LEADING OFF

- Penn State hosts Indiana for its Big Ten opening series of the 2025 season.
- The Nittany Lions are off to a 9-1 start for the first time since 1980 and have won eight-straight games for the first time since 2016.
- Penn State earned a 7-6 win over FDU on Tuesday as Joe and Jesse Jaconski each drove in two runs.
- The Nittany Lions also hosted their first Dollar Dog Night of the 2025 season with 4,049 fans consuming 5,960 hot dogs.
- Penn State is coming off a 3-0 weekend in Virginia.
- PSU tallied 40 runs and launched seven homers in wins over Richmond, VCU and William & Mary.
- Before last Sunday's game at William & Mary, the Nittany Lions had scored 10+ runs in five-straight games for the first time since 1978.
- On Friday against Richmond, Paxton Kling blasted a grand slam, while Nate Voss had a three-run homer and Ryan Weingartner added a solo shot.
- On Saturday at VCU, Jesse Jaconski had a pair of two-run homers, while Voss had a grand slam and Cole Wagner had a solo homer.
- Kling leads the Nittany Lions with six homers, while Jaconski, Voss and Weingartner each have three and Wagner has two.

PSU'S STRONG START

- After a 3-0 weekend in Virginia and a 7-6 win over FDU, the Nittany Lions are off to a 9-1 start.
- Penn State is 9-1 to start a season for the first time since 1980.
- The Nittany Lions enter the Indiana series with an eight-game win streak, its first time winning eight-straight since 2016.
- Penn State entered its William & Mary game on a streak of fivestraight games with 10+ runs, the first time PSU has done that since 1978
- The Nittany Lions have hit 20 homers through the first 10 games.

NITTANY LION SWEEP IN VIRGINIA

- · Penn State earned three wins in Virginia.
- The Nittany Lions picked up a 17-6 run-rule victory at Richmond on Friday, a 16-7 win at VCU on Saturday and a 7-6 victory at William & Mary on Sunday.
- The Nittany Lions batted .333 on the weekend with 38 hits and 37 RBI, while positing 40 runs.
- Among the 38 hits were four doubles, a triple and seven homers.
- PSU hit three homers on Friday at Richmond, including a grand slam by Paxton Kling, a three-run homer by Cole Wagner and a solo shot by Ryan Weingartner.
- The Nittany Lions followed with four homers at VCU, including a pair of two-run homers by Jesse Jaconski, a grand slam by Nate Voss and a solo homer by Cole Wagner.
- Wagner collected six hits on the weekend, while Matt Maloney had eight hits with multi-hit performances in each game.
- On the mound, **Dimond Loosli** picked up a win and posted three shutout innnings, while **Ben DeMell** earned a win on Saturday with 2.1 shutout frames.

NITTANY LIONS AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS IN HOMERS

- Through 10 games, Penn State has slugged 20 home runs.
- The Nittany Lions rank seventh in the country, and second in the Big Ten, averaging 2.00 homers per game.
- Penn State also ranks 18th in the nation in total home runs and 19th in slugging percentage (.551).
- Paxton Kling leads the Nittany Lions with six homers, while sitting 15th in the country in total homers and 10th in home runs per game (0.60).
- Kling is among eight Nittany Lions with at least one home run this season and is one of five with multiple homers.
- Jesse Jaconski, Nate Voss and Ryan Weingartner own three homers, while Cole Wagner has two and Joe Jaconski, Matt Maloney and Jack Porter and each have one.

KLING CLAIMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

- Penn State junior outfielder Paxton Kling was tabbed Big Ten Player of the Week and Perfect Game National Player of the Week for his efforts in PSU's sweep at Longwood.
- Kling batted 7-of-13 (.538) at the plate with four homers, a double, six RBI and seven runs.
- He notched a 1.538 slugging percentage and a .600 on-base percentage.
- Kling launched two homers, including a three-run shot, in Saturday's first game. It was his first career multi-homer game.
- Kling added a solo homer, a double and two runs in Saturday's second game.
- He led off Sunday's contest with a homer and added two hits and two steals, while scoring three runs.

PENN STATE SWEEPS LONGWOOD

 The Nittany Lions picked up a three-game sweep at Longwood on Feb. 21-23.

- Penn State won 11-1 in game one, 10-0 in game two and 15-7 in game three.
- The Nittany Lions earned their first non-conference road sweep since Feb. 16-18, 2018 at Elon.
- Penn State tallied 36 runs in the series, its most in a three-game series since scoring 39 against Michigan State in 2021.
- PSU notched 10+ run in three-straight games for the first time since April 7-12, 2024 and recorded 10+ runs in each game of a three-game series for the first time since May 8-9, 2022 vs. Michigan State.
- The Nittany Lions' shutout in game two was their second shutout this season.
- Penn State has two shutouts against non-conference opponents in a season for the first time since 2019.

PSU EARNS TWO W'S IN PUERTO RICO

- The Nittany Lions earned two wins at the PR Baseball Challenge with victories over Missouri (10-0) and UConn (7-6).
- Penn State's win over Missouri was its first against an SEC team since 1995 at Alabama.
- It was also PSU's first shutout since a 1-0 win over UMass in 2022.
- UConn was a 2024 NCAA Super Regional team.
- Penn State combined for 21 runs on 27 hits over the weekend, including six doubles and six homers.
- The six homers were by six different players with one each by Joe Jaconski, Paxton Kling, Matt Maloney, Jack Porter, Cole Wagner and Ryan Weingartner.
- Jaconski led the Nittany Lions with a .462 average (6-of-13), four RBI and 11 total bases.
- On the mound, Penn State struck out 35 batters in 27 innings and held opposing hitters to a .216 average.
- PSU's starters Mason Horwat, Matt Morash and Ryan DeSanto combined to allow two earned runs in 11 innings while collecting 15 strikeouts.
- Horwat fired five shutout innings, giving up one hit, and tallied seven strikeouts against Missouri.
- DeSanto tossed four no-hit innings and struck out six against UConn.
- Ben DeMell and Anthony Steele each made two appearances in relief with DeMell picking up a save on Sunday.

PENN STATE ENTERS SECOND YEAR UNDER MIKE GAMBINO

- In its first season under head coach Mike Gambino, Penn State went 29-24 overall and 12-12 in Big Ten play. The 29 wins are Penn State's most under a first-year head coach.
- Penn State posted its first winning record in the regular season since 2016 (28-27) and maintained a .500 or better mark for the entire season for the first time since 2011 (32-22).
- The Blue and White notched its best record in Big Ten play since going 12-12 in 2016.
- Penn State reached the Big Ten Tournament Championship Game for the first time since 2000 and won three-straight games to open the Big Ten Tournament.
- The Nittany Lions maintained a .500 or better record for the entire season for the first time since the 2011 season (finished 32-27)
- Penn State ranked 99th in the RPI, its highest ranking to finish a season since 2007 (66th).
- The Nittany Lions went 11-3 in weekend opening games, tying Illinois and Nebraska for the best record among Big Ten teams.
- Penn State was 6-2 in Big Ten series openers, trailing only Illinois' 7-1 mark, and tying Nebraska and Purdue.
- Non-conference action included a series win at Stanford, a 2023 College World Series participant, and wins over Georgetown (58th in RPI) and Pitt (96th).

CATCHERS NOTES


- The Nittany Lions boast three catchers with plenty of college baseball experience and strong defensive numbers.
- Senior Matt Maloney has made 51 starts in 54 appearances in his first two seasons at Penn State.
- In his collegiate career, Maloney has played in 145 games with 122 starts. He has a .294 average with 134 hits, 25 doubles, one triple, six homers, 75 RBI, 79 runs and 10 steals. He also has 42 walks and 24 hit-by-pitches.
- He has a .448 slugging percentage and a .383 on-base percentage at PSU.
- He has recorded 18 multi-hit games and 11 multi-RBI games at PSII
- In 2025, Maloney has 10 hits, with two doubles and a homer, eight RBI and seven runs.
- He had three-multi hit games in Virginia with two hits vs. Richmond, three vs. VCU and three vs. William & Mary, while scoring four runs and driving in four.
- A member of the Buster Posey Award watch list in 2024, Maloney batted .321 with 52 hits, including 14 doubles and two homers, 37 RBI and 24 runs. He also posted a .444 slugging percentage.
- On defense, Maloney notched 18 assists and caught seven runners stealing.
- Junior Nate Voss joins the Nittany Lions after playing the 2024 season at lowa Western C.C. and the 2023 season at Michigan.
- He has started three games at catcher and one as DH in 2025.
- · This season, he has three homers and 10 RBI.
- · Voss launched a three-run homer against Longwood.
- He blasted a three-run homer at Richmond and a grand slam at VCU.

PAGE 26 | 2025 PENN STATE BASEBALL HEAD COACH MIKE GAMBINO



Mike Gambino was hired on July 3, 2023 as the 15th head coach in Penn State baseball program history. Gambino took over the Penn State Baseball program after 13 years at the helm of his alma mater Boston College.

In 2024, Penn State went 29-24 overall and 12-12 in Big Ten play. The 29 wins are Penn State's most under a first-year head coach.

Penn State posted its first winning record in the regular season since 2016 (28-27) and maintained a .500 or better mark from the entire season for the first time since 2011 (32-22). The Blue and White notched its best record in Big Ten play since going 12-12 in 2016.

The Nittany Lions finished with a Top-100 RPI for the first time since 2007.

Penn State reached the Big Ten Tournament Championship Game for the first time since 2000 and won three-straight games to open the Big Ten Tournament for the first time in program history. Gambino was the first Big Ten baseball coach to lead his team to a Big Ten Championship Game in year one since Minnesota's John Anderson in 1982.

The Nittany Lions' tremendous Big Ten Tournament run, as the eighth seed, included wins over Illinois (8-4) and Michigan (9-5 and 7-6) before falling to No. 2 seed Nebraska, 2-1, in the championship game.

In the regular season, Penn State earned Big Ten sweeps over Maryland and Northwestern, a series win over Rutgers and victories against Michigan, Indiana, Michigan State and Minnesota. PSU was 6-2 in Big Ten series openers.

Non-conference play included series wins over Stanford, Davidson, Harvard and UMass Lowell, while also earning two wins over Army and one over Monmouth on opening weekend and a win over Georgetown. Midweek wins included Pitt and FDU.

Penn State had three of its five largest home crowds in 2024. The Nittany Lions set a program record with 5,025 fans against Kent State (4/16). PSU also had 4,902 fans against FDU (4/9) and 3,505 against Pitt (3/26). Penn State finished second in the Big Ten in average attendance (1,615).

Adam Cecere (first team), J.T. Marr (first team) and Travis Luensmann (second team) were tabbed American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) All-Region East Team. Penn State had three ABCA All-Region selections for the first time since 1973. The three selections were tied with Maryland for most in the Big Ten.

Cecere (second team) and Marr (second team), Bryce Molinaro (third team) and Mason Horwat (freshman team) earned All-Big Ten honors.

As a team, Penn State finished among the Top Five in the Big Ten in batting average (.306; 2nd), slugging percentage (.491; 2nd), sac flies (32; 2nd), double plays (46; 3rd), double plays per game (0.87; 3rd), doubles per game (2.08; 4th), home runs per game (1.34; 5th) and runs per game (7.6; 5th).

The Nittany Lions had seven players with 52+ hits and eight with 40+ hits, seven players with 37+ RBI, five with a .409+ on-base percentage and eight with a .425+ slugging percentage.

Penn State, Illinois and Indiana were the only Big Ten teams with seven players owning 37+ RBI and PSU was one of two Big Ten teams with seven players owning 52+ hits.

The Nittany Lions launched 71 homers, its most since hitting 91 in 1998. PSU's 46 homers in Big Ten games were tied for most in the conference with Illinois

Cecere (17), Grant Norris (14) and Molinaro (11) became Penn State's first trio with 11+ homers in a season since 1999 (Shawn Fagan, 13; Dan Beers, 13; Chris Netwall, 12).

Marr posted incredible numbers, batting .416 with 92 hits (17 doubles, six homers), 54 RBI and 50 runs. His batting average never dipped below .408 in the entire 2024 season. Marr's 92 hits are tied-second in a season at Penn State, while he ranks seventh in total bases (127), eighth in at-bats (221), doubles (17) and RBI (54).

Marr ranked second in the Big Ten in hits per game (1.74; 2nd nationally), batting average (.416; 5th), hits per game (92; 22nd), eighth in on-base percentage (.464) and 11th in OPS (1.039).

Cecere paced the Big Ten in slugging percentage (.676) and OPS (1.140), while holding second in walks per game (0.89; 49th nationally), third in home runs (17), home runs per game (0.32) and walks (47), fourth in onbase percentage (.474) and sixth in sac flies (5).

Cecere's 47 walks are tied for a PSU season record and his 17 homers are tied-second in a season at Penn State. He also ranks sixth in a season in slugging percentage (.676), seventh in hit-by-pitches (10), eighth in total bases (125) and ninth in RBI (53).

Joe Jaconski ranked fifth in the Big Ten in walks (43) and Norris ranked ninth in homers (14). Norris' 14 homers are sixth in a season at PSU, while Jaconski's 43 walks are fourth.

On the mound, Luensmann ranked fifth in the Big Ten in hits allowed per nine innings (6.67; 34th nationally) and sixth in wins (7), while Jaden Henline sat second in walks per nine innings (1.99) and Anthony Steele was third in appearances (26).

In 13 seasons leading the Eagles, Gambino ranks second in program history in wins (291) while guiding Boston College to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances in 2016 and 2023 and an NCAA Super Regional appearance in 2016. He had five seasons of 25 or more wins and eight seasons with 10 or more ACC wins. BC also appeared in the ACC Championship Tournament four times under Gambino's tutelage, including berths in three of four years for the first time since Boston College joined the ACC in 2006.

Gambino has a long history of developing Major League Baseball talent with 34 draft picks in his 13 years at BC. He had three first round picks and eight picks in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft in his BC tenure. Four former Boston College players appeared in MLB games in 2023: outfielder Jake Alu (Washington Nationals), outfielder Sal Frelick (Milwaukee Brewers), pitcher Michael King (New York Yankees) and pitcher Emmet Sheehan (Los Angeles Dodgers). Five of Gambino's former BC players have reached the major leagues.

He coached five All-American selections and five Freshman All-Americans at Boston College. Gambino guided 16 All-ACC selections, including 2021 ACC Player of the Year Sal Frelick.

In his time at Boston College, Gambino put together five recruiting classes ranked among the nation's Top 60 by Perfect Game.

In 2023, Gambino guided the Eagles to a 37-20 overall record and 16-14 mark in ACC play. The 37 overall wins tie the program record set by the 2005 squad and the 16 ACC victories are also a highwater mark for the program topping the 14 victories by the 2010 team. Boston College logged 12 ranked wins, including a thrilling 7-6 victory over No. 2 Tennessee in 10 innings, on the way to playing in the Tuscaloosa Regional and reaching the regional final. The Eagles were ranked for 12 weeks in the DIBaseball Poll, reaching as high as ninth. Three of Gambino's players earned All-ACC accolades, including Chris Flynn claiming second-team All-ACC as a starting pitcher.

Gambino also spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers and was an assistant coach at Boston College from 2003-05.

Gambino played for the Eagles from 1997-2000, starting 166 games in the middle infield. He posted a career batting average of .313 with 22 doubles, eight home runs, 87 RBIs and 117 runs. His 78 hits in 2000 were a program record that stood until 2011. Gambino's 52 runs his final year are in the top 10 in BC history.

The Garrison, New York native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast region honoree following his senior campaign. He also earned second-team All-New England and Big East Academic Team accolades during his playing career.

Gambino played two seasons in the Boston Red Sox minor league system. He spent the 2000 season with the Augusta Green Jackets before splitting the 2001 season between Augusta and the Lowell Spinners. In 2002, the Red Sox hired Gambino as a special assistant to the Major League staff before heading back to Lowell for a coaching role with the Spinners just prior to the June draft. Following his stint in Lowell, the Red Sox sent Gambino to the MLB Scout Development Program.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from Boston College in English and theology. He and his wife, Jill, have two children, Sonny and Callahan.
