THIS WEEK: Coming off its first unblemished non-conference run in eight years, the Huskies look to keep building momentum into their first Big Ten slate, which begins this Friday and Saturday at home in Seattle. Washington (10-0) hosts Indiana and Illinois on consecutive nights, both matches starting at 7 p.m. and streaming on Big Ten Plus.

These first conference foes start off a 20-match run through the toughest and deepest volleyball conference. Washington will only see most Big Ten teams once each, except for the three other conference newcomers Oregon, USC, and UCLA where the Huskies will have home-and-away series. Currently there are seven Big Ten teams in the AVCA Top-25, and UW is the first one out this week, coming in at 26th in the polling totals. Five of those seven ranked teams are in the top-11.

UW achieved its first unbeaten non-conference since 2016 with some trends it looks to continue in league play. The Huskies had a higher attack percentage than all 10 opponents, and held nine of 10 opponents under .200 attack percentages, with seven under .150. Through 10 matches, the Huskies are holding opponents to a .131 mark that ranks sixth in the NCAA. That's compared to 2023, when UW's opponents hit .244 for the season. Much of that is due to an uptick in blocking, where UW is now averaging 2.80 blocks per set as a team (17th nationally) compared to 1.78/set in 2023. Last season, UW had six matches with double-digit total blocks. This year the Dawgs have seven double-digit block efforts through just 10 matches.

Washington has some recent familiarity with these first two Big Ten rivals. The Huskies and Hoosiers met for the first time ever last year, and the Dawgs had a 3-0 win in three close sets on a neutral court. Washington and Illinois played each other five times over six years from 2017-22, with UW winning the final three of those, but the Fighting Illini won in Seattle in 2017 and 2018.

HEAD COACH LESLIE GABRIEL • Second Season

The time was finally right for Leslie Gabriel. After devoting over two decades to the perennial success of Washington Volleyball, Gabriel took on the Head Coach mantle in late December of 2022. As a player and then as an assistant, Gabriel was part of 618 wins for the Huskies before she achieved No. 619 and No. 1 as Head Coach on August 25, 2023.

The 2020 AVCA National Assistant Coach of the Year, Leslie Gabriel (née Tuiasosopo) helped lay every foundational brick as she worked with previous head coaches Jim McLaughlin and Keegan Cook to build the Huskies into a national power. In her twenty-two seasons on the UW staff, Gabriel has helped the Huskies finish ranked in the top-10 nationally fourteen times.

As a Husky player from 1995-98, Gabriel was one of the best blockers in Pac-12 history. She joined McLaughlin's staff when he took over the program in 2001, rising to Associate Head Coach, and helping develop a legacy of Husky All-Americans at every position. In her more than two decades at UW, Gabriel has worked with twenty-seven AVCA All-Americans.

Gabriel is the ninth Head Coach in Washington history. She is the fourth female Head Coach, but the first since Debbie Buse in 1991. Buse is also the only other former Husky player to serve as Head Coach.

During Gabriel's time at Washington, the Huskies have reached five Final Fours (2004, 2005, 2006, 2013, 2020) winning the 2005 NCAA title, and advanced to 21-straight NCAA tournaments from 2002-22, averaging 25 wins per year. The Huskies won seven Pac-12 Conference titles in Gabriel's tenure (2004, 2005, 2013, 2015, 2016, 2020, 2021) and seven more second-place finishes.

The Dawgs earned a winning record in her first season at the helm in 2023, despite one of the smallest and youngest rosters in her tenure that was hit hard by injuries. Top returning scorer Emoni Bush redshirted the season and UW started three freshmen, but the Dawgs still finished with a 16-15 overall mark. Kierstyn Barton and Katy Wessels both made the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team and senior transfer May Pertofsky earned All-Region honors in spite of missing significant time with a foot injury.

As a player, Gabriel, along with All-American Makare Desilets, formed one of the nation's best blocking tandems, leading the Huskies to the top of the NCAA blocking rankings in 1997. An All-Pac-10 Team selection as a junior and twice more an honorable mention, Gabriel ranks in the UW career top-10 in four categories, including total blocks (3rd - 613) and block assists (3rd - 520). She also ranked in the top-25 nationally in blocks per game in each of her four seasons at Washington.

After completing her eligibility in 1998, Gabriel trained with the USA National Team program and played at the 1999 World University Games in Spain. She returned to Washington where she earned her bachelor's degree in psychology in 2000. From August 2000 until May 2001, the Woodinville, Wash., native played professional volleyball in Murcia, Spain.

Gabriel is the oldest of five children, including former UW football players Marques and Zach Tuiasosopo. Marques played quarterback eight years in the NFL, while her youngest brother, Matt, played five seasons of Major League Baseball, debuting for the Seattle Mariners in September 2008. Younger sister Ashley played softball at Washington and was a member of the 2009 NCAA Championship team.

Leslie married Anthony Gabriel, an academic advisor at Washington, in 2010, and gave birth to the couple's first son, Daylon, in May of 2011, followed by a second son, Myles, in March of 2013, and a daughter, Lanea, in October of 2014.



ASSISTANT COACH MICHAEL BRUNSTING

Michael Brunsting joined Leslie Gabriel's staff in February of 2023 after rising through the ranks of club and collegiate coaching. A former letterwinner at UC San Diego, Brunsting competed for seven years on the AVP beach tour while transitioning into coaching.

Brunsting orchestrates the Husky offensive game plans and

works closely with the setters. In 2024, Husky setter Molly Wilson was chosen for the U.S. Collegiate National Team that trained with the U.S. Olympic Team in its run-up to the Paris Olympics.

Brunsting's coaching path to Seattle started as a volunteer assistant at UCLA in the 2021 spring season, which led to a full-time assistant coach at William & Mary in the fall of 2021, and then to Utah State in 2022. Both the Aggies in 2022 and Bruins in spring '21 advanced to the NCAA Championships with Brunsting on staff.

Brunsting began coaching in 2016 as an assistant at Irvine Valley College before coaching at the high school and club levels, working at Orange Coast VC.

In 2022, Brunsting helped Utah State post a 22-11 record and capture the MWC tournament title. Utah State advanced to the NCAA tournament for the first time since 2010.

A native of Poway, Calif., Brunsting attended UC San Diego from 2011-2014, playing setter and opposite. He was named the Tritons' Most Valuable Player his senior year in 2014.



ASSISTANT COACH JUSTICE MAGRAW

Former Husky letterwinner Justice Magraw enters her second season as an assistant coach in 2024 after previously serving as the program's Technical Coordinator in 2022 and as a volunteer coach in 2021. Magraw, who graduated in 2015 as part of the winningest class in school history, works closely with the Husky back row as well as managing opponent scouting.

A native of Redmond, Wash., Magraw was a DS for the Huskies from 2012-15, during which time the Huskies had three 30-win seasons. She earned her Bachelors degree majoring in Communications and graduated cum laude. She also competed for the Husky Beach Volleyball team and was named the 2016 Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year for beach.

Her coaching career began at the club level with Sudden Impact, in Bellevue, Wash. in 2015. Magraw became the Head Varsity and Junior Varsity Coach at The Overlake School from 2017-18 and was named Emerald City League Coach of the Year.

Magraw entered collegiate coaching in 2019 at the University of Portland, where she was a volunteer assistant for the indoor team, and an assistant coach for the beach squad, until May of 2021. She returned to Washington in the fall of 2021 in a volunteer capacity as the Huskies won the Pac-12 title and reached the Sweet 16.



ASSISTANT COACH HARDY WOOLDRIDGE

Hardy Wooldridge is in his second season as an assistant coach for the Huskies, where he works closely with the Husky pin hitters.

Since beginning his collegiate coaching career at Washington as a volunteer coach in 2016-17, Wooldridge went on to serve as associate head coach at Fresno State, before moving to the powerhouse Pepperdine men's program in 2023.

The Mission Viejo, Calif. native returned to the university where he completed his Bachelors degree in Geography in 2016. Wooldridge is married to former Husky Gabbi Parker, a 2013 grad. They welcomed their first son, Theo, in August of 2023.

Wooldridge spent two seasons as a volunteer for the Huskies in 2016-17. Those seasons saw the Huskies win the 2016 Pac-12 title and advance to the Elite Eight in 2016 and the second round in 2017.

When former Husky assistant Jonathan Winder was named Head Coach at Fresno State, Wooldridge headed with Winder to the Mountain West. The squad produced 11 All-MWC honorees in their four seasons, including a program-record four in 2018.

Wooldridge then headed to Malibu when Winder was named Head Coach for the Pepperdine men, helped the Waves rank No. 10 in 2023.

Wooldridge played collegiately at Thompson Rivers University in British Columbia then played pro for Colombier Volley LNB in Switzerland.
