

#### **WEEKLY NOTES**

#### HISTORICAL NOTES

-The 'U' is in its 136th year in program history in the spring of 2024.

-John Anderson is in his 43rd year at the helm of the Gopher baseball program and has compiled a 1,380-1011 career record. This includes a 615-419 record in Big Ten play.

-On April 22, 2022, Ánderson became the first B1G coach to ever surpass 600 wins in conference play. He looks to add to that total this season.

#### ANDERSON'S FINAL RIDE

-The 2024 season will be head coach John Anderson's 43rd and final year leading the Gophers. He announced in December that he will retire at the conclusion of the season.

-Anderson has led Minnesota to 11 Big Ten titles and have made the NCAA Tournament 19 times. He is an eight-time Big Ten Coach of the Year honoree and was named Mideast Region Coach of the Year three times.

-Anderson's career began as a player for the Gophers in 1974 before he became a student assistant from 1976-77 and graduate assistant in 1978. From 1979-81, he served as an assistant coach before being hired as the head coach in '81.

#### JUNIOR LEADERSHIP

-Minnesota's roster consists of 12 juniors that have gained valuable experience in their first two seasons as members of the youngest team in the Big Ten in 2023.

-Eight of the 12 juniors saw regular playing time last season in key roles. Brady Counsell, Jake Perry and Ike Mezzenga made up the Minnesota infield for most of the season, while Jake Larson found his way into 32 games. Tucker Novotny was the Friday starter in 2023 and Connor Wietgrefe, Noah Rooney, and Seth Clausen played prominent roles in the Gopher bullpen.

#### WIETGREFE'S WORLD

-Junior LHP Connor Wietgrefe put together his fifth quality start of the season on Saturday afternoon at Michigan.

-The Prior Lake, Minn. native pitched 6.0 innings, allowing two runs on three hits and three walks. Wietgrefe fanned eight Wolverine hitters in the start and picked up his team-high fourth win of the season.

-In two starts in the month of April, Wietgrefe has pitched 12.2 innings, allowing just two runs. He has struck out ten batters and has a 1.42 ERA while picking up two wins.

-The southpaw currently ranks fifth in the Big Ten in ERA (3.40), tied for third in wins (4), seventh in innings (50.1) and tenth in strikeouts (46).

#### **NEELS BY THE NUMBERS**

-Sophomore Weber Neels has picked up where he left off after a stellar freshman season.

-Neels leads the team in average (.321) and on base percentage (.437). He is second in RBIs (26), doubles (8), walks (17,) and is third in hits (36). He is also slugging .473 with three home runs for the season.

-Splitting time at catcher and first base, Neels is one of three players that has played all 31 games this season and leads the team with 423 putouts.

#### CONSISTENCY IN COUNSELL

-Counsell has been a consistent bright spot in the Gophers lineup. He reanks in the top five in all offenseive categories including leading the team in home runs (8), runs (31), total bases (72), walks (19) and stolen bases (14).

-A Milwaukee, Wis. native, Counsell is slashing .305/.40/.563. He has 39 hits, including nine doubles, and 22 RBIs. He has picked it up in April, slashing .433/.500/.833 with 10 RBIs, nine runs scored and six home runs in eight games this month.

-Counsell leads the team with 80 assists, playing all 31 games at second base.

#### PRODUCTIVE PITCHING

-The Gophers' pitching staff has put together impressive numbers among Big Ten ranks to begin the season. The Gophers have allowed the second-fewest earned runs (149) and third fewest runs (188) in the Big Ten. As a team, the 'U' also ranks third in the Big Ten in ERA (4.97) and sixth in opponent hitting (.265). The team also ranks third in the conference in strikeouts per nine innings (9.7).

-Their team ERA is top 22% in the nation (66/295) while their strikeouts per nine is top 15% in the

nation (44/295).

-Individually, Will Semb is fourth in the Big Ten and 76th in the nation in K/9 at 11.10.

#### NEWCOMERS MAKING AN IMPACT

-Kyle Remington has been a staple out of the Gophers' bullpen. He was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week on Mar. 11. He continued his impressive freshman season by working 1.2 innings of relief against Michigan. He held the Wolverines scoreless, allowing one hit, zero walks and picked up one strikeout.

-Tyler Hemmesch has pitched 16.2 innings in eight appearances for the Gophers in his rookie season. He's tallied 16 strikeouts with a 2.70 ERA and is holding opponents to .179 average off him.

-Charlie Sutherland has appeared in 20 games this season with six starts. He has emerged as one of the Gophers' go-to hitters off the bench. For the season, he is slashing .286/.432/.457 with a home run, three doubles, six RBIs and six runs scored.

-Senior transfer Justin Thorsteinson has provided the Gophers a trustworthy arm in the back end of the bullpen. In 25.2 innings, he has a 2.45 ERA and 23 punch outs. -Freshman Jack Taxdahl earned his first start behind the dish last Saturday. He went 1-4 with a run scored in the win. In eight games this season, he is hitting .286 with two RBIs and three runs scored.

-Freshman Jack Spanier has seen an increase in playing time after flashing the leather at shortstop. In 14 games played, he has recorded 10 putouts and 27 assists without committing an error. Spanier has also picked up five hits since seeing more regular action.

#### **WEEKEND RECAP**

-After dropping game one at Michigan, the Gophers bounced back to win game two of their Saturday doubleheader, 8-3, behind another quality start from Wietgrefe. The Gophers dropped game three of the series.

-Minnesota was scheduled to play two mid-week games last week, but Tuesday's game was canceled due to weather.

-The Gophers picked up a run-rule victory on Wednesday evening against South Dakota State. Tucker Novotny, Sam Kennedy and Caden Capomaccio combine to strikeout 16 Jackrabbits. Just five of the 21 outs recorded by Minneosta came from something other than a strikeout.


ASSISTANT COACH-PITCHING & PLAYER DEVELOPMENT, 8TH SEASON

-Pitching Coach Ty McDevitt recently wrapped up his seventh season on the University of Minnesota coaching staff and fifth full season as the Gophers' pitching coach in 2023. He served as a volunteer assistant for the from 2017-18.

-In his first four seasons on the staff, he has morphed Minnesota into a national contender by overseeing a pitching staff that accumulated 109 wins, helping the Goohers win the 2018 Big Ten Regular Season and Tournament titles.

-From 2017-19, the Maroon and Gold posted a 3.84 ERA and a 1.32 WHIP while striking out an astounding 1,396 hitters in just three seasons. Under McDevitt's tutelage from 2018-20, pitcher Max Meyer evolved from a 34th round draft pick out of Woodbury High School into one of the nation's premier arms. He was drafted No. 3 overall in 2020.

-McDevitt is wearing No. 60 this season in honor of the 1960 National Championship team.

#### SCOUTING THE HOOSIERS

- -Indiana was chosen to finish second in the Big Ten in the preseason poll.
- -The Hoosiers have eight players with 20 or more RBIs on the season led by sophomore Tyler Cerny with 41, which is tied for fourth in the Big Ten. Redshirt freshman Brenczewski is having a standout season for Indiana, slashing .337/.415/.467 and was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week on April 8.
- -Indiana's pitching staff is highlighted by Connor Foley, who ranks second in the Big Ten with 65 strikeouts. However, Foley has struggled a big with allowing runs in his last three outings and has a 7.43 ERA in that span.

#### OPPONENT SERIES HISTORY

- -Minnesota leads the all-time series with Indiana, 114-56.
- -The two teams have not faced each other since 2022 in Bloomington. This will be the first matchup between Indiana and Minnesota at Siebert Field since 2016.
- -The Hoosiers took the first two games of the last

-Minnesota won game three 9-8 behind a two-hit, four-RBI day from Kyle Bork, including a triple and a home run.

The Gophers will remain home for two midweek games with St. Thomas on Tuesday and Wednesday. Minnesota will head to College Station to take on Penn State over the weekend.

#### **GOPHERS IN THE PROS**

-After undergoing Tommy John surgery in 2022, the No. 3 overall draft pick of 2020, Max Meyer returned to the mound on April 1 against the Angels. In what was his third career start, Meyer pitched 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on two hits with four strikeouts, leaving the game with a 4-2 lead. Meyer picked up his first career MLB win on April 7 against the St. Louis Cardinals. He pitched

- 6.0 innings, allowing just one run on three hits and one walk, including retiring the first 13 batters he faced. For the season in three starts, he is 2-0 with a 2.12 ERA in 17.0 innings. He has 14 strikeouts and is holding batters to .180 hitting.
- -LHP Lucas Gilbreath pitched in 47 games in 2022 for the Colorado Rockies, but missed 2023 with Tommy John surgery. He is still on the Rockies 40-man roster and is still TBD on a return.
- -Brett Bateman was drafted in the eighth round of the 2023 MLB Draft by the Chicago Cubs. He was assigned to the High-A affiliate, South Bend Cubs on April 4. In 18 at bats, he is slashing .278/.536/.278 with one RBI and four stolen bases.
- -A 2023 sixth-round pick of the Philadephia Phillies, George Klassen has made two starts for the Phillies Single-A affiliate Clearwater Thrashers. He is 2-0 with two wins, 17 strikeouts and 0.50 WHIP in 10.0 innings without allowing a run.


