### **FIRST SERVE**

- James Madison begins the second half of CAA play this week with a three-match homestand, welcoming Northeastern, Elon and Hofstra to Godwin Hall.
- JMU begins its tough week against conference-leader Northesatern on Thursday, Oct. 20 before facing Elon on Saturday, Oct. 22 and Hofstra on Sunday, Oct. 23. Thursday's contest will be streamed on MadiZONE, while Saturday's match will feature an audio-only broadcast. Streaming information may be found on JMUSports.com.
- •The Dukes (11-10, 3-5) enter the weekend with an all-time record of 787-585 (.574) in their 48th full season of volleyball. JMU holds a 185-144 record in CAA play.
- •Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher stands at 116-84 in her seventh season in Harrisonburg and is the third-winningest coach in JMU volleyball history.
- •JMU's 2016 schedule features three 2015 NCAA Tournament participants.
- •The Dukes roster features four seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and five freshman.

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- The Dukes closed out a two-match road slate, facing Towson and Delaware in league action.
- •Senior Janey Goodman racked up a matchhigh 15 kills, but James Madison stumbled to the Tigers in straight sets.
- •JMU competed in its first five-set contest of the season, but fell short to Delware, 3-2. Four Dukes racked up double-digit digs as sophomores Bryn Recker and Tilbe Yaglioglu each recorded double-doubles.

### **UP NEXT**

• After wrapping up its three-match home slate, JMU will begin its final road tilt of the season. The three-match road trip begins on Friday, Oct. 28 when the Dukes travel to William & Mary. JMU will play its final road contests the following week with contests at the College of Charleston (11/3) and UNCW (11/5).

### **SCOUTING NORTHEASTERN**

- Northeastern boasts a 17-5 this season and sits on top of the CAA standings with a 7-1 mark
- •The Huskies bring a six-match win streak

into Thursday's contest after back-to-back sweeps of Delaware and Hofstra at home.

- Freshman middle blocker Shaina White ranks second in the league with a .360 hitting percentage as the Huskies rank fifth in the CAA with a .213 team clip.
- Senior setter Jamie Bredahl tops the league with a 0.42 service aces/per set ranking with a CAA-best 34 total, while sophomore libero Gabrielle Eyl holds the second-best digs/pet set average with a 5.31 average.

### A WIN OVER TOWSON WOULD...

- Give JMU its third consecutive victory over Northeastern in Harrisonburg.
- Be the Dukes' fifth victory in the last seven meetings.
- •Be James Madison's fourth victory in conference play.
- •Be head coach Lauren Steinbrecher's 117th win at JMU.

### **JMU-TOWSON SERIES**

- James Madison leads the all-time series 15-14, dating back to 1984, as the Dukes have won four of the last six meetings.
- This will be the 11th meeting between Northeastern and JMU in Harrisonburg. JMU holds a slight 6-4 advantage inside its home gym.

# LAST TIME VS. NORTHEASTERN - OCT. 2, 2016

- Despite out-blocking the Huskies at the net, James Madison fell on the road to Northeastern, 3-1 (25-27, 25-21, 22-25, 22-25), marking the first time since 2011-2012 that the Dukes have lost back-to-back matches to the Huskies.
- In a match that featured 35 ties and 14 lead changes, James Madison led the Huskies in points, kills, aces, blocks and assists, but could not find a way to maintain its lead late in sets.
- Janey Goodman led JMU with a then seasonhigh 23 kills while attacking at a .556 clip.
   Freshman setter Sarah Martin recorded her third double-double of the season with 14 assists and 13 digs. Sophomore Bryn Recker garnered a career-high six service aces as the Dukes tallied 10 total in the match.

- Since joining the CAA for the 2014 season, the Dukes have dominated the short series history over Elon with six consecutive wins and have never lost to the Phoenix.
- In Harrisonburg, the Dukes hold a 3-0 advantage over Elon and have only lost two sets to the Phoenix inside Sinclair Gym.

### LAST TIME VS. ELON - SEPT. 23, 2016

- Janey Goodman and Bryn Recker combined to be the first Duke pair to recorded 15 or more kills in match since the 2015 season with 18 and 15, respectively, as JMU topped Elon 3-1 (25-16, 25-23, 22-25, 25-22) on the road for the Dukes' second victory in conference play.
- The Dukes hit at an impressive .308 team clip and racked up 60 kills against Elon, while holding the Phoenix to a .182 clip.
- Goodman's 18 kills led all hitters in the match as she swung at a .350 clip, while chipping in four digs and three blocks.
   Sophomore setter Tilbe Yaglioglu dished out 30 assists (7.5 per set.).

# GOODMAN NAMED FINALIST FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

 Right side hitter Janey Goodman was selected as one of 30 candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award.

- •To be eligible, a student-athlete must be classified as a NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- •The 30 candidates will be narrowed down to 10 finalists later this season with those names being placed on the official ballot. The winner will be selected through a combinatin of media, coaches and fan voting and will be announced at the 2016 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship in December.

### **BLOCK PARTY**

- The Dukes have been dominate at the net all season and have strung together double-digit blocks in 11 of JMU's 21 matches this season.
- James Madison is out-blocking opponents,
   175.5 to 109.5, this season and are averaging
   2.37 blocks per set good for second in the league.
- •Sophomore middle blocker Taylor Gail leads JMU with 82.0 total blocks with a 1.19 blocks per set average, ranking first in the Colonial Athletic Association.

### FRESHMAN CONTRIBUTIONS

- •Freshman Briley Brind'Amour has appeared in all 21 of the Dukes matches this season, seeing action in 60 sets. She is averaging 2.27 kills per set, ranking second on the squad with 136 total, while adding 16 blocks.
  •Setter Sarah Martin lis tied for the team lead with four double-doubles this season, while holding a team-best 6.72 assists per set average. Dishing out 363 total helpers this season, Martin has helped guide the Dukes to a .228 hitting percentage, good for third in the league.
- Defensive specialist Sarah Driscoll, middle blocker M'Kaela White and redshirt outside hitter Kelly Vahos have also come off the bench to provide depth for JMU.

### **ALL-TOURNAMENT ACCOLADES**

- The Dukes have been a staple on the All-Tournament team in all four of James Madison's nonconference tournaments.
- Senior Janey Goodman earned All-Tournament honors in all four of the Dukes' nonconference tournaments, inclduing picking up Most Valuable Player accolades at the Cornell and JMU Invtitational.

- James Madison earned its second tournament sweep at the Cornell Invitational as senior Kelly Robertson and junior Taylor Austin joined Goodman with All-Tournament honors.
- The Dukes opened the season sweeping the JMU Invtiational with Goodman, Robertson and sophomore Taylor Gail taking home All-Tournament team accoladess.

### **AUSTIN'S PRESENCE IN BACK ROW**

- Junior libero Taylor Austin has put together double-digit dig performances in all of her 20 appearances for James Madison this season.
- Against UNCW, Austin totaled a career-best 34 digs, becoming the first Duke to tally 30 or more digs since her then career-best perfomrance of 31 against Northern Arizon on Aug. 28, 2015.
- The Ashburn, Va. native has recorded 20 or more digs in eight matches this season

with two 30 or more dig performances, while leading the league and ranking second in the nation with a 5.59 digs per set average.

 With 1,264 career digs, Austin currently ranks third all-time at JMU as is one of five Dukes to ever eclipse the 1,200 digs mark.

### **GOODMAN RISING UP CHARTS**

- Senior right side hitter Janey Goodman continues to string together an impressive senior season as she leads the league in kills (4.40) and points (5.08) per set.
- Goodman has tallied double-digit kills in 18 of the Dukes' 21 matches and has recorded 20 or more kills in five matches this season.
- With 321 total kills thus far over her senior campaign, Goodman has rocketed herself into third all-time at JMU with 1,485 career kills.

In her sixth season at the helm of the Dukes, Steinbrecher earned her 100th career win in a 3-1 victory over Northeastem on Oct. 9. With the program's best start since 1999 and claiming the regular season title, she was named the Colonial Athletic Association Co-Coach of the Year for the second time in her career. Under her leadership, the top-seeded Dukes (12-4) hosted the CAA Volleyhall Tournament for the first time since 2002. The Dukes finished the 2015 season reaching the semifinals in the CAA Tournament where they faced #5 Charleston. JMU finished the season with a 22-8 record highlighted by a 14 game win streak for the first time since 1987.

In 2014, the team advanced to its fourth semifinal round in the CAA tournament under Steinbrecher, finishing 8-8 in conference and 17-14 overall. Janey Goodman, Lizzy Briones and Martha Stewart added to Steinbrecher's Alf-CAA players list.

Under her tutelage, 15 Dukes have received all CAA honors, highlighted by first team honors for Lindsay Callahan (2010), Natalie Åbel (2011) and Briones (2013). Abel also added VaSID State Player of the Verar in 2011, becoming only the second player in MU history to receive that honor, canniele Erh was named All-CAAI and Itter seasons she played for Steindrecher, becoming just the second player in school history to be named All-CAA four times.

Steinbrecher had immediate success in her first year with the Dukes, compiling a 22-8 overall record and a 10-4 mark in Colonial Affilictic Association play. Her team garnered the second-seed in the CAA tournament, their first appearance since 2007. For her efforts, she was named the CAA co-Coach of the Year as well as the Virginia Sports Information Directors (VaSIO) State Coach of the Year.

The 2010 JMU volleyball team recorded the seventh-best winning percentage in school history (.733) and the fifthbest since moving to Division I in 1986. The Dukes were especially strong at home where they compiled a 13-1 mark, which tied for the second-best home mark in school history.

Steinbrecher also authored one of the best turnarounds in the nation, taking over a team that went 11-19 in 2009 and guiding them to an 11-win improvement in 2010. That +11 win differential was the sixth-best turnaround in the country while the .366 improvement in winning percentage was the fourth-best in the nation. In her second season with the Dukes, she led the team to its second consecutive 20-win season, finishing 20-11 overall. It was the first time the team posted back-to-back-20-win seasons since 1999-2000. In CAA play, Madison went 8-6 and reached the CAA tournament semifinals for the second straight year. In the quarterfinals, Madison swer

Georgia State 3-0 for its first win in the CAA tournament since 2007.

JMUs third year under Steinbrecher was marred by injuries, dropping it to 13-16 overall and 5-7 in the CAA. The
season was highlighted by taking a set off then-16th-ranked and national quarterfinalist Minnesotta. In the CAA
Championship tournament, the Dukes rallied from a 2-0 deficit to upset third-ranked Northeastern, 3-2.

Steinbrecher advanced the Dukes to the CAA bournament for the fourth straight season in 2013 after going 8-6 in CAA play to finish tied for third. It was the first time JMU advanced to four straight leavage tournaments since the 1997 through 2000 timeframe. The Dukes finished the regular season by winning three straight against CAA foes and four of their last five, including completing season sweeps against Hotstra and William & Mary.

destrified in 2009 by the American Volleyball Coaches Association as one of the "30 best coaches in the country under the age of 30." Steinbrecher came to JMU following three years as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Kentucky.

Steinbrecher joined UK head coach Craig Skinner's staff in the spring of 2007 and made her impact immediately, helping the Wildcats to steady improvement in each season. After a 19-12 season in 2006 prior to her arrival, Kentucky went 22-10 in 2007 followed by 26-6 with a 17-3 mark in the Southeastern Conference in 2008. In 2009, the Wildcats went 29-5 overall and 17-3 in the SEC. They advanced to the round-of-16 in the NCAA Championships and finished the year ranked 12th in the AVCA coaches poll. Steinbrecher's recruiting efforts included landing the 13th-ranked class in the country in 2009.

Prior to her time at Kentucky, Steinbrecher competed professionally for one year in Almeria, Spain, after a stellar four-year collegiate career at Georgia feeh. The Yellow Jackets reached the NCAA Championships all four years of her career, including trips to the quarterfinals in 2003 and the round-of-16 in 2004. Georgia feet won a pair of Alantic Coast Conference regular-season championships (2003, 04) as well as the tournament championship in 2002.

Steinbrecher was an AVCA honorable mention All-American in 2003, named All-ACC in 2002 and 2003, and becam one of just two players in Yellow backet history to earn ACC Bookie of the Year honors in 2001. She was also ACC All-Tournament in 2003 and earned five other all-tournament accolades, including MVP of the 2003 Georgia Tech invitational.

When she graduated, Steinbrecher ranked second in solo blocks (99), fifth in career kills (1,70G), fifth in kills per set (3,60), eighth in total blocks (368) and ninth in block assists (269) on the Georgia Tech career charts. She also ranked fifth (541 in 2003) and eighth (506 in 2004) in season kill totals as well as second (38 in 2004) and fifth (34 in 2006) in assist on the chart and in the NOAH errord books with the second-best hitting percentage in a match all-time, connecting on 17 kills in 18 swings for a .944 attack rate.

Also a stellar student, Steinbrecher was named to the ACC Honor Roll during each of her four years at Georgia Tech. She was honored as an ESPN The Magazine District III University Division Academic All-District performer in both 2003 and 2004, honoring academic and athletic excellence among all Division I volleyfall players from Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Virginia. She was also named Academic All-ACC in 2005 and was a Dean's List student at GT.

Following the completion of her volleyball career with the 2004 season, Steinbrecher continued competition as a student-athlete by joining the Yellow Jacket's women's basketball squad for the remainder of the 2004-05 season and the 2005-06 campaign.

Steinbrecher earned her Bachelor of Science in Business Management in December 2005. She is a native of Huntsville, Ala., and resides in Harrisonburg with husband, Casey, and son, Luke.
