## THE LEAD

No. 24 Iowa State hits the road after a two-game homestand to take on the Texas Tech Lady Raiders. The Cyclones entered the AP Top 25 poll for the first time this season after taking down then-No. 24 West Virginia (74-64) and then-No. 4 Baylor (66-63).

## KEY STORYLINES

- Five games into the Big 12 schedule, Iowa State sits atop league standings with a 5-0 record, tied with No. 12 Kansas State.
- It is the seventh time in program history the Cyclones have started the conference slate with five-straight wins.
- ISU has only started conference play 6-0 once. The 1999-2000 team opened league play with a 6-0 record but dropped to 6-1 following a 58-49 loss to Kansas in Lawrence on Jan. 29.
- The Cyclones were named both ESPN Women's Basketball Power Rankings Team of the Week and the USBWA National Team of the Week.
- ISU freshman Audi Crooks was named the Big 12 Player of the Week, the first time a Cyclone freshman has earned the league's top weekly honor.
- Crooks led Iowa State to two wins over AP Top 25 opponents, recording two 20-point games and her second career double-double.
- Iowa State won consecutive games against AP Top 25 opponents for the first time in a regular season week since 2009-10.
- The Cyclones recorded their 18th win over a AP Top 10 team in the Fennelly era.
- Bill Fennelly earned his 600th win as Iowa State's head coach on Jan. 6 at BYU. Fennelly has accounted for 72 percent of ISU's women's basketball program wins and is the winningest coach, regardless of sport, in school history.
- Addy Brown is the only player in NCAA Division I to average at least 14 points, nine rebounds and five assists while shooting over 50 percent from the floor.
- Iowa State's "fab five" freshmen contribute the highest percentage of team points, rebounds and minutes across all Power 5 programs.

- Named Iowa State's sixth head women's basketball coach in 1995.
- Has coached 10 Associated Press All-Americans at Iowa State
- Coached consensus All-American Ashley Joens, the three-time Cheryl Miller Award winner.
- Coached consensus All-American Bridget Carleton, the 2019 Cheryl Miller Award winner.
- Led Iowa State to school-record 28 wins in 2021-22. Has 10 seasons with at least 25 wins at Iowa State.
- Iowa State captured Big 12 Tournament titles in 2000, 2001 and 2023 and has played in the championship game seven times.
- A three-time finalist for the Naismith Coach of the Year Award (2001, 2002, 2005).
- His 767 career wins is tied for eighth among active women's coaches in NCAA Division I and makes him the 25th-winningest NCAA women's basketball coach all-time.
- Fennelly is also tied for the second-longest tenured Power 5 basketball coach in men's or women's basketball.

## FROM THE NOTEBOOK

### LAST TIME OUT

Iowa State picked up its first win over an AP Top 10 team since the 2020-21 season as the Cyclones downed then-No. 4 Baylor, 66-63, in Hilton Coliseum.

- Audi Crooks led the Cyclones with 23 points in the win, the sixth 20-point performance of her career with a season-high-tying 10 field goals, including the eventual game-winning bucket.
- Hannah Belanger chipped in 15 points, including two clutch free throws, her only two attempts of the day, with 10 seconds to play to put ISU ahead by three points.
- After the Bears held a commanding 24-11 lead at the end of the first quarter, Iowa State responded by outscoring Baylor in each of the following three periods.
- Addy Brown stuffed the stat sheet with nine points, 11 rebounds, six steals and five assists.
- Brown's six swipes are the most by a Cyclone in a single game since Emily Ryan swiped nine against Omaha (Nov. 9, 2021).
- Baylor entered Saturday's contest as one of five teams averaging at least 80 points, 40 rebounds and 20 assists per game. ISU held the Bears to 63 points, 31 boards and 15 assists.
- Like every other game this season, Iowa State outrebounded Baylor 36-31. ISU's rebound margin is +13, the seventh-best mark in the nation.

### INSIDE WEDNESDAY'S MATCHUP

Iowa State and Texas Tech face off for the 45th time in program history.

- Iowa State leads the all-time series with a 29-15 overall record and while the series is tied, 10-10, in games played in Lubbock.
- The Cyclones have won each of the last six contests and 13 of the last 14.
- With a new Big 12 scheduling matrix, Iowa State will only play certain teams once in the regular season. Texas Tech is the first team on the Cyclones' schedule that ISU will play only on the road.

- Bailey Maupin leads the Lady Raiders with 15.2 points per game while Jasmine Shavers is also averaging double figures with 14.6 points per game.
- Texas Tech favors scoring from the free throw line or 2-point field goals over long range scores. Of the 1,263 total points the Lady Raiders have scored this season, only 360 points have come from beyond the arc.
- Texas Tech has made 273 free throws (31st DI) compared to ISU's 185 this season.

### TOP-25 OPPONENT WIN WEEKS

In the Fennelly era, Iowa State has faced at least two AP top-25 regular season opponents in the same span of one week 28 times.

- Iowa State rose to the challenge to take down then-No. 24 West Virginia, 74-64, and then-No. 4 Baylor, 66-63, to complete the feat for the first time in 14 years.
- When playing AP top-25 opponents back-to-back, Iowa State has now won consecutive games three times, previously during the 2009-10 season when it knocked off No. 20 Texas in overtime (73-71, Jan. 23, 2010) before defeating No. 11 Oklahoma (63-56, Jan. 27, 2010).
- As the 2023-24 AP rankings stand now, Iowa State would also face No. 7 Kansas State (Feb. 14) and No. 11 Texas (Feb. 17) back-to-back this season.

### NOTABLE MILESTONES

Iowa State players and coaches have reached several impressive milestones throughout the season.

- Head coach Bill Fennelly earned his 600th win at Iowa State with an 80-75 victory at BYU on Jan. 6. Fennelly is Iowa State's all-time winningest coach, regardless of sport.
- Hannah Belanger recorded her 2,000th career point against Kansas on Jan. 3 with a season-high 19 points and six 3-pointers. Belanger was the 14th active NCAA player to reach 2,000 career points and is fifth for 3-pointers made (328).
- Isnelle Natabou recorded her 1,000th career point at St. Thomas (Nov. 29)

### MILESTONE WATCH

Iowa State has several players and coaches nearing significant milestones this season.

- Isnelle Natabou is one point away from her 100th point as a Cyclone and 25 blocks away from 100 career blocks.
- Jalyann Bristow is six points from her 100th point as a Cyclone.

- Hannah Belanger is 45 assists from 400 career assists and 47 rebounds from 500 career rebounds.
- Nyamer Diew is two field goals from 200 made field goals in her career and 10 3-pointers from 100 triples in her career.
- Emily Ryan has recorded 643 career assists and is third all-time in program history.

- Ryan also entered the 2023-24 season top 3 in ISU career free throw percentage. With six games played this season, she is third (.863) all-time behind Kelsey Bolte (.879) and Jadda Buckley (.867).

- Ryan is also one steal from cracking the Top 10 steals leaders at Iowa State with 144 career swipes.
- As a freshman, Addy Brown has been a triple threat; scoring, rebounding and assisting. With a team-high 89 assists through 16 games, she is one assist from cracking the top 5 freshmen assists leaders.

- Brown could also make a push for single-season top 5 marks by a freshman in points and rebounds, posting 233 points and 148 rebounds.

- Arianna Jackson is nine assists from 50 career assists.
- Audi Crooks is one of the top players in NCAA Division I for field goal percentage, shooting at a 61.5 percent clip through 16 games. Iowa State single-season records for field goal percentage range from .661 (Angie Welle, 2002) to .579 (Shelly Coyle, 1990) in the top 10.
- Crooks also reached 100 field goals made (107) with 10 against Baylor. The fifth-best mark for field goals in a season by a Cyclone freshman is Angie Welle's 134 makes in 1998-99.

### CROOKS COOKS

Iowa State freshman Audi Crooks has garnered national attention as one of the nation's most exciting freshmen.

- Last week, Crooks led Iowa State to two AP Top 25 wins with two 20-point games (22 vs. No. 24 West Virginia, 23 vs. No. 4 Baylor).

- Her efforts earned her the first Big 12 Player of the Week honor for a Cyclone freshman in program history.
- Crooks also pulled down a career-high-tying 11 rebounds against the Mountaineers.
- She had previously been named the league's Freshman of the Week twice (Dec. 18, Jan. 2).

### REIGNING FROM THREE

As has been the case for decades, Iowa State is one of the top 3-point shooting teams in the country.

- Hannah Belanger leads the ISU effort from deep, canning 37 triples through 16 games and connecting on 40.2 percent of her attempts from deep.
- This season, ISU is Top 20 in NCAA DI and second in the Big 12 with 8.9 triples per game.



## JUST THE FACTS

Two Iowa State freshmen have top 10 field goal percentages among NCAA DI freshmen. Audi Crooks (1st) and Addy Brown (6th) also rank third and eighth among all Big 12 players in the category.

ISU has dominated the boards, specifically on the defensive end. Averaging 32.8 defensive rebounds per game, the Cyclones are fourth in the nation and lead the nation with the mark.

The Cyclones own one of the top marks in NCAA DI 3-point percentage, connecting on 38.6 percent of attempts from deep. ISU is eighth in the nation and leads the Big 12 in the category.

910

The Cyclones have made at least one three-point field goal in an NCAA women's record 910 consecutive games, a streak which encapsulates the entirety of the Bill Fennelly Era at Iowa State.



- The Cyclones have made 142 3-pointers this season, posting 10 or more made triples in six games this season.
- In 2022-23, the Cyclones were 12th in the country at 8.8 3-pointers per game. That effort was led in part by Ashley Joens, who had a team-high 89 3-pointers and led the Big 12 in 3-pointers per game (2.78).
- Iowa State finished 282 3-pointers last season, the seventh-most in a season in Iowa State history. All of the top seven have come under the tenure of head coach Bill Fennelly.
- Iowa State was second in the country in 2021-22 with 357 made 3-pointers. In six seasons prior to Bill Fennelly's arrival at Iowa State (the first six with the 3-pointer in women's basketball), ISU combined for 345 3-pointers.
- Iowa State's 357 surpassed the previous school record for 3-pointers in a season of 303 by the 2018-19 squad and the old Big 12 record of 325 by Kansas State's 2012-13 team.

#### NATION'S LONGEST 3-POINT STREAK

- The Iowa State women's basketball team owns women's basketball's longest streak for consecutive games with a 3-pointer, sitting at 910.

- The streak began on Feb. 19, 1995 at Colorado when Tara Gunderson netted a triple and is still active.
- The Cyclones reached 900-consecutive games with a made 3-pointer at St. Thomas (Nov. 29, 2023) when Kelsey Joens knocked down a triple for ISU's first points of the contest.
- Iowa State has made 7,374 triples over the course of the streak and made 10 or more in a game 279 times.
- Iowa State has hit 200 or more 3-pointers in a season 21-straight seasons, which is an NCAA record.
- Iowa State has hit 357 triples in 2021-22 season, reaching the 300s for the fourth time in program history.

#### SHARE AND SCORE

Iowa State has reached the 25-assist threshold in four games this season (25, Nov. 20 vs. Southern; 25, Nov. 25 vs. Syracuse; 25, Dec. 3 vs. UNCW; 26, Dec. 17 vs. Troy).

- The last time Iowa State had a season of recording 25+ assists in multiple games was 2021-22 when they posted marks of 27 vs. Prairie View A&M (Dec. 19, 2021), 26 vs. West Virginia (Jan. 1, 2022) and 25 vs. TCU (Feb. 12, 2022).
- The Cyclones have posted 25+ assists in at least three games in a single season six times. In 1999-2000, ISU posted at least 25 assists in a game six times, the top total for single season in program history.
- Iowa State's 16 assists in the first half against Southern were the most in a half this season.
- The Cyclones rank 12th in NCAA DI and third in the Big 12 through 15 games with 19.5 assists per game.

#### BELANGER AMONG NCAA'S TOP ACTIVE CAREER LEADERS

Graduate transfer Hannah Belanger had a record-breaking career at NCAA DII Truman State before joining the Iowa State squad in June.

- The Grafton, Wisconsin native is averaging 9.4 points per game for the Cyclones through 16 contests.
- Belanger is fifth for career 3-pointers among active NCAA players across all divisions with 331 made triples. She has reached the mark in 124 career games, the third-least number of games in the top 10.

#### IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Early into the season, the Iowa State freshmen are making an impact not only on their team but nationally as well.

- Audi Crooks leads NCAA freshmen in field goal percentage and is third in the Big 12, shooting over 61 percent from the floor.
- Crooks, an Algona, Iowa native, leads ISU with 16.7 points per game. That mark is seventh among all Big 12 players.
- Addy Brown is second on the team in both scoring average (14.6 PPG) and field goal percentage (.517) following a near double-double against Baylor with nine points, 11 rebounds, six steals and five assists.

- Brown ranks 75th nationally for season field goal percentage and is eighth in the Big 12.

### KEEPING UP WITH THE JOENS'

While Ashley Joens graduated as one of the best players in program history and was drafted into the WNBA, Iowa State will not be missing a Joens from the roster. Kelsey Joens joins the Cyclones as one of five freshmen making an immediate impact in 2023-24.

- Kelsey scored a season-high 17 points at St. Thomas (Nov. 29) on 6-of-8 shooting from the floor and 3-of-4 shooting from deep, including the first triple of the game that allowed Iowa State to reach 900-consecutive games with a made 3-pointer.
- Ashley and Kelsey have combined to hit the first 3-pointer in a game 46 times over the course of their six total seasons as Cyclones.
- 16 games into her Cyclone career, Kelsey has knocked down 24 3-pointers, recorded a .387 3-point percentage and swiped a team-high 21 steals. She averages 6.6 points per game and 4.8 rebounds per game.
- The younger Joens is the fourth of five sisters in her family and the fourth to be playing Division I basketball. Courtney (Illinois) and Ashley (Iowa State) have completed their respective collegiate careers while Aubrey is a senior at Oklahoma this season.

### FAB FIVE FRESHMEN

With five freshmen earning significant playing time, Iowa State's Fab Five have proven themselves worthy of national attention.

- The group has contributed 63 percent of team points, 63 percent of team rebounds and 57 percent of team minutes.
- The group has also combined for 45 starts through 16 games with at least three freshmen starting in each of ISU's last 12 contests.
- The five young Cyclones lead all other Power 5 freshmen groups in each category.
- Audi Crooks leads ISU with 16.7 points per game while Addy Brown has averages nearly 15 points and 9.3 rebounds per game.
- Brown also leads the Cyclones with 34.4 minutes per contest, a mark that is seventh overall in the Big 12.

### HERE FOR THE LONG HAUL

The Iowa State women's basketball coaching staff is the longest tenured full staff in the country.

- The Iowa State staff of head coach Bill Fennelly, associate head coach Jodi Steyer, assistant coaches Latoja Schaben and Billy Fennelly and director of operations Josh Carper are in their 14th season together. The group has combined for 103 years with Cyclones women's basketball.

### #HILTONMAGIC

The Cyclones have been phenomenal at home during Bill Fennelly's tenure, compiling a 376-81 record (.823) in Hilton Coliseum, including a 187-9 (.954) mark against regular-season non-conference opponents. Iowa State has gone undefeated at home three times, most recently during the 2004-05 season.

- Iowa State's 16 wins at Hilton Coliseum in 2021-22 was tied for the third-most in a season in school history.
- ISU's 5-0 non-con home record in 2022-23 marked the 22nd time Iowa State has gone undefeated at home in regular season non-conference contests under head coach Bill Fennelly.

### NEW TO IOWA STATE

The future is bright for Iowa State as the Cyclones signed the No. 13 freshman class of 2023.

- The five freshman are averaging 49.0 of Iowa State's 77.5 points per game through 15 games this season.
- Audi Crooks (16.3) and Addy Brown (14.9) lead the Cyclone scoring effort while Brown also leads the team in rebounding (9.1 RPG) and assists (84).
- Kelsey Joens has knocked down 23 triples and swiped a team-high 20 steals through 15 games.
- Iowa State also welcomed three transfers to the 2023-24 roster: Hannah Belanger (Truman State), Isnelle Natabou (Sacramento State) and Alisa Williams (LSU).
- Belanger has earned a spot in the starting lineup and Natabou has averaged 6.6 points and 5.3 rebounds per game as a strong defensive presence in the paint. Williams will redshirt the 2023-24 season.
