Head coach Steve Holm is entering his sixth season with the Redbird baseball program in the 2023-24 academic year. Through the 2022 season, his overall mark is 107-130, a winning percentage of .451. Holm is 42-54 in Missouri Valley play, a winning percentage of .438.

Holm and the Redbirds posted a 36-26 (14-7 MVC) record and earned a share of the Missouri Valley Conference regular season title in 2019, his debut season as head coach. The 36 wins was a 14-win improvement than the year prior and the most wins for an Illinois State team since winning 39 in 2013. It was also the most wins for a first-year Redbird baseball head coach in program history.

The 'Birds earned an at-large NCAA Tournament berth in 2019 and were placed in the Louisville regional, defeating both Big Ten regular season champions Indiana and No. 7 Louisville, before ultimately falling to Louisville in the Illinois State's first-ever appearance in a regional final. Louisville advanced to the Final Four of the College World Series where they were defeated by eventual champions No. 1 Vanderbilt, who ISU had also beaten earlier in the year in Nashville.

Holm was named MVC Coach of the Year for the 2019 season. The Redbirds also collected the MVC Player of the Year (Joe Aeilts) and MVC Pitcher of the Year (Brent Headrick) awards.

Illinois State shook up the college baseball world to open the 2022 season, knocking off 2nd-ranked Arkansas in Fayetteville to open the season. The Redbirds also defeated the nation's last remaining unbeaten team, #19 Purdue, in a thrilling extra-inning, walk-off victory to open ISU's home slate. Illinois State also defeated the Big Ten's Illinois and Iowa, in addition to Purdue.

Ryan Cermak became the program's third-highest pick in program history in 2022 and highest since 2001 after he was selected in the 2nd round and 71st overall by the Tampa Bay Rays in the 2022 MLB Draft. Cermak won the program's first ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove and was back-to-back MVC Defensive Player of the Year and First-Team All-MVC.

During the shortened 2020 season, Holm and the Redbirds recorded road victories at No. 23 Oklahoma and No. 13 Arkansas en route to a 7-9 record.

Under Holm's lead, the Redbirds have defeated seven different ranked opponents (#1 Vanderbilt in 2019, #7 Louisville in 2019, #23 Oklahoma in 2020, #13 Arkansas in 2020, #25 Indiana State in 2021, #2 Arkansas in 2022, #19 Purdue in 2022, #17 Iowa in 2023). The Redbirds have also been ranked in the NCAA's RPI Top 25 two seasons (25 in 2020, 23 in 2019). The Redbirds were one of just 11 total programs and three Mid-Majors to be ranked in the RPI Top 25 in both 2019 and 2020.

Prior to taking over the ISU program, Holm was a pitching coach at Purdue and an integral part of the staff that helped the Boilermakers improve by 28 wins over a two-year period and become a NCAA Regional participant in 2018.

WALLY CRANCER - ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/RECRUITING COORDINATOR

Former Georgia Tech standout Wally Crancer is entering his sixth season as the Redbirds' assistant head coach and recruiting coordinator in 2023-24 academic year. Crancer helped lead the Redbirds to a 36-26 (14-7 MVC) record in his first season at Illinois State, in which they earned a share of the Missouri Valley Conference regular season title for the first time since 2013. The Redbirds earned an at-large NCAA Tournament berth in 2019 and were placed in the Louisville regional, defeating both Big Ten regular season champs Indiana and No. 7 Louisville, before ultimately falling to Louisville in the first ISU appearance ever in a regional final. Louisville advanced to the Final Four of the College World Series where they were defeated by eventual champions No. 1 Vanderbilt, who Illinois State had also beaten earlier in the year in Nashville.



TONY JANDRON - ASSISTANT COACH

Tony Jandron was announced as an Illinois State assistant coach on July 21, 2023 and is entering his first season as a Redbird in the 2023-24 academic year. Jandron, a native of Negaunee, Mich., spent the previous five seasons as an assistant at Central Michigan, amassing a 177-80 (.689) record as a Chippewa. In Jandron's time at Central Michigan, the Chippewas earned their first NCAA berth since 1995, tied the program record for victories in a season (47), and broke the programs stolen base record in a season (133). The 2019, 2021, 2022 teams won 132 games, marking the winningest three-year stretch in program history. Central Michigan was in the NCAA Tournament three straight times (2019, 2021, 2022) during Jandron's time in Mount Pleasant. The dramatic 6-5 victory over Miami (Fla.) in an NCAA Regional game in Starkville, Miss. was CMU's first NCAA Tournament victory since 1988.



DEREK PAROLA - ASSISTANT COACH/ DIRECTOR OF CAMPS

Illinois State University alum Derek Parola (B.S. '18, MBA '20) is entering his fourth season as the Assistant Coach and Director of Camps in the 2023-24 academic year. Parola was the team's Director of Operations for the 2020 season and was a baseball student-athlete from 2015-2019 for the 'Birds. As a player, Parola started 170 games for the Redbirds, primarily at second base. While at ISU, he recorded a .265 batting average, 14 HR, 110 RBI, and 106 runs scored. Parola also had 373 assists in his career, posting an impressive .977 fielding percentage. Parola was a key contributor to Illinois State's 2019 Missouri Valley Conference title, hitting .289 with six HR, 42 RBI, 42 runs scored, and stealing 14 bases as a senior. He spent four and a half months as an assistant coach at the University of Illinois Springfield before electing to return to Illinois State when the position opened.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

INDIANA HOOSIERS



SCOUTING INDIANA

- ◆ Indiana enters Wednesday with a 9-6 record, including 3-3 at home in 2024 with wins over Miami (OH), Northern Kentucky, and Troy. IU will travel to Nashville for a midweek contest at #9 Vanderbilt before hosting the Redbirds on Wednesday.
- ◆ The Hoosiers finished 43-20 (16-8 Big Ten) in 2023, including a 26-4 home record, ultimately falling in the Lexington Regional to Kentucky.

AT THE HELM

- ◆ The head coach of the Indiana Hoosiers, in his 6th season, is **Jeff Mercer**.
- ◆ Mercer continues to build the program through high-level high school talent and deliberate evaluation of the transfer portal. The player development within the program has also shown in his first four seasons with a Big Ten-best 19 student-athletes drafted over that span.
- ◆ Mercer start this his IU coaching career has seen him join IU coaching legend Everett Dean as the only IU coaches to win a Big Ten title in their first year as a head coach, a trip to the NCAA Louisville Regional, a season cut short due to a global pandemic and the first-ever conference-only slate in Big Ten history.
- ◆ Mercer brought a winning background to Indiana. In his time as a head coach (2017-18) and an assistant coach (2014-16) at Wright State, he was a part of three Horizon League regular season and conference tournament titles, three NCAA appearances, and a combined record of 199-92 (.684). The Raiders won four NCAA tournament games over that span, having reached the regional finals twice.
- ◆ Mercer returned the Hoosiers to the NCAA Tournament in 2023 with 43 wins overall and a second-place finish in the Big Ten conference. IU made the regional final for the first time under Mercer, advancing to the championship game of the Lexington Regional.
- ◆ IU's 43 wins were the most since 2013 and tied for the fifth most in a single season in program history. The Hoosiers had the highest RPI (31) and the most Quad 1 wins (10) in the Big Ten and won a record 26 games at Bart Kaufman Field.

SERIES HISTORY

- ◆ The Redbirds and Hoosiers have met 8 previous times, as Indiana leads the series 5-3, with the series dating back to 2000.
- ◆ In the last meeting, Illinois State dropped a 12-7 result at Bart Kaufman Field as the Hoosiers scored seven runs in the eighth, including a grand slam, to claim the win over ILS.

GAME NOTES

STARTING OFF 2024 STRONG

In the season opening win over St. Thomas, Illinois State totaled 18 runs and 20 hits to gather the program's first win of 2024.

The 20 hits are the most in a game for the Redbirds since March 2019 when ILS finished with 22 hits at SIUE.

Meanwhile, the 18 runs are the most runs scored in a season opener for ILS since a 27-run outburst at Belmont to start the 2019 season as well.

With the win, Illinois State has now won four straight season openers (at Austin Peay, win 13-2 in 2023; at #2 Arkansas, win 3-2 in 2022; at SIUE, win 6-1 in 2021) and 9 of the last 12.

RUN AFTER RUN AFTER RUN

With a 18-12 win over St. Thomas to begin the 2024 season, Illinois State has now scored 15+ runs on 10 separate occasions since 2019 (four times in 2023, twice in 2022, and three times in 2019).

10 different 'Birds tallied a hit during the contest, led by Daniel Pacella's three hits and four RBIs.

STEPPING UP TO THE PLATE

2024 Opening Weekend saw Valley schools combine for 219 runs scored. Illinois State sits with the second-most runs amongst MVC schools with 34, only trailing Southern Illinois' 43.

The 34 runs scored by the Redbirds were the 25th most in NCAA Division I.

MVC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

On March 2, sophomore Tyrelle Chadwick turned in one of the most impressive pitching performances in ISU history.

Chadwick set a new-career high with 12 strikeouts to lead Illinois State to a series-clinching 5-0 win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

The Kamloops, B.C., native, who only allowed one hit and no walks over nine scoreless innings, recorded the first nine-inning one hitter for Illinois State since April 2013.

His 12-strikeout shutout performance is also the first nine-inning complete game for the Redbirds since May 2021 as well as the first nine-inning complete game shutout since 2019.

The performance gained the attention of D1Baseball as the national organization named Chadwick the best pitcher from week 3. He finished with a game score of 97.

LAWRENCE VS. VANDY

Luke Lawrence provided the consistency to Illinois State's series at #9 Vanderbilt. The sophomore third baseman brought in a team high 4 RBIs, while hitting .333 and going 4-for-12 at the plate with a slugging pct. of .583.

In the series opener, Lawrence went 4-for-4 with a home run as he reached base safely six times thanks to two walks as well.

CALL THE 'PEN

In a three-game series at #9 Vanderbilt (March 8-10), the Redbirds saw 10.0 innings of relief from their bullpen, including 3.1 innings from junior Joe Husak in the series finale.

Husak continues to lead the MVC in ERA through 13 games. The Cambridge, Iowa, native went 3.1 innings at Vanderbilt, giving up two hits while allowing a run and striking out two Commodores.

He currently has an MVC-best 1.04 ERA over 17.1 innings while recording a 14:5 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

DANNY DINGERS (AND MORE)

Sophomore Daniel Pacella reached base at a blistering .625 clip in a three-game series at Little Rock (Feb. 23-25) while going 5-for-11 with a double, a homerun, 4 RBIs, and 5 runs scored.

Pacella also walked four times, becoming the first player with four+ walks in a game since Jordan Libman in 2021.

IT JUST MEANS MORE

For the first time since 2019, Illinois State traveled to Nashville, Tennessee in March to face the Vanderbilt Commodores in a three-game series from March 8-10, 2024.

Prior to 2024, the last time Illinois State made the trip down to Nashville was 2019, a season for the record books on many accounts.

The Commodores finished the 2019 season as NCAA National Champions while the 'Birds finished the year as co-MVC regular season champions and made an NCAA Tournament appearance.

Playing in the Louisville Regional, the 'Birds defeated Big Ten's Indiana as well as host Louisville before dropping back-to-back results against the Cardinal, who would eventually end the season as NCAA runner-up.

NOW BATTING...

The 2024 roster sees 11 Redbirds returning on the offensive side of the plate, led by sophomore **Daniel Pacella**, and senior **Auggie Rasmussen**. The pair played in all 50 games during the 2023 season.

Rasmussen ended 2023 with a .315 average. He finished second on the team in batting average, while leading the 'Birds in runs scored (46), hits (64), doubles (16), and stolen bases (25-of-29).

Pacella averaged .307 in his freshman season. He led the team in home runs (16) and RBIs (56) while drawing 17 walks as well. The Mundelein native also totaled 38 runs and 63 hits during the 2023 season.

MVC PRESEASON POLL

Illinois State, which finished 9th in the 10-team MVC in 2023, was projected to finish 7th in the Valley for 2024. Indiana State was picked to win the league, receiving eight of the 10 first-place votes.

ON THE MOUND FOR YOUR REDBIRDS

The 2024 roster holds seven Redbirds who return to pitch for ISU, led by fifth-year senior **Erik Kubiawicz**. The Oakdale, Minn. native made 18 appearances (10 in MVC play) for the 'Birds in 2023.

Kubiawicz finished 2023 with a 4-3 record, 29.0 innings pitched, 27 strikeouts, nine walks, and allowed 28 hits.

AIMING FOR EVANSVILLE

The 2024 Missouri Valley Championships are scheduled for May 21-25 at German American Bank Field in Evansville, Indiana.

FRESH FACES

The 'Birds welcomed in 10 transfers to Normal for the 2023-24 academic year, including juniors Noah Smith (Louisville) and Tanner Perry (Southern Illinois).

The other eight transfers are: catcher Tyler Herron (Parkland), catcher Daniel Contreras (Wabash Valley CC), LHP Braden Roesch (Illinois-Springfield), RHP Tresdon Rybarczyk (Parkland), RHP Ben Dandelet (Hutchinson CC), RHP Joe Husak (Des Moines Area CC), RHP Carter Monke (Parkland), and RHP Keaton Hopwood (Coastal Carolina).

The 2023-24 freshman class for ISU is: OF Luke Stulga, OF Tugg Hollandsworth, INF Eddie Letamendi, RHP Matthew Donnison, RHP Lawson Minshew, LHP Jack Finn, RHP Colin Miller, and RHP Jesse Courtney.

2023 SEASON SUMMARY

Illinois State was 20-30 overall (9-18 MVC) in 2023 in a season that saw pitchers Elijah Dale and Derek Salata become the newest 'Birds drafted in the MLB Draft.

Dale was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 13th round of the 2023 MLB Draft, while teammate Derek Salata saw his name picked by the Oakland Athletics in the 19th round.

Daniel Pacella gained national attention as he was named a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper following a season where he hit .307 with 16 home runs and 56 RBIs en route to being named Honorable Mention All-MVC.
