• As two of the Big Ten title contenders square off, Purdue gets an opportunity to host rival Indiana for a weekend series for just the third time since Alexander Field opened in 2013. An Alexander Field attendance record was established Wednesday and the benchmark could be reset again with both teams in contention at the top of the standings.

• The Boilermakers have won a program-record 10 consecutive games in Big Ten play, surging into first place with the league's longest win streak in conference play since Rutgers (10) two years ago. The Hoosiers won all four of their Big Ten series in April, punctuated by a sweep of Rutgers in Bloomington last weekend. Around the conference, Illinois (11-4 Big Ten), Michigan (10-5), Nebraska (10-5) and Iowa (10-8) have also reached 10-win mark in the league play. After facing each other, Purdue (at Michigan, vs. Illinois) and Indiana (at Nebraska, vs. Michigan) both play a pair of those teams over the final two weekends of the Big Ten season.

• As the first Big Ten team to reach 30 wins this season, the Boilermakers enter the month of May in first place for the first time since winning the league in 2012. Purdue and IU finished 1-2 that year but did not play until the winner's bracket final and championship game of the Big Ten Tournament.

• However, since 2013, the Big Ten schedule – in part due to the league's expansion – did the rivalry series no favors. The teams did not play Big Ten games against each other in 2013, 2015 and 2019. Along the way, 17 of the last 24 IU-Purdue games have been played in Bloomington. The road team has not won a series since the Boilermakers took two of three at Sembower Field in May 2010. The league coaches have since voted to make rivalry series permanent meaning Purdue should host in the even-numbered years and IU the odd for the foreseeable future.

HEAD COACH GREG GOFF

Greg Goff joined Purdue baseball as an assistant coach in July 2017 and was promoted to head coach in June 2019. The 2023 season is his 18th as a collegiate head coach.

Previously a head coach at four universities, Goff succeeded his friend and longtime colleague Mark Wasikowski, who returned to the University of Oregon as the Ducks' new head coach in June 2019.

Goff has previously served as the head coach at Campbell University (2008-14), Louisiana Tech University (2015-16) and the University of Alabama (2017) as well as Division II University of Montevallo (2004-07). He also helped lead the Boilermakers to a memorable 38-win season in 2018, punctuated by the program's third NCAA Regional bid in program history. Purdue finished second in the Big Ten standings and was also the runner-up at the Big Ten Tournament in Goff's first year with the program.

A national-best 15-0 start, program records for strikeouts and stolen bases, and a return to the Big Ten Tournament highlighted Purdue's resurgent and successful 2022 season. The Boilermakers raced out the best start in program history as the final unbeaten team nationally and recovered from a rough patch in April to return to the conference tournament, navigating a challenging back half of the league schedule. Purdue eclipsed its program benchmark in steals behind the first trio of Boilermakers ever with 20-plus steals each. Curtis Washington Jr. (31), Mike Bolton Jr. (28) and Evan Albrecht (22) teamed up to account for 81 of the 116 stolen bases (70%) as Purdue led the Big Ten and ranked sixth nationally in steals per game. CJ Valdez was a first-team All-Big Ten performer as a full-time DH; Cam Thompson also enjoyed a breakout season with 13 home runs and a 1.031 OPS. Bolton went on to break Purdue's all-time steals record in 2023.

Along with bringing an upbeat personality to the dugout and contagious energy to his role as the first-base coach, Goff helped numerous Boilermakers develop offensively in 2018 and 2019 as an assistant coach. He played a leading role in coaching the base running and outfield defense.

In his first two years at Purdue, Goff helped develop and organize new community events for the program like the Preseason Fan Fest and First Pitch Dinner. Both events have proved very popular and are well attended, helping generate preseason interest going into a campaign.

The Boilermakers also continue to expand their community outreach, exceeding 600 combined hours of service for the 2021-22 academic year. During the 2019 fall semester, over 40 players logged at least 10 hours of community service as Purdue completed over 450 hours of community outreach as a team.

Goff and his wife, Tina, are the parents of four daughters: Kara, Kiley, Kolby and Kenzie. Kara (Louisiana Tech & LSU) and Kiley (Louisville, active) both played collegiate softball.

SIX 40-WIN SEASONS

- As a head coach, Goff's teams have won over 40 games six times. Campbell was one of only eight Division I programs to win 40-plus games for three straight years from 2012 to 2014, posting 131 total victories during that span. The Camels enjoyed a historic 49-10 campaign in 2013.
- He also won 42 games in his final season at Louisiana Tech, helping lead the Bulldogs to an NCAA Regional bid.
- Montevallo was a DII College World Series qualifier in 2006 under his guidance. As an assistant coach at Delta State, the Statesmen also qualified for the DII College World Series in 1994 and 1996.

ENDED NCAA REGIONAL DROUGHTS AT CAMPBELL & LOUISIANA TECH

- In Goff's final season at Campbell (2014), the Camels qualified for their first NCAA Regional in 24 years. Two years later, he led Louisiana Tech to its first Regional bid in 29 years. The 2014 Camels and 2016 Bulldogs both won at least one game in their Regionals, with La Tech coming through the loser's bracket to reach a Regional final at Mississippi State.

HISTORY OF TURNAROUNDS

- Goff's teams have had a losing record only five times in his 14 years as a head coach. Four of those five seasons were his first at a respective university. He has led his teams to some impressive turnarounds.
- In just two seasons, Louisiana Tech went from 15-35 the year before Goff's arrival to 42-20 in 2016, ending a 29-year NCAA Regional drought in the process. At Campbell, he inherited a team that was 11-45 in 2007. But under Goff, the Camels posted a winning record (27-24) in his second season and won 40 games by his fifth year (2012).
- Purdue's win total also jumped from 29-27 in 2017 to 38-21 in Goff's first year on the staff in 2018.

COACHING HONORS

- Goff was named the South Central Region Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association at both Louisiana Tech (2016) and Montevallo (2006). He was the 2013 Big South Coach of the Year at Campbell after leading his team to a school-record 49 wins and a conference title. Montevallo won a combined 100 games over his final two seasons, posting a new single-season record both years.

BEFORE BECOMING A HEAD COACH

- Goff has coached 10 future big leaguers and over 50 MLB Draft picks, highlighted by Cy Young award winner Brandon Webb while he was the pitching coach at Kentucky (2000-03). Longtime big leaguer and World Series champion Joe Blanton also pitched for Goff at Kentucky.
- Along with his years as the pitching coach at Kentucky, Goff served as an assistant at Southeast Missouri State (1998-99) and his alma mater Delta State (1994-97) before becoming a head coach for the first time in the summer of 2003 at Montevallo. It was at SEMO in the late 1990s where he first worked with Wasikowski. They helped lead the Redhawks to an NCAA Regional in 1998.

QUICK NOTABLES FROM 2024

- Purdue has scored 10-plus runs in a game in 10 of the first 11 weekends of the season (all but the sweep at Rutgers, April 5-7). The 2012 Big Ten championship team did it in each of the first five non-conference weekends as the only previous to do so every weekend before Big Ten play began. The Boilermakers have outscored the opposition 72-16 over the last two Big Ten weekends (sweeps vs. MSU & Northwestern).
- Purdue has turned 48 double plays – 45 of the ground ball variety – in its first 45 games, ranking second nationally behind Michigan (50 in 45 games). A dozen DPs came in a five-game stretch from March 3-10. The Boilermakers turned four twin killings in the March 9 home opener vs. UAlbany, achieving that feat for the first time since a March 2018 win vs. Virginia Tech. The biggest double play of the season was undoubtedly an inning-ending 4-6-3 with the bases loaded and the score tied 3-3 in the ninth inning at Rutgers. It was induced by **Aaron Suval**.
- The Boilermakers bounced back from a 1-4 start in Big Ten play by tying the program record (from 2001) with a 10-game conference win streak. After taking the series finale at Ohio State, they opened April with a series sweep at Rutgers, the program's first on the road in Big Ten play since April 2018 at Maryland. Purdue won the opener in 10 innings and rallied for a Saturday win thanks to a go-ahead, three-run homer from **Connor Caskenette** in the ninth inning. The Boilermakers became the first visiting team to sweep a three-game Big Ten series in Piscataway since Maryland in April 2017. Rutgers entered the weekend 41-10 at home since the start of the 2022 season.
- The Boilermakers started three lefthanders on the mound each of the first four conference weekends, giving three southpaws the ball in a Big Ten series for the first time since the league went to three-game weekends in 2009. It's also believed to be the first time ever Purdue has started exclusively lefties in a Big Ten series (of 3 games or longer).
- **Luke Gaffney** is the first player in conference history (award was added in 2011) to win Big Ten Freshman of the Week each of the first two weeks of a season and three of the first four. He now has five total honors after being a repeat winner again April 15 and 22. Gaffney enters the weekend leading the Big Ten in RBI, runs and total bases, eclipsing the Purdue freshman records during the nine-game homestand in April. His three-double game on Feb. 17 was just the second by a Boiler since March 2018.
- **Camden Gasser** enters the weekend leading the Big Ten in walks (47) and on-base percentage (.541). He reached base safely in the first 24 games he played, the fifth longest season-opening streak by a Boilermaker since 2001. Entering the IU series, he's been on base safely multiple times in 11 straight games. Purdue's single-season records are Dan Black's 62 walks in 2009 and Ryne White's .521 OBP in 2007.
- **Mike Bolton Jr.** is the longest tenured active Boilermaker (182 career games), joining the program in the fall of 2019. He broke the program's all-time stolen base record (70) last season and has 93 steals for his career. He's the Big Ten's active career leader and fourth nationally. Bolton is 53 of 55 in his career in Big Ten play and led the league with 28 steals overall in 2023. Bolton Jr. hit game-opening home runs on consecutive Saturdays in April, connecting on the first pitch of the game both times. Purdue had gone without a leadoff home run since May 2017 prior to his heroics on April 20.
- **Logan Sutter** is top 10 in the Big Ten with 15 doubles, reaching the 10-double mark on March 10 as the fastest Boilermaker (via date on the calendar) to reach the benchmark. The Purdue single-season record is 21 and the last Boilermaker with 20 doubles was 2012 Big Ten Player of the Year Kevin Plawecki. Plawecki's 10th double was March 24.
- Purdue scored 10 runs in an inning in consecutive Sunday wins vs. George Mason (Feb. 25) and Cal State Fullerton (March 3). The Boilermakers also scored 10 unanswered runs in Sunday wins vs. Stony Brook (Feb. 18) and UAlbany (March 10). They've posted three 10-run innings in a season for the first time since 2012. They have scored 125 of their 391 runs (32%) on Sundays this year.
- Purdue has three players with a 10-game hit streak for the second year in a row. **Connor Caskenette** and **Jo Stevens** have been part of the trio both years.
- Purdue's earliest home opener ever (March 9) marked the beginning of a 13-game homestand, matching the longest ever at Alexander Field and one game shy of a team record from 1982. The Boilermakers won seven of their eight games of the homestand but dropped four of their last five to finish with an 8-5 mark.
- Purdue won its season opener in shutout fashion for the first time since 1991. The Boilermakers also won twice in shutout fashion in the first 10 games of a season for the first time since 2003. Now they have four shutouts in a season for the first time since 2018.
- **Luke Wagner** and **Jackson Dannelley** teamed up to shutout Southeastern Louisiana on March 2, ending SELA's five-game win streak. The Lions had scored 59 runs during their streak and then scored 11 runs while beating No. 11 East Carolina on Sunday on the final day of the four-team Keith LeClair Classic.
- Wagner posted a streak of 22 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run from Feb. 25 through March 16. It was the longest streak by a Boilermaker since 2018.
- Dannelley is second in the Big Ten lead with five saves. All five have been relief outings in which he recorded at least nine outs.
- Purdue won the nightcap of its March 16 doubleheader vs. Samford 13-12 in 10 innings despite the visitors putting together an eight-run inning. The Boilermakers won a game in which an opponent scored eight-plus in an inning for the first time since the opening weekend of the 2020 season (vs. Hofstra).
- **Jordan Morales** was the first lefthander since 2014 and only the second this century to start on Opening Day for Purdue. He also became the 10th pitcher, and first lefty, this century to start the season and home openers.
- The 14-inning midweek marathon with UIC on March 20 was played over five hours and three minutes. It was the longest game (in time) in program history, the longest ever at Alexander Field (since 2013) and Purdue's longest (in innings) since winning in 15 innings vs. Ohio in March 2016.
