**BLOOMINGTON, III.** – The Illinois Wesleyan University football team welcomes Carroll University to Tucci Stadium Saturday, Oct. 5, for Homecoming. Kickoff of the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin tilt is scheduled for 1 p.m.

**SOPHOMORE SPECIAL:** Sophomores **Christopher Kosinski** and **Robert Neidballa** teamed up for a momentum-shifting special teams play on Augustana's first play of the third quarter, Sept. 28. After the IWU defense forced a three-and-out, Kosinski blocked the ensuing punt and Neidballa scooped it up for the 20-yard score. Illinois Wesleyan is one of 20 teams nationally to return a blocked punt for a touchdown this season.

Neidballa was named CCIW Special Teams Player of the Week for his performance. It was the first weekly CCIW award of his career, while it was the third time this season a Titan was named the league's player of the week.

**SACK LUNCH:** Junior defensive lineman **Mike Murphy** was a force in the trenches against Augustana, Sept. 28, as the Orland Park, Ill. native matched a career-high with three sacks. Murphy's trio of sacks rank tied for fourth-most in IWU single-game history. He also added a pair of quarterback hurries.

Murphy currently ranks fifth in the nation and leads all CCIW players with five sacks. No other player in the league has more than 2.5.

**CLASHES WITH CARROLL:** The Titans and Pioneers have squared off on the gridiron 42 times since the series began in 1935. Illinois Wesleyan heads into Saturday's showdown with a 25-17 lead in the all-time series and winners of five straight against Carroll.

The series, which began with a 12-6 IWU win in 1935, took place each season from 1955 to 1991. Following a 25-year hiatus the series picked back up when Carroll rejoined the CCIW in 2016.

## HEAD COACH NORM EASH

In 32 seasons (1987-2018) as Illinois Wesleyan University head football coach, Norm Eash has built the Titans into one of the country's highly-regarded and respected

NCAA Division III programs.

In the three decades, he has coached nine College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin championship teams (1992, 1994, 1996, 2000, 2001, 2007, 2009, 2017, 2018); six NCAA Division III playoff teams (1992, 1996, 2009, 2011, 2013, 2017); 11 first team Division III All-Americans (including linebacker Jordan Hassan in 2017); eight Academic All-Americans; and one winner of the Gagliardi Trophy honoring the nation's top Division III player (Lon Erickson in 1996).

Eash's current career mark at his alma mater is 208-105-1 (.664). The "dean" of league coaches, Eash has been CCIW "Coach of the Year" six times (2017, 2009, 2007, 2001, 1996 and 1992). His career CCIW mark is 150-82-1 (.646), surpassing wins of his own college coach Don Larson for most all-time victories in the league. Larson was 142-89-6 in 33 years from 1954-86.

On October 12, 2013, the Titans downed North Park 52-21 and the win was Eash's 169th career victory, the most in IWU history and besting the mark of 168 set by Larson, from 1954-86. An article about Eash eclipsing the Larson mark appeared in the Winter 2013-14 Illinois Wesleyan Alumni Magazine.

Prior to 2016, Eash was No. 8 among Division III active coaches in total victories and No. 28 among all-time Division III coaches.

Eash's record in NCAA Division III play is 3-6. The 2017 team was 9-2 and lost to Case Western Reserve in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. The nine victories has only happened six other times in Illinois Wesleyan football history.

The 2013 team was 9-2 and lost at home in the first round to Wartburg while the 2010 team was also 9-2 and lost a first round NCAA home game in three overtimes to Monmouth.

The 2009 Titans were 10-2 overall, earned a share of the CCIW championship and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Division III playoffs before losing to eventual national champion

Wisconsin-Whitewater.

The Illinois Wesleyan 1996 and 1992 teams were both 10-1, captured CCIW outright championships, and both advanced to the quarterfinal round of the Division III playoffs, losing each time to Mount Union (1996 champions).

Eash's 1994, 2000, 2001, 2007, 2017 and 2018 teams shared the CCIW title.

Prior to 1992, only three other IWU teams (1965, 1951, and 1888) had gone through the regular season with a perfect record and the 1992 team was the first Titan team to claim an outright, undefeated CCIW championship since 1965.

In the decade of the 1990s, Eash's teams were 72-21-1 (.771) and were consistently rated in national publications among the top Division III teams.

In 2011, Eash was elected as an "honorary member" of the American Football Coaches Association for his "devotion, dedication and distinguished service to the game of football."

A native of Chenoa, Ill., Eash captained his high school football and basketball teams and was a Little All-State football selection in 1970. A 1975 IWU graduate, Eash was a starting defensive lineman as a sophomore and a starting offensive tackle his last two seasons, playing on an 8-1 team in 1974 that tied for the CCIW title. Eash taught physical education and was an assistant coach in football, basketball, and track at Streator High School from 1975 to 1982, then was head football coach and athletic director at Dwight High School. His Dwight teams were 34-15, qualified for the Illinois High School playoffs three times, and reached the Class 2A quarterfinals in 1983, when Eash was Kankakee Area Coach of the Year.

Eash and his wife, Cheryl, have one son (Kyle) and four daughters (Kendra, Kelsey, Kaylyn and Karley).

In addition to his duties as football coach, Eash is an associate athletic director and chair of the physical education department at Illinois Wesleyan, and he has led Titan teams to victories in international exhibition games in Germany (1996), Italy (2001), France (2005), Austria (2009), Finland (2013) and Japan (2017). His IWU team also won a home international game against Monterrey Tech-Mexico in September 2016.

**HOSTING THE PIONEERS:** Illinois Wesleyan owns a 14-7 record against Carroll in Bloomington all-time. The last time the Titans and Pioneers faced off at Tucci Stadium, IWU cruised to a 30-0 Homecoming victory, Oct. 14, 2017.

**HOMECOMING:** In the last 54 years, Illinois Wesleyan has compiled a 34-20 record in its Homecoming games. The Titans have come out victorious in each of their past two Homecoming matchups (2017 vs. Carroll - W, 30-0 & 2018 vs. Carthage - WOT, 44-34).

IWU has hosted Carroll for its annual Homecoming five times in the past 54 years. The Titans are 3-2 in those five tilts.

**DOUBLE-DIGIT STOPS x4:** Four Titans finished with double-digit tackles in Illinois Wesleyan's win over Augustana, Sept. 28. **Keenan Scott** and **Ryan Swift** tied for the team lead with 13 stops apiece, while **Dave Lux** and **Francis Urbanski** added 11 tackles each. Swift, Lux, and Urbanski all set career-bests in the Titans' win over the Vikings.

Moreover, it was the first time IWU had four players with 10-or-more tackles in a game since Nov. 10, 2012 when the Titans accomplished the feat against Elmhurst. **Chris Simms** led the way with a game-high 13 tackles and **Tim Hollowed** tallied 11. **Kyle Pfister** and **Mike Kraft** registered 10 each.

**TITANS IN OCTOBER:** The Titans have compiled a 93-49 (.654) record in the month of October under **Norm Eash**.

Illinois Wesleyan is currently on a 12-game win streak in the month of October, which dates back to a 42-6 win over Augustana, Oct. 8, 2017. IWU's last loss in the month came on its 2016 Homecoming at the hands of Wheaton, 28-24, Oct. 1.

**NOTHING TO SEE HERE:** Illinois Wesleyan has been one of the more disciplined teams in the country so far this season, ranking second in the nation and first in the conference with just nine penalties. IWU averages just 3.0 flags per game, the fourth-fewest in the nation.

**HOME COOKING:** The Titans are 113-46 (.711) at home since **Norm Eash** became head coach in 1987. IWU has won 12 of its past 14 home games dating back to the 2016 season.

**IWU PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:** Chosen by Titan coaches to honor top players in the week's game and practices. The "Titan Award" honors a player for work ethic, loyalty and spirit.

**BEHIND ENEMY LINES:** Carroll enters the weekend with a 1-2 overall record and is still in search of its first CCIW win of the season, sitting at 0-2. The Pioneers opened the season with a 44-34 win at Lakeland before falling to Carthage (36-7) and Elmhurst (32-30) in back-to-back weeks.

Carroll averages 27.0 points a contest and 309.0 yards per game, with 217.7 coming through the air. Junior quarterback Michael Johnson is 44-for-69 on the season for 550 yards and six scores, while Isaac Allen has rushed for a team-best 163 yards through three games.

Defensively, the Pioneers are giving up 34 points per game. Justin Kontny has a team-leading 39 tackles, including five TFLs.

**YEAR 128:** In its 128th season, IWU has an overall 1,051-game record of 594-415-42 (.585 winning percentage). Of the 1,050 games, head coach **Norm Eash** has been involved in 353 of them (317 as a coach, 36 as a player from 1971-74).

Illinois Wesleyan's 35-27 win at Albion on Sept. 13, 2014 was the 1,000th game in Illinois Wesleyan football history.

**ALL-CCIW RETURNERS:** The 2019 Illinois Wesleyan roster features seven players who have earned All-College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin accolades, the most the Titans have returned since 2013. The all-league picks include **Brandon Bauer, Jake Buhe, Jack Healy, Trevor Koepke, Ryan Swift, Michael Norwood, and Zach Walsh.**

**TWO TITANS EARN CCIW WEEKLY HONORS:** Sophomore running back **Hamid Bullie** and senior defensive back **Trevor Koepke** were named CCIW Players of the Week, Sept. 16. Bullie garnered CCIW Offensive Player of the Week honors, while Koepke was tabbed the CCIW Defensive Player of the Week.

Bullie turned in a strong debut at No. 23 UW-La Crosse, Sept. 14, racking up 177 rushing yards on 37 carries. His 177 yards are the most by a CCIW player this season.

Koepke reeled in defensive player of the week honors following a seven-tackle performance at UWL. Koepke tied for the team lead in stops, while also adding a fumble recovery, two pass breakups, and an interception.

**CCIW PRESEASON POLL:** For the 10th consecutive season, the Illinois Wesleyan football team has been picked to finish third in the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin (CCIW) football annual preseason coaches' poll, announced on Thursday, Aug. 8.

Illinois Wesleyan was third with 68 points and one first place vote following back-to-back co-conference titles in 2017 and 2018. The Titans have won nine titles under head coach Norm Eash, who begins his 33rd season in 2019 and is the longest-tenured active CCIW coach.

North Central was picked to win the league with 79 points and two first-place votes, while Wheaton was selected second (72 points, two first-place votes). WashU was predicted to finish fourth, with Carthage, Millikin, Augustana, Elmhurst, Carroll, and North Park rounded out the preseason poll.
