2024 INDIANA BASEBALL MEDIA POLICIES AND INFORMATION

Media Credential Pick Up

All single game media and photo credentials for the 2024 Indiana baseball season can be picked up at the Bart Kaufman Field ticket office two hours before first pitch. Season credentials will be handed out to those who requested them ahead of the first home game of the season (Feb. 20 vs. Miami).

Only individuals associated with a media outlet in a working capacity will be granted credentials. Anyone who abuses or fails to follow these guidelines is subject to have their credential privileges revoked. Please me mindful and respectful of all people you interact with in and around Bart Kaufman Field and the Indiana baseball program.

Media Seating

Members of the media with valid media credentials may enter Bart Kaufman Field through any of three gates in the stadium. Please have your credential in sight and be prepared to have any bags or backpacks searched upon entering.

There will be roughly six or seven media seats available in the press box, as well as 8-10 additional seats in the overflow media area that will be set up behind the seats in front of the press box windows. This location will be have WiFi and power available but will not have air conditioning or heat, so please plan accordingly based on weather conditions. We will make adjustments as needed based on availability.

Priority seating will be assigned for the seats in the press box for all games. If you are not assigned a seat in the press box, you will need to sit in the overflow media section. All credentialed media are welcome to work in the press box for two hours before and one hour following the end of head coach Jeff Mercer's press conference.

Photo/Video Areas

Media credentials are required for all photographers, videographers and television media.

Photographers and videographers WILL NOT be permitted in or between the dugouts during pregame warmups or while the game is in progress. Only official university and/or team media personnel are permitted inside the dugouts while the game is in progress.

Credentialed media can shoot from along the main concourse of Bart Kaufman Field, in the bleachers and anywhere that is not sectioned off or reserved. Please do not interact with players or baseball staff of either team during or before the game unless specifically given access by a member of either teams' communications staff.

Internet/WiFi

High-speed wireless Internet is available throughout Bart Kaufman Field. WiFi can be accessed through the network named "iua" with the password GOIUGAMEDAY. Instructions on how to join the iua network are listed on the seat place cards located at every media seat.

Game Notes, Box Scores, Stats, Rosters, etc.

Game notes and stats can be found on the baseball media center online while pregame lineups will be printed and available in the press box at Bart Kaufman Field.

Immediately following the conclusion of each game, box scores, recap, season stats and portions of the postgame press conference will be uploaded to the online baseball media center.

Live Stats

Live stats for all Indiana home games can be accessed through Stat Broadcast by visiting iuhoosiers.com. There is no password to access the link. Links for away games will be available online.

Postgame Interviews

Indiana head coach Jeff Mercer and select student-athletes will be available for postgame interviews following the completion of competition each day. Postgame interviews will take place in the batting facility located down the left-field line or on the field at the conclusion of the game.

An Indiana strategic communications representative will meet the media to the postgame interview area following each game. Please have your credential ready to present to security guards. Media are not permitted in the clubhouse, in the batting cages or on the field unless accompanied by a communications representative. Select quotes will be available following the press conference.
