THE LEAD

The fifth-ranked Iowa State Cyclones open the postseason at the Big 12 Championship Saturday, March 5 and Sunday, March 6 at the BOK Center in Tulsa, Okla. Iowa State features a pair of top-seeds in Ian Parker (141) and David Carr (157), while having all 10 wrestlers seeded. The Cyclones are the only Big 12 school with all 10 wrestlers to receive a top eight seed.

KEY STORYLINES

- Iowa State closed the dual season with a 17-16 victory over No. 9 Missouri, the 13th-straight dual win of the season. Iowa State's streak is the second longest in the country heading into next season.
- In the victory over Missouri, then No. 13 Yonger Bastida trailed 4-0 with :59 left in the match against No. 6 Rocky Elam before roaring back to send the match to sudden victory at 6-6. Just :11 into sudden victory, Bastida recorded a takedown for the win and essentially locked up the dual win.
- Iowa State has won three Big 12 titles (2007, 2008 & 2009), while the Cyclones have won 42 individual titles. Both numbers rank as the second-most in Big 12 history behind Oklahoma State.
- In the last three Big 12 Championships, Iowa State's team totals have been the three-highest by a non-winning team in league history (2021 - 117.5, 2020 - 116.5, 2019 - 114.5).
- David Carr is one of two wrestlers in the tournament looking for their third title.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

50 WINS FOR DRESSER

-With a victory over Air Force on Feb. 5, Iowa State Head Coach Kevin Dresser picked up his 50th win as a Cyclone. Dresser holds a 52-23 record in five years and has 212 career victories after tallying 160 at Virginia Tech during his 11 years with the Hokies.

A HILTON FINALE

-After six years as Cyclones, Ian Parker and Jarrett Degen wrestled their final duals in Hilton Coliseum Feb. 4-5. Parker holds a 38-8 record at Hilton Coliseum, while Degen is 26-9. Degen went 9-2 at Hilton in 2018-19, while Parker was a perfect 7-0 in 2019-20 at Hilton. From 2019-21, Parker won 12-straight matches at Hilton.

LAST YEAR IN TULSA

-Iowa State crowned two champions at the 2021 Big 12 Championship, as the Cyclones finished third as a team. David Carr (157) and Gannon Gremmel (285) both took home titles, while Ian Parker (141) finished second. Iowa State scored 117.5 points, finishing behind co-champions Oklahoma and Oklahoma State with 124 points.

FOUR SHUTOUTS THIS YEAR

-The Cyclones tallied back-to-back shutouts twice this year. The four shutouts on the season tied for the sixth-most in school history, while it is the most since recording four in 2008-09.

SCHOOL RECORD FALLS

-Iowa State tied the school record for falls in a match with seven against Northwest Kansas Technical College on Jan. 6. The Cyclones had previously earned seven falls in a match against Wisconsin (1919) and Grinnell (1953). Iowa State's 56 points were the second-most ever scored in a dual behind the 57 against New Mexico in 1998.

BACK TO 141

-Redshirt-senior Ian Parker made a return to 141 pounds against Northwest Kansas Technical College on Jan. 6. In the first match of the night, Parker picked up an 18-1 technical fall in 2:55. Parker owns an 89-26 career record and is 9-1 on the season after falling 3-2 to Iowa's ninth-ranked Max Murin at 149 pounds in his first match of the season.

HOMEGROWN

-Ames native Marcus Coleman is 14-3 on the year and recently won 12-straight matches. Coleman has five top 20 victories on the season, with his only three losses coming to fourth-ranked Parker Keckeisen of Northern Iowa twice and 24th-ranked Jeremiah Kent of Missouri. Against NWKTC, Coleman picked up his 60th career victory and is currently 67-34 in his career at Iowa State.

HE'S GOING STREAKING...

-At 157 pounds, top-ranked David Carr won his 50th-straight match against Missouri. Carr joins Cornell's Gianni Diakomihalis and Minnesota's Olympic Gold Medalist Gable Steveson as the only three wrestlers in the country with a current winning streak over 40. Diakomihalis has won a nation-leading 65-straight matches, while Steveson just recently won his 44th-straight match. Carr's last loss came in December 2019. During that stretch, he has accumulated 12 majors, nine tech falls and 10 pins.

...WE'RE GOING UP THE QUAD.

Iowa State's 13-match winning streak is the longest streak the Cyclones have put together since winning 17-straight matches from Feb. 13, 2004 to Jan. 21, 2005. Penn State holds the longest streak in the country at 28, joining the Cyclones as the only teams with an active win streak in double digits.

YOU'RE MY BOY, BASTIDA

-Sophomore Yonger Bastida holds a 17-3 record on the year and has won eight of his last nine matches. Of his 17 victories on the year, 12 have come via bonus points, while he is 14-2 in duals this year. In his last five matches, Bastida has scored 91 points with two major decisions and two technical falls.

TOUGH TO TAKE DOWN

-Over the last two seasons, David Carr has allowed just three takedowns. Two of those takedowns came in the championship match of the Daktronics Open in the season opener this year, as Carr defeated seventh-ranked Peyton Robb of Nebraska 7-5 (SV). He held a 60-1 takedown differential last season, while having a 56-2 advantage this season.

TRACKING TERUKINA

-Kysen Terukina had an 11-match winning streak snapped at Oklahoma, but bounced back with a 2-1 victory over No. 6 Trevor Mastrogiovanni of Oklahoma State in his next match. Against West Virginia, Terukina beat No. 5 Killian Cardinale for back-to-back top-six wins. Last season, Terukina beat out returning All-American Alex Mackall for the starting spot and qualified for the NCAA Championships.

SHOOTING FOR THE SCHUYLER

-Heavyweight Sam Schuyler had a 10-match winning streak snapped against sixth-ranked Wyatt Hendrickson of Air Force. At 14-4 on the year, all of his losses have come against top-20 ranked wrestlers. During his 10-match win streak, two came by fall and two came by major decision.

DRESSER'S DEVELOPMENT

-Kevin Dresser inherited a team that finished tied for 57th at the 2017 NCAA Championships. Since then, Iowa State has finished T-45th, 16th and T-13th at the NCAA Championships, improving every year.

-Heading into the 2019-20 season, Coach Dresser's roster included one returning All-American and one returning Big 12 Champ. Over the past two seasons, Iowa State has produced four Big 12 Champs, eight All-Americans and one National Champion.

-The Cyclones have set and broken Iowa State's best Academic All-Big 12 number in school history the past two seasons, with 11 Academic All-Big 12 student-athletes this season.

#HILTON50

-The 2021-22 season marks the 50th anniversary of Hilton Coliseum. Throughout the year, Iowa State is honoring many memorable moments across sports that have taken place inside James H. Hilton Coliseum.

BOK CENTER

-Big 12 announced that the conference tournament will remain in Tulsa through the 2024 season. The BOK Center will also be the host site of the 2023 NCAA Championships.
