### THE LEAD

Iowa State opens its ninth season under head coach Kevin Dresser with the inaugural Cyclone Invitational presented by Daily's Premium Meats. It is the first time since the 2019-20 season that ISU begins its season with an individual tournament instead of a dual.

### KEY STORYLINES

- Following a 2024-25 season which saw several key Cyclones go down with season-ending injuries, Dresser and his staff have reloaded their squad. For the first time since 1982-83, ISU enters a season with seven past All-Americans on its roster.
- ISU's 2025-26 dual slate features six teams that finished inside the top 15 at last year's NCAA Championships, including three of the top six teams. Overall, Iowa State's dual slate features 10 of the top 25 teams from the 2025 national tournament.
- Iowa State welcomed nine newcomers to its roster for the 2025-26 season, three freshman and six from the transfer portal.
- Dresser and Co. utilized the transfer portal to add several high-impact pieces to the roster, including three former All-Americans - Rocky Elam (Missouri), Stevo Poulin (UNCO) and Vinny Zerban (UNCO). Isaac Dean (Rider), a 2025 NCAA Qualifier who reached the Round of 16 last season, also joined the Cyclones.
- Those new faces joined a group of returners that already had four past All-Americans among it - Jacob Frost (2025), Evan Frost (2024), Anthony Echemendia (2024) and Yonger Bastida (2022).
- Additionally, six of ISU's eight NCAA Qualifiers from last season are back to improve their finish from the NCAA Championships.
- Iowa State also returns two-time Big 12 Champion Paniro Johnson. Last season, Johnson won the second 149-pound conference title of his career and compiled a 27-6 record. He registered dual victories at 149, 157 and 165 pounds during the regular season.
- Jacob Frost placed seventh at the 2025 NCAA Championships after navigating a bracket that was loaded with seven returning All-Americans and two national champions. He finished the season with a 33-9 record and 16 bonus-point victories (3 WBF, 9 TF, 4 MD). Eight of his nine losses on the season came against wrestlers who finished sixth or better at the NCAA Championships. The other loss was against 2023 national champion Andrew Alriez at the Big 12 Championship, which he avenged at the national tournament.
- Echemendia and Bastida are expected back in the lineup after suffering season-ending injuries last season. Connor Euton, who tore his ACL during last year's Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk dual, also returns and will challenge 2025 NCAA Qualifier Aiden Riggins for the 165-pound spot.
- Iowa State finished the 2024-25 season with a 12-5 dual record, including a 6-2 mark in Big 12 duals. It marked Dresser's fourth-consecutive season with 12 or more dual victories.

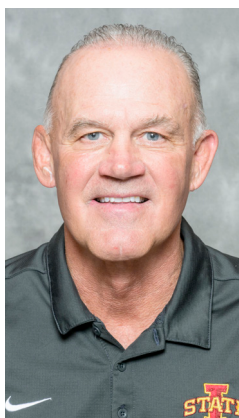

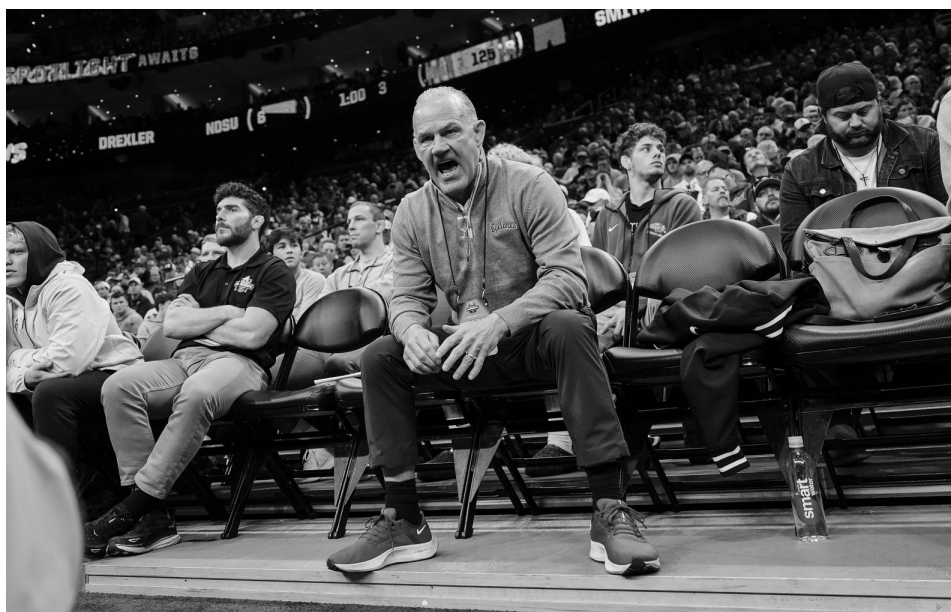
## PROGRAM BUILDER

Kevin Dresser is well regarded in the wrestling community for his ability to build programs from the ground up. After a legendary stint as a high school coach in Virginia, Dresser rejuvenated both Virginia Tech's and Iowa State's wrestling programs.

Dresser's efforts have seen Iowa State climb on the national stage, highlighted by a 2024 Big 12 title and NCAA team trophy (4th place), ISU's best national finish since 2010. He inherited an ISU program that scored one point and finished tied for 57th at the 2017 NCAA Championships. Since then, Iowa State has finished T-45th, 16th, T-13th, 17th, 11th, 4th and T-27th at the national tournament.

After a consistent upward trend throughout Dresser's tenure in Ames, ISU suffered a setback during an injury-filled 2025 season which saw three returning All-Americans out of the lineup due to season-ending injuries.

Iowa State wasn't the first program Dresser resurrected from the dead. He turned Virginia Tech from a program that routinely finished outside the top 30 nationally into a program where top-10 finishes became the norm. His time in Blacksburg culminated with his first NCAA team trophy after a fourth-place finish in 2016.

### FRESHMAN FACES

Iowa State welcomed three freshman to the roster this season.

- Christian Castillo, rated as the nation's No. 11 overall recruit by FloWrestling and No. 14 by MatScouts, was ISU's highest-rated freshman. Castillo is expected to redshirt this season.
- ISU also added Jacob Helgeson, a three-time Iowa high school state champion, and Carter Pearson, the No. 107 recruit nationally by MatScouts.

### WHAT'S RETURNING?

Iowa State returns 69 percent of its dual meet victories from last season's roster and 16.5 of its 18 points from the 2025 NCAA Championships.

### CROWDED IN THE MIDDLE

Iowa State has no shortage of depth in the middle weights this season. From 141-157, ISU has four credentialed wrestlers, three All-Americans and a two-time Big 12 champion, contending for just three spots.

Dresser has stated that some of the lineup battles could last well into the season.

- **141:** Anthony Echemendia has descended back down to 141 pounds where he placed fifth in 2024.
- **149:** All-American Jacob Frost is battling two-time Big 12 champion Paniro Johnson for the starting job. You might ask, "Why not just have one move up a weight class?"
- **157:** Vinny Zerban, an All-American transfer from Northern Colorado, has laid claim to this weight class for now.

PROGRAM ON THE RISE

Head coach Kevin Dresser, in his ninth season at the helm of the program, has brought Iowa State wrestling back into the national conversation.

- Dresser inherited a program that scored one point and finished tied for 57th at the 2017 NCAA Championships. Since then, Iowa State has finished T-45th, 16th, T-13th, 17th, 11th, 4th and T-27th at the NCAA Championships.
- After a consistent upward trend throughout Dresser's tenure in Ames, ISU suffered a setback during an injury-filled 2025 season which saw three returning All-Americans out of the lineup due to season-ending injuries. Iowa State still qualified eight for the national tournament and had one All-American.
- Iowa State had no conference champions in 2017 and failed to have a wrestler reach All-America status. Since then, Dresser has produced 11 Big 12 Champs, 14 NCAA All-Americans, two National Champions and led ISU to its first Big 12 team title since 2009.
- In 2024, Iowa State finished in fourth place with four All-Americans at the NCAA Championships with 68.5 team points, its best finish and point total since 2010.

BIG 12 DUAL SUCCESS

Iowa State is 47-14 in Big 12 duals under head coach Kevin Dresser. Dresser and the Cyclones have been even better in recent seasons.

HOME SWEET HILTON

- Iowa State is 22-4 on its home mat since the 2021-22 season.
- Cyclone fans once again showed up to Hilton Coliseum in large numbers. ISU averaged 5,694 fans per home dual last season. That makes Iowa State one of three schools in the country, and the only one in the Big 12, to average 5,000-plus fans per dual in each of the last three seasons (Penn State, Iowa).

NEXT MAN UP

Due to the injuries to the roster last season, ISU used 15 unique lineup combinations in 17 duals and 25 different wrestlers saw the lineup.

GOING FOR BONUS

- Kevin Dresser preaches a high-paced, entertaining style of wrestling and encourages his athletes to give fans their money's worth.
- Nearly half of Cyclone wrestlers' wins last season came with bonus points (70-of-159, 44%).

FROST WARNING

- Twin brothers Evan (133) and Jacob (149) Frost have appeared in the ISU lineup at the same time 12 times in their careers, including 10 times in 2024-25.
- Both brothers have earned All-America honors in their careers (Evan, 2024; Jacob, 2025).
  - Last season, they became the first set of Cyclone brothers to qualify for the NCAA Championships in the same season since Michael and Gabe Moreno in 2015.
  - Evan and Jacob wrestled their high school senior seasons at Dowling Catholic in Des Moines, Iowa, but called Metairie, Louisiana home growing up. The pair moved from Louisiana to Iowa for a better and more high-profile wrestling experience. They each won three state titles in Louisiana and Evan added a fourth in Iowa while Jacob grabbed a runner-up finish as a senior.

ELAM: BIG 12 FOE TO FRIEND

- Rocky Elam, a transfer from Big 12 foe Missouri, joined the Cyclones for his final season of eligibility.
- Elam was a former 197-pound rival of Yonger Bastida. The pair wrestled six times while Elam was at Mizzou with Elam holding a 4-2 advantage in those meetings.
  - Elam missed the 2024-25 season while recovering from multiple injuries. At the 2024 NCAA Championships, he placed sixth as the No. 12 seed despite wrestling with a substantial shoulder injury.
  - Four-time All-American and two-time Big 12 Champion.
  - Career NCAA Finishes: 5-4-3-6
  - 2021 Junior World Champion (92 kg)

**J. FROST MOVES UP**

Fresh off an All-America finish at 141 pounds last season, Jacob Frost has moved up to 149 pounds for the 2025-26 campaign. He's in the midst of a lineup battle with two-time Big 12 champion Paniro Johnson for the spot.

- Frost placed seventh at 141 pounds as the No. 9 seed at the 2025 NCAA Championships to earn his first career All-America honor. He became the 311th All-American in program history.
- Frost's 141-pound bracket at the national tournament was loaded with seven returning All-Americans and two national champions. He defeated 2023 national champion Andrew Alirez in the second round of the tournament.
- Frost finished the season with a 33-9 record and 16 bonus-point victories (3 WBF, 9 TF, 4 MD).
- Eight of Jacob's nine losses on the season came against wrestlers who finished sixth or better at the NCAA Championships. The other loss was against Alirez at the Big 12 Championship, which he avenged at the national tournament.

**E. FROST MOVES DOWN**

Due to the aforementioned depth in the middle weights, Evan Frost aims to be back down at 133 pounds for the 2025-26 season.

- Frost is ranked No. 5 in InterMat's preseason rankings and No. 9 in FloWrestling's rankings.
- Last season, Frost fell a match shy of returning to the podium at the NCAA Championships after losing in the Blood Round to Penn State's No. 8 Braeden Davis.
- He posted a 22-6 record in 2024-25 with five top-20 victories and 12 bonus-point wins (7 MD, 3 TF, 2 WBF).

- Defeated Little Rock's No. 3 seed Nasir Bailey, 5-3, in the Round of 16 on a takedown with 0:13 remaining. The win avenged his tech fall loss to Bailey from a season prior.

- Has two career CKLV runner-up finishes.

**CUBAN CONNECTIONS**

Iowa State has three native Cubans on its roster - Anthony Echemendia, Yonger Bastida and Osmany Diversent.

- Echemendia and Bastida both won Big 12 titles for the Cyclones in 2024 but missed the 2024-25 season due to injury.
- Childhood friends, Bastida hails from Trinidad, Cuba while Echemendia is from Cabaiguan, Cuba - a mere 36 miles away from each other.
- From ages 9-18 the pair trained together at EIDE Lino Salabarría Pupo - a sports teaching facility for the training and development of high-performance athletes in Sancti Spiritus, Cuba, located between their hometowns and 1,620 miles away from Ames, Iowa.



**BASTIDA'S BACK**

Heavyweight Yonger Bastida is back for his senior campaign after missing the 2024-25 season due to injury. Bastida is ranked in the top three in all major preseason polls and as high as No. 1 by InterMat. Last weekend, he defeated Michigan's No. 4 Taye Ghadiali at the All-Star Classic, 8-2.

- Bastida only saw the mat twice during the 2024-25 season before being shut down for the year. He went 2-0 with a notable win over Iowa's Ben Kueter.
- In Bastida's last full season (2023-24), he entered the NCAA Championships with an undefeated record, but fell short of the podium following a last-second quarterfinal

defeat to Michigan's Lucas Davison and subsequent Blood Round defeat later on Friday evening - his only two losses of the year.

- Bastida's 2023-24 season was still noteworthy, however. He had 102 takedowns to his name and only allowed six, three of which occurred at the national tournament.
- Bastida finished with a 26-2 record which included 18 bonus point victories (3 WBF, 9 TF, 6 MD).

**ECHEMENDIA'S OFFSEASON BATTLE**

While most college wrestlers were hitting the weight room this offseason, Anthony Echemendia was battling to save his leg.

- After undergoing a routine surgery to mend a high-ankle sprain, Echemendia was nearly back in the lineup for ISU's Jan. 26 dual against Oklahoma State. In a last-minute decision, Dresser elected to wrestle Jacob Frost instead to give Echemendia an additional week of recovery.
- The next morning, Anthony began having new pain in his ankle. His ankle became swollen and he was soon admitted into the hospital for an infection.
- Anthony battled a Staph infection in his ankle that came with a threat of losing his leg. Over the next three months, Anthony had to undergo three additional surgeries and six weeks of IV infusion antibiotics three times daily.
- Anthony and made a return to the mat for summer training in July 2025.

ECHEMENDIA NOTABLES

Echemendia enters the 2025-26 season ranked No. 7 in FloWrestling's preseason poll. Echemendia headlined the NWCA All-Star Classic last weekend where he fell to Ohio State's two-time defending NCAA champion Jesse Mendez, 7-3.

- Last season, Echemendia wrestled to a 6-3 record before suffering what proved to be a season-ending ankle injury at the Cliff Keen Invitational.
- He finished his last full season (2023-24) with a 24-6 record. He registered 17 bonus-point victories (1 WBF, 9 TF, 7 MD) and tallied 96 takedowns while allowing only 12.
- 2024 All-American (5th) and Big 12 Champion at 141 pounds.
- Echemendia is 10-9 against top-15 opponents as a Cyclone.

PANIRO JOHNSON

Paniro Johnson enters the 2025-26 season ranked No. 6 in FloWrestling's preseason poll at 149 pounds. Johnson is locked in a lineup battle with returning All-American Jacob Frost.

- Johnson went 27-6 during the 2024-25 season with an 11-5 record against ranked opponents. Johnson won the second Big 12 title of his career.
- Despite winning 18 of his last 19 matches entering the national tournament, Johnson saw his season come to an end in the Round of 16.
- Allowed only five takedowns on the season.
- Registered dual victories at 149, 157 and 165 pounds last season.
- Two-time Big 12 Champion (2023, '25).

CALI STYLE

MJ Gaitan hit the weight room this offseason and finally looks the part for 174 pounds. He enters the season ranked No. 15 by FloWrestling.

- Gaitan had a roller coaster 2024-25 season battling injury and changing weight classes but finished with a 17-11 record and nine bonus-point victories (5 WBF, 1 TF, 3 MD).
- He qualified for his second NCAA Championships in 2025 where he upset the No. 10 seed, Central Michigan's Alex Cramer, in the First Round.
- Gaitan, who brings big-move and bonus-point potential to the lineup, is never out of a match. He has registered 16 career pins.

RIGGINS FINISHES STRONG

Aiden Riggins, perhaps one of ISU's most improved wrestlers throughout the course of last season, enters 2025-26 ranked No. 16 by InterMat.

- Riggins struggled to begin the 2024-25 season but came on strong late in the year. He earned an automatic berth to the NCAA Championships thanks to a fourth-place finish at the Big 12 Championship as the No. 8 seed.
- He went 3-2 and reached the Round of 16, scoring 2.5 points, at the NCAA Championships, the second-most points of any Cyclone.
- Finished with a 17-19 season record after moving from 174 to 165 pounds after the new year.
- Transferred to Iowa State after spending two seasons at Iowa.
- An Iowa prep standout at Waverly-Shell Rock, Riggins was the No. 25 recruit nationally on MatScouts' 2022 Big Board. He was a two-time state champion, three-time finalist and four-time placewinner (170-4 prep record).

- Euton appeared in ISU's dual lineup at 165 pounds three times last season, but suffered a season-ending knee injury during the Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk dual. He finished the match on a torn ACL.

Vinny Zerban enters the 2025-26 season ranked No. 6 at 157 pounds by FloWrestling.

- Transferred to Iowa State following a late coaching change at Northern Colorado.
- Zerban is the reigning 157-pound Big 12 champion and finished sixth at the 2025 NCAA Championships. He posted a 22-7 record with 11 bonus-point victories (3 WBF, 6 TF, 2 MD).
- Three-time NCAA Qualifier.
- 69-24 career record.
- Two-time Missouri state champion and four-time placewinner.

### THE POULIN FILE

Stevo Poulin enters the 2025-26 season ranked No. 7 at 125 pounds by FloWrestling.

- Transferred to Iowa State following a late coaching change at Northern Colorado.
- Posted a 24-6 record and placed 8th at the 2025 NCAA Championships.
- Three-time NCAA Qualifier. Reached the Blood Round twice as a redshirt freshman and sophomore before breaking through last season to reach the podium.
- 2023 Big 12 champion as the No. 4 seed.
- Three-time New York state champion and four-time finalist (132-1 prep record).

### ADRIAN MEZA

Adrian Meza, a Valiant College Prep [Ariz.] product, was a key piece of Iowa State's 2024 recruiting class. Meza went 11-2 last season while using his five dates to maintain his redshirt.

- Redshirted the 2024-25 season.
- Meza reached the Round of 12 at the 2024 Cliff Keen Invitational and won a Grand View Open title in tournament action.
- In dual action, Meza went 3-0 and earned the first ranked victory of his career by defeating No. 27 Kale Petersen, 5-1, in the Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk dual.
- He was rated as the nation's No. 54 recruit by FloWrestling and No. 68 by MatScouts.

### KANE NAAKTGEBOREN

Kane Naaktgeboren saw action in three 2024-25 duals and earned his first career dual victory against Oklahoma.

- Redshirted the 2024-25 season.
- Registered a 15-5 record in his true freshman season.
- Linn-Mar High School product and the nation's No. 90 overall recruit by MatScouts.
- Capped his outstanding prep career with a state title and perfect 37-0 record. He was named the 2024 Bob Steenlage Iowa High School Wrestler of the Year, Cedar Rapids Gazette Wrestler of the Year and Dave Schultz High School Excellence Award recipient and was a 2024 Dan Gable Wrestler of the Year finalist.
- Naaktgeboren was a four-time Iowa high school state medalist with a 128-10 career record, including a school-record 108 falls.

CYCLONES ON THE WORLD STAGE

Cyclone wrestling fans had strong rooting interests on the international freestyle circuit this offseason. ISU heavyweight Daniel Herrera and alum David Carr represented Team USA at the U23 World Championships and Senior World Championships, respectively.

- Herrera placed fifth at 125 KG at the U23 World Championships in Novi Sad, Serbia, reaching the semifinals before eventually falling in the bronze medal bout.
- Carr finished fifth at 74 KG at the senior level world championships. He proved that he is among the best in the world by reaching the world quarterfinals, but suffered two narrow defeats to top-seeded Chermen Valiev (ALB) and three-time world champion Zaubek Sidakov (UWW) despite leading late in both matches.
