WEEKEND SNAPSHOT

After an illustrious first season under head coach **Amanda Janney** in 2015, the Indiana Hoosiers are anxious for what awaits them this year. Indiana returns their leading scorer from 2015, a NFHCA All-American in the midfield, and one of the best single-season goalkeepers in program history. Joining the fold this season is Janney's first full recruiting class, an eight-player group of young, fresh talent. The Hoosiers begin their season at home versus Louisville in the "Battle of the Border", followed by an away trip to face the Ohio Bobcats. IU's game versus Louisville will stream online at BTN2Go.com.

HOOSIER NOTABLES

TURNING THE CORNER

The Hoosiers are ready to begin the 2016 fall season, Amanda Janney's second year as head coach. In addition, assitant coach/goalkeeper specialist Ayla Halus begins her second season of cultivating one of the top goalkeeping corps in the Big Ten. Janney's addition of assistant coach **Kayla May** and volunteer assistant coach **Emily Rice** provided several new dynamics to offseason training.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

The Indiana players made their selections for team captains at the beginning of the preseason. Redshirt junior **Elle Hempt** will join returning captains **Kate Barber** and **Mollie Getzfread** to lead Indiana into their 2016 campaign.

MAKING THEIR MARK

Four Hoosiers are commencing their senior season this weekend. **Kate Barber, Morgan Dye, Malia Fujisawa**, and **Mollie Getzfread** have combined for 16 academic plaudits, an All-Big Ten selection, and an All-American honor.

"THE BATTLE OF THE BORDER" BEGINS

The annual meeting between the Indiana Hoosiers and the Louisville Cardinals has taken on a name: "The Battle of the Border". This intense rivalry, split by the Ohio River Valley, has produced intense competition over their 15 meetings. The Hoosiers and Cardinals met at the beginning of last season, where Louisville won a 3-0 contest.

BRACING FOR THE BOBCATS

Indiana closes the weekend with a trip to Athens for a game against the Ohio Bobcats. Ohio, like Indiana, is receiving votes in the preseason polls with aspirations of quickly rising into the national top 20. This all-time series is currently in a 5-5 deadlock, and the winner of Sunday's game will take the series lead. In their last meeting, in 2014, Indiana earned a 1-0 victory in Athens.

OF NOTE

- Kate Barber, Morgan Dye, and Noëlle Rother were named to the 2016 Big Ten Players to Watch List.
- Junior Maddie Latino was Indiana's top scorer last year, and she'll aim to build off of that success in the 2016 season. Latino tallied 28 points on 10 goals and 8 assists, ranking 35th nationally in points per game.
- Coming back from a dominant freshman campaign, Noëlle Rother will lead the Hoosier defense between the pipes this season. Rother ranked 23rd nationally in her goals against average last year, and her 114 saves in 2015 was the third-highest single-season total in IU history.
- 2015 All-American Kate Barber returns to Indiana as a key playmaker in her senior season. Barber thrived on attack penalty corners last year, scoring or creating 11 goals from the top of the circle.
- The Hoosiers are excited about the potential of junior Taylor Pearson, who joins Latino up front this season. Pearson netted 11 goals in the spring season and four in their scrimmage last weekend at Ball State. She returns from a season with three goals and three assists, including one game-winner.

HEAD COACH AMANDA JANNEY

FIRST YEAR AT INDIANA



In 2015, Janney's first season with Indiana, the Hoosiers improved by four wins in the Big Ten conference, setting a new school record with five wins against Big Ten teams. Indiana improved from an eighth-place finish in 2014 to take the third seed in the 2015 Big Ten Tournament. Three Hoosiers—Kate Barber (First Team-unanimous), Sydney Supica (Second Team), and Noëlle Rother (Second Team)—earned All-Big Ten and All-NFHCA All-West Region accolades. In addition Barber received All-American honors from the NFHCA and Synapse Sports, the first All-American Hoosier since Audra Heilman (2013).

Season highlights in 2015 include the Hoosiers' weekend sweep against lowa and Northwestern, both ranked in the national top-20; a 3-0 road win at Ohio State, the Hoosiers' first shutout over the Buckeyes in program history; a home 1-0 win over Penn State, won on a last-second penalty corner goal before halftime; a 1-0 overtime loss at Maryland, where Indiana held the sixth-ranked Terrapins scoreless for 77 minutes; and a 2-0 win against Rutgers on Senior Day to clinch the program record for single-season Big Ten wins.

Indiana University Vice President and Director of Athletics Fred Glass announced the hiring of Temple University Head Coach Amanda Janney as the new head coach of the Indiana field hockey program on Monday, Feb. 9, 2015. Janney's experience includes a pattern of great success as both a player at Wake Forest and on the U.S. Indoor National

Team, and as a head and assistant coach.

Joining the Hoosiers after 10 years as the head coach at Temple, Janney has compiled a 114-94 record with 10 straight postseason appearances. Last season, Janney led the Owls to a No. 11 NCAA RPI ranking and a finish of No. 14 in the NFHCA Coaches Poll.

At Temple, Janney took over a team that had not turned in a winning record since 1992 and transformed it into a consistently successful program. In those 10 seasons, Janney coached five Atlantic 10 Players of the Year, 23 All-Conference selections, three All-Americans, three Temple Student-Athletes of the Year and 16 Regional All-Americans.

"We are thrilled to have Amanda Janney as the new leader of Indiana field hockey," Glass said. "On the field, in the classroom, and in the community, Amanda's track record as the head coach at Temple is extraordinary. Known as an elite recruiter and talent developer, we believe we have hired one of the great field hockey coaches in the country."

Janney was selected as head coach after a comprehensive national search led by Glass who worked in consultation with the Search Advisory Committee, consisting of key administrators, support staff, along with redshirt junior forward Nicole Volgraf and sophomore defender Malia Fujisawa, who served as the student-athlete

representatives to the committee. Glass and the committee reviewed dozens of potential candidates, performed extensive research and reference checks on a handful or so, and had four candidates, including Amanda, on campus to interview with Glass and the committee. After a thorough review, Glass made the decision to hire Janney as head coach.

Janney is excited about opportunity to coach at Indiana and in one of the nation's elite conferences.

"I want to thank Fred Glass and the administration for this amazing opportunity," said Janney. "I am already so impressed with the team leaders, the IU field hockey alumni, and the Spirit of Indiana. I am ready to lead IU field hockey and compete in the Big Ten, one of the best conferences in the country."
