# **ABOUT THE FRISCO CLASSIC**

- Alabama will head to Frisco, Texas for the Frisco Classic at Riders Field from March 1-3. The weekend in Frisco will be the Crimson Tide's first neutral site weekend since 2016. That 2016 season saw the Tide travel to Cary, N.C., for the USA Baseball Classic from March 4-6. Alabama came away from Cary with a 3-1 record.
- The Crimson Tide will first face Indiana on Friday, March 1. It will be just the second meeting between the two schools with the only other matchup coming on March 14, 1989, at Baseball City Stadium in Haines City, Fla. The neutral site contest finished in favor of the Hoosiers, 10-7.
- Crimson Tide head coach Rob Vaughn owns a 7-7 career mark against the Hoosiers.
- Alabama's opponent on Saturday will be Arizona. It will mark the first time the two programs have met on the baseball diamond. It will also be the first time Vaughn has faced Arizona during his collegiate head coaching career.
- The weekend will wrap up with Dallas Baptist on Sunday. The Tide and Patriots have met just once in history on March 1, 2008, in the Southwest Diamond Classic in Frisco. The neutral site pairing saw UA earn an 8-1 win.
- Vaughn holds a 1-2 record all-time against Dallas Baptist.

#### **ABOUT ALABAMA**

- Alabama enters the weekend in Frisco at 9-0 overall, including a 4-0 stretch over the last week. The Crimson Tide swept Valparaiso last weekend in Tuscaloosa before a trip to Birmingham on Tuesday saw the Tide defeat UAB in extras.
- The Crimson Tide scored three runs in the 10th inning of Tuesday's game to come away with a 9-7 victory over UAB at Regions Field in Birmingham.
- UAB gained a 4-0 advantage after two innings of play, plating one in the first and three in the second. Both teams stayed scoreless until the fifth when a two-run homer from Bryce Eblin cut the lead in half. Two innings later, TJ McCants tied things up with a two-run shot of his own.
- The Tide added two more in the eighth, but one Blazer run in the home half followed by a second tally in the ninth sent the game to extras.
- Alabama plated three runs in the 10th. Singles from Eblin and Justin Lebron set the stage for Gage Miller, who
  doubled to right to score Eblin and put a pair in scoring position. One out later, lan Petrutz singled through the left
  side to add another run and move men to the corners. The inning's final run came in one out later thanks to a wild pitch.
- UAB got a run back in the bottom of the 10th, but a strikeout looking ended things in favor of the Crimson Tide.
- Alabama's offense was spread across the lineup on Tuesday night with seven of the nine starters recording at least one hit. Miller, **Mason Swinney**, Eblin and Lebron all contributed three-hit nights to lead the bats.
- **Matthew Heiberger** collected his first career win, allowing one run on one hit and a walk with three strikeouts over the final 1.2 frames in Birmingham. The Crimson Tide was able to keep things close thanks to an impressive relief effort from **Tyler Fay** who contributed 3.2 scoreless frames with two strikeouts.
- A season-high 15 hits helped the Tide to a 14-2 win over Valparaiso last Friday at Sewell-Thomas Stadium.
- Alabama wasted no time getting on the board, exploding for a six-run second. Valparaiso countered with a two-run
  third, but that would be all for the Beacons. The Crimson Tide posted eight runs over the final three innings of play for
  the run-rule victory.
- Miller highlighted Alabama's offense, going 2-for-4 with a double, one homer, two runs scored and a team-high five RBI. *Mac Guscette* and *Will Hodo* led the Tide in hits, each contributing three on the day. Guscette reached base safely in all four plate appearances, finishing 3-for-3 with a double and a hit-by-pitch while tallying one RBI and two runs scored. Hodo went 3-for-4 with a double and two runs of his own.
- Ben Hess notched his second win as many starts last Friday, giving up two runs on four hits and a walk with five punchouts across his scheduled 4.0 innings of work.
- Alabama clinched a series over Valparaiso with a 13-3 win on Saturday.
- Valpo delivered an early blow with two in the top of the first. The Crimson Tide answered with a seven-spot in the home half, hammering four home runs in the frame to make it a 7-2 affair after one full. The Beacons plated one in the third but would add no more, as the Tide went on to score six unanswered for the 13-3 run-rule victory in seven innings.
- Miller, Petrutz, **Coleman Mizell** and Lebron all contributed a homer in that fourth. **Aidan Moza** got the win last Saturday, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and two walks with four strikeouts in his start.
- The Crimson Tide completed the weekend sweep thanks to an 11-1 win last Sunday.
- Valparaiso got out front early for a second straight day, plating one run in the top of the first. Alabama answered with a two-spot in the home half and proceeded to score in six of the seven innings for the run-rule victory.
- McCants and **Evan Sleight** tied for the team lead in RBI with three apiece. McCants finished 2-for-5 with two home runs and two runs scored to go with his RBI, while Sleight led the Tide in hits thanks to a perfect 3-for-3 showing that included two doubles, a walk and one run along with the RBI. Miller and Hodo each tied for the lead in runs scored with three apiece, with Miller adding his third home run in as many games.
- **Greg Farone** got the win after throwing a scheduled 3.0 innings. He allowed one run on two hits with five strikeouts in his shortened outing before handing it over to the bullpen for the sweep-clinching win last Sunday.
- Alabama welcomed back 15 letterwinners for the 2024 season. Included in those 15 are two positional starters and eight pitchers that returned for the new campaign.

# **McCANTS POWERING THE OFFENSE**

- TJ McCants has been the leader of the Crimson Tide offense through the first week-plus of play.
- In February, the senior paces Alabama or is tied for the team lead in nearly every offensive category including doubles (3), home runs (6), RBI (19) and stolen bases (4-4) along with slugging percentage (1.057). He also ranks second in walks (5) and tied for second in runs scored (12) through nine games.
- McCants has contributed at least one hit and one run in every game while recording at least two RBI in seven of the nine contests, highlighted by a six-RBI effort against Alabama State last Wednesday. He has also recorded at least one extra-base hit in eight of his nine starts.
- Entering the Frisco Classic, McCants leads the SEC in RBI and is tied for the league lead in home runs while ranking second in total bases (37) and fourth in both hits (14) and slugging percentage.

#### MILLER CLOSE BEHIND

- Gage Miller has nearly matched TJ McCants, providing the Crimson Tide with a 1-2 punch at the top of the lineup.
- After nine games, Miller leads UA in hits (16) and runs scored (17) while ranking second in homers (5) and RBI (16).
- The Palmyra, Pa., native has been red hot as of late, batting .550 (11-20) with two doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, 11 runs, one walk and two hit-by-pitch across the last five games.
- Miller leads the SEC in runs scored while ranking second in hits and third in both home runs and RBI.
- Entering the matchup with 21st-ranked Indiana to begin the weekend in Frisco, Miller owns an eight-game hitting streak, one behind McCants for the team-long mark.

#### **LEANING ON THE PEN**

- The Tide has called on its bullpen early and often to start the season as the starters continue to build up a pitch counts.
- Alabama's relivers own a 1.12 ERA (5 ER/40.1 IP) and have struck out 46 compared to 11 walks while holding the opposition to a lowly .176 average.
- The Tide has used 14 total relievers with 10 of the 14 yet to give up a run.
- Alabama's pen has been key to helping the team maintain a 1.62 ERA (13 ER/72.0 IP), the third-lowest mark in Division I and second-lowest total in SEC play entering the new weekend.
- UA's pitching staff has also posted three shutouts to tie with Texas and Texas A&M for the national lead.

#### STREAKING TO START

- Alabama enters the weekend in Frisco having won nine games to open the season. That nine-game streak ties for the eighth-longest winning streak to start a new year, matching the 2018, 1938 and 1924 squads.
- The Crimson Tide's all-time longest winning streak to start a year is 15 games which occurred in 1997. Ranking second is a 14-gamer followed by an 11-game streak at No. 4 and a 10-game stretch to start ranking fifth on the program's all-time list.
- The nine-game streak is also tied for the second-longest winning streak by a head coach to start his Alabama career. Vaughn's streak ties Wallace Wade (1924) for the second-longest streak to begin a career with the duo trailing only Kid Peeples' record of 10 straight victories back in 1897. Peeples coached only the 1897 season.

#### **LEBRON NAMED SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - FEB. 19**

- Alabama shortstop Justin Lebron was named the SEC Freshman of the Week on Feb. 19.
- The freshman started all three games of Opening Weekend at shortstop against Manhattan. He batted a team-high and league-high tying .667 (4-6) with a double, one homer, three RBI, two runs, four walks and a hit-by-pitch.
- · Lebron recorded at least one hit in all three games against the Jaspers while leading UA in walks.
- Highlighting his first weekend of collegiate ball was an inside-the-park home run in Sunday's series finale. He became just the second player in Crimson Tide history to hit an inside-the-parker for his first career home run.
- The Miramar, Fla., native also played elite defense, recording four putouts and three assists in seven chances while also turning a slick double play on his own.

#### STARTING OFF RANKED

- Alabama entered the 2024 season ranked in three of the five major polls.
- The Crimson Tide's highest ranking came from the USA Today Coaches Poll, with UA ranked at No. 17 to start the season. The Tide was also ranked 17th by the Coaches Poll to close out the 2023 season.
- D1Baseball.com had the Crimson Tide ranked No. 19 entering the new year after Alabama finished at No. 10 in the site's final noll last season
- The NCBWA ranked UA as its No. 23 team. The organization had the Crimson Tide at No. 16 at the end of 2023.

#### **ALTON'S PRESEASON ACCOLADES**

- Sophomore Alton Davis II earned multiple preseason honors entering his second season with the Crimson Tide.
- Davis II was named to the AII-SEC Second Team as a reliever while also being tabbed to the NCBWA's Stopper of the Year Watch List.
- The Hueytown native finished last season as the Crimson Tide's closer, securing eight saves across nine chances, including a league-high tying six in SEC play.

# **GET TO KNOW VAUGHN'S STAFF**

- Rob Vaughn was named the 33rd head coach in Alabama baseball history on Monday, June 12, 2023.
- Vaughn came to Tuscaloosa after spending the previous six seasons at Maryland. While in College Park, his teams compiled a 183-117 overall record, including an 84-54 mark in conference play.
- The Terps laid claim to the 2022 and 2023 Big Ten regular season crowns while adding a Big Ten Tournament title in 23. Maryland also earned a spot in three consecutive NCAA Regionals from 2021-23.
- Vaughn retained interim head coach Jason Jackson, assigning him the title of Associate Head Coach. He then brought Anthony Papio and Mike Morrison with him from Maryland. Papio was officially hired on June 23 while Morrison's hiring followed just over a week later on July 1.
- Papio played under Vaughn at Maryland before serving in three different roles across seven seasons on staff. He began his coaching career as a student assistant in 2017 before being elevated to volunteer assistant from 2017-21. Papio most recently served as an assistant coach for the 2022 and 2023 seasons.
- Morrison spent the previous two seasons at UMD with Vaughn, working as an assistant and serving as the Terps' pitching coach. Prior to his time at Maryland, Morrison served in two different roles at his alma mater, Coastal Carolina. He began his time with the Chanticleers as Director of Player Development and Scouting in 2020 before being elevated to an assistant coach in 2021.
- Vaughn's rounded out his first staff at UA by adding former Alabama standout Mikey White as the team's Coordinator of Player Development. White, who played for the Crimson Tide from 2013-15, spent last season at Tennessee Tech after completing a seven-year career in professional baseball.

#### 2024 EDITION OF THE CRIMSON TIDE

- Alabama entered 2024 with a bunch of new faces. The Crimson Tide welcomed back only 15 letterwinners, including two positional starters and eight total pitchers, from last season's NCAA Super Regional squad.
- The 2024 roster's returning positional starters are made up of Mac Guscette and Bryce Eblin. Guscette served as the Tide's primary catcher last season while Eblin played in 40 games with 22 starts when healthy.
- On the mound, the Tide returned eight pitchers, highlighted by preseason All-American Ben Hess and preseason All-SEC honoree Alton Davis II. Hess, who was hampered by injuries his first two seasons in Tuscaloosa, looks to anchor UA's starting rotation. Davis II took over the closer role last season on his way to Freshman All-America accolades. The left-hander finished with eight saves overall, including six in conference play.
- The 2024 Tide welcomed 27 newcomers, including 13 freshman and 14 transfers from the collegiate and JUCO ranks.

#### A DEEPER DIVE INTO LAST SEASON

- Alabama finished last season at 43-21 overall and 16-14 in Southeastern Conference play.
- The 43 wins were the most in a single season since 2006 when that team finished 44-21. Of those 43 wins, 38 came during the regular season, the most since a 39-17 finish by that '06 squad.
- UA accumulated 16 wins in SEC play for the first time since 2009 when that team finished 18-11. The Tide also finished above .500 in conference action, a first since 2014 and the first across a complete 30-game conference slate since 2008.
- A major point of emphasis was placed on midweeks with the Crimson Tide finishing 12-1 on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. That record included a 10-0 start to midweek action.
- The success in conference play earned the Tide a spot in Hoover for a third consecutive season. Alabama had not reached the SEC Tournament in three straight years since 2014-16 prior to 2023.
- The Tide's 2-2 run in Hoover provided Tuscaloosa with the opportunity to host an NCAA Regional for the first time since 2006. UA swept the Regional, 3-0, to advance to Super Regionals for the first time since 2010.
- Alabama began the season on a 14-game winning streak to tie for the second-longest winning streak to start a season, trailing only the 1997 roster's 15-game mark. The 14-game streak also tied for the fifth-longest winning streak at any point in a season in Alabama history.
- The Crimson Tide entered SEC play with 16 totals wins and proceeded to pick up one victory apiece at then-No. 2 Florida, against then-No. 22 Kentucky and at then-No. 6 Arkansas. A series loss to Mississippi State set Alabama at 4-8 overall and 0-4 in conference series after four weeks.
- Following the series loss to the Bulldogs, Alabama went 5-1 over the final six series and 12-6 overall in conference play. The only series loss in the final six-week stretch came at top-ranked LSU.
- In the middle of that hot streak, Alabama made a change at head coach. The announcement came on the morning of May 4, with Jason Jackson taking over as interim head coach.
- Jackson guided Alabama to a 13-6 record over the final stretch. His first win came the night of May 4, a dominant 11-2 victory over then-No. 5 Vanderbilt. The Tide took two games from the 'Dores for a series win, one of three in a row to close out the regular season. The Tide had not won three straight SEC series since 2014.
- Alabama's season came to an end on Sunday, June 11, with Rob Vaughn being named the new head coach the very next afternoon. Vaughn was formally introduced as head coach at a press conference on Tuesday, June 13.

#### TOP THREE IN HITTING AND PITCHING OVERALL

- Alabama finished the 2023 regular season as the only team ranked in the top-three for both hitting and pitching in the Southeastern Conference.
- UA was third in hitting, behind only top-five LSU and Florida, while ranking second in pitching behind just Tennessee.

## LEAGUE LEADERS FOR RUN DIFFERENTIAL IN CONFERENCE PLAY

- Alabama finished the 2023 SEC slate as the league leaders in run differential at plus-48. The Tide totaled 191 runs while allowing a league-low 143. The Crimson Tide finished one run ahead of Arkansas in run differential.
- UA owned the sixth-strongest intra-conference schedule with the Tide's opponents combining for a 136-133 (.506) record. Alabama did not face Georgia, South Carolina or Tennessee, who totaled a 43-46 record in league play.

#### LIMITING WALKS WAS KEY

- Alabama's pitching staff kept the walks down during the 2023 campaign. The Tide arms allowed 236 free passes on the year, a total that finished as the fourth-fewest in the SEC.
- The Crimson Tide allowed five-or-more free passes only 21 times. In those 21 games, UA held a 9-12 record overall.
- When Alabama was able to keep its walk total below five, the Tide owned a 34-9 mark.

#### STACKING SHUTOUTS

- Alabama tallied seven shutouts on the season, including two in postseason play, last year.
- The seven shutouts tied for the second-most in Crimson Tide single-season history, matching the 2014, 2011 and 1967 teams. The Tide's all-time mark for shutouts is 11 by the 1974 team.
- UA's seven shutouts tied for the sixth-most in Division I and were tied for the fourth-most among SEC teams.

#### **SERVING UP STRIKEOUTS**

- Alabama totaled an impressive 593 strikeouts through 64 games in 2023.
- The Tide's 593 punchouts tied the Alabama single-season record and were the top total during Jason Jackson's tenure as the pitching coach.
- Under Jackson, the Tide pitching staff has finished in the top-10 on Alabama's single-season list for strikeouts on three occasions. The 2021 group totaled 497 punchouts, good for ninth, while the 2022 team finished with 540, which is now the fifth-most in program history. The 2022 squad also set the single-season record for strikeouts per game at 9.31.

#### **BIG-TIME OFFENSE IN 2023**

- Alabama's bats went on a tear during the 2023 season, maintaining a .293 (634-2,162) average and totaling 634 hits. UA averaged 9.9 hits per game and recorded double-digit hits in 36 games (56.3 percent), including 13 contests during Southeastern Conference play.

#### **SCORING IN NEARLY HALF THE INNINGS**

- The Crimson Tide offense produced runs at an impressive clip in 2023.
- UA's bats saw time in the box in 542.0 total innings and crossed a run in 224 of those for a 41.3 percent mark.
- Of those 224 innings, 118 went for two-or-more runs with 23 going for five-plus runs.
- Alabama scored double-digit runs in 24 total games, including eight contests during SEC play.
- The big-time scoring translated to wins, with the Crimson Tide holding a 33-8 record when scoring six-or-more runs in a game, including a 23-1 record when scoring 10-plus runs.

#### SUPPLYING SOUVENIRS

- Alabama hit 112 home runs last season to finish 12th in Division I and fifth in the SEC.
- The Tide homered in 54 of the 64 total games of the 2023 campaign while producing multiple homers 35 times. Alabama also hit two-or-more homers in 18 contests during SEC play.
- UA averaged 1.75 homers per game, good for 23rd nationally and sixth in the conference ranks.
- The 112 homers finished as the fourth-most in Alabama single-season history and the most during the dead bat era (since 2011).
- The Tide homered in 24 straight games from April 18-June 3 to set the program record for consecutive games with a roundtripper. It topped the previous high of 18 games by the 2009 team from Feb. 20-March 18. It also passed the second-longest stretch, which was 17 games in 1997 from March 9-April 4.
- Alabama got off to a red-hot start to open the year, recording a homer in the first 16 games. That stretch ranked as the third-longest streak with a home run in UA history at the time.

#### **SEVEN GRAND SLAMS IN '23**

- Included in Alabama's 2023 home run total was seven grand slams, four of which came in consecutive games from Feb. 28-March 5.
- The Tide's first grand slam of last season came off the bat of Camden Hayslip against Jacksonville State on Feb. 28.
- Alabama then hit a grand slam three days in a row during the UIC series, first by Tommy Seidl in the opener on March 3. Colby Shelton followed by hitting a grand slam on both Saturday and Sunday. The four-game stretch with a slam set a new program record (since 1983).
- $\bullet$  Ed Johnson hammered UA's fifth grand slam in game one of the March 11 contest with Columbia.
- Andrew Pinckney then recorded the sixth grand slam on May 4 against then-No. 5 Vanderbilt. He
  was followed one weekend later by Seidl, who hit his second of the year at Texas A&M on May 14.
- Alabama's seven grand slams in 2023 tied for the second-most in UA single-season history since grand slams were tracked in 1983. The seven grand slams are the most by a Tide team during the 'dead bat era' (since 2011), surpassing the previous total of four by the 2017 roster.
- The program record for grand slams since '83 is 11 by the 1984 team with the 1997 and 2009 squads each tying the 2023 group for second place at seven.
- Alabama's slams were a part of the team's 37 hits with the bases loaded that made up a combined .352 (37-105) average with the bags juiced.

#### PATIENCE PAID OFF

- Alabama's hitters were extremely patient in 2023, drawing 340 walks through 64 games.
- The Tide's walk total ranked fifth in the SEC and 13th nationally at season's end.
- UA averaged 5.31 walks per game to set the new program-high mark. The previous record was 5.30 by the 1999 team.

- Rob Vaughn was hired as Alabama's 33rd head baseball coach on June 12, 2023 and formally introduced on Tuesday, June 13.
- The 2022 ABCA/ATEC East Region Coach of the Year, Vaughn has helped 19 student-athletes earn first, second, third or freshman All-America honors during his collegiate coaching career.
- Vaughn has coached 36 players who have been drafted or signed professional contracts during his time as a collegiate coach, including 2023 first-rounder Matt Shaw along with MLB standouts Brandon Lowe and LaMonte Wade Jr.
- Vaughn came to Tuscaloosa after spending the previous six seasons as the head coach at Maryland where he led the Terps to a 183-117 mark, including an 84-54 record in Big Ten play.
- A two-time Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2022 and 2023, Vaughn's UMD squads claimed two straight Big Ten titles in '22 and '23 along with earning a Big Ten Tournament crown in 2023.
- Vaughn led UMD to two of the program's 40-win seasons as a head coach (2022, 2023) and helped the Terps advance to three consecutive NCAA Regionals from 2021-23.
