# **GAMEDAY NOTES**

- The Purple Aces had a tough week across the diamond over the University of Evansville's Spring Break. In five games last week UE had 32 hits while scoring 24 runs on offense. On defense the Aces struck out 47 batters but committed seven errors to keep their season fielding percentage at 94.8%.
- UE had its fifth batter of the season record a home run over the weekend. Sophomore outfielder Charlie Longmeier hit his first collegiate home run for Evansville in the second game of the team's doubleheader with Samford. Longmeier hit a ball out past the left center field wall in Birmingham recording the Aces eighth home run of the year.
- Evansville will be back for its first game in the Hoosier state in over three weeks on Tuesday. The Aces are in the last week of their month long road trip with four games a little closer to home. UE will be back at German American Bank Field at Charles H. Braun Stadium on Tuesday, March 25 for a midweek game with Western Kentucky.
- Senior center fielder Ty Rumsey has taken over the top of the offense for the Aces after this past week. As one of only three UE players to appear in every game this season Rumsey has a .370 batting average while leading the team in at-bats, hits, hit-by-pitches, and stolen bases. He is also the Missouri Valley Conference leader in four categories; hit by pitch (9), hit by pitch per game (0.47), stolen bases (12), and stolen bases per game (0.63).
- UE plays its first of two games against Indiana this week. The two teams are playing a home-and-home series for the first time since 2022. In 2022 three games were played in Bloomington while one game was played at Evansville. Indiana will make the return trip to GAB Field on April 29.
- It's a new look team for Evansville in 2025. UE returns 39.7% of its at-bats from the prior season and only 38.1% of its hits. A trio of Aces makes up the bulk of that number in seniors Cal McGinnis, Harrison Taubert, and Ty Rumsey. McGinnis saw the most production in 2024 with a .348 average, 69 hits, 38 runs, two triples, and six home runs.

#### **TEAM NOTES**

#### WHAT A SEASON!

The Aces are coming off one of their best seasons in program history after capturing the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament Title for the first time in 18 years, winning the program's first ever NCAA Regional, and appearing in the program's first NCAA Super Regional. Along with the longest postseason run for the program, the 2024 UE roster set three single season records and two career records. Designated hitter Kip Fougerousse set two program records for most hits (94) and home runs (22) in a season to lead last year's team on offense.

#### **30 FOR 30 FOR 30**

UE has posted three straight 30-win seasons for the first time since the 2005 (35 wins), 2006 (43 wins), and 2007 (34 wins) seasons. The last time Evansville had four 30 win seasons in a row dates back to the 1990's with UE Hall of Famer Jim Brownlee as the Head Coach. Under Brownlee's direction the Aces achieved six 30-win seasons back-to-back from 1991 to 1996.

#### OH CANADA!

The Aces have taken to plucking the Great White North's best heading into the 2025 season. UE has four players on its roster from Canada. Returning sophomore infielder Brodie Pert welcomes transfers Cole lantomasi and Owen Byberg along with freshman RJ James to Evansville. The Aces Canadian contingent isn't the first time UE has had multiple players from across the border. Evansville had three Canadians on its roster in both the 2020 and 2021 seasons.

#### HOME OF THE FREE(LAND) CLUB-HOUSE

Right before the beginning of the season the Purple Aces broke ground on an exciting new project at Charles H. Braun Stadium. Evansville alum and MLB Pitcher Kyle Freeland along with his wife Ashley Freeland ('15) donated \$3 million for a new state-of-the-art clubhouse. The clubhouse will be built throughout the 2025 season along the first base line. The Freeland Clubhouse will include a locker room, offices for coaching staff, and a lounge designed to foster a culture of excellence and camaraderie among UE Baseball. Completion of the clubhouse is set for the fall of 2025 to begin being used by the program for the 2025-26 academic year.

#### WE ARE UE

There are several ways to reference the University of Evansville. Generally, the first reference should always be "University of Evansville" or "Purple Aces". Later references to our team may be "Aces" as well as just using the word "Evansville".

Our school abbreviation is "UE". Under no circumstances is it acceptable to use "EU".

#### **INDIVIDUAL NOTES**

#### LEADING AT THE PLATE

Senior right fielder Harrison Taubert had a breakout week at the plate for UE against Missouri. Taubert led the Aces at the plate as he went .500 against Missouri including five multi-base hits. He followed up his big weekend at Missouri with another .500 weekend at Central Arkansas going 7-for-14. Taubert also had Evansville's first inside the park home run in two years at Southeast Missouri on the 11th. Taubert hit a ball that bounced off the wall in left field at Capaha Field and was fast enough to get all the way home.

#### FIRST MVC HONORS

Sophomore LHP Kevin Reed was the first Ace to earn a weekly Missouri Valley Conference honors in 2025. Reed was named the MVC Pitcher of the Week on Tuesday, March 11 for his performance at Central Arkansas. The sophomore southpaw became the first Valley player to pitch two shutouts on the season when Reed didn't allow a single run in seven innings in his third victory of 2025 in Conway. At Bear Stadium, Reed helped face the minimum batters in three of his seven innings by taking Central Arkansas down in order while also having two innings with multiple strikeouts in the bottom of the second and the bottom of the fourth. In total Reed struck out six Bears batters bringing his season total up to 24 Ks on the year. Reed added two strikeouts in 1.1 innings at Samford on Sunday.

#### **NOW THAT'S A WAY TO DEBUT**

Freshman infielder Drew McConnell (Blue Springs, Mo. Blue Springs HS) made quite an impression in his first collegiate game with the Aces. McConnell helped power UE to its first win of 2025 against USI by leading Evansville in RBIs, sending four runners home. In his debut game, McConnell went 2 of 3 at the plate with a single and a double, while scoring twice and walking once. In the field McConnell helped assist on one out from his position at shortstop.

#### **FILL THE TROPHY CASE**

Sophomore left-hander Kenton Deverman continues to rack up preseason awards with Opening Day on the horizon. While Preseason MVC awards won't be announced until mid-March, Deverman already has three separate preseason recognitions. Deverman was recognized three times by D1Baseball as a Third Team All-American, their projected MVC Pitcher of the Year, and the 15th best starting pitcher in college baseball. Deverman was also named Perfect Game's Preseason MVC Starting Pitcher.

#### THE SKIPPER

Head coach Wes Carroll also comes into 2025 with some new hardware along with his team. At the end of the 2025 season Carroll was named the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA)/ATEC Midwest Regional Coach of the Year in a vote of the ABCA's All-America and Coach of the Year Committee. Carroll was one of just eight Division I Head Coaches to earn the honor and the first UE program history.



# WES CARROLL



#### **COACH NOTES**

- Evansville alum Wes Carroll heads into his 16th season as head baseball coach at the University of Evansville as the Aces have ushered in a new era of Evansville Baseball.
- Carroll earned his second MVC Coach of the Year honor in 2022 after leading Evansville to a second-place finish in the league standings with a 14-6 conference mark (32-24 overall). Carroll also earned MVC Coach of the Year honors in 2014 after guiding UE to the MVC regular-season title.
- Carroll currently ranks second all-time at UE in career coaching victories with 389, behind only his mentor and head coach Jim Brownlee.
- In July 2019, UE announced that German American Bank had made a financial commitment to University of Evansville athletics which resulted in an impressive renovation to the Aces' baseball stadium, which is now known as "German American Bank Field at Charles H. Braun Stadium." Included in the renovations were a full Astroturf field, padded walls throughout the entire stadium with new fence lines down the first and third base lines, dugout and bullpen renovations as well as a new LED scoreboard.
- Carroll learned the game "the Purple Aces' way" growing up just minutes from the UE campus in nearby Newburgh, Indiana. He watched his older brother and former Major League infielder, Jamey Carroll, excel at shortstop for UE, and later got to experience the success the program is capable of first-hand as a four-year starter for the Purple Aces and a member of UE's 2000 NCAA Tournament team.
- Carroll became UE's first Freshman All-American in 1998, thanks to a rookie campaign in which he hit .355 with 18 doubles, two home runs, and 39 runs batted in. Carroll went on to hit .299 or better in each of his four years at UE, and finished his career by setting the school's all-time career record for doubles (74), while also ranking in the school's career top 10 in six different categories. He still holds the record for career doubles, has the second-most base hits in school history with 308, and ranks 10th all-time in UE history with a .339 career batting average. Carroll earned all-conference and all-region honors on the UE infield during his four-year career, before being named to the Missouri Valley Conference's All-Centennial Team in 2007 as one of the top players in league history.
