## THE LEAD

No. 12 Iowa State will be looking to get back into the win column and continue its unbeaten campaign at Hilton Coliseum on Saturday against Baylor. The Cyclones are coming off a 78-77 setback at Kansas State on Wednesday night, moving into a tie for third place with the Bears in the Big 12 standings.

## KEY STORYLINES

■ Iowa State was led by 18 points from Lexi Donarski. Over the Cyclones' last three games, Donarski is averaging 14.3 points per game, and is shooting 42.4 percent from the field in that stretch.
■ Ashley Joens, the defending Big 12 Player of the Week, finished with 17 points at K-State on Wednesday night. Joens leads the Big 12 with 20.0 points per game and averages 9.3 rebounds per game, tallying nine double-doubles across the season.

- On Monday, Joens was named to the Wooden Award Late Season Top 20, in addition to claiming her Big 12 Player of the Week distinction.
- Nyamer Diew had one of her best games as a Cyclone at Kansas State, recording her first career double-double with a season-high-matching 14 points and a career-best 14 rebounds, an effort which included six offensive rebounds.

■ As a team, Iowa State went 13-of-13 from the free throw line, tied for the secondbest free throw shooting effort as a team under head coach Bill Fennelly (14-14 vs. West Virginia, Feb. 24, 2021).
■ The Cyclones rank second nationally with a team free throw shooting percentage of 79.9 percent. The effort is led by Emily Ryan, who is 92.3 percent from the line to rank eighth nationally. Donarski is 92.9 percent, but does not meet the minimum free throws for the national rankings.

- With a win on Saturday, head coach Bill Fennelly would become the 27th coach in NCAA Women's Basketball history to reach 750 career wins, the 13th to get all 750 at Division I programs and would be one of nine active coaches at 750 victories.
- Emily Ryan leads the Big 12 with 35.3 minutes played per game, posting eight 'complete games' this season and 22 for her career.

## LAST TIME OUT

No. 12 Iowa State was unable to hold onto a double figures lead built across the first half, falling at Kansas State 78-77 Wednesday night. The Cyclones were up 34-23 with three minutes left in the first half, but found themselves down as much as seven in the final period. ISU was able to tie it at 64-64, but unable to retake the lead.
■ In defeat, Iowa State was led by Lexi Donarski, who finished with 18 points on 7-of-14 shooting.
■ Ashley Joens contributed 17 points to the Cyclone effort, 13 of them coming in the second half.

- Nyamer Diew had one of her best games as a Cyclone, posting her first career double-double with a season-highmatching 14 points and a career-best 14 rebounds (including six offensive boards).
- Denae Fritz had her third-straight game in double figures, finishing with 12 points, including going 5-of-5 from the free throw line.
■ Fritz led ISU to a 13 -for-13 evening as a team from the charity stripe, the second-best free throw shooting effort by Iowa State in the Bill Fennelly Era.


## REIGNING FROM THREE

As has been the case for decades, Iowa
State is once again one of the top 3-point shooting teams in the country.

- The Cyclones are currently eighth in the country at 9.03 -pointers per game. That effort has been led in part by Ashley Joens, who leads the team with 57 3-pointers.
- Iowa State was second in the country in 2021-22 with 357 made 3-pointers. ISU has at least 103 -pointers 17 times, including a school-record-tying 19 against Prairie View A8M (Dec. 19, 2021) and at TCU (Feb. 12, 2022).
■ Iowa State's 357 surpassed the previous school record for 3-pointers in a season of 303 by the 2018-19 squad and the old Big 12 record of 325 by Kansas State's 2012-13 team.
- Ashley Joens (91) and Lexi Donarski (88) led ISU's 3-point barrage. They were the only duo in program history to hit at least 80 treys in a season, and the only pair in the country in 2021-22 with at least 853 -pointers apiece.


## A HISTORIC SQUAD

The 2021-22 Cyclones were the winningest squad in program history.

- Iowa State's 28 wins were a new program record, breaking the previous mark of 27 done three times (1999-00, 2000-01, 2008-09).
- Iowa State's 25 regular season (preconference tournament] victories were the most in school history.
■ Iowa State reached 14 conference wins for the first time in program history.


## JOENS CLIMBING UP THE RECORD BOARDS

Ashley Joens is now Iowa State's all-time leading scorer, but there are still many other records and milestones the Cyclone star is after.

## JOENS AMONG NCAA'S TOP ACTIVE CAREER LEADERS

Along with the Iowa State record books, Ashley Joens is also among the current NCAA active career leaders in multiple categories.
■ Joens is Division I's active career scoring leader with 2,769 points, while her 19.0 points per game is good for sixth place.

- She is also the Division I active career leader in free throws made (655).
■ Joens ranks second among career active leaders in rebounds (1,267), free throws attempted (790), double-doubles (58) and field goals attempted $(2,101)$ and is third in field goals made (901).
- Joens is the only active NCAA women's basketball player across all divisions with at least 2,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds. She is one of three players at 2,000 points and 900 rebounds, both of whom ISU has played this season (Maddy Siegrist, Villanova \& Madi Williams, Oklahoma).
- Joens is also making her way up the NCAA's all-time career scoring list, currently in 31st place and in range of passing a few notable names.

## KEEPING UP WITH JOENS

By deciding to return for a fifth season, Ashley Joens begins the season as one of the most well-known and familiar players in the country, having been a multi-time All-Big 12, All-American and Cheryl Miller Award Winner.

- The midseason award lists have begun to come out and Joens is featuring on those, being named to the Wooden Award Late Season Top 20.
- In the preseason, Joens was named to the Preseason Associated Press All-America Team, the Big 12 Preseason Player of the Year, the All-Big 12 Preseason Team, the Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Watch List Wooden Award Preseason Top 50, the Wade Trophy "Wade Watch" and the Cheryl Miller Award Watch List.

■ 2021-22 saw her get a promotion to Second Team All-America from both the Associated Press and USBWA.

## LEXI DONARSKI: COMPLETE PLAYER

Along with her exploits on defense, FirstTeam All-Big 12 selection Lexi Donarski has been one of Iowa State's most consistent performers on offense.

- Donarski became the 33rd player in Iowa State history to reach 1,000 career points, doing so vs. West Virginia (Jan. 4, 2023).
- She has scored in double figures in her career 57 times, going over 20 points 14 times.
- Donarski led Iowa State with 20 points, including four 3-pointers, in ISU's NCAA Second Round win over Georgia (Mar. 20, 2022).


## LEXI DONARSKI SAYS STOP!

Along with being one of Iowa State's leading scorers, Big 12 Defensive Player of the Year Lexi Donarski made a name for herself as one of the Big 12 and country's top defenders.
■ In Big 12 games in 2021-22, the player Donarski was primarily responsible for defending averaged 9.3 points per game. The group came into their games against the Cyclones combining to average 14.7 points per game.
■ As shown below, Donarski's defense is not just limited to keeping points off the board, the ball tends to stay away from wherever Donarski is on-court.

Iowa State has been in the top-5 in attendance nationally for the last 13 recorded seasons (2020-21 attendance not recorded due to Covid-19). ISU currently ranks fourth in the country with 9,897 fans per game.


The Cyclones have made at least one three-point field goal in an NCAA record 882 consecutive games, a streak which encapsulates the entirety of the Bill Fennelly Era at Iowa State.


## WELCOME TO THE EMILY RYAN DISH-TRIBUTION CENTER!

Iowa State point guard Emily Ryan is one of the best distributors of the basketball in the country and her teammates have benefited from it.

- Ryan's 6.8 assists per game is good for 10th nationally, while her 2.25 assist-toturnover ratio is at 4lst in the country.

■ Last season, Ryan's 7.1 assists per game ranked atop the Big 12 and was third nationally.

- Ryan is Iowa State's single-season record holder for assists, with her 249 dimes in 2021-22 ranking fourth in Big 12 history.
- Ryan has three double-doubles on the year, one being points-assists, the other two points-rebounds.
- Ryan is the sixth player in the Bill Fennelly Era to record double-doubles two different ways in the same season (Nikki Moody, 2013-14; Alison Lacey 2007-08 and 200910; Anne O'Neil, 2004-05; Lyndsey Medders, 2004-05; and Megan Taylor, 1999-00).
- Ryan's 17 assists at TCU (Feb. 12, 2022) broke ISU's school record and tied for the most in a Big 12 conference game in league history.

## EMILY RYAN TRIPLE-DOUBLE WATCH

Emily Ryan's multi-faceted game means that there have been multiple occasions this season when she has been on the verge of getting a triple double.

- Ryan had a close call against Kansas State (Jan. 11, 2023), finishing with 14 points, a career-best 11 rebounds and eight assists.
- Her closest call came against Villanova (Dec. 18, 2022), when she finished with 16 points, 10 assists and nine rebounds.
- Against Columbia (Nov. 20, 2022), she finished with 13 points, eight rebounds and nine assists.
■ At Texas Tech (Dec. 31, 2022), Ryan had her first career 10 -rebound game, also finishing with 15 points and six assists.
■ At Oklahoma (Jan. 8, 2023), she was close in all three areas, finishing with nine points, eight rebounds and eight assists.
■ There have been three triple-doubles in Iowa State history, the most recent by Nikki Moody vs. Wyoming on Nov. 28, 2014 (14 pts., 10 reb., 11 ast.).


## EMILY RYAN: THE SCORING THREAT

While being one of the top distributors in the country, Emily Ryan has grown more comfortable with calling her own number and giving herself scoring opportunities, ranking fourth on ISU in 2022-23 with 11.4 points per game.
■ Ryan has become ISU's most reliable option from the free throw line, going 60-of-65 at the free throw line (92.3 percent) to rank seventh nationally.

- Ryan got her scoring rolling for the 2022-23 campaign against Southern (Nov. 10, 2022), finishing with 19 points on 6-of-8 shooting.
■ At Iowa (Dec. 7, 2022), Ryan put away a season-best four 3-pointers.
■ At West Virginia (Mar. 5, 2022), Ryan recorded a career-best 29 points, going 10-of-12 from the field.
- Against Oklahoma State (Feb. 5, 2022), Ryan finished with 18 points on six 3 -pointers, six rebounds, six assists and three steals. She was the only player in the country last season to have at least six treys, six boards, six dimes and three swipes in the same game.


## LEADING FROM THE LINE

Very few teams take care of business from the free throw line quite like Iowa State.

■ Iowa State ranks second in the country with a team free throw percentage of 79.9 percent.

- At Kansas State (Feb. 1, 2023), Iowa State went 13-of-13 from the line, the 27th time under Bill Fennelly the Cyclones were perfect at the charity stripe, with 13 -for- 13 being the secondbest overall (14-14, Feb. 24, 2021 vs. West Virginia).
- Against SIUE (Nov. 29, 2022), the Cyclones went 18-of-19 (94.7 percent) from the line.

■ Emily Ryan ranks seventh in the country with her 92.3 FT percentage.
■ Lexi Donarski is 92.9 percent from the line, but does not meet the NCAA minimum ( $2.5 \mathrm{FTMs} / \mathrm{game}$ ) to be ranked.

- The Cyclones finished 2021-22 third in the country with a team free throw percentage of 81.0 percent (the llthbest season percentage in NCAA Division I history).
■ Iowa State set a school record for free-throw percentage in a season in 2020-21, shooting at an 82.7 percent clip, which ranks fourth in NCAA Division I single-season history.


## ALL ABOARD THE KANE TRAIN!

Redshirt senior Morgan Kane was one of ISU's breakout players in 2021-22 and has stepped back up with big contributions in the absence of Stephanie Soares.

- Kane has started each of the last five games, and is averaging 7.8 ppg and 5.8 rpg across 19.2 minutes per contest.
- Over the season, Kane has averaged 12.9 minutes per contest with 4.7 points and 4.1 rebounds per game while shooting 60.7 percent from the field.
- She is particularly effective on the offensive glass, with 40.2 percent of her rebounds in 2022-23 and 39.8 percent of her career boards coming via the offensive glass.
- Kane went from having no career starts or scored in double figures heading into 2021-22, to making 30 starts and scoring in double figures 11 times.
- Kane has two career double-doubles after posting 15 points and 10 rebounds at Oklahoma State (Jan. 15, 2022). She had 13 points and a career-best 11 rebounds vs. UNI (Dec. 12, 2021).


## SOARES' IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Iowa State senior Stephanie Soares will miss the remainder of the season after tearing the ACL in her left knee at Oklahoma (Jan. 8, 2023). While it is uncertain whether she will get another season in Cardinal \& Gold, her impact in the 13 games she did play was impressive.
■ Even with playing just two minutes at OU, Soares averaged 14.4 points per game at 54.4 percent shooting and 9.9 rebounds per game, recording eight double-doubles.
■ Soares was one of the top shot blockers in the country, recording 39 blocks (3.0 per game], which was in the top-five nationally at the time of her injury.
■ Soares was named the Big 12 Player of the Week after averaging 21.0 ppg and 11.5 rpg at the Phil Knight Invitational.

■ Against Michigan State (Nov. 24, 2022), Soares finished with 23 points, 11 rebounds and six blocks, the fourth game in school history with a player having at least 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks.
■ In her Iowa State debut vs. Cleveland State (Nov. 7, 2022), Soares filled the stat sheet with 15 points, 14 rebounds, four blocks, four steals and three assists.

- At UNI (Nov. 16, 2022), Soares had an efficient 23 points on 9-of-11 shooting (3-for-3 3-pointers) in just 26 minutes.


## NATION'S LONGEST 3-POINT STREAK

■ The Iowa State women's basketball team has the nation's longest streak for consecutive games with a 3-pointer, sitting at 882 .
■ The streak began on Feb. 19, 1995 at Colorado when Tara Gunderson netted a triple. The first three games of the streak came prior to the start of Bill Fennelly's tenure as Iowa State head coach.
■ Iowa State has made 7,131 triples over the course of the streak and made 10 or more in a game 269 times.
■ Iowa State has hit 200 or more 3 -pointers in a season 20-straight seasons, which is an NCAA record.
■ Iowa State hit 357 triples in 2021-22 season, reaching the 300s for the fourth time in program history.

## \#HILTONMAGIC

The Cyclones have been phenomenal at home during Bill Fennelly's tenure, compiling a 365-79 record (.822) in Hilton Coliseum, including a 182-8 (.957) mark against regular-season non-conference opponents. Iowa State has gone undefeated at home three times, most recently during the 2004-05 season.

■ Iowa State has won 12-straight at Hilton Coliseum, the 15th time under Fennelly the Cyclones have won at least 10-straight at home.

- Iowa State's 16 wins at Hilton Coliseum in 2021-22 tied for the third-most in a season in school history.
■ ISU's 5-0 non-con home record this year marked the 22nd time Iowa State has gone undefeated at home in regular season non-conference contests under head coach Bill Fennelly.


## HERE FOR THE LONG HAUL

The Iowa State women's basketball coaching staff is the longest tenured full staff in the country.
■ The Iowa State staff of head coach Bill Fennelly, associate head coach Jodi Steyer, assistant coaches Latoja Schaben and Billy Fennelly and director of operations Josh Carper are in their 13th season together.

## COMING SOON TO HILTON COLISEUM

While all eyes are on the here and now and the 2022-23 season, the future is bright for Iowa State as the Cyclones signed the No. 13 signing class of 2023 that will join the program in 2023-24.
■ ISU's top ranked recruit, Derby, Kansas' Addy Brown (No. 31 in the ESPNw/Hoop Gurlz Class of 2023 rankings) was named to the McDonald's High School All-American Game, joining Lexi Donarski (2020) as Cyclones to earn the honor.

- Brown is one of three top-60 recruits in ISU's Class of 2023 according to ESPNw/ Hoop Gurlz, also being joined by Jalynn Bristow (No. 47) and Audi Crooks (No. 57).

■ The Cyclones' other two additions, Arianna Jackson and Kelsey Joens are both in the Jr. All-Star Girls Basketball Top 100 for the Class of 2023 along with their three counterparts.
