### IOWA STATE

#### **HEAD COACH MATT CAMPBELL**

Fourth Down Plays in the Red Zone:

“I don’t know exactly what is going on. I thought there were good play calls, it was more of a lack of execution and why that happened, I don’t know. Those were obviously huge plays in the football game. We were right there, plus you are playing field position. You are playing that game where you get the ball back, if you don’t have success, in pretty good field position. We did it, finally had the opportunity to score and had the opportunity to put the game away and we let that slide.”

On Drake Nettles:

“Drake kind of had a better week this week. We were outside most of the week, playing in the elements. Drake has kind of split time a little bit with PATs through the last couple weeks and it just kind of felt that was the best situation because of the element and obviously what happened in practice. Right or wrong, we believe in Drake, he’s a good kid and he has done a great job for our team and earned a right to be out there.”

On senior class:

Opening Statement:
