THE LEAD

Iowa State faces its second-straight top 10 opponent as the Cyclones travel to No. 5 Texas on Saturday. The Cyclones enter the contest coming off a 96-93 double overtime victory over No. 7 Kansas State on Wednesday night in Hilton Coliseum.

KEY STORYLINES

- Iowa State faces its second AP Top 10 opponent of the week on Saturday following a 96-93 double overtime win over No. 7 Kansas State.
- The two matchups mark the first time since the 2014-15 regular season that the Cyclones will face AP Top 10 teams consecutively.
- Iowa State is one of 12 NCAA Division I teams to secure two AP Top 10 wins this season and one of 20 to win three games against AP Top 25 opponents.
- The Cyclones turned in their best free throw shooting performance of the season Wednesday night to hold off the Wildcats. ISU made 18-straight free throws to close out the game and was 14-of-14 in both overtime periods.
- Iowa State has outrebounded its opponent 21 times through 23 games this season and ranks 11th in NCAA Division I with +9.8 rebound margin.
- Audi Crooks and Addy Brown each finished with 20 points against Kansas State, the second time this season the duo posted 20-point performances in the same game (Dec. 30, Oklahoma State).
- Crooks and Brown have claimed five Big 12 weekly awards this season. Crooks was most recently named the league's Freshman of the Week on Jan. 29.
- Bill Fennelly earned his 600th win as Iowa State's head coach on Jan. 6 at BYU. Fennelly has accounted for 72 percent of ISU's women's basketball program wins and is the winningest coach, regardless of sport, in school history.
- Addy Brown is the only player in NCAA Division I to average at least 13.0 points, 8.5 rebounds and 5.0 assists.
- Iowa State's "fab five" freshmen contribute the highest percentage of team points, rebounds and minutes across all Power 5 programs.

THE FENNELLY FILE

- Named Iowa State's sixth head women's basketball coach in 1995.
- Has coached 10 Associated Press All-Americans at Iowa State
- Coached consensus All-American Ashley Joens, the three-time Cheryl Miller Award winner.
- Coached consensus All-American Bridget Carleton, the 2019 Cheryl Miller Award winner.
- Led Iowa State to school-record 28 wins in 2021-22. Has 10 seasons with at least 25 wins at Iowa State.
- Iowa State captured Big 12 Tournament titles in 2000, 2001 and 2023 and has played in the championship game seven times.
- A three-time finalist for the Naismith Coach of the Year Award (2001, 2002, 2005).
- His 770 career wins is tied for eighth among active women's coaches in NCAA Division I and makes him the 25th-winningest NCAA women's basketball coach all-time.
- Fennelly is also tied for the second-longest tenured Power 5 basketball coach in men's or women's basketball.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

LAST TIME OUT

Iowa State picked up its second AP Top 10 win of the season, a 96-93 double overtime thriller with No. 7 Kansas State in Hilton Coliseum.

- Five Cyclones scored in double figures, led by the dynamic freshmen duo of Audi Crooks and Addy Brown with 20 points apiece.
- Crooks tallied her 10th 20-point performance of the season, reaching 400 career points while it marked Brown's fourth 20-piece and pushed her past 300 career points.
- Emily Ryan put up her first double-double of the season with 12 points and 12 assists and was three rebounds shy of a triple-double.
- The win marked the 19th Top-10 win in school history and the second over an opponent ranked No. 7.
- Kelsey Joens and Isnelle Natabou played crucial roles off the bench, chipping in 13 and 12 points, respectively.

INSIDE THE SERIES

Iowa State and Texas meet for the final time in the regular season as Big 12 foes. The Longhorns hold a 26-23 edge in the all-time series entering Saturday's contest.

- While Iowa State has won the last two contests, including last season's Big 12 Championship matchup in Kansas City, the Longhorns had won the seven contests prior.
- Iowa State is 7-13 in Austin and has not won on the road against Texas since Feb. 12, 2020 (69-51).
- The Big 12 Championship win was ISU's first since 2001 and earned the Cyclones their 21st trip to the NCAA Tournament.

ABOUT THE LONGHORNS

Texas is one of five Big 12 members ranked in the AP Top 25 poll with a 23-3 overall record.

- The Longhorns lead the Big 12 in field goal percentage this season (.500), a top-5 mark in NCAA DI.
- Texas enters Saturday's contest riding a five-game win streak and has won seven of its last nine contests.

- Madison Booker leads Texas with 15.8 points per game, a mark that has improved to 20.3 points per game in conference play with Rori Harmon's absence following a season-ending injury.
- Taylor Jones (12.9) and Aaliyah Moore (10.7) also average double figures this season.
- Jones also leads the team with 7.0 rebounds per game.

NOTABLE MILESTONES

Iowa State players and coaches have reached several impressive milestones throughout the season.

- Audi Crooks scored her 400th career point against No. 7 Kansas State on Feb. 14. With 409 points this season, she owns the second-highest total by a Cyclone freshman after passing Ashley Joens' 408 points in 2018-19.
- Head coach Bill Fennelly earned his 600th win at Iowa State with an 80-75 victory at BYU on Jan. 6. Fennelly is Iowa State's all-time winningest coach, regardless of sport.
- Hannah Belanger recorded her 2,000th career point against Kansas on Jan. 3 with a season-high 19 points and six 3-pointers. Belanger was the 14th active NCAA player to reach 2,000 career points and is sixth for 3-pointers made (344).
- Isnelle Natabou recorded her 1,000th career point at St. Thomas (Nov. 29) and followed up with her 700th career rebound against UNI (Dec. 20) less than a month later. She became the 49th active NCAA DI player to reach both milestones.

MILESTONE WATCH

Iowa State has several players nearing significant milestones this season.

- Hannah Belanger is 38 assists from 400 career assists and 38 rebounds from 500 career rebounds.
- Belanger is also four 3-pointers from 350 career triples. She has made 52 3-pointers this season and is also 11 points from 2,100 career points.

- Jalynn Bristow is six rebounds from 100 rebounds this season.
- Addy Brown is five boards from 200 career rebounds and nine assists from 125 dimes.
- Audi Crooks is 26 rebounds from 200 rebounds this season.
- Nyamer Diew is seven rebounds from 300 boards at Iowa State and five points from 600 career points.
- Kelsey Joens is seven rebounds from 100 career rebounds.
- Isnelle Natabou is 12 rebounds from 750 career rebounds and 24 blocks from 100 career blocks.
- Emily Ryan is five assists from 700 career assists and 40 points from 1,200 career points.



EMILY RYAN DISH-TRIBUTION CENTER

Emily Ryan is one of Iowa State's most prolific point guards, recording top 10 career marks in both assists and steals while becoming the program's 34th 1,000 point scorer last March.

- The Claflin, Kansas native has recorded 695 career assists and is third all-time in program history.

- Over four seasons, she has tallied single-game assists at every mark, 1-17. Ryan has never finished a game with less than one assist through 108 career games.
- Ryan is currently ninth among all NCAA active women's basketball players and fifth in Division I with her career assists total. She has reached the mark in the fewest games (109).
- In the last five seasons, there have been four Big 12 individual performances of 14 or more assists. Ryan owns three of the four following a 14-assist performance against Oklahoma State on Jan. 31.

- The "Floor General" has also posted a top-3 career free throw percentage through 109 games. Her .866 clip sits behind only Kelsey Bolte (.879, 211-240) and Jadda Buckley (.867, 326-376).
- Also a scoring threat, Ryan has tallied 12 double-doubles in her career following a 12-point, 12-assist performance against Kansas State on Feb. 14.
- On Mar. 10, 2023 against Baylor, she became the 34th player in Iowa State history to record 1,000 career points. Her career total is currently 1,160.

- Ryan cracked the Top 10 steals leaders at Iowa State with her 145th career swipe and is two from overtaking Tracy Eckert's No. 9 all-time total (159).

REIGNING FROM THREE

As has been the case for decades, Iowa State is one of the top 3-point shooting teams in the country.

- Hannah Belanger leads the ISU effort from deep, canning 52 triples through 23 games and connecting on 37.4 percent of her attempts from deep.
- This season, ISU is 21st in NCAA DI and second in the Big 12 with 8.6 triples per game.
- The Cyclones have made 198 3-pointers this season, posting 10 or more made triples in seven games this season.
- In 2022-23, the Cyclones were 12th in the country at 8.8 3-pointers per game. That effort was led in part by Ashley Joens, who had a team-high 89 3-pointers and led the Big 12 in 3-pointers per game (2.78).
- Iowa State finished 282 3-pointers last season, the seventh-most in a season in Iowa State history. All of the top seven have come under the tenure of head coach Bill Fennelly.
- Iowa State was second in the country in 2021-22 with 357 made 3-pointers. In six seasons prior to Bill Fennelly's arrival at Iowa State (the first six with the 3-pointer in women's basketball), ISU combined for 345 3-pointers.
- Iowa State's 357 surpassed the previous school record for 3-pointers in a season of 303 by the 2018-19 squad and the old Big 12 record of 325 by Kansas State's 2012-13 team.

QUICK FACTS

Iowa State point guard Emily Ryan is one of the best distributors of the basketball in the country and in program history. Her teammates at Iowa State have greatly benefited from her court vision.

OH THE WONDERFUL THINGS MS. BROWN CAN DO

Iowa State freshman Addy Brown is one of the most well-rounded players in women's basketball.

- As a freshman, Addy Brown has been a triple threat; scoring, rebounding and assisting. With a team-high 116 assists through 23 games, she reached the top 5 freshmen assists leaders.

- Brown could also make a push for single-season top 5 marks by a freshman in points and rebounds, posting 306 points and 195 rebounds.
- No player at Iowa State has reached 300 points, 195 rebounds and 110 assists in their freshman year. Only three Cyclones since 1999-2000 have reached the marks prior to Brown (Bridget Carleton, 2018-19; Tracy Gahan, 2001-02; Anne O'Neil, 2004-05).
- Brown is the 20th player in NCAA DI since 1999-00 to average over 8.0 rebounds per game and 5.0 assists per game in a season.

CROOKS COOKS

Iowa State freshman Audi Crooks has garnered national attention as one of the nation's most exciting freshmen.

- Audi Crooks is one of the top players in NCAA Division I for field goal percentage, shooting at a 57.1 percent clip through 23 games. Iowa State single-season records for field goal percentage range from .661 (Angie Welle, 2002) to .579 (Shelly Coyle, 1990) in the top 10.
- Crooks also reached 100 field goals made with 10 against Baylor. She holds the second-best mark by a freshman in ISU history. She is two off Colleen Peterson's top mark of 163 makes in 1975-76.

- She is 39 made field goals from reaching the top 10 in ISU history regardless of class.
- Crooks has scored 409 points to lead the Cyclones this season, now second among the top 5 best marks by a freshman in a single season. Her total sits behind Megan Taylor (460) after passing Ashley Joens (408) and Colleen Peterson (408).
- Crooks has scored in double figures in 22 of 23 games and finished with 20+ points 10 times this season.
- She posted a career high with 29 points against Oklahoma State on 14-of-21 shooting, the most field goals made by a Cyclone in a conference game since Bridget Carleton's 16 against Oklahoma State (Jan. 2018) and the most by a Cyclone freshman in program history.
- The in-state icon led Iowa State with 20 points to its most recent AP Top 10 win over No. 7 Kansas State, playing a career-high 35 minutes in the Cyclones' double overtime victory.
- One of the nation's most efficient freshmen, the Algona, Iowa native averages nearly 18 points per game to lead ISU to go along with 7.6 rebounds per game.
- In week 11, Crooks led Iowa State to two AP Top 25 wins with two 20-point games (22 vs. No. 24 West Virginia, 23 vs. No. 4 Baylor).

- Her efforts earned her the first Big 12 Player of the Week honor for a Cyclone freshman in program history.
- Crooks also pulled down a then-career-high 11 rebounds against the Mountaineers.
- She has earned Big 12 weekly awards four times this season (Dec. 18, Jan. 2, Jan. 15, Jan. 29).

NATION'S LONGEST 3-POINT STREAK

- The Iowa State women's basketball team owns women's basketball's longest streak for consecutive games with a 3-pointer, sitting at 916.
- The streak began on Feb. 19, 1995 at Colorado when Tara Gunderson netted a triple and is still active.
- The Cyclones reached 900-consecutive games with a made 3-pointer at St. Thomas (Nov. 29, 2023) when Kelsey Joens knocked down a triple for ISU's first points of the contest.
- Iowa State has made 7,419 triples over the course of the streak and made 10 or more in a game 280 times.
- Iowa State has hit 200 or more 3-pointers in a season 21-straight seasons, which is an NCAA record.
- Iowa State hit 357 triples in 2021-22 season, reaching the 300s for the fourth time in program history.



SHARE AND SCORE

Iowa State has reached the 25-assist threshold in six games this season (25, Nov. 20 vs. Southern; 25, Nov. 25 vs. Syracuse; 25, Dec. 3 vs. UNCW; 26, Dec. 17 vs. Troy; 27, Jan. 31 vs. Oklahoma State; 25, Feb. 14 vs. No. 7 Kansas State).

- The Cyclones rank 16th in NCAA DI and fourth in the Big 12 through 23 games with 18.7 assists per game.
- Addy Brown leads ISU with 116 assists this season, the most by a Cyclone freshman since Emily Ryan set the best single-season mark with 164 dimes.
- Against Kansas State, ISU assisted on 25 of its 28 made field goals.
- Emily Ryan (14) and Addy Brown (9) combined for 23 of ISU's 27 assists against Oklahoma State. It was the first time in the Fennelly era multiple Cyclones had posted nine or more assists in a single contest.
- In the last five seasons of Big 12 contests, Emily Ryan has posted 14 or more assists three times. Every other conference player has only managed the feat once.
- The last time Iowa State had a season of recording 25+ assists in multiple games was 2021-22 when they posted marks of 27 vs. Prairie View A&M (Dec. 19, 2021), 26 vs. West Virginia (Jan. 1, 2022) and 25 vs. TCU (Feb. 12, 2022).
- The Cyclones have posted 25+ assists in at least three games in a single season six times. In 1999-2000, ISU posted at least 25 assists in a game six times, the top total for single season in program history.
- Iowa State's 16 assists in the first half against Southern were the most in a half this season before the Cyclones matched the total in the second half against Oklahoma State on Jan. 31.

BELANGER AMONG NCAA'S TOP ACTIVE CAREER LEADERS

Graduate transfer Hannah Belanger had a record-breaking career at NCAA DII Truman State before joining the Iowa State squad in June.

- The Grafton, Wisconsin native is averaging 9.0 points per game for the Cyclones through 23 contests.
- Belanger is sixth for career 3-pointers among active NCAA players across all divisions with 346 made triples. She has reached the mark in 131 career games, the fourth-fewest number of games of those in the top 10.

IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Early into the season, the Iowa State freshmen are making an impact not only on their team but nationally as well.

- Audi Crooks leads NCAA freshmen in field goal percentage and is fourth in the Big 12, shooting over 57 percent from the floor.

- Crooks, an Algona, Iowa native, leads ISU with 17.8 points per game. That mark is fifth among all Big 12 players.
- Addy Brown is second on the team in both scoring average (13.3 PPG) and field goal percentage (.477) while posting a team-high 8.5 rebounds per game.
- Brown ranks 107th nationally for season field goal percentage and is eighth in the Big 12.
- Arianna Jackson has averaged 6.1 points per game in conference play and knocked down 19 triples through 12 Big 12 contests.

FAB FIVE FRESHMEN

With five freshmen earning significant playing time, Iowa State's Fab Five have proven themselves worthy of national attention.

- The group has contributed 63 percent of team points (1,095-1740), 63 percent of team rebounds (603-963) and 56 percent of team minutes.
- In conference play, the rebounding percentage increases to 64 percent while the other two categories remain steady.
- The group has also combined for 65 starts through 23 games with at least three freshmen starting in 18 of ISU's last 19 contests.
- The five young Cyclones lead all other Power 5 freshmen groups in each category.
- Audi Crooks leads ISU with 17.7 points per game while Addy Brown has averages 13 points and 8.5 rebounds per game.
- Brown also leads the Cyclones with 33.5 minutes per contest.

Two Iowa State freshmen have top 10 field goal percentages among NCAA DI freshmen. Audi Crooks (1st) and Addy Brown (8th) also rank third and eighth among all Big 12 players in the category.

The Cyclones have made at least one three-point field goal in an NCAA women's record 917 consecutive games, a streak which encapsulates the entirety of the Bill Fennelly Era at Iowa State.

TOP-25 OPPONENT WIN WEEKS

In the Fennelly era, Iowa State has faced at least two AP top-25 regular season opponents in the same span of one week 28 times.

- Iowa State will face consecutive Top 25 opponents for the second time this season, hosting No. 24 Oklahoma (Feb. 10) and No. 7 Kansas State (Feb. 14) before traveling to No. 5 Texas (Feb. 17).
- The Cyclones dropped an 86-72 contest to the Sooners before surviving a double overtime thriller, 96-93, against the Wildcats.
- The Top 10 week with Kansas State and Texas marks the first time since 2014-15 that the Cyclones will face consecutive Top 10 opponents and just the third time in program history during the regular season.
- Iowa State rose to the challenge earlier this season to take down then-No. 24 West Virginia, 74-64, and then-No. 4 Baylor, 66-63, to complete the feat for the first time in 14 years.
- When playing AP top-25 opponents back-to-back, Iowa State has now won consecutive games three times, previously during the 2009-10 season when it knocked off No. 20 Texas in overtime (73-71, Jan. 23, 2010) before defeating No. 11 Oklahoma (63-56, Jan. 27, 2010).

HERE FOR THE LONG HAUL

The Iowa State women's basketball coaching staff is the longest tenured full staff in the country.

- The Iowa State staff of head coach Bill Fennelly, associate head coach Jodi Steyer, assistant coaches Latoja Schaben and Billy Fennelly and director of operations Josh Carper are in their 14th season together. The group has combined for 103 years with Cyclones women's basketball.

#HILTONMAGIC

The Cyclones have been phenomenal at home during Bill Fennelly's tenure, compiling a 378-82 record (.822) in Hilton Coliseum, including a 187-9 (.954) mark against regular-season non-conference opponents. Iowa State has gone undefeated at home three times, most recently during the 2004-05 season.

- Iowa State's 16 wins at Hilton Coliseum in 2021-22 was tied for the third-most in a season in school history.
- ISU's 5-0 non-con home record in 2022-23 marked the 22nd time Iowa State has gone undefeated at home in regular season non-conference contests under head coach Bill Fennelly.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JOENS'

While Ashley Joens graduated as one of the best players in program history and was drafted into the WNBA, Iowa State will not be missing a Joens from the roster. Kelsey Joens is one of five freshmen making an immediate impact in 2023-24.

- Kelsey scored a season-high 17 points at St. Thomas (Nov. 29) on 6-of-8 shooting from the floor and 3-of-4 shooting from deep, including the first triple of the game that allowed Iowa State to reach 900-consecutive games with a made 3-pointer.
- The younger Joens also chipped in 13 points in ISU's win over No. 7 Kansas State, arguably her most impressive performance in conference play.
- Kelsey knocked down three 3-pointers and was 4-of-4 from the charity stripe while corralling seven rebounds and playing 30 minutes.
- Ashley and Kelsey have combined to hit the first 3-pointer in a game 46 times over the course of their six total seasons as Cyclones.
- 23 games into her Cyclone career, Kelsey has knocked down 31 3-pointers, recorded a .388 3-point percentage and swiped a team-high 23 steals. She averages 6.1 points per game and 4.0 rebounds per game.
- The younger Joens is the fourth of five sisters in her family and the fourth to be playing Division I basketball. Courtney (Illinois) and Ashley (Iowa State) have completed their respective collegiate careers while Aubrey is a senior at Oklahoma this season.

NEW TO IOWA STATE

The future is bright for Iowa State as the Cyclones signed the No. 13 freshman class of 2023.

- The five freshman are averaging 47.6 of Iowa State's 75.7 points per game through 23 games this season.
- Audi Crooks (17.8) and Addy Brown (13.3) lead the Cyclone scoring effort while Brown also leads the team in rebounding (8.5 RPG) and assists (11.6).
- Kelsey Joens has knocked down 31 triples and swiped a team-high 23 steals through 23 games.
- Iowa State also welcomed three transfers to the 2023-24 roster: Hannah Belanger (Truman State), Isnelle Natabou (Sacramento State) and Alisa Williams (LSU).
- Belanger has earned a spot in the starting lineup and Natabou has averaged 5.5 points and 4.4 rebounds per game as a strong defensive presence in the paint. Williams will redshirt the 2023-24 season.
