SETTING THE SCENE

The William Jewell men's basketball team opens Great Lakes Valley Conference play this weekend as they play host to Maryville on Saturday followed by a match up with McKendree on Monday.

THE SERIES

This will be just the second meeting all-time with both opponents. The Cardinals fell 94-80 to Arkansas Tech in 2018 but have not met with Southwestern Oklahoma State since 1986 when the Cardinals won 71-65.

CARDINAL NOTES

The Cardinals are coming off a 1-1 week at the Drury Thanksgiving Classic. Jewell got back in the win column on Tuesday after defeating Arkansas Tech to snap a three-game skid but fell to Southwestern Oklahoma State on a buzzer beating tip in layup.

Mason Alexander started his 83rd and 84th career game earlier this week, surpassing Eysan Wiley (2017-21) and John Kiely (1985-88) for 20th all-time.

Jewell has been superb at taking care of the basketball through the first two weeks of the years, averaging just 8.8 turnovers per game, entering the week, third best in the nation. The Cardinals have allowed under 10 turnovers in two of their first six games.

Heri Tshiyoyo has posted two double-doubles through four games, ninth most in Division II, and one of just three players in the GLVC with multiple this season. The fifth-year center is averaging 9.5 rebounds per game, which ranked in the top-three in the GLVC and 32nd nationally.

The Cardinals boast two of the best three point shooters in program history on the same roster for the second straight season. Alexander continues to add to his lofty total, now sitting 226 three point field goals, top-five all-time and seven shy of passing Patrick Whelan (2014-18). Jordan Jermain has 117 and is already 18th all-time with nearly three full seasons of eligibility remaining.

MABEE CENTER

Home of the Cardinals since 1980

The Mabee Center, which can seat approximately 2,400 fans, is home to the William Jewell basketball, volleyball and wrestling teams as well as Kregse Pool, home of the Jewell swimming team. The building also houses four recreation basketball courts, squash and racquetball courts, an indoor track, the athletic performance center and multipurpose classroom as well as the athletic offices and locker rooms, the Athletic Training Room, and the William Jewell College Athletic Hall of Fame. This large facility provides space for not only student-athletes but also faculty, staff and students looking to stay in shape by participating in a wide variety of fitness and recreational programs.

The Mabee Center opened in 1980 and was

spearheaded by Jewell's former President Dr. Thomas Field. Along with Dr. Field's efforts, Norris Patterson, Mike Michael, Fred Presley, John Hackworth, Rodger LaBeth, Bruce Thomson, Mike Reuck and Wayne Valentine all contributed to the efforts of bringing the Mabee Center to life on Jewell's campus. A \$750,000 matching grant was given to Jewell from the Mabee Foundation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, which at the time was the largest ever given by the Mabee Foundation.

The competition area was renamed to Larry Holley Court to honor the legendary men's basketball coach who served the College for 40 years. After returning to his alma mater in the fall of 1979 he has guided 11 Jewell squads to HAAC regular season conference championships, and 14 to the NAIA National Tournament appearances. Four of those teams reached the Final Four (1993, 1995, 1996, 1997) with three finishing in the Elite Eight (1988, 1992, 2004). In total, Holley coached 24 NAIA All-Americans including six first team selections and one NAIA-II National Player of the Year (Brook Russell, 1996). Twenty-six of his players were named NAIA Scholar-Athletes and more than 98% of fourth year players earned their degree.

A 1967 Jewell graduate, Holley scored 1,122 points in his career and was an All-Conference and All-District selection as a senior. Off the court he was president of his fraternity (Lambda Chi Alpha); president of the J Club (letter winner's organization); Vice-President of the senior class, a member of Aeons (senior men's honorary fraternity), selected to Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities, and he was the recipient of the Colonel Alexander Doniphan Award (now named for Bill Summers) that goes to the senior man deemed most likely to succeed. He was also a member of the Concert and Pep Bands and Chapel Choir all four years. Coach Holley passed away on May 12, 2022 at the age of 77.

Chris McCABE

Head Coach • Fourth Season

Chris McCabe, now in his fourth season at the helm of the William Jewell men's basketball program, became the 14th head coach in program history on April 30, 2019.

Last season, the Cardinals posted their most wins since 2018 with a 15-15 record, including a win over No. 11 Washburn. In March, Jewell made a late run, winning the first postseason game in the NCAA era with a home victory over Lindenwood in the opening round of the GLVC Tournament. The Cardinals followed with an upset of No. 1 Southwest Baptist in the second round before f alling to UMSL by just four in the semifinal.

During his tenure, McCabe has mentored two All-Conference honorees, including Jordan Jermain and Eysan Wiley who led the GLVC in rebounds, along with 2021 All-Freshman Team member, Grant Stubbs. Additionally, under his tutledge the Cardinals have lowered their opponent's scoring average by more than 12 points and defeated three teams receiving votes in the national polls.

In his first season he led the Cardinals to double-digit wins for the third straight year and won the first game of his collegiate coaching career in a 98-77 victory over Purdue Northwest. In February of that season, he led Jewell to perhaps their biggest win of the NCAA era with a 70-69 overtime victory over No. 12 ranked Bellarmine, the Cardinals first win over the Knights in program history. In total, his teams has played three Division I bound teams in the last three years, including Bellarmine, Southern Indiana and Lindenwood, winning all three of their final matchups.

McCabe came to Jewell from Liberty North High School where he started the program and spent nine seasons as head coach. During that span, he led the Eagles to a 158-94 mark which included eight district final appearances in nine years, including five straight during stretch of three Class 4 quarterfinal appearances from

2012-2016. After going 8-19 in his first season, McCabe led Liberty North to a Missouri Class 4 Final Four just three years later. He sent 12 athletes on to play collegiate

basketball with numerous others pursuing other sports. His players, which included current Cardinals Robbie Hanson and Macaleb Hughes, were recognized with 19 All-Conference selections and four All-State honors during his tenure. Prior to Liberty North, McCabe spent time at Liberty High School under coach Roger Stirtz, helping the Blue Jays to three conference championships and better than a .750 winning percentage before the district split into two high schools.

He started his career at Johnson County Community College as a student assistant before serving under coach Jim Wooldridge at Kansas State assisting closely with scouting, film, preseason workouts and camps.

On campus McCabe has also served in multiple leadership roles, including on the Strategic Planning Committee and as a past president of Staff Council.

He earned his undergraduate degree in social science at Kansas State and a master's in educational administration from Northwest Missouri State. He is married to wife Melynda and the proud father of seven-year-old Ellyanna.



As settlers migrated West in the 1830s, a group of Baptists who lived along the Missouri River envisioned a college at the edge of the American wilderness in Liberty. Many towns in Missouri wanted the college, but Clay County Baptists, joined by Mexican War veteran Colonel Alexander Doniphan and Dr. William Jewell, a physician, legislator and Baptist layman who donated land for a college, persevered with grassroots fundraising.

The General Association (forerunner of the Missouri Baptist Convention) approved a proposal, and the Missouri Legislature granted a charter to found a college in 1849. Named for its key founder, William Jewell College's relationship with the Baptist Convention continued through 2003.

Challenging times in Missouri's frontier days forced a number of colleges to close, but strong leadership enabled Jewell to forge ahead, honoring the founders who believed in the power of education to change the world. As students entered the Civil War, classes were suspended and Federal troops occupied campus, using Jewell Hall as a lookout point, an infirmary and a stable.

When Jewell reopened, enrollment began to steadily climb. World War I and the burning of a nearby women's college brought female students to Jewell, where they were admitted on the same terms as men beginning in 1920. The GI Bill created another influx of students post-World War II. In the decades that followed, Jewell strengthened its academic profile, adding numerous new programs. In 1982, the College invested in study abroad programs and developed partnerships with Oxford and Cambridge Universities in England to create the Oxbridge Honors Program. Jewell emerged as a national liberal arts college, garnering attention for rigorous curriculum and outstanding student outcomes.

Today, Jewell sits at the edge of both urban and rural landscapes. In one direction lie rolling hills and Midwestern countryside, reminiscent of the College's rustic beginnings. From another vantage, the Kansas City skyline graces the horizon. Our prime location in a thriving metropolis means rich cultural offerings for student, while Jewell's partnerships with Kansas City corporations, entrepreneurs and alumni yield internships, mentors, research programs, dynamic lecturers and career possibilities.

Jewell has been called "the campus of achievement" in recognition of students' prestigious scholarships and fellowships, placement in the country's finest graduate schools and contributions to their professions and communities beyond The Hill. Recognition is an outcome of Jewell's investment in students, inspiring them to become lifelong learners, teaching them to think critically, challenging them to ask tough questions, encouraging them to pursue spiritual development, engaging them in the world and preparing them for lives of leading and serving.


