2 Setter Tilbe Yaglioglu recorded her second consecutive double-double with 25 assists and 10 digs against Charleston. The sophomore has tallied three double-doubles this season.

3 JMU has been lethal at the net, out-blocking opponents, 130.5 to 97.5 and posting double-digit blocks in four straight matches. Taylor Gail ranks second in the CAA with a 1.18 blocks/set average.

FIRST SERVE

- James Madison continues CAA play this weekend, taking on Towson and Delaware on the road.
- JMU opens its road trip against Towson on Friday, Oct. 14 inside the SECU Arena before making the trek to Newark, Del. to battle the Blue Hens on Sunday, Oct. 16. Both matches will feature live streaming available on the host institutions' athletics website.
- The Dukes (11-8, 3-3) enter the weekend with an all-time record of 787-583 (.574) in their 48th full season of volleyball. JMU holds a 185-142 record in CAA play.
- Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher stands at 118-82 in her seventh season in Harrisonburg and is the fifth-winningest coach in JMU volleyball history.
- JMU's 2016 schedule features three 2015 NCAA Tournament participants.
- The Dukes roster features four seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and five freshman.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Dukes closed out a two-match homestand, facing UNCW and the College of Charleston in CAA action.
- JMU suffered knocked off UNCW, 3-1, on Oct. 7 as four Dukes recorded career highs in digs led by junior Taylor Austin's career-best 34.
- Despite setters Sarah Martin and Tilbe Yaglioglu each recording a double-double against the Cougars, JMU closed the weekend with a 3-1 loss to the College of Charleston.

UP NEXT

- JMU opens a three-match homestand next week welcoming three conference foes to Sinclair Gym - Northeastern (10/20), Elon (10/22) and Hofstra (10/23).

SCOUTING TOWSON

- Towson is 15-5 this season, coming

off a pair of losses on a road and a nonconference victory over Delaware State at home

- Towson's two-match win streak was snapped in Hempstead as Hofstra topped the Tigers, 3-1. Towson forced a five sets against Northeastern but fell 3-2 in Boston. The Tigers fell to 3-3 in CAA play with the losses.
- The Tigers bounced back on Tuesday night with a straight-set sweep over Delaware State.
- Redshirt sophomore libero Anna Holehouse leads the team and is ranked seventh in the SEC with a 4.32 digs/set average. Overall, Towson ranks fifth in the league with a 16.15 digs/per set team average.
- Senior outside hitter Jessica Lewis ranks second in the conference with a 4.05 kills/set average. Towson tops the conference with a .254 team hitting percentage and a 14.01 kills/per set team average.

A WIN OVER TOWSON WOULD...

- Give JMU its first victory over the Tigers at Towson since Oct. 9, 2011.
- Be Auburn's fourth victory in conference play.
- Be head coach Lauren Steinbrecher's 119th win at JMU.

JMU-TOWSON SERIES

- Towson leads the all-time series 26-22, dating back to 1974. Towson has won four of the last six meetings.
- This will be the 18th meeting between Towson and JMU in Towson. The Tigers are 12-6 against the Dukes in their home arena.

LAST TIME VS. TOWSON - NOV. 13, 2015

- James Madison and Towson was decided in straight sets for the fourth time in six meetings, but the Dukes ending on the wrong side of a sweep (20-25, 19-25, 23-25) inside the SECU Arena to close the 2015 regular season.

• Janey Goodman topped the Dukes with a match-high 18 kills on the night. Freshman libero Jacqui Koebel recorded a career-high 10 digs, doubling her previous career high, while senior setter Sarah Patterson dished out 37 assists.

SCOUTING DELAWARE

• Delaware stands at 6-13 overall and is searching for its first victory in conference play with a 0-6 mark.

• The Blue Hens enter the weekend on an eight-match losing streak.

• Senior setter Julia Anderson is sixth in the CAA with a 7.85 assists/set average, while graduate student Alexa Swann is one of the best blocks in the conference with a 1.13 blocks/set average.

• Senior Taylor Hollingsworth is one of the best defenders in the league as the libero averages 4.68 digs per set with 337 total digs this season.

A WIN OVER DELAWARE WOULD...

• Give JMU is fourth consecutive win over the Blue Hens and be the eighth victory in the last nine meetings.

JMU-DELAWARE SERIES

• Delaware leads the all-time series, 25-23, but the Dukes have dominated the series over recent years, winning three consecutive and holding a 6-4 record over the last 10 meetings.

• In Newark, the Blue Hens hold a 16-5 advantage over the Dukes. JMU has only two victories on the road against Delaware since 2011.

LAST TIME VS. DELAWARE - Oct. 25, 2015

• Janey Goodman tallied her 11th double-double of the season to lead JMU to a straight-set sweep (25-16, 25-21, 25-22) over the Blue Hens inside Sinclair Gym, picking up the

Dukes' 14th consecutive win of the season.

• The Dukes hit at an impressive .340 team clip and racked up 49 kills against Delaware, while holding the Bens to a .193 clip.

• Goodman's 15 kills led all hitters in the match as she swung at a .294 clip, while chipping in 11 digs and three blocks. Senior setter Sarah Patterson dished out 43 assists (14.3 per set.)

BLOCK PARTY

• The Dukes have been dominate at the net all season and have strung together double-digit blocks in four consecutive matches and 10 matches overall this season.

• James Madison is out-blocking opponents, 160.5 to 97.5, this season and are averaging 2.43 blocks per set - good for second in the league.

• Sophomore middle blocker Taylo Gail leads JMU with 72.0 total blocks with a 1.18 blocks per set average, ranking second in the Colonial Athletics Association.

FRESHMAN CONTRIBUTIONS

• Freshman Briley Brind'Amour has appeared in all 19 of the Dukes matches this season, seeing action in 55 sets. she is averaging 2.29 kills per set, ranking second on the squad with 126 total, while addind 15 blocks.

• Setter Sarah Martin leads the team with four double-doubles this season, while holding a team-best 7.20 assists per set average. Dishing out 331 total helpers this season, Martin has helped guide the Dukes to a .230 hitting percentage good for third in the league. • Defensive specialist Sarah Driscoll, middle blocker M'Kaela White and redshirt outside hitter Kelly Vahos have also come off the bench to provide depth for JMU.

ALL-TOURNAMENT ACCOLADES

• The Dukes have been a staple on the All-Tournament team in all four of James Madison's nonconference tournaments.

• Senior Janey Goodman earned All-

Tournament honors in all four of the Dukes' nonconference tournaments, including picking up Most Valuable Player accolades at the Cornell and JMU Invitational.

- James Madison earned its second tournament sweep at the Cornell Invitational as senior Kelly Robertson and junior Taylor Austin joined Goodman with All-Tournament honors.
- The Dukes opened the season sweeping the JMU Invitational with Goodman, Robertson and sophomore Taylor Gail taking home All-Tournament team accolades.

AUSTIN'S PRESENCE IN BACK ROW

- Junior libero Taylor Austin has put together double-digit dig performances in all of her 18 appearances for James Madison this season.
- Against UNCW, Austin totaled a career-best 34 digs, becoming the first Duke to tally 30 or more digs since her then career-best performance of 31

against Northern Arizona on Aug. 28, 2015.

- The Ashburn, Va. native has recorded 20 or more digs in seven matches this season, while leading the league and ranking second in the nation with a 5.56 digs per set average.
- With 1,217 career digs, Austin currently ranks fourth all-time at JMU as is one of five Dukes to ever eclipse the 1,200 digs mark.

GOODMAN RISING UP CHARTS

- Senior right side hitter Janey Goodman continues to string together an impressive senior season as she leads the league in kills (4.26) and points (4.98) per set.
- Goodman has tallied double-digit kills in 16 of the Dukes' 19 matches and has recorded 20 or more kills in four matches this season.
- With 277 total kills thus far over her senior campaign, Goodman has rocketed herself into third all-time at JMU with 1,441 career kills.

Lauren Steinbrecher, formerly Lauren Sauer, was named volleyball head coach at James Madison on Jan. 25, 2010. She has compiled an 107-74 record going into her seventh season as head coach of the Dukes.

In her sixth season at the helm of the Dukes, Steinbrecher earned her 100th career win in a 3-1 victory over Northeastern on Oct. 9. With the program's best start since 1999 and claiming the regular season title, she was named the Colonial Athletic Association Co-Coach of the Year for the second time in her career. Under her leadership, the top-seeded Dukes (12-4) hosted the CAA Volleyball Tournament for the first time since 2002. The Dukes finished the 2015 season reaching the semifinals in the CAA Tournament where they faced #5 Charleston. JMU finished the season with a 22-8 record highlighted by a 14 game win streak for the first time since 1987.

In 2014, the team advanced to its fourth semifinal round in the CAA tournament under Steinbrecher, finishing 8-8 in conference and 17-14 overall. Janey Goodman, Lizzy Briones and Martha Stewart added to Steinbrecher's All-CAA players list.

Under her tutelage, 15 Dukes have received All-CAA honors, highlighted by first team honors for Lindsay Callahan (2010), Natalie Abel (2011) and Briones (2013). Abel also added VaSID State Player of the Year in 2011, becoming only the second player in JMU history to receive that honor. Danielle Erb was named All-CAA in all three seasons she played for Steinbrecher, becoming just the second player in school history to be named All-CAA four times.

Steinbrecher had immediate success in her first year with the Dukes, compiling a 22-8 overall record and a 10-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. Her team garnered the second-seed in the CAA tournament, their first appearance since 2007. For her efforts, she was named the CAA co-Coach of the Year as well as the Virginia Sports Information Directors (VaSID) State Coach of the Year.

The 2010 JMU volleyball team recorded the seventh-best winning percentage in school history (.733) and the fifth-best since moving to Division I in 1986. The Dukes were especially strong at home where they compiled a 13-1 mark, which tied for the second-best home mark in school history.

Steinbrecher also authored one of the best turnaround in the nation, taking over a team that went 11-19 in 2009 and guiding them to an 11-win improvement in 2010. That 11-win differential was the sixth-best turnaround in the country while the .366 improvement in winning percentage was the fourth-best in the nation.

In her second season with the Dukes, she led the team to its second consecutive 20-win season, finishing 20-11 overall. It was the first time the team posted back-to-back 20-win seasons since 1999-2000. In CAA play, Madison went 8-6 and reached the CAA tournament semifinals for the second straight year. In the quarterfinals, Madison swept Georgia State 3-0 for its first win in the CAA tournament since 2007.

JMU's third year under Steinbrecher was marred by injuries, dropping it to 13-16 overall and 5-7 in the CAA. The season was highlighted by taking a set off then-16th-ranked and national quarterfinalist Minnesota. In the CAA Championship tournament, the Dukes rallied from a 2-0 deficit to upset third-ranked Northeastern, 3-2.

Steinbrecher advanced the Dukes to the CAA tournament for the fourth straight season in 2013 after going 8-6 in CAA play to finish tied for third. It was the first time JMU advanced to four straight league tournaments since the 1997 through 2000 timeframe. The Dukes finished the regular season by winning three straight against CAA foes and four of their last five, including completing season sweeps against Hofstra and William & Mary.

Identified in 2009 by the American Volleyball Coaches Association as one of the "30 best coaches in the country under the age of 30," Steinbrecher came to JMU following three years as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Kentucky.

Steinbrecher joined UK head coach Craig Skinner's staff in the spring of 2007 and made her impact immediately, helping the Wildcats to steady improvement in each season. After a 19-12 season in 2006 prior to her arrival, Kentucky went 22-10 in 2007 followed by 26-6 with a 17-3 mark in the Southeastern Conference in 2008. In 2009, the Wildcats went 29-5 overall and 17-3 in the SEC. They advanced to the round-of-16 in the NCAA Championships and finished the year ranked 12th in the AVCA coaches poll. Steinbrecher's recruiting efforts included landing the 13th-ranked class in the country in 2009.

Prior to her time at Kentucky, Steinbrecher competed professionally for one year in Almeria, Spain, after a stellar four-year collegiate career at Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets reached the NCAA Championships all four years of her career, including trips to the quarterfinals in 2003 and the round-of-16 in 2004. Georgia Tech won a pair of Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships (2003, 04) as well as the tournament championship in 2002.

Steinbrecher was an AVCA honorable mention All-American in 2003, named All-ACC in 2002 and 2003, and became one of just two players in Yellow Jacket history to earn ACC Rookie of the Year honors in 2001. She was also ACC All-Tournament in 2003 and earned five other all-tournament accolades, including MVP of the 2003 Georgia Tech Invitational.



When she graduated, Steinbrecher ranked second in solo blocks (99), fifth in career kills (1,706), fifth in kills per set (3.60), eighth in total blocks (368) and ninth in block assists (269) on the Georgia Tech career charts. She also ranked fifth (541 in 2003) and eighth (506 in 2004) in season kill totals as well as second (38 in 2004) and fifth (34 in 2002) in season solo blocks. In 2002, she etched her name in the NCAA record books with the second-best hitting percentage in a match all-time, connecting on 17 kills in 18 swings for a .944 attack rate.



Also a stellar student, Steinbrecher was named to the ACC Honor Roll during each of her four years at Georgia Tech. She was honored as an ESPN The Magazine District III University Division Academic All-District performer in both 2003 and 2004, honoring academic and athletic excellence among all Division I volleyball players from Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Virginia. She was also named Academic All-ACC in 2005 and was a Dean's List student at GT.

Following the completion of her volleyball career with the 2004 season, Steinbrecher continued competition as a student-athlete by joining the Yellow Jacket's women's basketball squad for the remainder of the 2004-05 season and the 2005-06 campaign.

Steinbrecher earned her Bachelor of Science in Business Management in December 2005. She is a native of Huntsville, Ala., and resides in Harrisonburg with husband, Casey, and son, Luke.
