## THE LEAD

No. 4 Iowa State is back in Hilton for a pair of Big 12 duals against Oklahoma and No. 10 Oklahoma State Friday and Sunday, respectively. The Cyclones have won 14 Big 12 duals in a row dating back to the 2020-21 season.

## KEY STORYLINES

- Iowa State is No. 4 in the NWCA Coaches Poll, marking 12 consecutive weeks ranked inside the top 10, including six inside the top five.
- Friday's dual against Oklahoma is senior night. Five Cyclones - Joel Devine, Isaac Judge, Grant Stotts, Sam Schuyler and Marcus Coleman - will be recognized following Friday's dual against the Sooners.
- The Cyclones and Sooners will face off for the 100th time Friday night. ISU has wrestled Oklahoma more times than any other opponent in program history.
- Iowa State was off last weekend but sent 17 wrestlers to the North Country Open. Five Cyclones - Conor Knopick (125), Evan Frost (133), Casey Swiderski (141), MJ Gaitan (174) and Rowan Udell (197) - finished atop the podium.
- In its most recent dual, Iowa State was victorious, 31-9, at Utah Valley.
- ISU's last Big 12 dual loss came during the 2020-21 season against No. 5 Oklahoma State, 16-15. The Cyclones have won 14 league duals in a row.
- The Cyclones have won 23 of their last 25 duals dating back to last season, with the lone losses coming to No. 1 Penn State and No. 2 Iowa.
- Ten of Iowa State's dual opponents this season are ranked in the latest NWCA Coaches Poll, including seven inside the top 15 and three in the top five.
- David Carr has won 19 consecutive matches since his loss in the second round of the NCAA tournament last year. Seven of his 13 wins this season have come with bonus points, including three falls.
- Carr has 44 takedowns to his name this season and has only allowed one.
- Yonger Bastida leads the team with 53 takedowns this season.

## FROM THE NOTEBOOK

### BIG 12 COMPETITION CONTINUES

ISU resumes Big 12 competition against longtime conference foes Oklahoma and Oklahoma State. The Cyclones have won 14 consecutive conference duals dating back to the 2020-21 season (last loss: vs. #5 Oklahoma State, 16-15).

### CHALLENGING SCHEDULE

Iowa State's 2022-23 schedule is its toughest in recent history. Ten of Iowa State's dual opponents are ranked in the latest NWCA poll, including seven inside the top 15.

Iowa State has competed against the No. 1, 2 and 3 ranked teams in the country for the first time since the 2011-12 season.

Sunday's matchup against Oklahoma State will mark Iowa State's fourth top 10 dual of the year.

### BRODERSON COMING ON STRONG

Julien Broderon has solidified himself as Iowa State's starter at 174 pounds.

The junior missed ISU's last dual at Utah Valley due to injury but went 2-0 against Wyoming and Arizona State his last time out, both bonus-point victories. Broderon recorded a 22-second pin against Hayden Hastings (WYO), the fastest of his career and fastest by a Cyclone this season.

### HOMEGROWN

Ames native Marcus Coleman has won five straight matches since suffering his only loss of the year to Oregon State's Trey Munoz.

In New Orleans, Coleman bumped up a weight class to 197 pounds to defeat a 2022 U23 World Silver Medalist and No. 23 Jacob Cardenas, and backed that up with a win over two-time defending national champion and top-ranked Aaron Brooks of Penn State. He was named Big 12 and NCAA Wrestler of the Week for his efforts.

Coleman finished last season 22-6, picking up five victories at the NCAA Championships. Coleman had eight top 20 victories on the season, with his only six losses coming to wrestlers seeded in the top 17 at the NCAA Championships.

Coleman elected to use his extra year of eligibility and returned for his sixth season in 2022-23.

### RETURNING PRODUCTION

Iowa State returned 78 percent of its dual victories from last season to its 2022-23 lineup, as well as 97 percent of its scoring from the NCAA Championships.

2021 All-Americans David Carr, Yonger Bastida and Marcus Coleman are back on the roster for the 2022-23 campaign, which marks the first time since 2010 Iowa State returns three All-Americans to its lineup from the previous year.

### HOT ON THE RECRUITING TRAIL

Iowa State reloaded during the offseason and brought in the No. 2 ranked 2022 recruiting class in the nation according to MatScouts. The class was headlined by three top 20 recruits nationally (No. 3 Casey Swiderski, No. 14 MJ Gaitan, No. 19 Manny Rojas).

### NEW FACES MAKE EARLY IMPACT

Iowa State has 20 newcomers on the roster this season, including 18 freshmen.

Five different freshmen have seen mat time in ISU's first 11 duals and have posted a combined dual record of 15-7.

## FROM THE NOTEBOOK

### CARR MOVES TO 165 POUNDS

David Carr moved up a weight class from 157 to 165 this season. Carr, a 2021 national champion and three-time All-American at 157 pounds, is one of three former national champions and four finalists in the 165-pound weight class this season.

Carr seems to have made the adjustment well. He is 13-0 on the year and has six victories over a ranked opponent to his name, including five in the top 15.

Carr has won 19 consecutive matches since his loss in the second round of the NCAA tournament last year. Seven of his 13 wins this season have come with bonus points, including three falls.

### SWIDERSKI GETS THE BALL ROLLING

Casey Swiderski was off to a hot start in his career before he missed most of December with a shoulder injury. The freshman started 4-1 on the year with two wins over top 20 opponents in Campbell's No. 18 Shannon Hanna and Wisconsin's No. 11 Joseph Zargo.

Swiderski was the first commitment for Iowa State in its second-ranked 2022 recruiting class and was tabbed by MatScouts as the No. 3 prospect nationally.

He has four Michigan state titles to his name, all at different weight classes (103, 135, 145, 152), and posted a 166-3 high school record, including a 45-0 mark as a senior.

Swiderski is one of four Michigan prep wrestlers all-time to win four-time team and individual state titles. Also among the group is Iowa State assistant coach Brent Metcalf (2002-05).

### JOHNSON PUTS COUNTRY ON NOTICE

Freshman Paniro Johnson has put the college wrestling world on notice with a pair of top 6 wins this season and continues to go toe-to-toe with the nation's best.

### BIG BAD BASTIDA

One of ISU's most electric wrestlers to watch, Yonger Bastida is 10-1 on the year and is 5-1 against ranked wrestlers.

Bastida is best on his feet and leads the Cyclones with 53 takedowns on the year.

The Cuban and has been named Big 12 Wrestler of the Week once this season after a win over Iowa's then second ranked and 2022 NCAA Finalist Jacob Warner.

Bastida finished last season with a 25-7 record after finishing fifth at the NCAA Championships and the Big 12 Championship. Of his 25 victories on the year, 13 came via bonus points.

### SCHUYLER ANCHORS THE LINEUP

Heavyweight Sam Schuyler has his sights set on the podium in March and is off to an 8-2 start to the year with a pair of wins against top 12 wrestlers, Campbell's No. 12 Taye Ghadiali and Wisconsin's No. 11 Trent Hillger.

Schuyler missed some time in late December due to an arm injury but is 2-1 since his return. His only losses on the year are to wrestlers ranked in the top six nationally.

### DRESSER'S DEVELOPMENT

Kevin Dresser inherited a team that finished tied for 57th at the 2017 NCAA Championships. Since then, Iowa State has finished T-45th, 16th, T-13th and 17th at the NCAA Championships.

Heading into the 2019-20 season, Coach Dresser's roster included one returning All-American and one returning Big 12 Champ. Over the past two seasons, Iowa State has produced four Big 12 Champs, 11 All-Americans and one National Champion.

## CARR & TERUKINA WRESTLE AT NWCA ALL-STAR CLASSIC

David Carr and Kysen Terukina wrestled at the NWCA All-Star Classic last week in Austin, Texas. Terukina was pinned by Minnesota's No. 4 Pat McKee but Carr prevailed over Princeton's No. 1 (157) Quincy Monday, 2-1.

It was the first clash between Carr and Monday on the mat, but their fathers, Nate Carr and Kenny Monday, were rivals in their college days. Nate, a three-time national champion for the Cyclones in the early 1980s, defeated Kenny in overtime for two of his titles. Nate went on to win a 68kg bronze medal at the 1988 Olympics while Kenny won gold at 74kg.

## THE DRESSER BUMP

After an injury to heavyweight Sam Schuyler in a previous dual and no backup available, Coach Dresser was forced to get creative with his lineup if Iowa State had any hope of beating No. 12 Cornell at the Collegiate Duals.

Joel Devine, Marcus Coleman and Yonger Bastida all wrestled up a weight class at 184, 197 and 285 pounds, respectively, and rattled off three consecutive victories to win the dual for the Cyclones, 18-13.

In the heavyweight match to decide the dual, Bastida gave up nearly 60 pounds to his opponent, No. 15 Lewis Fernandes, but still came out on top, 4-2.

## IOWA STATE DOWNS NO. 12 WISCONSIN

Iowa State took eight of 10 matches from No. 12 Wisconsin in a 26-6 victory over the Badgers on the first weekend of the year.

Cyclone wrestlers defeated all five of Wisconsin's returning All-Americans and won seven matches against wrestlers ranked in the top 20 nationally at their weights.

Iowa State opened the dual with four consecutive wins against Badgers ranked inside the top 15 at their weights. Two freshman, Casey Swiderski (141) and Paniro Johnson (149), were responsible for a pair of those upsets.

## FEELIN' FROSTY

Jacob and Evan Frost are a combined 27-6 for the Cyclones this season, wrestling mainly in open tournaments.

The identical twins wrestled their senior seasons at Dowling Catholic High School in Des Moines, Iowa, but called Metairie, Louisiana home growing up. The pair moved from Louisiana to Iowa for a better and more high-profile wrestling experience. They each won three state titles in Louisiana and Evan added a fourth in Iowa while Jacob grabbed a runner-up finish as a senior.

### Carr Makes the U.S. National Team

Carr secured a spot on the U.S. Senior National Team over the summer and is one of five current collegiate athletes on the freestyle roster.

Carr also earned a spot on the U23 World Team and competed at the U23 World Championships in Pontevedra, Spain Oct. 22-23 but fell short of the podium.

Carr has two world medals to his name, a U20 gold (2019) and a U17 bronze (2016).

### Gaitan Earns U20 Pan-American Silver

Gaitan took home a silver medal from the U20 Pan-American Championships, held in Oaxtepec, Mexico, in July. The freshman cruised through the 77kg Greco-Roman bracket before eventually falling in the finals.
