2 JMU has been lethal at the net, out-blocking opponents, 191.5 to 114.5 and posting double-digit blocks in 12 matches. Taylor Gail ranks second the CAA with a 1.22 blocks/set average.

3 Senior Janey Goodman's impressive senior campaign continues as the right side sitter leads the conference and ranks 13th nationally in points per set (5.08).

FIRST SERVE

- James Madison begins the second half of CAA play this week with a three-match homestand, welcoming Northeastern, Elon and Hofstra to Godwin Hall.
- After upsetting conference leader Northeastern in four sets on Thursday evening, JMU continues its weekend slate facing Elon on Saturday, Oct. 22 and Hofstra on Sunday, Oct. 23.
- The Dukes (12-10, 4-5) enter the weekend with an all-time record of 788-585 (.574) in their 48th full season of volleyball. JMU holds a 186-144 record in CAA play.
- Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher stands at 117-84 in her seventh season in Harrisonburg and is the third-winningest coach in JMU volleyball history.
- JMU's 2016 schedule features three 2015 NCAA Tournament participants.
- The Dukes roster features four seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and five freshman.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Dukes complete the upset over conference-leading Northeastern on Thursday evening, topping the Huskies and four sets to snap their six-match win streak.
- The Dukes out-blocked Northeastern, 16.0 to 5.0, as senior middle blocker Kelly Robertson tallied nine blocks. Senior right side hitter Janey Goodman paced the way offensively with a match-high 25 kills.

UP NEXT

- After wrapping up its three-match home slate, JMU will begin its final road tilt of the season. The three-match road trip begins on Friday, Oct. 28 when the Dukes travel to William & Mary. JMU will play its final road contests the following week with contests at the College of Charleston (11/3) and UNCW (11/5).

SCOUTING ELON

- Elon stands at 15-9 overall and sits just below JMU in sixth place in the CAA standings with a 2-6 record in league action.
- The Phoenix enter the weekend on a five-match losing streak after losing at home to UNCW (3-2) and College of Charleston (3-1) over the weekend.
- Sophomore outside hitter Kam Terry ranks fourth in the CAA with a 3.22 kills/set

average while ranking fifth in points with a 3.61 per set mark.

- Junior setter Sydel Curry is one of the best in the league, ranking second with a 10.16 assists per set average with a league-high 803 total this season.

A WIN OVER ELON WOULD...

- Be JMU's fifth CAA victory of the season
- Be coach Lauren Steinbrecher's 118th victory
- Be JMU's seventh consecutive victory over the Phoenix.
- Sweep the 2016 series meetings in favor of JMU

JMU-ELON SERIES

- Since joining the CAA for the 2014 season, the Dukes have dominated the short series history over Elon with six consecutive wins and have never lost to the Phoenix.
- In Harrisonburg, the Dukes hold a 3-0 advantage over Elon and have only lost two sets to the Phoenix inside Sinclair Gym.

LAST TIME VS. ELON - SEPT. 23, 2016

- Janey Goodman and Bryn Recker combined to be the first Duke pair to recorded 15 or more kills in match since the 2015 season with 18 and 15, respectively, as JMU topped Elon 3-1 (25-16, 25-23, 22-25, 25-22) on the road for the Dukes' second victory in conference play.
- The Dukes hit at an impressive .308 team clip and racked up 60 kills against Elon, while holding the Phoenix to a .182 clip.
- Goodman's 18 kills led all hitters in the match as she swung at a .350 clip, while chipping in four digs and three blocks. Sophomore setter Tilbe Yaglioglu dished out 30 assists (7.5 per set.).

SCOUTING HOFSTRA

- Hofstra stands fourth in the conference with a 5-3 league record and a 15-6 mark overall.
- The Pride's five-match win streak was snapped on Oct. 15 as Hofstra fell to Northeastern in straight sets. The Pride is set to face William & Mary on Friday evening before facing the Dukes.
- Sophomore middle blocker Malia Randolph leads the conference with a .368 hitting percentage, while two members of the pride - freshman right side hitter Laura Masciullo

JMU-ELON SERIES

• Sunday marks the 35th meeting between the Dukes and the Pride as Hofstra leads the all-time series 22-12. JMU holds a slight advantage in matches played in Harrisonburg with an 8-7 mark.

• Over the last 10 meetings, JMU holds a 6-4 record and has swept the Pride in four of those six victories.

LAST TIME VS. HOFSTRA - SEPT. 30, 2016

• Hofstra delivered JMU its first loss in Colonial Athletic Association play despite a career night from sophomore middle blocker Taylor Gail as the Dukes fell in straight sets (20-25, 21-25, 22-25) in Hempstead.

• Gail powered the offense with nine kills to tie her career high while attacking at a .429 clip. The sophomore added four blocks to help JMU to its seventh match of the year with a double-digit blocking effort.

• Sophomore setter Tilbe Yaglioglu tallied her first double-double as a Duke, garnering 16 assists and 10 digs as junior libero Taylor Austin led the defense with 18 digs.

GOODMAN NAMED FINALIST FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

• Right side hitter Janey Goodman was selected as one of 30 candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award.

• To be eligible, a student-athlete must be classified as a NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

• The 30 candidates will be narrowed down to 10 finalists later this season with those names being placed on the official ballot. The

winner will be selected through a combination of media, coaches and fan voting and will be announced at the 2016 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship in December.

BLOCK PARTY

• The Dukes have been dominate at the net all season and have strung together double-digit blocks in 12 of JMU's 22 matches this season.

• James Madison is out-blocking opponents, 191.5 to 114.5, this season and are averaging 2.46 blocks per set - good for second in the league.

• Sophomore middle blocker Taylor Gail leads JMU with 89.0 total blocks with a 1.22 blocks per set average, ranking second in the Colonial Athletic Association.

FRESHMAN CONTRIBUTIONS

• Freshman Briley Brind'Amour has appeared in all 22 of the Dukes matches this season, seeing action in 61 sets. She is averaging 2.23 kills per set, ranking second on the squad with 136 total, while adding 16 blocks.

• Setter Sarah Martin leads the team with five double-doubles this season, while holding a team-best 6.59 assists per set average. Dishing out 382 total helpers this season, Martin has helped guide the Dukes to a .226 hitting percentage, good for third in the league.

• Defensive specialist Sarah Driscoll, middle blocker M'Kaela White and redshirt outside hitter Kelly Vahos have also come off the bench to provide depth for JMU.

ALL-TOURNAMENT ACCOLADES

• The Dukes have been a staple on the All-Tournament team in all four of James Madison's nonconference tournaments.

• Senior Janey Goodman earned All-Tournament honors in all four of the Dukes' nonconference tournaments, including picking up Most Valuable Player accolades at the Cornell and JMU Invitational.

• James Madison earned its second tournament sweep at the Cornell Invitational as senior Kelly Robertson and junior Taylor Austin joined Goodman with All-Tournament honors.

• The Dukes opened the season sweeping the JMU Invitational with Goodman, Robertson and sophomore Taylor Gail taking home All-

Tournament team accolades.

AUSTIN'S PRESENCE IN BACK ROW

- Junior libero Taylor Austin has put together double-digit dig performances in all of her 21 appearances for James Madison this season.
- Against UNCW, Austin totaled a career-best 34 digs, becoming the first Duke to tally 30 or more digs since her then career-best performance of 31 against Northern Arizona on Aug. 28, 2015.
- The Ashburn, Va. native has recorded 20 or more digs in nine matches this season with two 30 or more dig performances, while leading the league and ranking second in the nation with a 5.67 digs per set average.
- With 1,292 career digs, Austin currently ranks third all-time at JMU as is one of five Dukes to ever eclipse the 1,200 digs mark.

GOODMAN RISING UP CHARTS

- Senior right side hitter Janey Goodman continues to string together an impressive senior season as she leads the league in kills (4.69) and points (5.08) per set.
- Goodman has tallied double-digit kills in 19 of the Dukes' 22 matches and has recorded 20 or more kills in six matches this season.
- With 346 total kills thus far over her senior campaign, Goodman has rocketed herself into third all-time at JMU with 1,510 career kills.
- The senior also ranks second in school history in attacks with 3,971 swings over her career.

Lauren Steinbrecher, formerly Lauren Sauer, was named volleyball head coach at James Madison on Jan. 25, 2010. She has compiled an 107-74 record going into her seventh season as head coach of the Dukes.

In her sixth season at the helm of the Dukes, Steinbrecher earned her 100th career win in a 3-1 victory over Northeastern on Oct. 9. With the program's best start since 1999 and claiming the regular season title, she was named the Colonial Athletic Association Co-Coach of the Year for the second time in her career. Under her leadership, the top-seeded Dukes (12-4) hosted the CAA Volleyball Tournament for the first time since 2002. The Dukes finished the 2015 season reaching the semifinals in the CAA Tournament where they faced #5 Charleston. JMU finished the season with a 22-8 record highlighted by a 14 game win streak for the first time since 1987.

In 2014, the team advanced to its fourth semifinal round in the CAA tournament under Steinbrecher, finishing 8-8 in conference and 17-14 overall. Janey Goodman, Lizzy Briones and Martha Stewart added to Steinbrecher's All-CAA players list.

Under her tutelage, 15 Dukes have received all CAA honors, highlighted by first team honors for Lindsay Callahan (2010), Natalie Abel (2011) and Briones (2013). Abel also added VaSID State Player of the Year in 2011, becoming only the second player in JMU history to receive that honor. Danielle Erb was named All-CAA in all three seasons she played for Steinbrecher, becoming just the second player in school history to be named All-CAA four times.

Steinbrecher had immediate success in her first year with the Dukes, compiling a 22-8 overall record and a 10-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. Her team garnered the second-seed in the CAA tournament, their first appearance since 2007. For her efforts, she was named the CAA co-Coach of the Year as well as the Virginia Sports Information Directors (VaSID) State Coach of the Year.

The 2010 JMU volleyball team recorded the seventh-best winning percentage in school history (.733) and the fifth-best since moving to Division I in 1986. The Dukes were especially strong at home where they compiled a 13-1 mark, which tied for the second-best home mark in school history.

Steinbrecher also authored one of the best turnarounds in the nation, taking over a team that went 11-19 in 2009 and guiding them to an 11-win improvement in 2010. That +11 win differential was the sixth-best turnaround in the country while the .366 improvement in winning percentage was the fourth-best in the nation.

In her second season with the Dukes, she led the team to its second consecutive 20-win season, finishing 20-11 overall. It was the first time the team posted back-to-back 20-win seasons since 1999-2000. In CAA play, Madison went 8-6 and reached the CAA tournament semifinals for the second straight year. In the quarterfinals, Madison swept Georgia State 3-0 for its first win in the CAA tournament since 2007.

JMU's third year under Steinbrecher was marred by injuries, dropping it to 13-16 overall and 5-7 in the CAA. The season was highlighted by taking a set off then-16th-ranked and national quarterfinalist Minnesota. In the CAA Championship tournament, the Dukes rallied from a 2-0 deficit to upset third-ranked Northeastern, 3-2.

Steinbrecher advanced the Dukes to the CAA tournament for the fourth straight season in 2013 after going 8-6 in CAA play to finish tied for third. It was the first time JMU advanced to four straight league tournaments since the 1997 through 2000 timeframe. The Dukes finished the regular season by winning three straight against CAA foes and four of their last five, including completing season sweeps against Hofstra and William & Mary.

Identified in 2009 by the American Volleyball Coaches Association as one of the "30 best coaches in the country under the age of 30," Steinbrecher came to JMU following three years as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Kentucky.

Steinbrecher joined UK head coach Craig Skinner's staff in the spring of 2007 and made her impact immediately, helping the Wildcats to steady improvement in each season. After a 19-12 season in 2006 prior to her arrival, Kentucky went 22-10 in 2007 followed by 26-6 with a 17-3 mark in the Southeastern Conference in 2008. In 2009, the Wildcats went 29-5 overall and 17-3 in the SEC. They advanced to the round-of-16 in the NCAA Championships and finished the year ranked 12th in the AVCA coaches poll. Steinbrecher's recruiting efforts included landing the 13th-ranked class in the country in 2009.

Prior to her time at Kentucky, Steinbrecher competed professionally for one year in Almeria, Spain, after a stellar four-year collegiate career at Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets reached the NCAA Championships all four years of her career, including trips to the quarterfinals in 2003 and the round-of-16 in 2004. Georgia Tech won a pair of Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships (2003, 04) as well as the tournament championship in 2002.

Steinbrecher was an AVCA honorable mention All-American in 2003, named All-ACC in 2002 and 2003, and became one of just two players in Yellow Jacket history to earn ACC Rookie of the Year honors in 2001. She was also ACC All-Tournament in 2003 and earned five other all-tournament accolades, including MVP of the 2003 Georgia Tech Invitational.

When she graduated, Steinbrecher ranked second in solo blocks (99), fifth in career kills (1,706), fifth in kills per set (3.60), eighth in total blocks (368) and ninth in block assists (269) on the Georgia Tech career charts. She also ranked fifth (541 in 2003) and eighth (506 in 2004) in season kill totals as well as second (38 in 2004) and fifth (34 in 2002) in season solo blocks. In 2002, she etched her name in the NCAA record books with the second-best hitting percentage in a match all-time, connecting on 17 kills in 18 swings for a .944 attack rate.

Also a stellar student, Steinbrecher was named to the ACC Honor Roll during each of her four years at Georgia Tech. She was honored as an ESPN The Magazine District III University Division Academic All-District performer in both 2003 and 2004, honoring academic and athletic excellence among all Division I volleyball players from Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Virginia. She was also named Academic All-ACC in 2005 and was a Dean's List student at GT.

Following the completion of her volleyball career with the 2004 season, Steinbrecher continued competition as a student-athlete by joining the Yellow Jacket's women's basketball squad for the remainder of the 2004-05 season and the 2005-06 campaign.

Steinbrecher earned her Bachelor of Science in Business Management in December 2005. She is a native of Huntsville, Ala., and resides in Harrisonburg with husband, Casey, and son, Luke.
