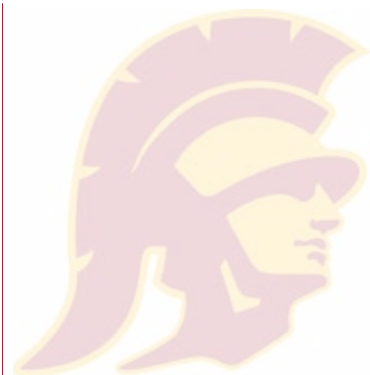

Deddeaux Field History

Even as it gets a full makeover with a new stadium being built on campus, Deddeaux Field will always be iconic. You knew there had to be something special about the ballpark from the day it first opened its gates on March 30, 1974.

Righthander Russ McQueen threw a no-hitter that afternoon in the first game ever played at Deddeaux Field as USC swept a doubleheader from California. The Trojans went on to win the national championship that year and Deddeaux Field has been their home ever since.

The facility has continually been improved over the years with the grandest project taking place before the 2002 season. A \$4 million project signified the largest improvement made to the facility as a new clubhouse and players' lounge were added on the first base side. Expanded offices for the coaching staff and new Hall of Fame were also part of the project, along with a new restroom pavilion.

A new bleacher section was added on the first base side, pushing capacity to 2,500 at Deddeaux Field.

The 2008 season brought a new scoreboard, along with the million-dollar Rod Deddeaux Research for Baseball Institute (RDRBI) which added batting cages, a new weight room and state-of-the-art video motion analysis.

Prior to the 2011 season, a \$600,000 project added new lights to Deddeaux Field to bring the facility to NCAA-mandated standards for hosting postseason play.

With dimensions of 335 feet down the right and left field lines, 365 in the right field power alley and 375 to the left field power alley, and 395 to straightaway center, Deddeaux Field is a natural grass field.

Deddeaux Field has also been used extensively by the entertainment industry. It has been the site of MTV's "Rock-and-Jock" softball game and was used in the production and filming of several motion pictures, including "Mr. Baseball," "The Big Leaguer," "A League of Their Own" and "For Love of the Game."

Andy Stankiewicz

3rd year as USC Head Coach

14th year overall

TROJANS

Former Major League Baseball player and longtime Grand Canyon manager Andy Stankiewicz was named USC baseball's head coach on July 3, 2022.

Stankiewicz, who has also spent time as a professional scout and minor league manager, came to USC after 11 successful seasons at Grand Canyon in which he won five regular-season Western Athletic Conference titles (2015, 2017, 2018, 2021, 2022) and was named the conference's Coach of the Year four times (2017, 2018, 2021, 2022). **He owns a career coaching record of 406-290-3 heading into the 2025 season.**

In 2024, USC went 31-28 (17-12) under Stankiewicz in year 2, finishing fourth in the Pac-12. The Trojans were one win away from a NCAA Regional appearance, advancing to the championship game of the Pac-12 tournament.

In 2023, Stankiewicz led the Trojans to a 34-23-1 (17-13) record in his first year at the helm. USC finished fourth in the Pac-12 standings after a projected 10th-place finish in the Pac-12 preseason poll. All three of those marks were program bests since 2015.

In 2022, Grand Canyon won 41 games, finished the regular season with three consecutive weeks in the D1Baseball.com Top-25 Poll and won a second-consecutive WAC title. The Lopes' strong resume earned them an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament for the first time in program history and the first time by a WAC school since 2012. GCU had one of the nation's strongest nonconference schedules and recorded victories over top-10 teams in Oregon State, Stanford and Texas Tech. The Lopes were a No. 3 seed in the Stillwater Regional.

In 2021, Stankiewicz and the Lopes cruised through the WAC Tournament and earned a spot in the Tucson Regional that postseason, the program's first ever NCAA Division I postseason appearance. Stankiewicz led the Lopes to 39 victories while recording a personal milestone by winning his 300th game on May 29 in the WAC tournament championship.

After a pair of successful seasons at the Division II level in 2012 and 2013, Stankiewicz successfully guided GCU through a transition to the Division I level. Despite the jump in competition, the transition saw the Lopes find immediate success, as the program claimed the WAC regular season championships in 2015, 2017 and 2018.

Stankiewicz is one of the more respected coaches on the collegiate baseball landscape, evidenced by his multiple selections to lead USA Baseball national teams in international competition. He has been a head coach at the 18U level and an assistant on both the Collegiate National Team and in the 17U National Team Development Program. Stankiewicz helped 18U teams to gold medals at both the 2017 World Baseball Cup and the 2014 COPABE Pan American Games.

Prior to his time at Grand Canyon, Stankiewicz held the position of minor league field coordinator for the Seattle Mariners. Before his stint with the Mariners, he was a member of the Arizona State baseball coaching staff from 2007 to 2009. He helped guide the Sun Devils to three Pac-10 championships and two appearances in the College World Series.

Stankiewicz also brings a professional coaching background, having served as manager for the New York Yankees NY-Penn League team in Staten Island. He guided Staten Island to the NY-Penn League championship in 2005.

Stankiewicz was selected by the New York Yankees in the 12th round of the 1986 MLB Draft and went on to play with the Yankees (1992-93), Houston Astros (1994-95), Montreal Expos (1996-97) and the inaugural season of the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998) during his MLB tenure.

Stankiewicz played in 16 games for the Yankees in 1993 before being traded to the Astros in the ensuing offseason. He spent two years with Houston and two years with the Montreal Expos before landing in Phoenix with the Diamondbacks in 1998. In what would be his final season in the majors, Stankiewicz played in 77 games for Showalter's Arizona Diamondbacks. With more than 1,000 fielding chances, Stankiewicz committed just 20 errors in seven years -- a career fielding percentage of .980.

NOTES

ALL-TIME SERIES VS INDIANA: This will be the second ever matchup between the Hoosiers and Trojans, with the only ever game coming in 1969 at the mid-season Riverside National Collegiate Baseball Tournament hosted by UC Riverside, where USC shutout IU 7-0.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS SAN DIEGO STATE: This will be the 91st matchup between the Aztecs and the Trojans, with USC having a 61-26-3 record against SDSU. The first matchup between the programs came in 1945, with the Trojans winning 12-4. The most recent matchup came in 2020 at Tony Gwynn Stadium, where the Trojans scored 11 unanswered runs in a midweek game to win 11-5.

SERIES WIN VS NEBRASKA: USC took two-of-three from Nebraska to win its second straight Big Ten series last weekend. On Friday night, the Trojans got 7.0 strong innings from Caden Hunter and used a two-out rally in the third to score three runs. Other than giving up three runs in the fourth, Hunter was dominant, facing the minimum over his last three innings and only giving up one hit outside of the fourth. Kevin Takeuchi drove in two of the five runs for USC, Adrian Lopez had a three-hit day and Augie Lopez hit his first career homer in a pinch hit at bat in the seventh. The Trojans fell on Saturday, after Nebraska came back for two runs in the final inning to beat the USC 6-5. The Trojans took the series on Sunday, taking down Nebraska 7-1 after Grant Govel tossed 5.0 scoreless innings and USC hit three homers (Maximo Martinez, Bryce Martin-Grudzielanek, Adrian Lopez) as the Trojans were in control from start to finish in the series finale.

MIDWEEK WIN AT ARIZONA STATE: Three homers and five Trojan arms combined to hold a potent Arizona State offense in check as USC took down the Sun Devils, 6-3, on Tuesday night. Dean Carpentier had a two-run homer and an RBI triple, Ethan Hedges hit a home run and recorded the save on the mound, and Brayden Dowd hit a monster two-run shot to right to make it a 4-2 game in the 5th. Andrew Johnson got the start and held ASU in check through his 4.0 innings of work. After two runners reached to start the fifth, Sax Matson came in and needed just four pitches to get out of the jam, getting a popup and double play. Hedges took over in the ninth, working around a two-out single to record his sixth save of the year.

SERIES AT MICHIGAN: USC took two of three games at Michigan over the weekend, winning the opening two matchups before falling in the finale. The Trojans jumped out to a 7-0 lead in the opener and held on despite a late push by the Wolverines for a 7-4 victory. Caden Hunter gave up just one run in 6.2 innings pitched on Friday and Abbrie Covarrubias drove in four runs. On Saturday, Caden Aoki gave up just two runs in 7.0 innings pitched and the Trojans scored four runs in the eighth to win 4-3. USC got run-ruled, 11-0, in seven innings on Sunday.

2025 PLAYER/TEAM NOTES:

- Ethan Hedges** has not only been the Trojans' offensive leader this season, but has established himself as one of the nation's top closers as well. Hedges ranks 12th in the Big Ten with a .374 batting average, is 7th in the conference with 34 hits, 15th with 25 RBI, 8th with 63 total bases and his .692 slugging percentage is 11th in the league. He is also the only USC player who has reached base in every game this year, and is currently riding a 9-game hitting streak. Hedges also has 6 saves so far this season, a total that is 5th in the NCAA and 1st in the Big Ten. In 8.0 innings pitched, he has only allowed 5 hits while striking out 8 batters and holding opponents to a .179 batting average. Hedges has hit a home run and been credited with a save in the same game 3 times this season.
- Brayden Dowd** has begun his sophomore season hitting .303 for the Trojans. The center fielder ranks 4th in the Big Ten in walks (23) and 16th in doubles (7), while also hitting 4 home runs. His 20 runs scored are second on the team, 14 RBI is

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third, and his 27 hits are second as well. He also has 2 stolen bases on the year. Dowd has been a tough hitter to strike out, K'ing just 17 times in 89 at bats, while reaching base in 23 of 24 games for the Trojans. Playing in his home state of Michigan two weekends ago, Dowd had a hit in all three games against the Wolverines, going 4-for-11 at the plate. Dowd's 7 multiple hit game streak is second on the team, and is currently on a 3-game hitting streak.

- **Abbrie Covarrubias** is hitting .284 with 21 hits, which is 4th most on the team, and has 3 doubles, one triple and one inside the park home run (vs. UConn). He drove in 4 runs against Michigan on Friday to lead the Trojans to a 7-4 victory. After a slow start to the season, he has hits in 7 of his last 10 games, including 3 multi-hit games.
- **Adrian Lopez**, a sophomore transfer from LBSU, hit the first home run of the season for USC, with a grand slam in the first inning on Saturday of opening weekend. Lopez had 8 homers for the Dirtbags last year. Two weeks ago at Fullerton he had 3 hits, scoring once and driving in a run as well, and on Saturday against Michigan, he had a clutch two-run double to tie the game in the 8th. This past weekend he had 6 hits against Nebraska, including a home run on Sunday. He tallied another multiple hit game against UC Irvine this week, with a 2B and a home run. He has 8 hits in the last 4 games, and has had at least one hit in 9 of his last 10 games.
- **Kade Higgins** is 4th on the team with 21 hits after posting back-to-back three hit days to open the series at Michigan. The grad transfer from UNLV, is hitting .263, with 4 doubles and 3 homers.
- **Kevin Takeuchi** returned to the lineup after a brief stint on the DL due to a shoulder injury, and had hits in all three games at Michigan, and all three games against Nebraska. He had 4 RBI against the Cornhuskers, including a 2B that scored two runs. The sophomore is fifth on the team with a .281 batting average.
- **Caden Hunter**, a junior transfer from Sierra College, has been electric on the mound for the Trojans on Friday nights, pitching to a 3.00 ERA (9th in the Big Ten) with a WHIP of 1.21. In 33.0 innings pitched, he has struck out 38 batters (5th most in the Big Ten), with his 10.36 strikeouts per nine innings 9th best in the Big Ten. His 7.09 hits allowed per 9 are 11th best in the conference. He most recently tossed a season-high seven innings against Nebraska. Hunter gave up all three of his runs and four of the five hits he allowed in the fourth inning, but faced the minimum the rest of the way to pick up the victory. Two weeks ago he pitched a gem on Friday night at Michigan, giving up just one run in 6.2 innings.
- **Caden Aoki** posted the biggest performance of the year against No. 14 Vanderbilt on March 1st, throwing 7.0 innings, giving up just 4 hits and 1 walk, and not allowing an earned run. His 10 strikeouts were a career high. Aoki was named the Big Ten Pitcher of the Week for his efforts against Vandy. He is the first USC pitcher to earn the award this season. This past weekend, he threw 6.1 innings against Nebraska, allowing 5 hits and 4 runs, while not allowing any walks. Against Michigan, he threw 7.0 innings allowing just 2 runs in the 3rd inning and then only allowing one baserunner the rest of the way as USC came back for a 4-3 victory. His 15.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio is 1st in the Big Ten and 4th in the country, and his 1.00 WHIP is 6th in the conference. His 0.53 walks per 9 are 1st in the Big Ten and 3rd in the NCAA.
- **Brodie Purcell** has been impressive out of the bullpen for the Trojans, pitching to a 1.29 ERA in 12 appearances. In 14.0 innings he has 16 K's and given up just 8 hits. He has given up just 2 hits in his last 6 appearances, throwing 9.1 scoreless innings.

SERIES WIN AND TOP 25 VICTORY: USC played in the Southern California College Baseball Classic earlier this season, winning two of the three games. On Friday night, the Trojans came from behind, after UConn scored twice in the top of the second. After the Trojans cut the lead in half in the 3rd with a John Elliott home run, they scored 3 more runs in the 4th thanks to a Jack Basseer solo home run, and an Ethan Hedges two-RBI single. Caden Hunter went 6.0 innings, only giving up one earned run and was credited with the win. The Trojans added some insurance in the 7th after Hedges, Adrian Lopez, and Basseer all had RBI hits. Abbrie Covarrubias hit an inside-the-park home run in the 8th. Grant Govel went 3.0 innings and got the save. On Saturday the Trojans knocked off No. 14 ranked Vanderbilt, 3-1. The Trojans struck early, scoring two runs in the 3rd, thanks to a Bryce Martin-Grudzielanek RBI double, and a Dean Carpentier sacrifice fly. Covarrubias added another in the 6th with a sacrifice fly, scoring Carpentier. Caden Aoki was stellar going 7.0 innings without allowing an earned run, striking out a career high 10. Mason Edwards faced 6 hitters, striking out 3 of them, before handing the ball off to Hedges, who struck out the last hitter in the game to record his fourth save. On Sunday, the Trojans travelled to Westwood to play UCLA. The Trojans had 10 hits, 3 more than the Bruins, but timely defense from UCLA limited the Trojans on offense as USC fell, 5-1.

FULERTON WIN: The Trojans travelled to Fullerton to play Cal State Fullerton on Tuesday, Feb. 25 and won 5-3. Michael Ebner made his first start of the year, throwing 1.0 inning, giving up one run with three K's. Ethan Hedges hit his fourth home run of the year in the first inning, with Kade Higgins hitting his third home run of the season right after Hedges. Garren Rizzo came into the game after Ebner and shut down the Titans, throwing 4.0 innings of one-hit baseball, striking out a career high 9. Bryce Martin-Grudzielanek hit his first home run in the fifth to give the Trojans an insurance run, and later in the eighth drove in another run with a RBI single. Ethan Hedges shut the door in the 9th to record his 3rd save on the year.

WEEKEND SERIES VS RICE: USC played a pair of games at Rice over the weekend, with the Saturday contest in the series rained out. On Friday, the Trojans picked up a 7-4 victory in 11 innings, scoring four runs over the final two frames. Rice came back with a walkoff home run in the bottom of the ninth on Sunday.

MIDWEEK VICTORIES: On Feb. 18, the Trojans picked up their fourth win in a row against UC Irvine to start the season, taking down the Anteaters 5-2. Ethan Hedges erased a 2-1 deficit with a grand slam in the sixth inning and Grant Govel picked up the win by tossing 5.0 scoreless and hitless innings to end the game. The Trojans added another game to the win column on Feb. 19, taking down CSU Bakersfield 7-0 at LMU. Hedges hit his 3rd home run of the year, while Brayden Dowd hit his 2nd. The bullpen pitched a 2-hit shutout with 6 of the 7 pitchers used recording at least one strikeout. The 7 USC pitchers struck out 12 batters and walked just two.

OPENING WEEKEND SWEEP: The Trojans picked up an opening weekend sweep of George Washington to start the 2025 campaign this past week. USC scored 10 runs in the first inning to take Friday's contest 15-2, then hit four homers on Saturday en route to a 9-8 victory. Brayden Dowd hit a three-run homer in the sixth inning of the finale to secure a 7-5 win for the Trojans.

2024 RETURNER NOTES:

- **Dean Carpentier** returns for his sophomore seasons after hitting .287 with 4 HR, 12 extra base hits, and 26 RBI. He added a total of 26 BB/HBP and recorded a .987 fielding

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percentage at 1B for the Trojans.

- **Caden Aoki** made 11 starts his junior season, recording a 3.91 ERA and 50 K in 53.0 IP. He was named to the Pac-12 All-Tournament team after a stellar performance in the championship game against Arizona, where he took a no-hitter into the 7th, going 6.1 innings with 8 strikeouts and only 1 earned run. Aoki was ranked the 51st starting pitcher in the nation by D1Baseball heading into the season.
- **Brayden Dowd** returns after an impressive freshman year where he slashed .324/.401/.400 with 6 2B and 26 runs scored. He drew 21 walks and scored 26 runs in 2024 while ranking 6th in the Pac-12 with 5 sacrifice flies and had 16 multiple-hit games. He was named to the Pac-12 All Tournament team after having 6 hits, 8 RBI, and 3 extra base hits in the Trojans' 4 tournament games.
- **Michael Ebner** returns with the second most innings on the mound for the Trojans last season with 39 IP. The Junior made 23 appearances with 3 starts last season, striking out 38 with a 1.51 WHIP. Ebner also excelled this summer in the Cape Cod League, earning Cape League All-Star recognition.
- **Bryce Martin-Grudzielanek** returns after being drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 20th round. He started 19 of his 20 game appearances last season and posted a slash line of .284/.369/.405. He had 6 multiple-hit games, including twice where he tallied 3 hits. He finished the year strong, having hits in 10 of his last 11 games as well as hitting .375 in the Pac-12 tournament.
- **Kevin Takeuchi** posted a slash line of .289/.367/.472 and led the team with the most 3-hit games on the season (6). He recorded 14 multiple-hit games, 17 doubles and 40 RBI. He hit a pair of home runs in a game against Arizona early in the season, finished the season ranked 6th in the Pac-12 with 5 sacrifice flies, and ranked 7th with 0.33 doubles per game. Takeuchi played Summer Ball in the West Coast League and was named the WCL's Top Prospect.

2024 TEAM NOTES:

- USC's 31 wins last year was just the third time since 2005 the Trojans eclipsed the 30-win mark (2024, 2023, 2015).
- The Trojans finished 12-11 on the road last season season, which was the first time the program was over .500 since 2015 (the last time USC made a regional), excluding the 2020 shortened season.
- USC's 9 game winning streak to end the regular season and into the Pac-12 tournament was the longest winning streak for the program since 2015.
- USC's pitching staff posted 497 strikeouts in 2024, which was good for the 6th most in program history. Their team ERA of 4.87 was also 4th best in the Pac-12.
- The Trojans slugged for 113 doubles last season which was good for 4th most in the Pac-12, in addition to their 18 triples which was the 3rd most in the conference.

INCOMING CLASS: USC welcomed the 20th-ranked recruiting class in the nation this offseason according to Perfect game. With 25 new players on the roster, 11 were ranked in the Top 10 at their position in their state, seven were in the Top 5 and five were in the Top 25 overall in their state. In California, USC had 11 players ranked in the Top 20 at their position including the third overall outfielder (Matthew Priest), fifth overall catcher (Augie Lopez) and fifth overall shortstop (Maximo Martinez). The incoming USC class features eight transfers and 17 incoming

THE NEW DEDEAUX FIELD

DEDEAUX FIELD UPGRADES: In June 2023, USC announced a series of athletic facilities upgrades, including upgrades at USC Baseball's home Dedeaux Field. The new 2,500-seat stadium will boast a variety of seating options, outdoor social spaces, an indoor hospitality space, multiple concession locations, expanded restrooms, a video board and an audio system. The new stadium will also include a brand-new press box, coaching and support staff offices and a team meeting space.

The project is part of USC President Carol Folt's athletics "moonshot," which will also include a new football conditioning center; Rawlinson Stadium - the new home of USC women's lacrosse and soccer; and renovations to Galen Center - the home of USC men's and women's basketball.

The new Dedeaux Field is scheduled to be completed prior to the start of the 2026 season. Recently, the new playing surface was installed, allowing the team to begin practicing on campus once again.
