THE OPENING SERVE

• The Hoosiers are coming off a 2015 season in which they recorded an overall record of 16-16, their most wins since the 2010 season, which they advanced to the Sweet 16. The Hoosiers started the 2016 season 9-0 for just the fourth time in school history.

• Senior Megan Tallman is averaging 10.55 assists/set this season. Tallman currently has 3,499 assists for her career, which ranks fifth on the Hoosiers all-time list for career assists. Tallman needs two assists to earn a spot as the Hoosiers all-time leader in career assists in the rally scoring era and move into fourth overall.

• Senior Taylor Lebo became the 17th player in program history to reach 100 career aces at the Indiana Invitational. Lebo now has 118, which ranks seventh on the Hoosiers all-time list. Lebo is 10 aces shy of moving into sixth on the list. Lebo leads the Hoosiers with 23 aces this season. Lebo is also approaching 1,000 career digs as she now has 967.

• The Hoosiers have six newcomers this year including five true freshmen and one sophomore transfer. The Indiana Volleyball incoming freshmen class was ranked No. 29 in the country by PrepVolleyball.Com.

• The Hoosiers lost a lot of offensive production from the team last year including 54.3 percent of their kills from a season ago. This season the Hoosiers are using a balanced attack and have eight players on their roster with at least 36 kills, led by senior Allison Hammond with 205.

• Freshman Meaghan Koors has been stepping it up from the service line in Big Ten play. Koors ranks third in conference only matches in total aces with seven and second in aces per set.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Nebraska: Nebraska leads the all-time series, 11-1, only IU win was 10/14/78.

Iowa: Indiana leads 39-31, Iowa has won last four. Last IU win was at Iowa on 11/10/12. Three of the last four matches have gone five sets, two going to extra points.

• Seven match win streak achieved for only third time in last 14 years.

• First time since 2010 finishing the season with overall record at .500 or better and fifth time in last 15 years finishing season with overall record at .500 or better.
• Second in the Big Ten in aces per set at 1.32 at second in total aces with 153. Seven players with 11 or more aces and three players with over 22 aces.
• The Hoosiers beat three teams that made the NCAA Tournament (Northern Arizona, Michigan and Michigan State)

FRESH FACES IMPRESS

The Indiana freshmen are making an impact through the non-conference portions of the schedule.

- 7 players that did not play for the Hoosiers in 2015 have played in the 2016 season. (including 6 freshmen).
- Hayden Huybers went 10-0-10 for a perfect 1.000 against Northwestern.
- Kendall Beerman ranks second in the Big Ten among freshmen in hitting percentage and fifth in kills. Beerman has 142 kills for the season.
- Meaghan Koors ranks third in the Big Ten among freshmen in aces at .24/set.
- Koors ranks first in the Big Ten in aces in conference matches with seven.

HITTING EFFICIENCY

The Hoosiers are fifth in the Big Ten in hitting percentage at .285 for the season and 15th in the NCAA.

- The Hoosiers have hit .400 or better in four matches this season.
- Against Princeton the Hoosiers set the third best hitting percentage in school history for a three-set match at .500.
- Against Cleveland State the Hoosiers hit .400 with 49 kills and nine errors on 100 attempts.

RECORDS AND MILESTONES

- Megan Tallman is fifth on the Hoosiers all-time list for career assists (3,499).
- Taylor Lebo moved into seventh on the Hoosiers all-time list for career aces (118).
- Lebo passed 900 career digs and currently has 967.

AN EXPERIENCED STAFF

The Hoosier coaching staff is one of the most experienced groups all-time at Indiana. Combined they have 60 years of coaching experience at the collegiate level. 17 of those years are head coaching experience.

THE CENTURY MARK

Seniors Taylor Lebo (109) and Megan Tallman (108) have both played in over 100 career matches. Combined Lebo and Tallman have only missed five matches in the last four years.

ACES WILD

Serving is a strength of the Hoosiers and that is reflected in their numbers for the 2016 season.

- The Hoosiers rank first in the Big Ten in total aces with 111 and second in aces per set at 1.88/set.
- Indiana ranks eighth in the NCAA in aces per set at 1.88 and 10th in total aces with 111.
- Taylor Lebo leads the Hoosiers with 23 aces this season. Allison Hammond is second with 20 and Megan Tallman has 18.
- The Hoosiers have 111 aces this season compared to 68 from their opponents.
- The Hoosiers have three players in the top-10 in the Big Ten in aces per set. (Lebo 4th, Hammond 5th and Tallman 9th).





OH CANADA!!!

After playing a combined 29 sets in her freshmen and sophomore seasons, junior Jessica Leish has played in 26 sets this season. Leish has totaled 69 kills this season compared to 39 in her previous two years.

- Against Cleveland State, Leish had one of her best matches of her career with 12 kills and hit .320. She also tallied two digs and two blocks.

HAVING A HAYDAY

• Freshman Hayden Huybers has made a solid contribution in her first season with the Hoosiers. Huybers, a native of Fishers, Ind., is the fifth generation in her family to attend IU.

- Against Northwestern, Huybers hit a perfect 10 for 10 with no errors to become the first Hoosiers since Samantha Thrower in 2011 to achieve that feat.

NO TASK TOO TALL

Senior captain Megan Tallman is leading the Hoosiers on and off the court this year.

- Against Northwestern Tallman stuffed the stat sheet with 46 assists, eight kills, eight digs and three aces.
- Tallman ranks 59th in the NCAA in total assists with 536.
- Tallman ranks fifth on the Hoosiers career assist list with 3,499.

SUMMER BALL

- Senior middle blocker Jazzmine McDonald was selected to the USA Volleyball Collegiate National team that toured Europe this past summer.
- McDonald and the team won the gold medal at the Global Challenge in Pula, Croatia.

Freshman Meaghan Koors has been stepping up in Big Ten play for the Hoosiers from the service line.

- Koors ranks third in the Big Ten in conference matches in total aces with seven and second in aces per set at 0.54/set.
- Seven of her 14 aces this season have come in Big Ten play, which represents four of the Hoosiers 17 matches this season.
- For the season, Koors ranks third in the Big Ten among freshmen in aces per set at 0.24/set.
- Koors has nine kills for the season as a defensive specialist and connected on three kills on six swings (.600 hitting percentage) against No. 3 Wisconsin on Saturday.

Sherry Dunbar-Kruzan, a Ball State University graduate and Indiana native, has established a track record of success both as a player and a coach. Entering her tenth season at the helm of the Hoosier Volleyball program, she has a career winning percentage of .581 (258-186). The Hoosiers have won at least one non-conference tournament in each of Dunbar's nine seasons and advanced to the Sweet Sixteen in the 2010 NCAA Tournament for the best finish in school history.

In 2015 the Hoosiers continued their streak of nine straight years winning at least one pre-season tournament as they took the Indiana Invitational and the Northern Colorado Classic. The team won 10 non-conference matches for the sixth time in the last 25 years and for the first time since 2010 finished the season with an overall record at .500 or better.

In 2014 the Hoosiers started the season 6-0, winning the UConn Classic and Indiana Invitational. The team finished with their most wins since the 2010 season. Senior Morgan Leach became the 17th player in program history to pass 1,000 kills, ending with 1,110. Sophomore Taylor Lebo ranked 13th in the NCAA with 51 aces, the fifth most in a single season in school history. Junior libero Courtney Harnish became the third player in program history with at least 445 digs.

In that magical 2010 season, the Hoosiers made their first NCAA Tournament appearance under Dunbar, and the team advanced to the Sweet Sixteen for the first time in program history, finishing the season with a record of 23-12. The Hoosiers took down eventual national champion Penn State in a 3-1 thriller in Bloomington, knocking off the Nittany Lions for the first time in program history. IU hosted the first two rounds of the NCAA Tournament, scoring wins over Tennessee and Miami in front of sold-out raucous crowds at University Gymnasium.

In 2013 the Hoosiers won both the Indiana Invitational and Hoosier Classic Tournament titles and captured wins in eight of their first nine matches. In Big Ten play the Hoosiers earned a five-set victory at No. 10 Michigan State. Senior Caitlin Hansen reached the 1,000 dig mark and senior Jordan Haverly became the first Hoosier to record 1,500 kills and 1,000 digs.

In 2012, the Hoosiers showed glimpses of great things to come, taking victories over 17th-ranked Purdue at home and Wisconsin, Northwestern and Iowa on the road. The team's sweep of Western Illinois at the Butler Invitational was Dunbar's 200th career victory. During the season, Kelci Marschall and Jordan Haverly both eclipsed 1,000 career kills becoming Indiana's 15th and 16th members of the 1,000-kill club and the fourth and fifth players to reach the milestone under Dunbar.



The 2011 season proved to be a rebuilding year for the Hoosiers with the loss of Haverly to a knee injury, but the season was not without a major highlight. Dunbar mentored Samantha Thrower to a national record performance against Buffalo. Thrower recorded 15 kills on 15 swings, tying the national record for hitting percentage with 15 or more swings.

It took Dunbar just over two years to convert a program which won a lone Big Ten match in the season prior to her arrival, into a team on the national radar. The 2009 season saw Indiana receive votes in the American Volleyball Coaches Association's Coaches Top-25 Poll, rising as high as No. 39 in the country. The Hoosiers narrowly missed out on a trip to NCAAs.

In 2008, Dunbar's program took a big step with a 17-15 record that put them on the brink of an NCAA Tournament berth. Marquee wins included: a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin, an adidas Classic title-clinching win over BIG EAST Tournament Champion Louisville and the five-set triumph over #13 Minnesota.

Dunbar and her staff have brought in highly-touted recruiting classes in recent years, including a class ranked No. 22 nationally by PrepVolleyball.com in 2009. Even more impressive, those rankings did not include transfers such as IU's Haverly who was a top-20 recruit coming out of high school and had four years of eligibility remaining as a Hoosier after initially starting at Nebraska. For 2011, the Hoosiers signed another stellar class that included PrepVolleyball.com All-American Colleen Smith, from the top-ranked team in the nation, Cary-Grove (Ill.) High School. The 2012 class includes Under Armor All-American Katie Gallagher and AAU All-American Amelia Anderson.

Dunbar's player development capabilities have also become quite evident in her first four years directing the IU Hoosiers. Several all-time school records have been set the past six seasons.

Ashley Benson, Caitlin Cox, Juli Pierce and Erica Short each completed their careers atop a career statistical category. Under Dunbar's tutelage, Pierce became IU's all-time digs queen while Short did the same for kills. Also, Pierce broke the record for most digs in a single season in 2007. Caitlin Cox set a new single-season mark for digs in 2009 and 2010, besting Pierce's previous record with 488 digs in 2009 and then 513 in 2010. Cox then knocked Pierce out of the top spot in the career digs category in 2011, meaning Dunbar has overseen the two best liberos in IU history in her five years at IU. Short fell just one kill shy of setting the best single-season mark as a senior.

Then there's Benson. She pulverized the IU all-time record books in 2010, setting new marks for career blocks, career hitting efficiency, single-season blocks and single-season hitting efficiency. Not only did Benson break a pair of career records, but she separated herself substantially from second-best. Her .339 attacking clip is 49 points higher than second place (.290) and she has distanced

herself by 108 blocks with a four-year total of 629 total blocks.

Speaking of Benson, she became the first All-American in school history, earning third team honors in 2009 and first team honors in 2010, marking Coach Dunbar's second player to earn national recognition as Short was a All-America honorable mention in '08.

In 2007, Dunbar wasted little time elevating the Indiana volleyball program to new heights. She led the Hoosiers to more Big Ten victories in her first season alone than the previous three seasons combined.

Hoosier Nation also witnessed Lauren Dittéon become Indiana's first All-Big Ten selection since 2004 under the guidance of Coach Dunbar.

As the head coach at the College of Charleston, Dunbar compiled an overall record of 113-22 (.837), with four Southern Conference regular season titles, three Southern Conference Tournament titles and three trips to the NCAA Regionals (2004-06), advancing to the second round in 2005.

In 2006, the Cougars compiled a 27-8 record en route to their third straight NCAA trip. Four players earned all-conference honors, and CofC earned both the Southern Conference Libero and Freshman of the Year awards.

That success came on the heels of a 2005 season that saw the College of Charleston post a school-best 32-2 record and advance to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The Cougars posted the third-best winning percentage in the nation, with their only losses coming to a pair of ranked teams.

Dunbar led the Cougars to a 26-6 record overall and a 15-1 mark in the SoCon in 2004. CofC earned a trip to the NCAAs before falling to defending national champion Southern California in the first round.

In her first campaign as head coach, College of Charleston closed out the 2003 season with a 28-6 overall mark, a 17-1 league record and the first of four straight SoCon titles.

Dunbar's teams have had an equally impressive record in the classroom. The Cougars earned the American Volleyball Coaches Association Team Academic Award three straight seasons from 2003-05. In addition, Dunbar has coached a CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team selection and a CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine Academic All-America Second Team honoree.

Before her arrival in Charleston, Dunbar spent six seasons as an assistant at Tennessee, where she was involved in recruiting, scouting, practice planning and community outreach programs. At the conference level, she served as the SEC representative for the NCAA Assistant Volleyball Coaches Committee.

Before joining the Lady Vols, Dunbar spent four years in a similar role at the University of San Francisco under Head Coach Karin Wallenstein, while also serving as the school's assistant compliance director. Her coaching duties included working with the middle blockers as well as scouting, recruiting and overseeing individual player training.

Born in Fontana, Calif., Dunbar's family moved to Ellettsville, Ind., when she was three years old. While playing at Edgewood High School, she was coached by Wallenstein, then an assistant at EHS. When Wallenstein was named head coach at USF in 1993, she named Dunbar her first assistant.

She earned a bachelor's degree from Ball State in 1992 and completed a master's in sports and fitness management at the University of San Francisco in 1996.

Dunbar-Kruzan is married to husband Mark and the two live in Bloomington.
