## STORY LINES

## LAST TIME OUT

- The Baylor women's basketball team completed the series sweep of Kansas with a 77-73 win on Wednesday night inside the Ferrell Center.
- Baylor forced 20 turnovers by Kansas marking the seventh time this season the Bears have forced their opponent to turn the ball over at least 20 times.
- Four Bears reached double figures led by junior **Sarah Andrews** who turned in her sixth 20-plus point performance of the season, finishing with 23. She has reached double digits in the scoring column in all but three games this season and nine straight after Wednesday's outing.
- Per Her Hoop Stats, Andrews became just the fourth player in NCAA Division I since 2009-10 to earn at least 20 points, eight assists, three steals and three blocks in a single game and is the first to do so since 2019.
- Fifth-year **Caitlin Bickle** finished with 16 points – her second-highest output in a Big 12 game this season – while rookie **Bella Fontleroy** added 14 in her second-straight start.
- **Ja'Mee Asberry** joined Andrews with three steals of her own marking the fourth-straight outing the graduate has recorded a swipe.

## BACK 2 BACK

- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** is coming off her fourth Big 12 Freshman of the Week honor, and second-straight, entering the Iowa State game.
- Per Her Hoop Stats, Littlepage-Buggs joined Brittney Griner (8x) and Nina Davis (7x) as the only Baylor freshman since 2009-10 to earn five double-doubles in league games.
- She is the only rookie in the league to earn the award four times this season, and the first Bear since the 2016-17 campaign to be recognized four times when Lauren Cox earned the award the same amount that year.

## SUPER SENIOR

- In her fifth season at Baylor, **Caitlin Bickle** has continued to make a difference for the Bears, especially through the first nine Big 12 games for BU.
- During Big 12 play, Bickle ranks third in the league in rebounding, sitting at 9.3 rebounds per game.
- On the year, Bickle has reached double-figure scoring 11 times and double-figure rebounding on eight occasions, including three of the last five outings. She also has four double-doubles on the year, including three during conference play.

## THE REBOUNDING ROOKIE

- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** cruised to her fourth double-double in five games against the Jayhawks after posting a 12-point, 10-rebound performance against Kansas on Wednesday night.
- Littlepage-Buggs leads all Division I rookies in the country in rebounds per game, sitting at 9.0 per contest.
- Her nine double-doubles on the year are tied for the second most in the Big 12 with Iowa State's Ashley Joens.
- Littlepage-Buggs ranks third overall in the league in rebounding for the entire season and fourth in Big 12 action.

## TOUGH DEFENSE

- For the 2022-23 season, the Bears are holding their opponents to just 58.2 points per game which is the third fewest points allowed by teams in the Big 12. Additionally, BU is holding its opponents to just 26.5% shooting from behind the 3-point arc, which is the lowest shooting percentage from range in the league.
- Baylor has held six opponents to less than 20 points in the opening half this season, including a season-low 13 points scored by HCU in the opening 20 minutes on Dec. 4.
- The Bears have held four opponents (Incarnate Word, HCU, Tennessee State, No. 17 Oklahoma) to five or less points in at least one quarter, and an additional six teams to 10 or less in a frame.

## SHARING IS CARING

- In the Bears' win over Kansas State on Jan. 18, Baylor recorded an assist on 96.6% (28-of-29) of its made baskets, which was the highest percentage of assisted baskets in a Division I game this season.
- **Caitlin Bickle** led the way with a career-high eight assists, while **Jaden Owens** finished with seven and **Jana Van Gytenbeek** added four off the bench.

## STORY LINES

## SCOUTING THE SERIES AND THE CYCLONES

- Baylor holds the 32-9 advantage in the all-time series with Iowa State and has won 12 of the last 14 meetings dating back to the 2015-16 season.
- The Cyclones are the last opponent the Bears haven't faced this season.
- Iowa State carries a 15-5 record into Saturday's game, and is a perfect 10-0 at home this season. In Big 12 play, the Cyclones are tied for second in the league standings. The Cyclones are coming off a 78-77 loss at Kansas State on Wednesday night.
- Iowa State has four players averaging double figures, led by Ashley Joens' 20 points per game.

## WINNING BIG

- The 66-point margin of win over Tennessee State on Dec. 15 was the largest by BU this season and largest in the Nicki Collen era. It was the second-largest victory by the program since recording a 93-point win against McNeese on Dec. 19, 2020, and a 55-point victory over UTA on Dec. 7 of this year.
- The 93 points put up by the Bears against the Tigers were the most scored this season, behind the 92-point output against Saint Louis (Nov. 25) and 91 outpouring against UTA (Dec. 7). Additionally, it was the sixth time BU reached 90 in a game in the Collen era.
- The Bears rank second in the Big 12 and 22nd nationally in scoring margin (15.4).
- Baylor has won 10 games by 20-or-more points - including three in Big 12 action - and six of those wins have been by at least 25.

## APPLYING PRESSURE

- The Bears have forced their opponents to turn the ball over 20-plus times in seven games this season, most recently forcing 20 turnovers by Kansas on Feb. 1.
- The Bears forced 28 turnovers by the Lady Mavs on Dec. 7 - the most in a game by an opponent since McNeese turned the ball over 38 times in 2020.
- A total of 376 points by BU this season have been scored off of opponent turnovers.

## BALANCED EFFORT

- Nine of the 12 active players on BU's roster have posted double figures in at least one contest this year, and four of them have recorded double-digit points in 10 or more games.
- Six Bears have recorded double-doubles this season, led by freshman Darianna Littlepage-Buggs, who has had eight.
- For the fifth time this season, and first time in Big 12 play, five Bears reached double figures led by Jaden Owens and Littlepage-Buggs, who each notched 16 in the win over Texas Tech on Jan. 28.

## NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED

- The Bears and junior guard Sarah Andrews combined for five national honors the week of Jan. 9 after picking up a pair of top-25 wins on the road at Oklahoma (Jan. 3) and Kansas (Jan. 7).
- Baylor was named ESPN's National Team of the Week, U.S. Basketball Writers Association National Team of the Week and the NCAA.com Team of the Week.
- Andrews was selected as the ESPN National Player of the Week, as well as the Naismith Trophy Player of the Week.

## ANDREWS, LITTLEPAGE-BUGGS SWEEP BIG 12 HONORS

- Sarah Andrews and Darianna Littlepage-Buggs were named the Big 12 Player and Big 12 Freshman of the Week, respectively, on Jan. 9. The award was the first career weekly honor for Andrews, while Littlepage-Buggs picked up her second recognition of the season.
- Andrews recorded a career-high 30 points against Oklahoma, becoming the fifth player in the Big 12, and first in conference play, to turn in a 30-point performance this season. In the win at Kansas, the guard notched her second-highest scoring output of the year, finishing with a game-high 27 points.
- After limited action against the Sooners due to foul trouble, Littlepage-Buggs turned in her fifth double-double of the year at Kansas, finishing with 17 points and 13 rebounds. Littlepage-Buggs added four steals against the Jayhawks becoming the first freshman Bear since the 2013-14 season to earn 15-plus points, 10-plus rebounds and four steals in a game.

## IN THE REARVIEW

- The Bears went 9-3 during the non-conference portion of their schedule to start the 2022-23 campaign.
- The nine wins marked the 23rd-straight year that BU has recorded at least nine victories in the non-con to start a season. The last time the Bears won less than nine games was during the 1998-99 slate when they went 8-4 against opponents outside of the league.
- The four top-25 matchups in the first 12 games marked the most since the 2016-17 slate.
- BU grabbed a top-25 win over Villanova at the Florida Gulf Coast Showcase on Nov. 26. All three of the Bears' setbacks have been to teams in the AP Top 25.
- The Bears have used six different lineups this season due to ongoing unavailability of players throughout the year.
- The Bears went 7-1 at the Ferrell Center in non-conference games. The eight home games marked the second time in the last five seasons BU has hosted that many non-con opponents to start a season.

## STORY LINES

## DYNAMIC DUO

- The freshman duo of **Bella Fontleroy** and **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** have been large contributors to the success of the 2022-23 BU squad.
- The pair combined for three of the first five Big 12 Freshman of the Week honors this season and six of the 13 handed out by the league.
- Fontleroy ranks third on the team with 11 games in double figures, while Littlepage-Buggs earned her fourth Big 12 Freshman of the Week honor on Jan. 30 after her eighth double-double (16 points, 10 rebounds) at Texas Tech on Jan. 28.

## BENCH BREAKS THROUGH

- Baylor's bench has outscored its opponents', 354-267, this season, and in 13 of 21 contests thus far.
- Led by freshman **Bella Fontleroy**, the rookie ranks fifth on the team in scoring (9.3 ppg). Of her 195 points scored this season, 71 (39%) of them have been accounted for in the fourth quarter.
- Transfer **Jana Van Gytenbeek** had a season-best performance off the bench in BU's 91-36 victory over UTA on Dec. 7. The junior scored a season-high 15 points, going 6-for-6 from the floor and a perfect 3-for-3 from 3-point range, while adding four assists and a pair of steals.

## BUGGS MAKES BIG STATEMENT

- With a 30-point, 11-rebound outing against Tennessee State on Dec. 15, **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** became the first Division I player in the country to outscore a Division I opponent by herself this season. Additionally, she became just the fourth in the Big 12 to do so since the 1999-00 campaign.
- With her performance, Littlepage-Buggs became the first Big 12 and Baylor freshman to outscore an opponent by herself since **Brittney Griner** did so in 2009-10.
- She was the first Bear to reach the 30-point plateau since **NaLyssa Smith** poured in 37 against Oklahoma on March 12, 2022.
- Littlepage-Buggs became just the third player in the Big 12 to notch 30 points in a game this year, behind Gabby Gregory (Kansas State) and Ashley Joens (Iowa State).

## RECOGNIZING THE ROOKIE, AGAIN

- **Bella Fontleroy** was named the Big 12 Freshman of the Week on Dec. 5 for the second time this season. She led all rookies in the league in scoring (17.0 ppg), rebounds (11.0 rbg) and field-goal percentage (.600).
- The Springfield, Missouri, native poured in a game- and team-high 17 points in the 79-35 win over HCU on Dec. 4, matching a career-high in the category.
- Fontleroy accounted for more than half of BU's 29 bench points in the 44-point victory, scoring nine of her 17 points in the fourth quarter.
- With a career-high 11 rebounds, she recorded her first-career double-double in the outing, and she has reached double-figure scoring in nine of 14 contests this season.

## FIGHT IN FLORIDA

- Baylor played three games in three days, including a pair of matchups with top-25 opponents, at the Gulf Coast Showcase, Nov. 25-27, in Estero Florida.
- Senior **Jaden Owens** was named to the 2022 Gulf Coast Showcase All-Tournament Team after a career outing at the event. She notched a career-high 17 points in the win over Villanova before surpassing that with 22 points against Michigan. On the weekend, she averaged 16.7 points per game and shot 60.6% from the floor.
- The Bears advanced to the championship game, falling to an undefeated Michigan team, 84-75.
- The contest marked the first time since the 2016-17 campaign that the Bears played a trio of non-conference regular-season games in a four-game span against teams in the AP Top 25 (Maryland, Saint Louis (NR), Villanova, Michigan)

## NEW KID ON THE BLOCK

- **Bella Fontleroy** was tabbed the Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Week on Nov. 14 after averaging 14.0 points, 5.5 rebounds and shooting 61.1% from the floor as the Bears picked up a pair of wins to start the year.
- After a big performance in her debut, Fontleroy earned her first career start against Incarnate Word, finishing in double-digit scoring with 11 points, becoming the first Big 12 rookie to post back-to-back double-digit scoring games this season.
- In Baylor's win over SMU, the Springfield, Missouri, native sank a 3-pointer in the corner to give BU a five-point cushion with a minute to play, before helping the Bears secure the 58-55 win.

## HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

- The Bears rank No. 20 nationally in total home attendance, and fourth among Big 12 teams, welcoming over 55,600 fans into the Ferrell Center their 13 home games this year.
- In the **Nicki Collen** era, Baylor is 24-5 in home games and an impressive 11-3 in Big 12 contests at the Ferrell Center under the direction of Collen.
- Baylor has won 72 of the last 74 non-conference games at the Ferrell Center, including 15 NCAA Tournament contests.
- It's last non-conference loss during the regular season at home prior to the 73-68 setback to No. 19 Maryland (Nov. 20) came Jan. 13, 2014 vs. UConn (66-55).
- The Bears suffered a 61-47 setback to South Dakota in the second round of the 2022 NCAA Tournament.

## STARTING STRONG

- The Bears have won 13-straight season openers, courtesy of the 88-50 victory over Lamar at the Ferrell Center on Nov. 7. Baylor's last season-opening loss was during the 2009-10 season to then-No. 9/8 Tennessee on the road, falling 74-65. The Bears were ranked No. 7/4 to start the year.
- Baylor's match-up with Lamar marked the 13th-consecutive year the Bears started their season at home. Baylor has won 18-straight home openers, dating back to the 2005-06 campaign.

## WELCOME HOME

- Eight new faces joined the Baylor program in the offseason. **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs**, who was tabbed the Preseason Big 12 Freshman of the Year, is joined by **Kyla Abraham** and **Bella Fontleroy** in the rookie class that was ranked No. 9 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.
- A transfer from Missouri who was named Preseason Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, **Aijha Blackwell** adds depth alongside **Jana Van Gytenbeek** (Stanford), **Erika Porter** (Illinois), **Catarina Ferreira** (Eastern Arizona College) and **Dre'Una Edwards** (Kentucky), who all joined the Bears in the offseason.

## PLAYERS TO WATCH

- A trio of Bears were named to preseason watch lists published by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame and Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) as a part of the Women's Starting Five.
- Returner **Ja'Mee Asberry** landed a spot on the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award Watch List, which recognizes the top shooting guard in women's NCAA Division I basketball.
- Additionally **Blackwell** and **Edwards** were selected to the Cheryl Miller (small forward) and the Katrina McClain (power forward) Award Watch Lists, respectively.
- Players can play their way onto and off the five lists at any point during the 2022-23 season. In late January, the watch list of 20 players per award will be narrowed down to just 10 and then five in late February.

## ANOTHER DAY, ANOTHER WATCH LIST

- Newcomer **Aijha Blackwell** was one of 50 to land herself a spot on the 2023 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Women's Watch List on Nov. 4 and the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 Watch List on Nov. 15.
- The midseason 30 team will be announced in early January, and then the competition will be narrowed down to 10 national semifinalists in early March. Following those results, four finalists will be named on March 21, 2023, and the winner of the 2023 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy for Women's Player of the Year will be announced on March 29, 2023.
- The players on the Wooden Award Watch List are considered strong candidates for the 2023 John R. Wooden Award Women's Player of the Year presented by Wendy's. The National Ballot consists of 15 top players who have proven to their universities that they meet or exceed the qualifications of the Wooden Award. The Wooden Award All American Team™ will be announced the week of the Elite Eight round of the NCAA Tournament. The winner of the 2023 John R. Wooden Award will be presented in Los Angeles in April.

## HEAD COACH NICKI COLLEN • 2ND SEASON



Nicki Collen was introduced as the fifth Head Coach in Baylor women's basketball history on May 5, 2021 and is in her second season at the helm in 2022-23.

In her first season with the Bears, Collen recorded the most wins by a rookie head coach in the country with 28. She helped lead the Bears to their 12th-straight Big 12 regular-season title and their 11th-straight top-two seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Collen implemented her system, which featured more perimeter shooting. Baylor went from the bottom of the list nationally to just outside the top 50 in 3-pointers made. In her first season, the Bears set new program records for 3-pointers made (233) and attempted (678).

From her introductory press conference, the Naismith Coach of the Year semifinalist said the Bears would be playing their best basketball late in the season, and she was right. Baylor became the first team to defeat a ranked opponent twice in a three-day span since 1999 when the Bears downed Texas two times to open the month of February. Two weeks later, exactly a month after sitting at the bottom of the conference standings with an 0-2 record, BU was back atop the league's leaderboard.

Collen implemented the 1-0 mentality that paid off with a 25-point win at No. 8 Iowa State in front of a nearly sold-out crowd of 13,000 raucous fans which clinched the conference crown. Baylor became the first team since Texas Tech in 2000 to start a Big 12 season 0-2 and go on to win the league.

After her first season ended in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, Collen saw three of her players be selected in the 2022 WNBA Draft, tying a program record. Two of them - NaLyssa Smith (No. 2) and Queen Egbo (No. 10) marked the first duo to be taken in the top 10 in program history.

Collen's first recruiting class was ranked No. 9 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.

Collen came to Baylor from the WNBA's Atlanta franchise, where she spent the last three seasons at the helm for the Dream. Her rookie season in Atlanta resulted in a 23-11 season in 2018, where she earned WNBA Coach of the Year honors and helped the franchise to the WNBA Playoff Semifinals.

Prior to her arrival in Atlanta, she spent two seasons under former head coach Curt Miller of the Connecticut Sun, helping the franchise improve from fifth in the East Division to second from 2016 to 2017, respectively.

"I am thrilled to be the head coach at Baylor University. I believe it is the top job in the country for women's basketball," said Collen. "I am excited to begin working with this extremely talented team and I am grateful for the unwavering support of President Livingstone and Mack Rhoades. The success of this program speaks for itself, and I will begin working today to ensure Baylor women's basketball continues to be a program that excels at the highest levels."

Collen's collegiate coaching career spanned for nine seasons prior to her WNBA arrival. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Colorado State from 2000-2002, one season at Ball State from 2002-2003, one at Louisville from 2003-2004, three at Arkansas from 2011-2014 and two at Florida Gulf Coast from 2014-2016.

Her teams' combined record in nine seasons as an NCAA Division I assistant was 214-74, good for a .743 win percentage. As an assistant, Collen guided four different squads to the NCAA Tournament, reaching the second round in three of those seasons.

She spent six of her nine seasons as an assistant under her husband, Tom Collen's head-coaching tenures at Colorado State, Louisville and Arkansas. She also coached under Tracy Roller at Ball State and Karl Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast. Collen helped the FGCU program to a 64-9 record and the school's first NCAA Tournament win in her two-year tenure.

In her nine seasons at the collegiate level, Collen coached three All-Americans and saw three players selected in the WNBA Draft.

Collen's collegiate playing career began at Purdue in 1993-94, when the Boilermakers made an NCAA Final Four run with a 29-5 overall record and a 16-2 mark in the Big Ten. Her sophomore season, Purdue made another deep run with an Elite Eight appearance to go with a 24-8 overall record. She transferred to Marquette, where she tallied 421 assists in her final two seasons, averaging 7.0 per game in her last 60 collegiate games. She helped the Golden Eagles to two-straight NCAA Tournament appearances in 1997 and 1998.

Nicki and her husband Tom have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan.

## TEAM NOTES

- Baylor has out-rebounded its opponents in 202 of the last 220 games, and 15 of 21 games in 2022-23.
- Baylor is 259-2 all-time when shooting 50 percent or better from the field and 40-0 when shooting 60 percent or higher. The Bears' last lost when shooting over 50 percent was to No. 22 Michigan on 11/27/22.
- 346 of Baylor's wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 23 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.
- Since the 2010-11 season, Baylor is 44-7 vs. Top 25 opponents at the Ferrell Center.
- Baylor is 344-103 (.770) vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season all-time.

## THE BAYLOR BEARS REGIME

## 2019 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2018-19 Bears became just the third women's program in NCAA history to win three titles when Baylor beat Notre Dame, 82-81, April 7 in Tampa, Florida. **Chloe Jackson's** go-ahead scoop layup with under five seconds left propelled her to NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player honors to go along with a team-high 26 points in the game. The Bears rode the wave of two All-American posts with **Kalani Brown** and **Lauren Cox**, each earning multiple all-America honors. The pair led Baylor to its 10th regular-season and tournament championship in the Big 12 and **Kim Mulkey** was honored as national coach of the year by the USBWA, the Associated Press and the WBCA.

## 2012 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2011-12 Bear season was as perfect as it could be. En route to claiming its second NCAA Championship in seven years, Baylor ran the table, posting an unprecedented 40-0 mark and claiming both Big 12 Conference crowns. **Brittney Griner** and Mulkey swept player of the year and coach of the year honors, earning WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, Naismith and Big 12 Conference recognition. Baylor was ranked No. 1 wire-to-wire in both polls and raced through conference play with a Big 12-record 18-0 mark. Griner and **Odyssey Sims** were named consensus All-Americans, while **Destiny Williams** was a WBCA All-America honorable mention honoree.

## 2005 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The squad posted a 33-3 record and claimed the Big 12 Conference title with a 14-2 mark. En route to the program's first NCAA Championship, the Bears defeated three No. 1 seeds. **Steffanie Blackmon** and **Sophia Young** were both named All-Americans. In addition to earning Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, **Mulkey** received the New York Athletic Club's prestigious Winged Foot Award.

## NCAA TOURNAMENT STAPLE &amp; 11-PLUS YEAR DOMINANCE

- The Bears have made 18-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and 20 overall. Those appearances have resulted in three national championships (2005, 2012, 2019), four Final Fours (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019), 10 Elite Eights and 14 Sweet Sixteens.
- The Bears are 24-time Big 12 Champions-- most in Big 12 history --capturing 12-consecutive regular season titles, 13 overall & 11 tournament titles.
- Baylor is 396-35 (.928) over the past 12 seasons while posting a 202-12 mark in Big 12 play and 29-2 in Big 12 Tournament play.
- 335 of Baylor's 396 wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 19 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.

## BIG 12 DYNASTY

- Baylor women's basketball has won a league-leading 24 Big 12 Conference titles -- 13 regular season and 11 tournament championships.
- Baylor has run the table in the conference four times (2012, 2013, 2018, 2019). It has only happened six times in Big 12 history (Oklahoma: 16-0 in 2006; Nebraska: 16-0 in 2010).
- Baylor has advanced to the Big 12 Championship game 11 times in a row and 15 times in program history.
- The Bears have won eight of the last 10 Big 12 Championship titles, last besting No. 17/20 West Virginia, 76-50, in the 2021 final.
