THE GAME: Illinois Wesleyan (2-1, 0-1 CCIW) continues its 126th football season with a College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin game against North Park (1-2, 0-1 CCIW) ... Kickoff is 6 p.m. at Tucci Stadium in Bloomington, Ill.

THE SERIES VS. THE VIKINGS: Dating back to 1960, IWU leads the series vs. North Park, 53-4, had won 29 in a row prior to a loss in 2015 in Chicago ... IWU has won 35 of the last 37 against the Vikings ... Illinois Wesleyan is 31-0 in Bloomington and 22-4 on the road against the Vikings. See full list below.

NEXT WEEK: The Titans will play their next two games on the road game, starting with a 1 p.m. game next Saturday at No. 4 Wheaton College and then a 1 p.m. kickoff on October 7 at Augustana ... Next Saturday is the Homecoming game at Wheaton.

POLLING PLACE: The Illinois Wesleyan football team fell to No. 20 (from No. 16) in the third D3football.com poll of the season ... Mary Hardin-Baylor is first in the poll, followed by Mount Union, Wisconsin-Oshkosh, Wheaton and North Central ... The D3football.com Top 25 is voted on by a panel of 25 coaches, Sports Information Directors and media members from across the country, and is published weekly ... IWU football team is tied for 23rd place in the season's first American Football Coaches Association Division III Coaches' Top 25 Poll released on Monday. The top five in the AFCA poll are the same as in the D3football.com poll.

UNDER THE LIGHTS: Since bringing lights back to Tucci Stadium in 2001, Illinois Wesleyan has a 9-3 home record under the lights... Saturday will be the 13th home night football game at IWU's Wilder Field since 1971... The Oct. 25, 2008 game was the latest night game on the calendar at home in at least 43 years. In 2002, IWU won its first overtime game in a 31-24 decision over Washington U. The Titans were to have played Aurora at night on Sept. 15, 2001, but the game was cancelled after the national tragedies of Sept. 11. Before 2002, the last home night game was on Oct. 2, 1971, when Carthage downed the Titans, 22-19. Home night game results since 1965:

GAME #1,031 AHEAD: In its 126th season, IWU has an overall 1,030-game record of 578-410-42 (.579 winning percentage) ... Of the 1,030 games, head coach **Norm Eash** has been involved in 332 of them (296 as a coach, 36 as a player from 1971-74) ... Illinois Wesleyan's 35-27 win at Albion on Sept. 13, 2014 was the 1,000th game in Illinois Wesleyan football history.

HOME AND AWAY: Since Norm Eash became head coach in 1987, Illinois Wesleyan is 105-43 (.709) at home and 88-59-1 on the road (.599).

SEPTEMBER: The Titans are 66-22-1 (.756) in the Norm Eash coaching era in the month, including a 2-1 mark in 2017 ... IWU was 2-1 in September 2016 ... The Titans had a 22-game September winning streak ended with the loss at Simpson in 2014 ... The last loss before that was on Sept. 15, 2007 to Mt. St. Joseph... IWU teams won 11 straight September games (all non-league) from 1995 (loss at Simpson) until 2001 (loss to Washington U.).



LAST WEEK: No. 16-ranked Illinois Wesleyan football team was limited to 71 second half yards and no points in a 26-13 loss to No. 5-ranked North Central in the CCIW opener for both clubs at Benedetti-Wehrl Stadium in Naperville, Ill., on Sept. 16 ... This game was the fifth matchup in the past seven years when both teams have been nationally-ranked. The Titans are 2-1 (0-1 CCIW) and the Cardinals are 2-0 (1-0 CCIW) and defeated IWU for the eighth straight year ... After falling behind 10-0, the Titans got on the scoreboard with 33 seconds left in the first quarter on a 6-yard run by sophomore **Brandon Bauer (Frankfort, Lincoln-Way East HS)**. The score was 10-6 when Anthony Sciarini's extra point kick was blocked. A 26-yard Cardinal field goal made the score 13-6 before Illinois Wesleyan tied the game on a 4-yard pass from Bauer to senior tight end **Andrew Apel (Arlington Heights, Buffalo Grove HS)** to cap an 11-play drive. Sciarini's kick tied the match at 13-13, which is where it stood at halftime ... North Central had the only scoring of the third quarter and led 20-13 heading into the fourth and Liam Crotty tacked on a 33-yard field goal with 9:58 to play in the game. Crotty, who tied a school game record with four field goals, hit a 39-yarder with 5:22 remaining to stake the Cardinals to the final 26-13 advantage ... Bauer completed 12 of 27 passes for 178 yards and a touchdown with his first two interceptions of the season. Two Bauer TD passes were negated by offensive pass interference calls. Junior running back **Morgan Alexander (Elmhurst, Ill. York HS)** rushed for 64 yards on 19 carries to pace the Titans ... Defensively, linebacker **Jordan Hassan (Wheaton, Glenbard West HS)** led IWU with 15 total tackles, 13 solo, and one tackle for loss. **Josh Akin (Blue Island, Eisenhower HS)** had eight total tackles while **Trevor Koepke (Tinley Park HS)** had five stops and **Trevor Staley (Lake Zurich HS)** had five ... North Central quarterback Broc Rutter was 24 of 37 for 226 yards and two touchdowns while running back Austin Breunig had 69 yards on 19 carries. The Cardinals, who survived nine penalties for 99 yards and lost two fumbles, had 346 yards of total offense on 75 plays while the Titans amassed 244 yards on 60 plays (178 passing and 66 rushing).

COACH NORM EASH: The "dean" of league coaches and winningest coach in school history, **Norm Eash** (Illinois Wesleyan, 1975) is in his 31st season at IWU ... He has a career overall record of 193-102-1 (.656) and a career CCIW mark of 135-81-1 (.618) ... Eash became the school's all-time football coaching win leader with a 52-21 victory over North Park on Oct. 12, 2013 ... He surpassed the record held by his own college coach, **Don "Swede" Larson** (168-121-6 from 1954-86) ... Eash is in second place all-time in CCIW victories, behind only **Larson** with 142 CCIW wins... Eash passed Augustana's **Bob Reade** for second place in conference coaching victories. Reade had 112 wins from 1979 to 1994 ... Eash has been CCIW "Coach of the Year" five times (2009, 2007, 2001, 1996, 1992) ... The win at Augustana on Oct. 17, 2009, was Eash's 100th CCIW win.

BEHIND ENEMY LINES: North Park is 1-2 with a season-opening 33-7 win at Anderson and a 24-14 road loss to NAIA school Midland (Fremont, Neb.) before falling by a 23-20 score at home to Elmhurst in the CCIW opener. North Park led the Bluejays 20-16 before a TD with 2:03 provided the come from behind win for Elmhurst ... The Vikings have nine returning starters back on defense at the start of the season, including six seniors ... Returning all-CCIW players on defense are linebacker Chaun Maiava, safety Matt DiFecchio and cornerback David Simmons ... The leading rusher from last season, Enrique Menendez, also is back. He gained 684 yards with seven touchdowns a year ago ... Alexis Santillan returns as the kicker and was 6-6 in field goals and 19-19 in extra points in 2016 ... Michael Conway is in his fifth season at North

Park and has a 10-33 overall record. He previously served 11 seasons as associate head coach and defensive coordinator at Division II California University of Pennsylvania, where his teams were 97-36 with five-straight playoff appearances and the No. 1-ranked defense in 2007. In 2000, he was associate head coach and defensive and special teams coordinator at Geneva College and was named NAIA Assistant Coach of the Year. He was head coach at Olivet Nazarene, his alma mater, where he led the Tigers to a four-year 31-14 record and NAIA finalists in 1998. His coaching career also includes stops as an assistant at Washington & Jefferson, Purdue, and Arkansas State.

PACIFIC REPRESENTATION: The Vikings have 11 players from Hawaii and seven players from American Samoa on their roster.

PREVIOUS CCIW HONORS: Illinois Wesleyan junior defensive back **Trevor Staley (Lake Zurich, Ill., Lake Zurich HS)** was named the CCIW "Defensive Player of the Week" on Sept. 5. Staley helped lead the Titans to a 17-10 win over UW-Whitewater. Staley totaled 10 tackles (seven solo) and one tackle-for-loss in the win.

OPPONENT PASSING RECORD: On Sept. 9 at Tucci Stadium, Nebraska Wesleyan QB Jonathan Curti completed 32 of 65 pass attempts for 461 yards and three touchdowns. The 65 pass attempts is a record for an opponent against Illinois Wesleyan, topping the old mark of 62 by North Central in 1967 while the 461 yards is just short of the record of 462 set by Wheaton in 1998 ... The 461 is a Nebraska Wesleyan school record for passing yards, breaking the previous record set in 1986.

SEASON OPENERS: IWU is 20-11 (.633) in opening-day games under Norm Eash, including the 17-10 win over Wisconsin-Whitewater on Sept. 2, 2017. The Titans have now won 10 straight season opening games after losing five in a row from 2003 to 2007.
