**Head Coach  
Wayne Brent  
110-149 overall record  
9th season at Jackson State**

Wayne Brent enters his ninth season at the helm of the Jackson State men's basketball program. Brent was named to the post as Head Men's Basketball Coach on March 27, 2013. In 2019, Brent guided the Tigers to a 15-17 mark overall and 11-7 in SWAC play. His Tigers closed the season on a five game winning streak to end the regular season and give the Tigers a first round host spot in the 2020 SWAC Tournament. JSU ended the season with a 69-52 win over Alcorn in the first round of the SWAC tournament before ending the season due to the 2020 World Wide COVID-19 Pandemic.

Brent, who is one of the most successful basketball coaches in the history of the Jackson Public School system, brings over 15 years of coaching experience at the high school and collegiate levels to JSU.

Prior to his arrival at Jackson State, Brent had a successful tenure at the helm of Callaway's boys basketball program. From 2007-13, his teams won five division and four state championships. In his first year, the Chargers finished 26-11.

The following year, the Chargers recorded a 33-6 mark and won their first state title under Brent. In 2009, the team tallied a 22-11 record and repeated as state champions. After a 13-11 record in 2010, the Chargers rebounded in 2011 finishing 24-6 en route to their third state crown. Prior to taking the Callaway job, Brent was the head coach at Piney Woods High School.

In three years at Piney Woods, he led the Tornadoes to a 72-16 record. In 2004, his first season at the school, the Tornadoes finished with a 31-6 record and earned a divisional title. Over the next two years, his teams went 20-6 (2005) and 21-4 (2006) adding two more divisional titles.

From 1998-1999 through 2000-2001, he served as an assistant men's basketball coach at the University of Mississippi. While at Ole Miss, the Rebels made three NCAA tournament appearances and a post-season NIT appearance.

Ole Miss finished with a 27-8 record, won the Southeastern Conference Western Division title before winning the SEC Tournament. That season, the Rebels advanced to the Sweet Sixteen in the NCAA Tournament. Prior to serving as an assistant at Ole Miss, he was the head coach at Provine High School.

In his six seasons at Provine, Brent compiled a record of 116-65, winning two state crowns. The Rams had only one losing season under his direction. It would also be his first as a head coach. In the final two seasons at Provine, the Rams won the Mississippi Class 5A title (1998) and finished ranked No. 1 in the state and No. 25 in the final USA Today Boys High School Top 25 poll.

For his efforts, Brent was named the Clarion-Ledger's Metro Coach of the Year in back-to-back seasons.

Prior to his time at Provine, Brent served as an assistant coach at Tallulah High School in Tallulah, La., for one year (1991-1992). Tallulah finished the season with a 13-15 record, but won the district championship and advanced to the state playoffs.

Brent is a 1989 graduate of University of Louisiana-Monroe, then called Northeast Louisiana University, where he played two seasons for the Warhawks basketball program from 1987-1989.

ULM finished the 1987-1988 season with a 21-9 mark, placed second in the Southland Conference and received a National Invitational Tournament (NIT) bid. The 1988-1989 team had a 17-12 record again finishing second in the Southland Conference.

Following graduation, Brent served as a graduate assistant coach at ULM for two years (1989-1991). During his two seasons as a graduate assistant, the Warhawks posted back-to-back 20-win campaigns (23-8 in 1990; 25-8 in 1991), won consecutive Southland Conference titles and advanced to two straight NCAA Tournaments.

Brent holds three degrees from ULM, including a Bachelor of Arts in Journalism (1989), a Bachelor of Science in Health and Human Performance (1992) and a Master's of Education in Health and Human Performance (1992).

Brent graduated from Provine High School in 1985 and also played three years of basketball for the Rams from 1982-1985. During his three playing years, Provine compiled a 66-28 record and won two city championships.

He is the father of Kristian Nycole (daughter) and Cameron Wayne (son).

**SWAC REGULAR SEASON CO-CHAMPS**

Jackson State finished the season undefeated in SWAC play with a 79-54 win over over Alabama State to claim the regular season SWAC Championship, and improved to 11-5 overall on the season and a perfect 11-0 in SWAC play.

## LAST TIME OUT... AT ALABAMA A&M

**Jackson State found itself in yet another close game on the road, but Alabama A&M's go-ahead free throws with 13 seconds left handed the Tigers another narrow defeat in what was a 60-58 decision on Monday night inside the T.M. Elmore Gym.**

**Jayveous McKinnis paced the Tigers as he was just shy of another double-double with 16 points and 9 rebounds.**

**The freshman duo Malachi Wideman and Coltie Young were huge off the bench for the Tigers. Young finished with 15 points recording three triples followed by Wideman who added 13 points with two triples.**

## TRISTAN JARRETT to NBA G-League

Tristan Jarrett became the first player in Jackson State basketball program history to be taken in the NBA developmental league draft.

Jarrett (Brownsville, Tenn.) led the SWAC in scoring with 20.3 points per contest in 2020-2021. He was the key scoring threat for a Jackson State Tigers team that was crowned 2021 SWAC Men's Basketball regular season co-champions.

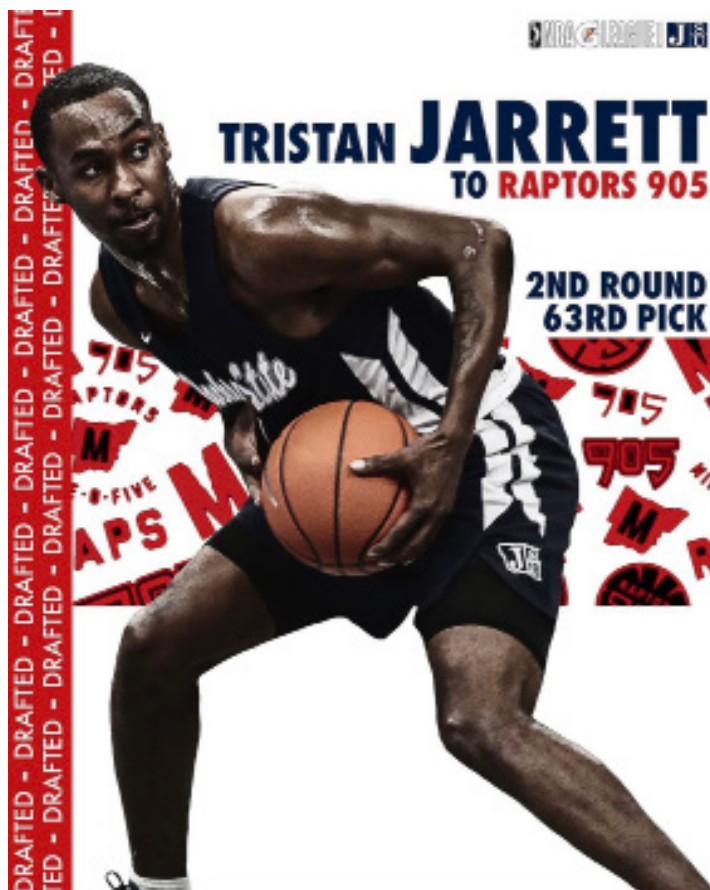
He also ranked 10th in the league in rebounds per game (5.7), 3rd in free throw percentage (.835), 5th in field goal percentage (.413), 1st in three-point field goals made per game (2.4), 9th in steals per game (1.5) and 7th in minutes played per game (31.7).

He was a finalist for the Howell Trophy, given annually to the best men's college basketball player in the state of Mississippi by the Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame.

Jarrett declared for the NBA draft in April, and was selected in the second round of the G-League draft with the 63rd pick by the Raptors 905.

Raptors 905 is the NBA G League affiliate of the Toronto Raptors, and was named Franchise of the Year for the 2019-20 season. The award is given to the G League team which best exemplifies three core pillars: Compete with Intensity, Lead with Integrity and Inspire Play.

Jarret is currently on the 905 training camp roster, and will be playing with Alex Antetokounmpo, the little brother of Giannis Antetokounmpo.

## **JONAS JAMES III - Jackson, MS. native 20-21 (JR.)**

- Started 17 games and appeared in all 18 games of his junior season which was shortened by the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Shot 65-for-163 from the field (39.9 percent).
- made 11 three-pointers on 31 attempts (35.5 percent).
- Was best at the free throw line, making 60.3 percent of the 63 total free throws attempted.
- Averaged 9.9 points-per-game and scored 179 points overall, finishing as the third-highest scorer on the Tiger offense that was crowned SWAC Co-Champs.
- Finished with double-figures in points-scored in ten games.
- Recorded a season-high 19-points at Alcorn on February 6.

## **KEN EVANS, JR. - Jackson, MS. native 20-21 (R. FR.)**

- Started four games and appeared in 18 as a redshirt freshman in first season on the floor with JSU MBB.
- Shot 30.7 percent from the field (27-88), 33.3 percent from beyond the arc (5-15), and 68.6 percent from the charity stripe (24-35)

Scored the second most bench points (67) on the team... Shot 67-of-187 (.358) overall, 22-of-83 (.265) from 3-point range and 18-of-25 (.720) at the free throw line... Scored in double-figures nine times and made three or more 3-pointers twice... Led Tulane in assists on five occasions... Scored a season-high 18 points and made eight field goals with five rebounds coming off the bench against Memphis (12/16)...
