THE LEAD

No. 3 Iowa State, wrestling its third dual in six days, closes out its dual schedule on the road at No. 11 Missouri Wednesday night. With a win, ISU can clinch its second consecutive finish atop the Big 12 dual standings.

KEY STORYLINES

- All eyes will be on the matchup at 165 pounds Wednesday for one of the most anticipated matches in the country this season: **No. 1 Keegan O'Toole vs. No. 2 David Carr**. Both wrestlers are undefeated this season and each has an NCAA title and junior world title to his name.
- Iowa State's 16 dual victories this season are its most since the 2007-08 season. With a win over Missouri, the Cyclones would have 17 dual victories for the first time since 2001-02.
- ISU has won 18 Big 12 duals in a row, its longest conference unbeaten streak in program history. It beats a previous best streak of 17 duals (16-0-1) by the Cyclones from 1962-65.
- The Cyclones haven't lost a Big 12 dual in over two calendar years with the last loss coming against Oklahoma State (1/30/21).
- The Cyclones have won 29 of their last 31 duals overall dating back to last season, with the lone losses coming to No. 1 Penn State and No. 2 Iowa.
- Iowa State remains No. 3 in the NWCA Coaches Poll, marking 15 consecutive weeks ranked inside the top 10, including nine inside the top five.
- ISU has five wins against top 15 opponents this season (#12 Wisconsin, #12 Cornell, #3 Arizona State, #10 Oklahoma State, #14 Northern Iowa).
- Ten of Iowa State's dual opponents this season are ranked in the latest NWCA Coaches Poll, including six inside the top 15 and three in the top five.
- David Carr has won 25 consecutive matches since his loss in the second round of the NCAA tournament last year. Per Fanco Wrestling, Carr's winning streak is tied for the fifth-longest active streak in Division I.
- Ten of Carr's 19 wins this season have come with bonus points, including six of his last nine. Carr has 70 takedowns to his name this season and has only allowed two.
- Sam Schuyler has been a reliable anchor for the Cyclones at heavyweight. In four duals this season, Iowa State's opponent has had a chance to win the dual in the final match and Schuyler's win sealed it for the Cyclones.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

BIG 12 DUAL STANDINGS AT STAKE

With a win against Missouri, ISU can clinch its second consecutive finish atop the Big 12 dual standings.

Iowa State has won 18 Big 12 duals in a row, its longest conference unbeaten streak in program history. It beats a previous best streak of 17 duals (16-0-1) by the Cyclones from 1962-65.

The Cyclones haven't lost a Big 12 dual in over two calendar years with the last loss coming against Oklahoma State (1/30/21).

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE

ISU has five wins against top 15 opponents this season (#12 Wisconsin, #12 Cornell, #3 Arizona State, #10 Oklahoma State, #14 Northern Iowa).

Ten of Iowa State's dual opponents this season are ranked in the latest NWCA Coaches Poll, including six inside the top 15 and three in the top five.

Iowa State has competed against the No. 1, 2 and 3 ranked teams in the country for the first time since the 2011-12 season.

HOMEGROWN

Marcus Coleman enters the dual with 91 career victories. With only one dual remaining in the season, the senior will need to stack wins in the Big 12 and NCAA Championships to become the 39th 100-match winner in ISU history.

In New Orleans, Coleman bumped up a weight class to 197 pounds to defeat a 2022 U23 World Silver Medalist and No. 23 Jacob Cardenas, and backed that up with a win over two-time defending national champion and top-ranked Aaron Brooks of Penn State. He was named Big 12 and NCAA Wrestler of the Week for his efforts.

Coleman finished last season 22-6, picking up five victories at the NCAA Championships. Coleman had eight top 20 victories on the season, with his only six losses coming to wrestlers seeded in the top 17 at the NCAA Championships.

Coleman elected to use his extra year of eligibility and returned for his sixth season in 2022-23.

NO WEIGHT CLASSES IN THE JUNGLE

Joel Devine has wins this season at 174, 184 and 197 pounds. He began the season at 174 pounds before eventually moving to 184. Against Oklahoma on senior night, Devine bumped up to 197 and picked up a win, despite weighing giving up 13 pounds.

RETURNING PRODUCTION

Iowa State returned 78 percent of its dual victories from last season to its 2022-23 lineup, as well as 97 percent of its scoring from the NCAA Championships.

2021 All-Americans David Carr, Yonger Bastida and Marcus Coleman are back on the roster for the 2022-23 campaign, which marks the first time since 2010 Iowa State returns three All-Americans to its lineup from the previous year.

HOT ON THE RECRUITING TRAIL

Iowa State reloaded during the offseason and brought in the No. 2 ranked 2022 recruiting class in the nation according to MatScouts. The class was headlined by three top 20 recruits nationally (No. 3 Casey Swiderski, No. 14 MJ Gaitan, No. 19 Manny Rojas).

CARR MOVES TO 165 POUNDS

All eyes will be on the matchup at 165 pounds Wednesday for one of the most anticipated matches in the country this season: **No. 1 Keegan O'Toole vs. No. 2 David Carr**. Both wrestlers are undefeated this season and each has an NCAA title and junior world title to his name.

Carr moved up a weight class from 157 to 165 this season. Carr, a 2021 national champion and three-time All-American at 157 pounds, is one of three former national champions and four finalists in the 165-pound weight class this season.

Carr seems to have made the adjustment well. He is 19-0 on the year and has 10 victories over a ranked opponent to his name, including seven in the top 15.

David Carr has won 25 consecutive matches since his loss in the second round of the NCAA tournament last year. Per Fanco Wrestling, Carr's winning streak is tied for the fifth-longest active streak in Division I.

SCHUYLER ANCHORS THE LINEUP

Heavyweight Sam Schuyler has been a reliable anchor for the Cyclones at heavyweight. In four duals this season, Iowa State's opponent has had a chance to win the dual in the final match and Schuyler's win sealed it for the Cyclones.

Schuyler has shown great improvement from last season to this season and has his sights set on the podium in March. He is 14-2 on the year with a notable win over No. 5 Dayton Pitzer of Pittsburgh.

Schuyler also has wins against two other top 12 wrestlers, Campbell's No. 12 Taye Ghadiali and Wisconsin's No. 11 Trent Hillger.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

SWIDERSKI GETS THE BALL ROLLING

Casey Swiderski was off to a hot start in his career before he missed most of December with a shoulder injury. The freshman started 4-1 on the year with two wins over top 20 opponents in Campbell's No. 18 Shannon Hanna and Wisconsin's No. 11 Joseph Zargo.

Swiderski snapped a streak of five straight losses with a win over No. 17 Danny Pucino of Illinois Sunday.

Swiderski was the first commitment for Iowa State in its second-ranked 2022 recruiting class and was tabbed by MatScouts as the No. 3 prospect nationally.

He has four Michigan state titles to his name, all at different weight classes (103, 135, 145, 152), and posted a 166-3 high school record, including a 45-0 mark as a senior.

Swiderski is one of four Michigan prep wrestlers all-time to win four-time team and individual state titles. Also among the group is Iowa State assistant coach Brent Metcalf (2002-05).

JOHNSON'S HOT START

Freshman Paniro Johnson put the college wrestling world on notice with a pair of top 6 wins early in the season and continues to go toe-to-toe with the nation's best.

During his gray-shirted 2021-22 season, Johnson compiled a 19-6 record and beat three previous NCAA qualifiers while competing for the CRITC. Out of high school, he rated as the No. 45 overall prospect in the class of 2021 by MatScouts and ranked No. 10 nationally at 145 pounds. Johnson is a four-time Pennsylvania High School state medalist.

BIG BAD BASTIDA

One of ISU's most electric wrestlers to watch, Yonger Bastida is 13-3 on the year and is 7-3 against ranked wrestlers.

Bastida is best on his feet and has 69 takedowns on the year.

The Cuban and has been named Big 12 Wrestler of the Week once this season after a win over Iowa's then second ranked and 2022 NCAA Finalist Jacob Warner.

Bastida finished last season with a 25-7 record after finishing fifth at the NCAA Championships and the Big 12 Championship. Of his 25 victories on the year, 13 came via bonus points.

DRESSER'S DEVELOPMENT

Kevin Dresser inherited a team that finished tied for 57th at the 2017 NCAA Championships. Since then, Iowa State has finished T-45th, 16th, T-13th and 17th at the NCAA Championships.

Heading into the 2019-20 season, Coach Dresser's roster included one returning All-American and one returning Big 12 Champ. Over the past two seasons, Iowa State has produced four Big 12 Champions, 11 All-Americans and one National Champion.

CARR & TERUKINA WRESTLE AT NWCA ALL-STAR CLASSIC

David Carr and Kysen Terukina wrestled at the NWCA All-Star Classic last week in Austin, Texas. Terukina was pinned by Minnesota's No. 4 Pat McKee but Carr prevailed over Princeton's No. 1 (157) Quincy Monday, 2-1.

It was the first clash between Carr and Monday on the mat, but their fathers, Nate Carr and Kenny Monday, were rivals in their college days. Nate, a three-time national champion for the Cyclones in the early 1980s, defeated Kenny in overtime for two of his titles. Nate went on to win a 68kg bronze medal at the 1988 Olympics while Kenny won gold at 74kg.

THE DRESSER BUMP

After an injury to heavyweight Sam Schuyler in a previous dual and no backup available, Coach Dresser was forced to get creative with his lineup if Iowa State had any hope of beating No. 12 Cornell at the Collegiate Duals.

Joel Devine, Marcus Coleman and Yonger Bastida all wrestled up a weight class at 184, 197 and 285 pounds, respectively, and rattled off three consecutive victories to win the dual for the Cyclones, 18-13.

In the heavyweight match to decide the dual, Bastida gave up nearly 60 pounds to his opponent, No. 15 Lewis Fernandes, but still came out on top, 4-2.

IOWA STATE DOWNS NO. 12 WISCONSIN

Iowa State took eight of 10 matches from No. 12 Wisconsin in a 26-6 victory over the Badgers on the first weekend of the year.

Cyclone wrestlers defeated all five of Wisconsin's returning All-Americans and won seven matches against wrestlers ranked in the top 20 nationally at their weights.

Iowa State opened the dual with four consecutive wins against Badgers ranked inside the top 15 at their weights. Two freshman, Casey Swiderski (141) and Paniro Johnson (149), were responsible for a pair of those upsets.

FEELIN' FROSTY

Jacob and Evan Frost are a combined 27-6 for the Cyclones this season, wrestling mainly in open tournaments.

The identical twins wrestled their senior seasons at Dowling Catholic High School in Des Moines, Iowa, but called Metairie, Louisiana home growing up. The pair moved from Louisiana to Iowa for a better and more high-profile wrestling experience. They each won three state titles in Louisiana and Evan added a fourth in Iowa while Jacob grabbed a runner-up finish as a senior.

Gaitan took home a silver medal from the U20 Pan-American Championships, held in Oaxtepec, Mexico, in July. The freshman cruised through the 77kg Greco-Roman bracket before eventually falling in the finals.
