NEWS & NOTES

FIRST SERVE

The Ducks face a pair of top-20 road tests beginning Friday at No. 18 Indiana. First serve is set for 4 p.m. PT inside Wilkinson Hall in Bloomington, Ind. The weekend continues Saturday at ninth-ranked Purdue (4 p.m. PT, BIG+) in West Lafayette, Ind.

SERIES INFO vs INDIANA

Oregon and Indiana will meet for just the second time, having first played last season in Eugene. The Ducks picked up a 3-1 victory in that match, the 2024 Big Ten opener for both.

SERIES INFO vs PURDUE

Saturday will be the sixth meeting between the two programs with Purdue owning a 4-1 lead. Oregon's lone win in the series was a straight-set victory in the 2023 NCAA regional semifinal played in Madison, Wis. This weekend's match will also be the Ducks' first-ever trip to West Lafayette.

LAST TIME OUT

Facing a 2-1 deficit, the Ducks forced a fifth set and had match point at 14-13 against Michigan State but the Spartans reeled off the final three points for the win. **Alanah Clemente** had 21 kills and **Cora Taylor** notched her team-leading fourth double-double with 41 assists and 10 digs. Taylor was one of three UO players with three aces along with **Valentina Vaulet** (15 kills) and **Iva Sucurovic** (six blocks)

SERVICE PRESSURE

Oregon goes into its road trip tied for third in the Big Ten with 163 service aces. Individually, **Alanah Clemente** is tied for the league lead with 41 aces while **Valentina Vaulet** follows closely with 39 aces, good for third in the Big Ten. Collectively, the Ducks have six players with 10 or more service aces this year, adding the efforts of **Cora Taylor** (19), **Iva Sucurovic** (15), **Sophia Meyers** (14) and **Reese Sheppard** (11). Oregon has five or more aces in 21 of 24 matches including a season-high 12 in last week's four-set win over UCLA (Nov. 6).

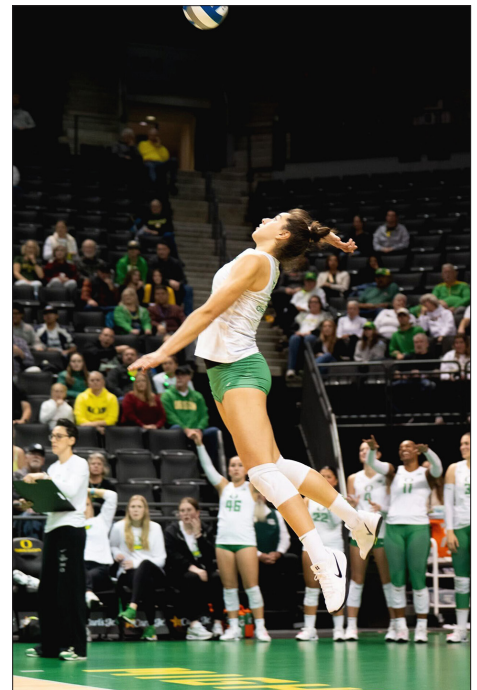
RPI WATCH

The Ducks (14-10, 5-9 BIG) held steady at No. 57 in this week's release of the NCAA RPI rankings. Beginning with its match at Indiana, Oregon faces three-consecutive opponents with an RPI inside the top 20: Indiana (14), Purdue (6) and USC (18).

FRESH IMPACT

Alanah Clemente is one of 10 freshman in the country averaging more than four points per set, and enters the week at sixth in the Big Ten with 4.35 points per set. The Santa Clarita, Calif., native leads the team with 3.55 kills per set and 41 aces. Clemente has reached double-digit kills in 12 of 14 matches in Big Ten play including three 20-kill performances.

DID YOU KNOW?



Oregon has at least eight aces in 11 matches this season including a season-high 12 aces in last week's four-set win over UCLA (Nov. 6). The Ducks enter the weekend tied for third in the Big Ten with 163 aces.

WHERE SHE STANDS (AND SETS)

Senior **Cora Taylor** enters Friday's road match at Indiana with 3,798 career assists, good for 10th among active NCAA DI setters. She has 40 or more assists in five matches this year, all during Big Ten play, including a season-high 48 assists against Wisconsin (Oct. 26). Taylor started her collegiate career at Butler (2022-24) where she had 3,036 assists. Taylor is averaging 9.37 assists per set in conference play this year.

BLOCKING IS FUN

Sophomore **Iva Sucurovic** is seventh in the big with 106 total blocks this season, also good for 1.15 blocks per set. She has posted five or more blocks in 11 matches this year including a season-high 12 blocks in a straight-set win at Montana State (Aug. 31). Sucurovic had 13 blocks last weekend and averaged 1.44 blocks per set against UCLA and Michigan State.

NEWEST MEMBERS OF THE FLOCK

Oregon head coach Trent Kersten announced the Ducks' four-player signing class that is ranked 17th in the country by Volleyball Adrenaline. The UO recruiting class features **Laura Eichert** (OH/Lake Stevens, Wash.), **Marlena Gracia** (S, Monroe Township, N.J.), **Alaina Pollard** (MB/Frankfort, Ill.) and **Lizzy Robinson** (DS/Corona Del Mar, Calif.). Eichert and Pollard are ranked as the No. 26 and 48 recruits, respectively, by PrepDig.

PLAYING AT MKA

The Ducks are 6-4 in home matches this season including Big Ten wins over Iowa, Ohio State, Minnesota and UCLA. Oregon's win over then-No. 18 Minnesota (Oct. 17) was the program's 150th win at Matthew Knight Arena. This season is the Ducks' 15th year playing at MKA with a record of 151-59, a tally that includes a 96-54 conference mark.

IT'S A MILESTONE

With her 13th kill against Wisconsin, graduate transfer **Sophia Meyers** tallied the 1,400th kill of her career. She finished the match with a season-high 17 kills to go along with a .342 hitting percentage. Meyers, a Seattle native, enters the weekend with nine outings of 10 or more kills, hitting .275 or better in seven of those matches.

PUTTING ON A SHOW

Freshman **Alanah Clemente** accounted for 6.75 points per set including 5.75 kills per set while hitting .323 against top-20

opponents Minnesota (Oct. 17) and Penn State (Oct. 18). She turned in back-to-back 23-kill performances and added a season-high six aces against the Gophers.

HEY 'BRO

In her second start as full-time libero, freshman **Reese Sheppard** picked up a season-high 12 digs against Penn State (Oct. 18). The Puyallup, Wash., native also contributed six digs and a season-high three aces. Sheppard began that weekend with 11 digs, three assists and a service ace in the Ducks' four-set victory over then-No. 18 Minnesota.

STAYING ALIVE

Oregon saved four match points in the fifth set against Iowa (Oct. 3). The Hawkeyes led 14-12 but Oregon pulled even after a kill from **Alanah Clemente** followed by a tandem block from **Iva Sucurovic** and **Cora Taylor**. The visitors had more match points at 16-15 and 17-16 but **Valentina Vaulet** saved both with kills. The Ducks went on to win the fifth set, 19-17, on another Vaulet kill.

BUILDING BLOCKS

Freshman **Holley McFadden** had 13.0 blocks, good for 1.63 blocks per set, in Oregon's wins over Iowa (Oct. 3) and Ohio State (Oct. 4). She had six in the weekend opener and followed with seven in the straight-set victory over the Buckeyes. McFadden has seven matches this year with at least four blocks including a season high of eight against South Dakota (Aug. 29).

YES, VAL!

Junior **Valentina Vaulet** put down a career-high 28 kills in the Ducks' five setter at Northwestern (Sept. 28). She hit .451 in the match with just five attack errors on 51 swings. It was the seventh 20-kill outing of her career, and first at Oregon. She also had six digs, three blocks and two aces. Vaulet leads the team with 297 kills (3.23 k/s) and is hitting .263 this season.

25-FOR-25

In the second set of their five-set win at Portland State (Sept. 19), the Ducks accounted for all 25 points without the benefit of an opponent error. Oregon had 20 kills, three aces and two blocks on its way to a 25-12 set win. **Maria Tabacuks** and **Iva Sucurovic** combined for 11 of the kills and behind **Valentina Vaulet's** serve, the team jumped out to a 7-0 lead in the set.

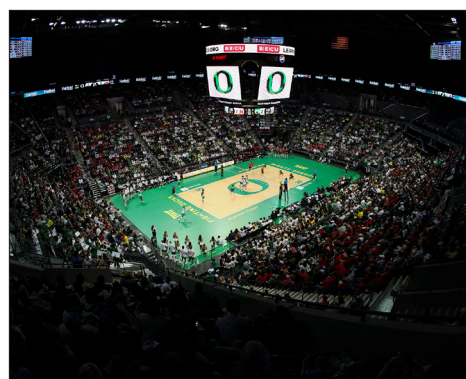

CLEMENTE SETS THE PACE

Freshman **Alanah Clemente** accounted for 4.56 points per set including 4.00 kills per set while hitting .424 in two wins over Oregon State and Portland State. She recorded back-to-back season highs with 17 kills (.483) against the Beavers followed by a 19-kill performance (.378) against Portland State.

SPARK OFF THE BENCH

Freshman **Ksenija Tomic** provided 10 kills over the last three sets of Oregon's five-set win at Portland State (Sept. 19). She put down six of her 10 kills in the fourth set, and finished the match with three blocks—two solo—and a dig. Tomic hit .421 in the victory.

RIVALRY WIN GETS KERSTEN TO 100

With Oregon's four-set road victory over Oregon State (Sept. 18), head coach **Trent Kersten** recorded his 100th career win. He enters the week with a 105-49 (.682) career record, a combined mark between his time at Oregon, LMU (45-12) and San Jose State (47-28).

OUT-OF-SYSTEM HANDS

Freshman libero **Natalie Fukumoto** dished out a season-high seven assists in the Ducks' five-set road win at Portland State (Sept. 19). She has at least four assists in eight of 19 matches this season. As an outside hitter, grad transfer **Sophia Meyers** tallied a career-high seven assists in Oregon's four-set win at Oregon State (Sept. 18).

LUCKY NO. 13

During the LBSU round robin (Sept. 11-13), grad transfer **Sophia Meyers** averaged 3.42 kills per set while hitting .394 (41-4-94) over three matches. She put down double-digit kills in each match including a season-high 16 kills against UC Riverside (Sept. 13). Meyers also posted 18 digs and eight blocks that weekend.

COMING IN CLUTCH

Playing in its first five setter of the season, Oregon responded by hitting .600 (13-1-20) in the fifth against Colorado State (Sept. 6). **Maria Tabacuks**, **Ksenija Tomic** and **Valentina Vau-**

let each had four kills in the frame. The Ducks jumped out to an early 4-0 lead and was ahead 8-3 at the side switch.

MILESTONE WATCH: 1,000 WINS

The Ducks' five-set home victory over Colorado State (Sept. 6) doubled as the 1,000th win in program history. Oregon won the first two sets and held off the Rams in five sets. The team never trailed in the fifth set.

BIG FIRST IMPRESSION

Alanah Clemente was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week after a standout weekend at the Bobcat Invite in Montana. The Santa Clarita, Calif., native accounted for 5.67 points per set and 4.83 kills per set, all while hitting .684 (29-3-38) over three matches. Clemente also tallied 1.67 blocks per set.

STARTS WITH A SERVE

With her first service winner of the season, junior **Valentina Vaulet** registered her 100th career ace. She had three aces in that match, a 3-1 win over South Dakota (Aug. 31). Vaulet has at least one ace in 14 of 16 matches including a season-high four service winners against Portland State (Sept. 19).

NEW LOOK DUCKS

A new era of Oregon Volleyball officially begins Friday under **Trent Kersten**, announced as the program's head coach on Feb. 3, 2025. The Ducks' roster will also have a new look with 14 of 15 spots being newcomers. Senior L/DS **Maya De Los Reyes** is the team's lone returner. Oregon will be replacing 100 percent of its kills and blocks production, and all but one assist, from a season ago. Including De Los Reyes, the Ducks' roster includes five players with prior playing experience at the NCAA level: sophomore **Marlee Arrington** (LMU), graduate student **Sophia Meyers** (LMU), senior **Cora Taylor** (Butler) and junior **Valentina Vaulet** (Michigan). Additionally, redshirt freshman **Orian Drore** began her career at Tennessee.

STARTING POINT

Oregon received votes in the AVCA Top 25 preseason poll and was picked to finish 12th of 18 teams in the Big Ten preseason coaches poll. The Ducks were one of nine teams mentioned in



the first AVCA poll of the season with seven inside the top 25 and two (Oregon, Washington) receiving votes.

ALL-BIG PERFORMER JOINS ROSTER

Rising junior **Valentina Vaulet** ranked 10th in the NCAA with 63 service aces and was 12th in the Big Ten with 4.16 points per set last season at Michigan. She earned a spot on the All-Big Ten Second Team. In two seasons in Ann Arbor, Vaulet racked up 591 kills, 320 digs, 99 aces and 96 blocks.

FROM LMU TO EUGENE

Sophia Meyers and **Marlee Arrington**, having played for head coach **Trent Kersten** last season at LMU, are among the new faces in Eugene. Meyers was a 2024 All-WCC First Team performer and has 1,250 kills and 1,016 digs in her career. Arrington was named to the 2024 WCC All-Freshman Team. Both helped LMU advance to the second round of last year's NCAA Tournament.

KERSTEN ADDS VETERAN SETTER

Cora Taylor played in 89 matches over the past three seasons at Butler, dishing out 3,036 assists coupled with 32 double-doubles. She led the BIG EAST with 1,144 assists during her sophomore season (2023) and was a member of the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team in 2022.

TABACUKS SHINES AT U19 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Incoming freshman **Maria Tabacuks** led Germany and was 12th overall in total scoring during this past summer's FIVB U19 World Championships in Croatia. In eight matches played, she accounted for 124 points with 104 kills, 13 blocks and seven service aces. Tabacuks topped 15 points five times including a best of 21 points (19 kills, 1 block, 1 ace) in a five-set loss to the United States in the round of 16.

THE STAFF

Joining head coach **Trent Kersten** on the sideline is associate head coach **Giovana Melo**, assistant coaches **Sarah Smevog** and **Lauren Page**, technical coordinator **Jerry Quan** and director of volleyball operations **Haley Stangle**. Melo spent the previous 11 seasons as the head coach at CSU Bakersfield that included two NCAA Tournament appearances. Smevog, an all-conference libero at San Jose State, played for Kersten and then served as an assistant at LMU the past two seasons. Page was an all-Pac-12 honorable mention performer for the Ducks in 2016 and helped UO to the NCAA regional finals in 2018, and is in her first season coaching at the NCAA level.

THE SCHEDULE

The Ducks' non-conference schedule features two matches against NCAA Tournament teams from a season ago including South Dakota (Aug. 29) and Colorado State (Sept. 6). The latter will be played at Matthew Knight Arena as UO's second home match of the year. The Big Ten slate begins on the road at Illinois. Oregon's conference home opener is Oct. 3 against Iowa. Along with their fellow west coast BIG teams, the Ducks'

home schedule also includes preseason top-25 teams Minnesota, defending national champion Penn State and Wisconsin.

ANOTHER #PRODUCKS PVF TITLE

The Orlando Valkyries and four past Oregon standouts won the 2025 PVF championship, knocking off Indiana (3-1) in the May 11 final. The #ProDucks list of four features **Lindsey Vander Weide**, **Abby Hansen**, **Hannah Pukis** and **Georgia Murphy**. Vander Weide had 15 points with nine kills in the final.

HEAD COACH TRENT KERSTEN



Trent Kersten was named the eighth head coach of the Oregon volleyball program in February 2025 by UO athletic director Rob Mullens. Kersten, the 2024 WCC Coach of the Year, comes to Eugene after a standout season at Loyola Marymount where he led the Lions to the WCC Championship and a trip to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Kersten spent the past two seasons at LMU where he was 45-12 overall with a 29-5 record in conference play. In those two years, he coached his LMU student-athletes to 13 All-WCC selections, seven WCC All-Academic performers and an AVCA Honorable Mention All-America certificate.

Overall, Kersten carries a 92-40 record through five seasons as a head coach. He spent three seasons as the head coach at San Jose State (2020-22).

Kersten led LMU to a 25-6 record in 2024 and their first West Coast Conference title since 1996. The 25 wins marked the most by the program since 2003 and the team's 16 conference wins were the most in program history. Among the wins, LMU beat eventual-NCAA national seed SMU during the non-conference season and took down Washington in five sets in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament.

Individually, Kersten coached LMU outside hitter Paige Flickinger to AVCA Honorable Mention All-Region and All-America accolades. He also saw Sam Hastings and Mia Schafer named WCC Libero and Co-Setter of the Year, respectively.

In his first season at the helm of the LMU program in 2023, Kersten led the Lions to a 20-6 overall record—its first since 2018—and a 13-3 tally in WCC play. Among the highlights, the team secured a season sweep of nationally ranked San Diego and clinched a runner-up finish in the WCC standings, its highest league finish since 2018.

Before his time in Los Angeles, Kersten began his career as a head coach at San Jose State where he was 47-28 overall and helped the Spartans to a runner-up finish in the Mountain West Conference in 2022.

One of the rising young coaches in the sport, Kersten built the San Jose State program into a Mountain West Conference contender during his tenure. The Spartans finished 2022 at 21-9 with a 14-4 record in conference play. The 14 wins in the Mountain West—good for a runner-up finish—were the most in program history, just surpassing the previous high of 13 set the year prior in Kersten's second year on the bench.

In 2022, San Jose State earned the No. 2 seed in the Mountain West Tournament and collected three all-tournament honors on its way to an appearance in the final. Kersten also coached 11 All-MWC picks and 20 Academic All-Conference performers.

Prior to his time at San Jose State, Kersten spent five seasons on the TCU coaching staff, where the team played in the postseason four of the five years. As the recruiting coordinator, his 2019 class was ranked fifth in the nation by Volleyball Magazine and sixth by Prep Volleyball.

Active in the USA Volleyball High Performance programs, Kersten has assisted in developing athletes ages 12 to 18. Kersten's 2019 team won a gold medal at the High-Performance Championships and he was selected to the 2020 U.S. Girls Youth National Training Team coaching staff as an assistant coach.

He has also assisted at the USA Volleyball Women's National Team Open Program tryouts and was an assistant coach at the 2021 USA Volleyball National Team Development Program Winter Training Series.

Kersten played three seasons at UCLA under legendary men's coaches Al Scates and John Speraw, the current president and CEO of USA Volleyball. As a walk-on, Kersten was a three-year starter and earned a scholarship during his playing career. A 2015 All-MPSF honorable mention selection, he ranked among the nation's top 15 in hitting percentage (.387) and blocks per set (1.08) in his final year.

Additionally, Kersten has extensive experience working with club teams in California and Texas.

Kersten graduated from UCLA in June of 2015 with a bachelor's degree in geography and environmental studies. He and his wife, Tara, have two daughters, Kolbie and Reese.
