Over the past three matches, Burke has recorded 102 assists and 31 digs with double-doubles against No. 10 Minnesota and No. 7 Wisconsin. She has added six kills and five blocks in the 5-1 . Burke has 353 assists this season with 127 digs and 13 aces. The junior has played in 68 matches including 58 straight starts and has led Michigan in assists in 59 straight matches.

Nyambio did the same last season hitting .331 and averaging 1.00 block per set. She has improved both numbers this season hitting .426 and 1.12 blocks per set. Her kills per set is the same as last season and .16 better than her career average. Awards and Honors: Allison Jacobs Named Co-Big Ten Player of the Week Allison Jacobs earned her first career Big Ten weekly award after leading Michigan in kills during a 4-0 week on September 8th. The graduate student recorded 66 kills over 13 sets for a 5.08 kills-per-set average, adding five aces and seven blocks over the four matches. She led U-M in kills in three of the four matches, including a double-double with 22 kills and 10 digs against Florida Atlantic, and was second on the team in digs over the week with 26. The last Michigan player to win Big Ten Player of the Week was Jacque Boney on Sept., 26 2022.

Awards and Honors: Allison Jacobs Selected to Preseason All-Big Ten Team Graduate-student outside hitter Allison Jacobs was named to the Big Ten Volleyball Preseason All-Conference Team in late July. Jacobs is one of nine outside hitters to make the 20-person team. She becomes the first player to earn Preseason All-Conference honors under head coach Erin Virtue, with Jess Mruzik last receiving the honor in 2022. After an injury forced her to miss the entire 2023 season, Jacobs earned All-Big Ten first-team honors in 2024 with 335 kills on a career-high .243 hitting percentage with 186 digs per set.

Two New Transfers To Maize and Blue
Joining the 13 returners are two transfers with very different experiences in college
volleyball so far with Jacyn Bamis joining as a graduate student with three collegiate
seasons under her belt while Sydney Schnichels joins as a redshirt sophomore with
only eight games of experience. Bamis joins from Hawaii by way of Clemson and was an
honorable mention to the All-Mountain West team in 2024 with the Rainbow Warriors. She
totalled 262 kills on a .279 hitting percentage with 82 blocks across 30 matches. Schnichels
played in eight sets last year for the Golden Gophers totaling six kills and three blocks.

Three Young Guns Join Wolverines As Freshman
Three Freshman are joining the Wolverines this season with Hannah Brady, Ece Senyapici and Leni Stanton-Parker hoping to make their collegiate debuts. Brady brings a big family pedigree to Ann Arbor as her sister, Maya, being a three-time first team All-American Softball player for UCLA and her Uncle being Tom Brady. Senyapici joins from Fernabache in Turkiye and represented her nation in a variety of tournaments including the U20 European Championships which Turkiye won. Stanton-Parker was a five year Invitee to the USA Volleyball National Team Development Program and was the MVP at IMG Academy.

Wolverines Lose Four Players From 2024 Team
U-M graduated three players from last season with Jacque Boney, Mira Chopra and Kendyl Reaugh earning degrees from U-M. Boney was a four year Wolverine who tallied 807 kills on a .299 hitting percentage with 404 total blocks totalling 1041 points across 118 matches and 428 sets. Chopra was also a four year Wolverine and tallied 41 aces along with 45 digs, nine blocks and nine kills. Reaugh used her COVID year with the Wolverines and played in 61 sets across 21 matches tallying 112 kills on a .165 hitting percentage with 24 blocks for 133.5 points. The Wolverines lost one transfer in Valentina Vaulet who played in 58 matches and 201 sets tallying 591 kills and 99 service aces along with 320 digs.

This Year's Leaders
Graduate student Maddi Cuchran, graduate student Allison Jacobs and senior Serena Nyambio will serve on the team's leadership committee for the 2025 season. Jacobs and Nyambio served on the leadership committee last fall season with graduated senior Jacque Boney. All three of Cuchran, Jacobs and Nyambio were chosen as leaders for the spring season before being chosen again by their teammates and coaches for the fall season.

Putting the Student in Student Athletes
In July, U-M Volleyball earned its sixth consecutive American Volleyball Coaches Association
Team Academic Award. The team first earned the award following the 2019-20 season.
The award honors teams that maintain a year-long team GPA of 3.3 or higher. 10 players
also earned Academic All-Big Ten honors with four earning Big Ten Distinguished Scholar
honors and four being named to the CSC Academic All-District Team.

Great Home Support Over Last Two Seasons
Last season, the program set its third highest single-game attendance mark after second and now fourth and fifth single-game attendance marks in 2023. The program set its overall attendance record for most fans (39,248) and highest average per game (2,803) in 2023 and both marks followed closely in 2024 with 34,558 total fans and 2,033 average.

Virtue Enters Third Season, Two Staff Members Return
Head Coach Erin Virtue was hired on January 17 2023 and now enters her third season
with a 25-35 overall record and a 13-27 Big Ten record. She helped Allison Jacobs earn
All Big Ten First Team Honors last season. Virtue is joined by five staff members with two
returning from the past season. Assistant Coach Nick Clark enters his third season with the
Wolverines and mainly works with the back row defense and Liberos. Performance Analyst
Matt Adams who is back for his third season with the program. He served in the same role
for the U23 Pan American Cup team that won a gold medal.

Three New Staff Members Join the Wolverines
Joining Head Coach Erin Virtue, Nick Clark and Matt Adams are three new staff members
with Coaches Kassie Kadera and Bjarne Huus joining along with a new Director of
Operations in Kenzie Shand. Kadera joins after four seasons at Memphis where the Tigers
tallied 54 wins. She was a four-year starter at Toledo earning All-MAC honors three times as
a setter and works with setters now. Huus joins after two seasons at Long Beach State where
he was an assistant before being elevated to Associate Head Coach. He will primarily coach
the blockers. Shand joins after two seasons as the Director of Ops at Utah State.

Wolverines Enjoy 13-Day International Trip

Thanks to donors Daryl and Dana Kenningham, the Wolverines were able to enjoy a 13-day Italy and Greece trip highlighted by four matches over seven cities with countless memories. The Wolverines kicked off their trip with a flight to Rome, where they and explored the Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain, and Colosseum. A day later, they toured Vatican City before winning a four-set match against Pomezia B1. They continued on to Venice, arriving by water taxi to spend the day wandering, then traveled to Milan, stopping for lunch at the Italian Volleyball Federation before facing Italy's National "B" team in a five-set friendly. In Milan, they toured the Galleria and Duono, enjoyed shopping time, and beat Lurano in another five-set match. After a day at Lake Como, they wrapped up their time in Italy with one more meal before flying to Greece. In Nafplio, they dined by the water at sunset, climbed 800 steps to Palamidi Fortress, relaxed on the beach, and explored Bourtzi Fortress. The final stretch in Athens featured the Acropolis and a 2-1 win over Ilisiakos. The tour concluded with a yacht trip for swimming and shopping before heading home.

Match Recaps:

Michigan Falls In Coemptive Match To No. 7 Wisconsin

The University of Michigan volleyball team dropped a competitive three-set match (22-25, 22-25, 20-25) to No. 7 Wisconsin. Setter Morgan Burke led the Wolverines with a double-double — 29 assists and 11 digs — and became the 10th player in program history to reach 2,000 career assists. Allison Jacobs paced Michigan's offense with 15 kills, while Serena Nyambio added four blocks. Each set featured multiple ties and lead changes as Michigan pushed the Badgers throughout. The Wolverines led midway through the first and second sets before late Wisconsin runs secured both frames. In the third, Michigan battled back from an early deficit, but a 4-0 Badger surge closed out the match.

Wolverines Take Down No. 10 Minnesota For First Ranked Win Since 2022
Michigan volleyball upset No. 10 Minnesota on Wednesday night (Oct. 1), winning 3-1 (18-25, 25-12, 25-14, 25-12) at Crisler Center for its first ranked win since 2022. Setter Morgan Burke posted 42 assists and 13 digs, while Allison Jacobs led with 20 kills as U-M hit .383 and topped .400 in the final three sets. Lydia Johnson (14 kills) and Ella Demetrician (15) added balance, while the defense held Minnesota to .093 hitting, highlighted by Serena Nyambio's five blocks and Maddi Cuchran's 17 digs. After dropping the first set, Michigan dominated the final three with big service runs and strong hitting.

Michigan Goes 0-2 In First Big Ten Week Falling To No. 1 Nebraska and MSU Michigan opened Big Ten play with back-to-back straight-set losses against No. 1 Nebraska and rival Michigan State. Against Nebraska, Allison Jacobs led the Wolverines with eight kills and Serena Nyambio paced the defense with four blocks as Michigan briefly challenged the Huskers in the opening set before Nebraska's runs proved too much. At Michigan State, Ella Demetrician and Lydia Johnson each posted 10 kills and Morgan Burke dished out 31 assists, helping Michigan battle closely in sets two and three.

Wolverines Sweep Notre Dame Twice in Home and Home
Michigan volleyball completed a dominant home-and-home sweep of Notre Dame,
winning 3-0 in both South Bend and Ann Arbor. On Friday, Allison Jacobs led the attack
with 12 kills on .400 hitting, while middles Jenna Hanes and Serena Nyambio combined
for 12 kills and seven blocks. Morgan Burke notched a double-double with 15 assists and
11 digs as the Wolverines used timely runs to control each set. Back in Criser on Sunday,
Nyambio starred at the net with a career-high-tying seven blocks as Michigan tallied 12
team stuffs and held the Irish to .096 hitting. Burke and Ellie White guided a balanced .330
team attack, and Maddi Cuchran anchored the defense with 12 digs. Both teams battled in
the first, before U-M led from tape to tape over the final two.

Wolverines hit. 423 as a team, led by Ella Demetrician's 12 kills
(.550) and Lydia Johnson's error-free nine kills (.818). Morgan
Burke paced the offense with 20 assists and nine digs. After
controlling the first set, Michigan pulled out a tight second
and used strong serving highlighted by three aces from Jenna
Hanes to close out the sweep.

Michigan Splits Weekend In Charlottesville
Michigan and Virginia split their two-match series in
Charlottesville, with the Wolverines falling in five sets Friday
before sweeping the Cavaliers Saturday, In the opener, Serena
Nyambio (15 kills, .458) and Lydia Johnson (14 kills, .414)
paced Michigan, while Cymarah Gordon sparked a late rally,
but Virginia closed strong to hand U-M its first loss. The
next morning, Allison Jacobs led with 16 kills and Johnson
delivered four straight late kills to seal a 3-0 victory, while
Nyambio hit .615 and Morgan Burke ran the offense with 24
assists as the Wolverines improved to 7-1.

Wolverines Win Michigan Invitational, Improve to 6-0 Michigan opened the Invitational with sweeps of Florida Atlantic and Marshall before closing with a 4-1 win to stay unbeaten. Allison Jacobs shined throughout, posting 22 kills vs. FAU, 10 vs. Marshall, and 19 against the weekend finale. Lydia Johnson (611) and Amalia Simmons provided strong support, while setters Morgan Burke and Ellie White combined for steady play making and a serving spark, highlighted by Burke's career-high six aces. Defensively, Maddi Cuchran anchored the back row with 18 digs vs. Marshall and 12 in the finale as U-M controlled play across the weekend.

Michigan Takes Down In State Team Eastern Michigan
The University of Michigan volleyball team swept Eastern
Michigan, 25-12, 25-19, 25-20, in its home opener Tuesday
night (Sept. 2). Allison Jacobs led U-M with 15 kills, while
Jenna Hanes added eight and Lydia Johnson chipped in
seven with three blocks. Morgan Burke (18 assists) and
Ellie White (14 assists, three aces) ran the offense. Michigan
dominated the first two sets, hitting .548 and .310 without
trailing. EMU briefly pushed ahead in the third, but the
Wolverines closed strong with 7-2 run capped by a Jacobs kill.

Wolverines Open Season Going 2-0 In Cincinnati
Wake Forest grabbed the opening set 25-19, but Michigan
edged a marathon second set 29-27 to even the match. The
Wolverines then pulled away late in the third (25-22) and
controlled the fourth (25-20) to seal a 3-1 season-opening
win. Allison Jacobs starred with 24 kills and 11 digs, while
Ella Demetrician added nine kills off the bench. Cincinnati
claimed the first set 27-25, but Michigan dominated the next
two 25-17, 25-17 and closed the match with a 25-20 win in the
fourth. Jacobs paced the attack with 15 kills, Lydia Johnson hit
.591 with 13 kills and no errors.

Meet Team 53
Team 53 returns 13 players from a 18-13 team and 8-12 in the Big Ten finishing 10th and is joined by five newcomers.

Allison Jacobs Enters Sixth Season, Hopes for Healthy Allison Jacobs is back for her fourth season at Michigan and sixth overall after starting her career at UCLA. Jacobs had her best ever season last year earning herself All-Big Ten First Team honors. Jacobs has had some injuries over her collegiate season including a season ending surgery forcing her to miss all of 2023 and then an ankle sprain that made her miss some of 2024. Entering the season, Jacobs has totaled 396 kills at Michigan and 637 overall along with 50 blocks at U-M and 98 overall. She tallied a career-high 25 kills twice last season and set her new-career high with 16 digs at UCLA.

Maddi Cuchran Returns for Fifth Year, Earned Spot
After gaining her freshman year back due to an NCAA petition,
Maddi Cuchran returns for her fifth year. She worked her way
up to the team's starting Libero starting all 31 matches last
season in all 117 sets after 109 total sets over her first three
seasons. She averaged 3.88 digs per set along with 1.08 assists
per set last season with 20 service aces. She has 675 career
digs and 162 career assists across 66 total matches played.
Against Notre Dame last season, she tallied a career-high 28
digs across sets. Cuchran was chosen as a captain this season.

Jacyn Bamis Joins For Fifth Year, After Two at Hawaii
In her fifth season, Jacyn Bamis starts at her third school.
Bamis hails Washington but started her collegiate career at
Clemson. She did not play in her first season with the Tigers
but played in more than half the matches the next season
tallying 81 kills and 42 blocks across 17 matches and 56 sets.
Bamis then transferred across the nation to Hawaii and played
in just nine matches in her third collegiate season and first for
the Rainbow Warriors. She found her spot and started all 30
matches last season recording 262 kills and 82 blocks across
117 sets earning an honorable mention on the Big West team.

Serena Nyambio Back for Final Year, Aims to be a Doctor
A consistent presence in the lineup and at the net over the
past three seasons, Serena Nyambio returns for her fourth
and final season in the Maize and Blue. Nyambio has tallied
446 kills and 264 blocks over 281 sets across 82 matches.
Nyambio missed a few games due to injury in her sophomore
season and one last year. She had her best season of her career
last season tallying 203 kills on a team-leading .331 hitting
percentage and added 14 solo blocks and 100 block assists.
She set a new career high in kills against Kent State with 17.
Nyambio was busy most of the summer doing lab work and
studying for the MCAT in preparation for Medical school.

Amalia Simmons Poised for Breakout Third Season
After redshirting her freshman season, Amalia Simmons
is ready to breakout in her redshirt junior season. Simmons
has had an up-and-down time at U-M. In her first season
playing Simmons played in 20 matches and 61 sets tallying
119 kills including 20 coming in the opening weekend against
Colorado State, She bounced in and out of the lineup and
added 31 digs and 21 blocks in that season. Simmons played
in less matches her second year but had a better hitting
percentage by .075 and tallied 47 kills. She struggled to make
the lineup but started the final four matches of last season.

Morgan Burke Back After 1,000 Assist Season
After winning the starting setter spot midway through her freshman season, Morgan Burke has not looked back and tallied 1,168 assists last season. She started every match in her sophomore season and averaged 9,98 assists per set and was the team's second best server tallying 31 aces in 31 matches. Over her two year's Burke has tallied 1656 which ranks 11th all-time in program history. Burke set single game career-highs in six different stats last season including 54 assists vs. Rutgers. She is the first U-M player from Nebraska.

Carly Greskovics Ready for Increased Role
Making her first career start at Wisconsin in 2023, Carly
Greskovics has contributed in 64 sets over two seasons.
Greskovics has tallied 61 digs, 11 assists and one service ace.
She was State Champion in Beach Volleyball in 2023 and is now set to contribute in the back court in her third season.

Lydia Johnson Brings International Experience to Team Hailing from Canada, Lydia Johnson made an immediate impact in her debut tallying seven aces and five blocks assists against Sacred Heart. A few days later she tallied nine kills against Colorado State but since then has struggled to find a spot in the lineup playing in just 19 total matches and 53 sets. Johnson has tallied 60 kills, 26 digs, 14 aces and 29 blocks. She has represented Canada at multiple tournaments including the U18 World Championships and Pan America Cup.

Sydney Schnichels Leaves Minnesota as Former Five Star Joining the Wolverines with three years of eligibility left, Sydney Schinchels is ready to contribute after just eight sets over two seasons at Minnesota. Schnichels redshirted her freshman year with an injury issue and only played in eight sets for her home state team in her redshirt freshman season tallying six kills and three blocks. She entered her time with the Gophers as the top recruit from Minnesota and 19th overall by PrepDig and was named to the AVCA Best and Brightest First Team. Schnichels will compete for the opposite starting spot.

Ella Demetrician Looking to Improve on Freshman Season Back after a 185 kill freshman campaign, Ella Demetrician is looking to get even better. Demetrician played a lot in the middle of the season allowing her to average 1.97 kills per set and adding 171 digs, 17 aces and 30 blocks. She tallied a career-high 18 kills against Notre Dame and 12 digs against UCLA last season. Demetrician was the No. 1 ranked player out of Wisconsin by Prep Dig for the class of 2024.

Jenna Hanes Ready To Help Middles as Sophomore
Jenna Hanes did not play much in her freshman season but
showed flashes against Washington. Against the Huskies,
Hanes hit .500 with five kills. She added one more kill across
two more sets through the season but took big steps in the
spring and preseason and is poised to make a big impact. In
high school, she was a All-American selection by VB Magazine.

Trixie McMillin Enters Second Season
Seeing action in 25 matches, Trixie McMillin made an impact in her freshman season. McMillin played in 75 total sets and recorded 49 digs, six assists and 10 service aces. She set her single game highs all in one week of each other with two assists against EMU, four aces against Kent State and seven digs against Notre Dame. McMillin graduated Summa Cum Laude and earned Biliteracy awards for Chinese and Japanese.

Ellie White Improving A Lot As A Setter
Setter Ellie White saw limited action in her freshman season playing in just eight matches and 15 sets but worked hard in the spring and offseason to improve as a setter. White tallied 16 assists along with four digs and one block as a freshman on her first year as a setter. She was a transitioned outside hitter and came in as the No. 1 player from Illinois and was the two time Illinois Gatorade Player of the Year.

Camille Edwards Back After Getting Hurt in First Contest Making her debut in the first match of the season, Camille Edwards is ready for a do-over for her freshman season after an injury cut the season short. Edwards tallied 11 assists and five digs over three sets before suffering a season-ending injury. She was part of the USAV Girls Junior National Championship team with TAV 18 Black.

Cymarah Gordon Looking Strong After Missing Season After playing in the 2024 Maize and Blue Scrimmage, Cymarah Gordon was shut down for the season with an injury. Gordon is healthy again and looks ready to compete for the starting outside spot. She helped lead her high school to a 43-2 record.

Hannah Brady Brings Strong Family Lineage To Ann Arbor Joining the Wolverines from California, Hannah Brady brings some strong family ties to Ann Arbor. A strong volleyball player in her own right playing Libero all four years at Oaks Christian, she set the school record for most career digs and was named a AVCA Phenom. As for her family, her mom was a four year softball player for Fresno State, her sister was a three-time all-American softball player at UCLA and her uncle, Tom, was a four year Wolverine and a seven-time Super Bowl Champion.

Ece Senyapici Ready For New Challenge in United States Without ever visiting Ann Arbor or the United States, Ece Senyapici made her decision to commit the Michigan as a Turkish international player. Senyapici came to A2 for the first time three days before training started but has integrated seamlessly. She has represented Turkiye across multiple ages and won the 2024 U20 European Championships. Senyapici also played club volleyball in Turkiye for Fernabache and finished second in back-to-back years at the U19 National Championships. She is enrolled in the College of Engineering.

Leni Stanton-Parker Looking To Impact As A Freshman Leni Stanton-Parker was born in Washington DC and won the Virginia State Championship in 2023. She tallied 173 kills on a 356 hitting percentage with 21 blocks in the championship winning season. Stanton-Parker then attended IMG Academy and was named the MVP for the 2025 season. She was a fiveyear invitee to the USNTDP and looks to compete this season as an outside hitter.

ERIN VIRTUE • 3RD YEAR 36-39 OVERALL 36-39 AT MICHIGAN 15-30 BIG TEN

Erin Virtue was announced as the seventh head coach in Michigan volleyball history on Jan. 17, 2023. She returns to Ann Arbor after spending five seasons (2011-15) with the Maize and Blue as recruiting and offensive coordinator.

In her first season with the program, Virtue led the team to a 7-22 record and a 5-15 conference record. The Wolverines won four of their last nine matches including a win over Ohio State.

Virtue is a member of the USA Women's National Team program, where she serves as offensive coordinator. Since 2019, she also is the director of the USA National Team Development Program, where she oversees all U15-U23 development programs for indoor and beach programs for both boys and girls. She served as the offensive coordinator and setters coach for the Women's National Team that earned a Gold Medal in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and a Silver Medal in the 2024 Paris Olympics.

Virtue served as Michigan's recruiting and offensive coordinator from 2011-15, coinciding with a run of four NCAA Tournament appearances, including two Sweet 16s and one Final Four appearance. The 2012 Wolverines tallied seven victories over top-25 opponents en route to a modern-day school-record 27 wins and a Final Four appearance.

Michigan teams won a combined 100 matches during Virtue's time in Ann Arbor with nine All-America selections, and Virtue coordinated five recruiting classes that ranked among the nation's top 20.

She coached senior setter Lexi Dannemiller in each of her four seasons with the Wolverines. Dannemiller, a six-time Big Ten Setter of the Week and an All-Big Ten Freshman Team selection in 2011, ended her career second in assists in the U-M record book (5,321) while helping the Wolverines to a national semifinal appearance in 2012. In her first season at Michigan, Virtue helped recruit the 12th-best class in the country, according to PrepVolleyball.com. Virtue also is a three-time recipient of the "30 Under 30" award, presented by the American Volleyball Coaches Association to honor up-and-coming coaching talents at all levels. She is one of three to earn the honor on three occasions.

Following her time at Michigan, Virtue spent three years (2016-18) as the associate head coach at Northwestern.

Prior to her first stint with the Wolverines, Virtue spent four seasons (2007-2010) at Cincinnati, where she helped the Bearcats to a 101-36 record. She was responsible for coaching the setters and liberos, mentoring setter Annie Fesl, who ended her career with the second most assists in program history (5,746), and three All-Big East selections. Virtue helped put together top-30 recruiting classes in 2008 and 2009, according to PrepVolleyball.com, while helping the Bearcats earn "Highest Honorable Mention" honors from the website for their 2010 class.

Virtue started her coaching career in 2006, spending that season at Loyola (Chicago) working with the setters while handling recruiting and training organization before joining Cincinnati.

Prior to her coaching career, Virtue was a standout volleyball player at the University of Illinois (2001-05). She helped lead the Fighting Illini to a spot in the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2003, earning All-Big Ten and honorable mention All-America accolades. During her time at Illinois, she also participated with the USA National A2 program during the summer of 2004 and was a coach at the USA A2 camp in 2006.

After graduating from Illinois in 2005 with a degree in kinesiology, Virtue trained with U.S. national team for a year (2005-06) before joining the coaching ranks.



Clark graduated from Eastern Michigan in 2010 with a dual major in Secondary Education and Social Studies with a minor in History. While at Eastern, Clark founded the Men's Club Program and served as president, coach and was an outside hitter with the team.

1st Season at Michigan

Bjarne Huus joins the Wolverines staff for his first season after two years as a coach at Long Beach State.

Huus was elevated into the Associate Head Coach position by Natalie Reagan prior to the 2024 season and originally joined the staff in March of 2023, hired by Tyler Hildebrand as the team's assistant and mental performance coach. In his first season with the team, Long Beach State posted a 21-10 overall record, recording the team's first 20-win season since 2016 and reaching the championship match of the first-ever Big West Championship tournament.


Huus, a Long Beach State alumni, returns to the Beach after playing professionally overseas, playing on Norway's National Team, and serving as the head coach for the Norwegian Girl's Youth National Team in the Nordic Championship U17 in 2022.

While at Eastern Michigan, Kadera served as the recruiting coordinator and assistant coach for the Eagles, as she navigated the program through the Covid-19 pandemic from both recruiting and travel perspectives. She specialized in working with the setters.

Prior to her time with the Eagles, Kadera was the head coach at Walsh University, an NCAA DII school in Canton, Ohio. After she joined Walsh University as an Assistant Coach for the 2014 season, the was promoted to the Head coach for the 2015-2018 campaigns. In 2018, Kadera led Walsh to its first ever East Division title and second conference tournament appearance. Her 2017 squad was the first to post a winning record in Walsh volleyball history. Kadera also spent time with Maverick Volleyball Club, Xtreme Volleyball Club, and Nova Juniors, where she was responsible for training the setters. Kadera broke into coaching as a volunteer assistant with the University of Akron in 2012.

On the court, Kadera was a four-year starter at setter for the University of Toledo from 2008-2011. A threetime co-captain of the Rockets, she ranked third in the MAC in assists per set in 2008, 2010, and 2011 and led the conference in 2009. Kadera earned All-MAC Second Team honors in 2009, 2010, and 2011 and was a seven-time All-Tournament Team selection. A graduate with a Bachelors Degree in Sport Management at Toledo, Kadera ranks second in program history in career assists with 4,853.
