GAMEDAY NOTES

• The Purple Aces left Springfield with a big win over the Missouri State Bears on Sunday afternoon. In UE's final MVC series at Hammons Field, Evansville had a big offensive showing in the series finale. The Aces outlasted an almost four-hour slugfest against the Bears, picking up a 16-11 win.

• UE had a season-high 17 hits against Missouri State on Sunday afternoon. Evansville had three 16 hit games earlier in the season with the most recent coming back in March during the Aces first weekend of conference play at Murray State. UE had three batters combine for nine of the team's 17 hits while nine of 10 batters recorded at least a hit.

• Evansville added four home runs over the weekend at Hammons Field. The Aces had their best slugging week of the season with five total long balls and 15 multi-base hits in four games at WKU and Missouri State. UE had its first back-to-back games with multiple home runs this season in Springfield while sophomore Charlie Longmeier had a home run in each game.

• The Aces had some of their younger players step up at the plate this weekend. Freshman first baseman Jake McGhee led the team's starters in batting average over the weekend slashing .462/.533/.538 as he was six of 13 at the plate. McGhee also added an RBI and two scored runs over three games.

• Sophomore left fielder Charlie Longmeier also had a big weekend for UE in Springfield. Longmeier along with senior infielder Cal McGinnis batted .429 in 14 at-bats in Hammons Field. Longmeier was one of three players with six hits against Missouri State. He was also the only Ace to record multiple home runs on the weekend with his fourth and fifth career homers on Saturday and Sunday.

• Over half of Evansville's lineup batted over .300 on the weekend against the Bears. In only three at-bats this weekend senior catcher/pinch hitter Evan Waggoner was a perfect three-of-three from the plate with two doubles. While McGhee, McGinnis, Longmeier, infielder Drew Howard, and outfielder Harrison Taubert all had batting averages over .300.

TEAM NOTES

WHAT A SEASON!

The Aces are coming off one of their best seasons in program history after capturing the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament Title for the first time in 18 years, winning the program's first ever NCAA Regional, and appearing in the program's first NCAA Super Regional. Along with the longest postseason run for the program, the 2024 UE roster set three single season records and two career records. Designated hitter Kip Fougereousse set two program records for most hits (94) and home runs (22) in a season to lead last year's team on offense.

30 FOR 30 FOR 30

UE has posted three straight 30-win seasons for the first time since the 2005 (35 wins), 2006 (43 wins), and 2007 (34 wins) seasons. The last time Evansville had four 30 win seasons in a row dates back to the 1990's with UE Hall of Famer Jim Brownlee as the Head Coach. Under Brownlee's direction the Aces achieved six 30-win seasons back-to-back from 1991 to 1996.

OH CANADA!

The Aces have taken to plucking the Great White North's best heading into the 2025 season. UE has four players on its roster from Canada. Returning sophomore infielder Brodie Pert welcomes transfers Cole Iantomasi and Owen Byberg along with freshman RJ James to Evansville. The Aces Canadian contingent isn't the first time UE has had multiple players from across the border. Evansville had three Canadians on its roster in both the 2020 and 2021 seasons.

OFFENSIVE CHANGE UPS

It's a new look team for the Aces on offense in 2025. UE returns 39.7% of its at-bats from the prior season and only 38.1% of its hits. A trio of batters makes up the bulk of that number in seniors Cal McGinnis, Harrison Taubert, and Ty Rumsey. McGinnis saw the most production in 2024 with a .348 average, 69 hits, 38 runs, two triples, and six home runs.

HOME OF THE FREE(LAND)

UE Baseball alum and Rockies pitcher Kyle Freeland and his wife Ashley returned to Evansville to break ground on the Freeland Clubhouse at Charles H. Braun Stadium. The Freeland's donated \$3 million for the project which is set to be completed for the 2026 season.

WE ARE UE

There are several ways to reference the University of Evansville. Generally, the first reference should always be "University of Evansville" or "Purple Aces". Later references to our team may be "Aces" as well as just using the word "Evansville".

Our school abbreviation is "UE". Under no circumstances is it acceptable to use "EU".

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

ROADRUNNER ON THE BASE PATHS

With two steals against Butler on Tuesday senior outfielder Ty Rumsey has the most stolen bases in a season for the Aces since 2012. Rumsey currently has 21 steals midway through the season to lead the MVC. He is also 20th in the nation in stolen bags while being 27th in stolen bases per game. Rumsey has a ways to take the season record for stolen bases from Eric Stamets who had 43 in the 2010 season.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME IN MO.

Senior right fielder Harrison Taubert has had his best offensive performances for the Aces while in the state of Missouri. Taubert led UE at the plate as he went .500 against Missouri including five multi-base hits. Taubert also had Evansville's first inside the park home run in two years at Southeast Missouri on the 11th. Taubert hit a ball that bounced off the wall in left field at Capaha Field and was fast enough to get all the way home.

FIRST MVC HONORS

Sophomore LHP Kevin Reed was the first Ace to earn a weekly Missouri Valley Conference honors in 2025. Reed was named the MVC Pitcher of the Week on Tuesday, March 11 for his performance at Central Arkansas, facing the minimum batters in three of his seven innings by taking the Bears down in order. He also had two innings with multiple strikeouts in the bottom of the second and the bottom of the fourth. In total Reed struck out six batters bringing his season total up to 24 Ks on the year.

NOW THAT'S A WAY TO DEBUT

Freshman infielder Drew McConnell (Blue Springs, Mo. Blue Springs HS) made quite an impression in his first collegiate game with the Aces. McConnell helped power UE to its first win of 2025 against USI by leading Evansville in RBIs, sending four runners home. In his debut game, McConnell went 2 of 3 at the plate with a single and a double, while scoring twice and walking once. In the field McConnell helped assist on one out from his position at shortstop.

FILL THE TROPHY CASE

Sophomore left-hander Kenton Deverman continues to rack up preseason awards with Opening Day on the horizon. Deverman earned four separate preseason recognitions in 2025. Deverman was recognized three times by D1Baseball as a Third Team All-American, their projected MVC Pitcher of the Year, and the 15th best starting pitcher in college baseball. Deverman was also named Perfect Game's Preseason MVC Starting Pitcher. On March 17 he was also named one of two All-MVC Preseason Starting Pitchers.

THE SKIPPER

Head coach Wes Carroll also comes into 2025 with some new hardware along with his team. At the end of the 2025 season Carroll was named the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA)/ ATEC Midwest Regional Coach of the Year in a vote of the ABCA's All-America and Coach of the Year

COACH NOTES

- Evansville alum Wes Carroll heads into his 16th season as head baseball coach at the University of Evansville as the Aces have ushered in a new era of Evansville Baseball.
- Carroll earned his second MVC Coach of the Year honor in 2022 after leading Evansville to a second-place finish in the league standings with a 14-6 conference mark (32-24 overall). Carroll also earned MVC Coach of the Year honors in 2014 after guiding UE to the MVC regular-season title.
- Carroll currently ranks second all-time at UE in career coaching victories with 389, behind only his mentor and head coach Jim Brownlee.
- In July 2019, UE announced that German American Bank had made a financial commitment to University of Evansville athletics which resulted in an impressive renovation to the Aces' baseball stadium, which is now known as "German American Bank Field at Charles H. Braun Stadium." Included in the renovations were a full AstroTurf field, padded walls throughout the entire stadium with new fence lines down the first and third base lines, dugout and bullpen renovations as well as a new LED scoreboard.
- Carroll learned the game "the Purple Aces' way" growing up just minutes from the UE campus in nearby Newburgh, Indiana. He watched his older brother and former Major League infielder, Jamey Carroll, excel at shortstop for UE, and later got to experience the success the program is capable of first-hand as a four-year starter for the Purple Aces and a member of UE's 2000 NCAA Tournament team.
- Carroll became UE's first Freshman All-American in 1998, thanks to a rookie campaign in which he hit .355 with 18 doubles, two home runs, and 39 runs batted in. Carroll went on to hit .299 or better in each of his four years at UE, and finished his career by setting the school's all-time career record for doubles (74), while also ranking in the school's career top 10 in six different categories. He still holds the record for career doubles, has the second-most base hits in school history with 308, and ranks 10th all-time in UE history with a .339 career batting average. Carroll earned all-conference and all-region honors on the UE infield during his four-year career, before being named to the Missouri Valley Conference's All-Centennial Team in 2007 as one of the top players in league history.
