus All-American Bridget Carleton, the 2019 Cheryl Miller Award winner.
- Led Iowa State to a school record 27 wins, three times. ISU also won 25 or more games on eight occasions under Fennelly.
- Iowa State captured Big 12 tournament titles in 2000 and 2001 and played in the championship game six times, most recently in 2019.
- A three-time finalist for the Naismith Coach of the Year Award (2001, 2002, 2005).
- His 690 career wins lists him in the top-15 in the NCAA among active coaches in Division I and in the top-50 winningest coaches all-time.
- Fennelly is also tied for the fourth-longest tenured Power 5 basketball coach in men's or women's basketball.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

ALL EYES ON THE CYCLONES

- The Iowa State women's basketball team was selected to finish third by the league's coaches in the Big 12 Preseason Poll.
- The Cyclones have earned their fair share of preseason recognition nationally, earning a No. 15 ranking by the AP to start the season, the highest preseason selection since 2001-02.
- A handful of other publications and news organizations tabbed Iowa State in the top-20 as well, with the Cyclones checking in at No. 14 in the Lindy's Sports Preview and ESPN putting ISU at No. 18 entering the season.

NATION'S LONGEST 3-POINT STREAK

- The Iowa State women's basketball team has the nation's longest streak for consecutive games with a 3-pointer, sitting at 801.
- The streak began on Feb. 19, 1995 at Colorado when Tara Gunderson netted a triple.
- Iowa State has made 6,318 triples over the course of the streak and made 10 or more in a game 231 times.

1,000-POINT CLUB

- In Iowa State's game against Baylor, Ashley Joens reached 1,000 points in her career, scoring her 1,000th on the final bucket for the Cyclones. She is the first sophomore to reach 1,000 in school history. Joens accomplished the feat in 64 career games, just three shy of the record of 61, held by Stacy Frese.
- Joens is tied for 29th in school history with 1,063 points 11 points away from 28th and 31 away from 27th.
- Scott is on the heels of joining the 1,000-point club, as she has 983 points in her career. She needs just 17 to reach the milestone.

JOENS CLIMBING THE RECORD BOOK

Junior Ashley Joens is swiftly etching her name into the Iowa State women's basketball record book. After a monster sophomore campaign she soared into the all-time career scoring and rebounding average rankings.

FREEBIES

- Joens also has a knack for getting to the free-throw line, as she led the nation with 224 fouls drawn last year. As a result, she ranked second nationally in free throws made (187), and third-nationally in free throws attempted (232).
- Her 187 free throws last season set a new school record as well.
- So far this season she has made 17 free throws, which ranks tied for fifth in the NCAA.

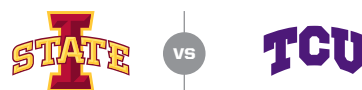
- At the close of last season she was listed No. 5 on ESPN's top-10 players to watch in 2020-21.

FRESHMEN IN STARTING LINEUP

Iowa State is poised to have one of the youngest starting lineups in the nation. The Cyclones have started three freshmen in each of the Cyclones' games this season.

- Iowa State and Cal are the only teams among power-5 to start three freshmen.

BLOCK PARTY

Senior Kristin Scott has 105 blocks in her Iowa State career, sitting at fourth all-time. Scott also blocked 42 shots in each of the last two seasons, which sit tied for 10th all-time in a single season.

JOHNSON RETURNS AFTER CAREER-BEST SEASON

Senior guard Rae Johnson recorded the best season of her Iowa State career in just about every stat category.

- She tallied a team-high 106 assists as ISU's starting point guard.
- Shot career-bests in field-goal percentage (40.5) and 3-point percentage (40.2).

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

- Her 51 triples on the year were the most of any Cyclone.
- She also went a career-best 84.5 percent at the charity stripe, which was the second-best mark on last year's team.

ESPENMILLER-MCGRAW LOOKS TO IMPROVE ON STRONG FRESHMAN SEASON

Sophomore Maggie Espenmiller-McGraw averaged a solid 8.6 points per game and 3.4 assists while starting in 23 games as a freshman last season. She is currently sidelined due to a stress injury.

- Earned a spot on the Big 12 All-Freshman team after averaging 9.1 points and 3.2 dimes in league action.
- Ended the season with 98 assists, which was second on the team.
- Her 8.6 points also ranked fourth on the squad.
- Netted 85.7 percent of her freebies, which ranked first on the team.

#HILTONMAGIC

The Cyclones have been phenomenal at home during Fennelly's tenure, compiling a 320-79 record (.809) in Hilton Coliseum, including a 176-7 (.967) mark against regular-season nonconference opponents. Iowa State has gone undefeated at home three times, most recently during the 2004-05 season.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Iowa State has placed an attendance limitation of 1,373 occupants for Hilton Coliseum.

FREE HOOPS

Iowa State is 20-13 in overtime games under head coach Bill Fennelly and 27-22 overall. In its last overtime game, Iowa State topped Kansas 71-69 in 2018. ISU has won five of its last six home overtime games, but lost its last two on the road.

CYCLONES MAINTAIN LONGEST TENURED STAFF IN DI

- The Iowa State women's basketball coaching staff holds the longest tenured coaching staffs in the country, tied with Texas A&M.
- The Iowa State staff of Head coach Bill Fennelly, associate head coach Jodi Steyer, assistants Latoja Schaben and Billy Fennelly along with director of operations Josh Carper are in their ninth season together.
