THREE HITS

1 Junior libero Taylor Austin leads the CAA and ranks 2nd nationally with a 5.81 digs/set average. Her 482 total digs ranks 7th in the NCAA and is fourth-most in a single season at JMU.

2 Senior Janey Goodman leads the conference and ranks 11th nationally in kills per set - the mark currently is the highest kills per set average in JMU history, while leading the league and ranking ninth in the nation in points per set.

3 JMU has been lethal at the net, out-blocking opponents, 220.5 to 128.5 and posting double-digit blocks in 14 matches. Taylor Gail, Kelly Robertson and Janey Goodman all rank in the conference's top 10 for blocks per set.

FIRST SERVE

- After a undefeated weekend on the court that moved JMU into striking distance in the conference standings, the Dukes put their three-match win streak on the line as they begin their final road tilt of the season at William & Mary.
- After upsetting then conference leader Northeastern last and notching back-to-back victories over Elon and Hofstra over the weekend, the Dukes look to sweep the season series against the Trib on Friday, Oct. 28. JMU will continue its road trip the following week by facing Charleston on Friday, Nov. 3.
- The Dukes (14-10, 6-5) enter the weekend with an all-time record of 790-585 (.575) in their 48th full season of volleyball. JMU holds a 188-144 record in CAA play.
- Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher stands at 119-84 in her seventh season in Harrisonburg and is the third-winningest coach in JMU volleyball history.
- JMU's 2016 schedule features three 2015 NCAA Tournament participants.
- The Dukes roster features four seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and five freshman.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Dukes improved to 6-5 in conference plays with an undefeated week on the court with four-set victories over Northeastern, Elon and Hofstra to move into fifth in the CAA standings and within striking distance of the top spot.
- Senior Janey Goodman paced the offense over the week, recording 20 or more kills over all three matches, while junior Taylor Austin ranked up 25 or more digs in each match defensively.
- For their efforts, Goodman was selected as the Colonial Athletic Association Offensive Player of the Week as Austin was tabbed as CAA Defensive Player of the Week.

UP NEXT

- JMU closes out its final road tilt of the season next weekend when the Dukes travel to conference leader College of Charleston on Nov. 3 before battling UNCW on Nov. 5. JMU closes out the 2016 regular season on Nov. 11 and 12 with matches against Delaware and Towson, respectively.

SCOUTING WILLIAM & MARY

- The Tribe sits at 8-16 overall with a 2-9 mark in league action to rank ninth in the CAA

standings.

- William & Mary enter the weekend on a five-match losing streak after Elon swept the Tribe in Williamsburg on Monday.
- Junior Sydney Biniak ranks seventh in the conference with a 3.08 kills/set average while ranking 10th in the league with a 3.32 points per set mark.
- Setter Autumn Brenner is having a strong freshman campaign for the Tribe as she ranks third in the league with a 9.36 assists per set average with the fourth-most total assists in the conference with 722 total. Brenner also ranks fourth in the conference with a 0.29 service aces per set average and has tallied 22 total this season.

LAST TIME VS. WILLIAM & MARY - SEPT. 21, 2016

- Three Dukes racked up double-digit kills as the Dukes swept William & Mary (25-22, 25-15, 32-30) in Sinclair Gym to open the 2016 Colonial Athletic Association schedule with a victory.
- Sophomore setter Tilbe Yaglioglu dished up 29 assists to help JMU to a .302 hitting percentage as senior Janey Goodman (13), freshman Briley Brind'Amour (11) and sophomore Bryn Recker (10) each finished in double figures.
- Junior Taylor Austin tallied 25 digs against the Tribe to move onto JMU's all-time digs chart with the eighth-most digs in program history.

•The Cougars have recorded three consecutive conference victories after sweeping Delaware last Friday and topping the Tigers of Towson on Sunday in four sets. Charleston will battle Northeastern (10/28) and Hofstra (10/30) before hosting JMU on Nov. 3.

•Sophomore Allison Beckman is the top setter in the league with a 10.39 assists per set average with 800 total this season to help Charleston to a .180 team hitting percentage this season - good for eighth in the league.

•Defensively, two Cougars rank in the top ten individually in digs as sophomore McKala Rhodes sits in fourth in the league with a 4.80 per set average and sophomore Devon Rachel holds down the 10th spot with a 3.48 mark.

A WIN OVER CHARLESTON WOULD...

• Be JMU's second straight victory against the Cougars in Charleston

• Be the Dukes' third overall win over Charleston

JMU-CHARLESTON SERIES

• Sunday marks the 12th meeting between JMU and Charleston as the Cougars lead the all-time series 9-2. Charleston holds the advantage in its home arena with a 2-1 record over JMU.

• JMU has only two victories over the Cougars - the last was a five-set thriller in Charleston a season ago.

LAST TIME VS. CHARLESTON - OCT. 9, 2016

• For the first time this season two Dukes recorded double-doubles, but Charleston topped JMU in four sets (26-25, 23-25, 18-25, 19-25) inside Sinclair Gym.

•Setters Sarah Martin and Tilbe Yaglioglu each tallied double-doubles as Martin racked up 24 assists and 10 digs while Yaglioglu added 25 assists and 10 digs.

• Senior Janey Goodman headed the offense with 14 kills and six blocks. Junior Taylor Austin added 23 digs while the Dukes racked up 11 blocks for their fourth consecutive match with double-digit blocks.

GOODMAN NAMED FINALIST FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

• Right side hitter Janey Goodman was selected as one of 30 candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award.

•To be eligible, a student-athlete must be classified as a NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

•The 30 candidates will be narrowed down to 10 finalists later this season with those names being placed on the official ballot. The winner will be selected through a combination of media, coaches and fan voting and will be announced at the 2016 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship in December.

BLOCK PARTY

• The Dukes have been dominate at the net all season and have strung together double-digit blocks in 14 of JMU's 24 matches this season.

• James Madison is out-blocking opponents, 220.5 to 128.5, this season and are averaging 2.56 blocks per set - good for second in the league.

•Sophomore middle blocker Taylor Gail leads JMU with 89.0 total blocks with a 1.25 blocks per set average to lead the league while senior middle blocker Kelly Robertson ranks third with a 1.09 blocks per set mark.

FRESHMAN CONTRIBUTIONS

•Freshman Briley Brind'Amour has appeared in all 24 of the Dukes matches this season, seeing action in 69 sets. She is averaging 2.16 kills per set, ranking second on the squad with 149 total, while adding 23 blocks.

•Setter Sarah Martin leads the team with five double-doubles this season, while holding a team-best 6.41 assists per set average. Dishing out 423 total helpers this season, Martin has helped guide the Dukes to a .233 hitting percentage, good for third in the league.

•Defensive specialist Sarah Driscoll, middle blocker M'Kaela White and redshirt outside hitter Kelly Vahos have also come off the bench to provide depth for JMU.

ALL-TOURNAMENT ACCOLADES

• The Dukes have been a staple on the All-Tournament team in all four of James Madison's nonconference tournaments.

• Senior Janey Goodman earned All-Tournament honors in all four of the Dukes' nonconference tournaments, including picking up Most Valuable Player accolades at the Cornell and JMU Invitational.

• James Madison earned its second tournament

sweep at the Cornell Invitational as senior Kelly Robertson and junior Taylor Austin joined Goodman with All-Tournament honors.

• The Dukes opened the season sweeping the JMU Invitational with Goodman, Robertson and sophomore Taylor Gail taking home All-Tournament team accolades.

AUSTIN'S PRESENCE IN BACK ROW

• Junior libero Taylor Austin has put together double-digit dig performances in all of her 23 appearances for James Madison this season.

• Against UNCW, Austin totaled a career-best 34 digs, becoming the first Duke to tally 30 or more digs since her then career-best performance of 31 against Northern Arizona on Aug. 28, 2015.

• The Ashburn, Va. native has recorded 20 or more digs in 11 matches this season with three 30 or more dig performances, while leading the league and ranking second in the nation with a

5.81 digs per set average.

• With 1,349 career digs, Austin currently ranks third all-time at JMU as is one of three Dukes to ever eclipse the 1,200 digs mark.

GOODMAN RISING UP CHARTS

• Senior right side hitter Janey Goodman continues to string together an impressive senior season as she leads the league in kills (4.58) and points (5.22) per set.

• Goodman has tallied double-digit kills in 21 of the Dukes' 24 matches and has recorded 20 or more kills in eight matches this season.

• With 389 total kills thus far over her senior campaign, Goodman has rocketed herself into third all-time at JMU with 1,553 career kills.

• The senior also ranks second in school history in attacks with 4,064 swings over her career.

Lauren Steinbrecher, formerly Lauren Sauer, was named volleyball head coach at James Madison on Jan. 25, 2010. She has compiled an 107-74 record going into her seventh season as head coach of the Dukes.

In her sixth season at the helm of the Dukes, Steinbrecher earned her 100th career win in a 3-1 victory over Northeastern on Oct. 9. With the program's best start since 1999 and claiming the regular season title, she was named the Colonial Athletic Association Co-Coach of the Year for the second time in her career. Under her leadership, the top-seeded Dukes (12-4) hosted the CAA Volleyball Tournament for the first time since 2002. The Dukes finished the 2015 season reaching the semifinals in the CAA Tournament where they faced #5 Charleston. JMU finished the season with a 22-8 record highlighted by a 14 game win streak for the first time since 1987.

In 2014, the team advanced to its fourth semifinal round in the CAA tournament under Steinbrecher, finishing 8-8 in conference and 17-14 overall. Janey Goodman, Lizzy Briones and Martha Stewart added to Steinbrecher's All-CAA players list.

Under her tutelage, 15 Dukes have received all CAA honors, highlighted by first team honors for Lindsay Callahan (2010), Natalie Abel (2011) and Briones (2013). Abel also added VaSID State Player of the Year in 2011, becoming only the second player in JMU history to receive that honor. Danielle Erb was named All-CAA in all three seasons she played for Steinbrecher, becoming just the second player in school history to be named All-CAA four times.

Steinbrecher had immediate success in her first year with the Dukes, compiling a 22-8 overall record and a 10-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. Her team garnered the second-seed in the CAA tournament, their first appearance since 2007. For her efforts, she was named the CAA co-Coach of the Year as well as the Virginia Sports Information Directors (VaSID) State Coach of the Year.

The 2010 JMU volleyball team recorded the seventh-best winning percentage in school history (.733) and the fifth-best since moving to Division I in 1986. The Dukes were especially strong at home where they compiled a 13-1 mark, which tied for the second-best home mark in school history.

Steinbrecher also authored one of the best turnarounds in the nation, taking over a team that went 11-19 in 2009 and guiding them to an 11-win improvement in 2010. That 11-win differential was the sixth-best turnaround in the country while the .366 improvement in winning percentage was the fourth-best in the nation.

In her second season with the Dukes, she led the team to its second consecutive 20-win season, finishing 20-11 overall. It was the first time the team posted back-to-back 20-win seasons since 1999-2000. In CAA play, Madison went 8-6 and reached the CAA tournament semifinals for the second straight year. In the quarterfinals, Madison swept Georgia State 3-0 for its first win in the CAA tournament since 2007.

JMU's third year under Steinbrecher was marred by injuries, dropping it to 13-16 overall and 5-7 in the CAA. The season was highlighted by taking a set off then-16th-ranked and national quarterfinalist Minnesota, 3-2. In the championship tournament, the Dukes rallied from a 2-0 deficit to upset third-ranked Northeastern, 3-2.

Steinbrecher advanced the Dukes to the CAA tournament for the fourth straight season in 2013 after going 8-6 in CAA play to finish tied for third. It was the first time JMU advanced to four straight league tournaments since the 1997 through 2000 timeframe. The Dukes finished the regular season by winning three straight against CAA foes and four of their last five, including completing season sweeps against Hofstra and William & Mary.

Identified in 2009 by the American Volleyball Coaches Association as one of the "30 best coaches in the country under the age of 30," Steinbrecher came to JMU following three years as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Kentucky.

Steinbrecher joined UK head coach Craig Skinner's staff in the spring of 2007 and made her impact immediately, helping the Wildcats to steady improvement in each season. After a 19-12 season in 2006 prior to her arrival, Kentucky went 22-10 in 2007 followed by 26-6 with a 17-3 mark in the Southeastern Conference in 2008. In 2009, the Wildcats went 29-5 overall and 17-3 in the SEC. They advanced to the round-of-16 in the NCAA Championships and finished the year ranked 12th in the AVCA coaches poll. Steinbrecher's recruiting efforts included landing the 13th-ranked class in the country in 2009.

Prior to her time at Kentucky, Steinbrecher competed professionally for one year in Almeria, Spain, after a stellar four-year collegiate career at Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets reached the NCAA Championships all four years of her career, including trips to the quarterfinals in 2003 and the round-of-16 in 2004. Georgia Tech won a pair of Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships (2003, 04) as well as the tournament championship in 2002.

Steinbrecher was an AVCA honorable mention All-American in 2003, named All-ACC in 2002 and 2003, and became one of just two players in Yellow Jacket history to earn ACC Rookie of the Year honors in 2001. She was also ACC All-Tournament in 2003 and earned five other all-tournament accolades, including MVP of the 2003 Georgia Tech Invitational.

When she graduated, Steinbrecher ranked second in solo blocks (99), fifth in career kills (1,706), fifth in kills per set (3.60), eighth in total blocks (388) and ninth in block assists (269) on the Georgia Tech career charts. She also ranked fifth (541 in 2003) and eighth (506 in 2004) in season kill totals as well as second (38 in 2004) and fifth (34 in 2002) in season solo blocks. In 2002, she etched her name in the NCAA record books with the second-best hitting percentage in a match all-time, connecting on 17 kills in 18 swings for a .944 attack rate.



Also a stellar student, Steinbrecher was named to the ACC Honor Roll during each of her four years at Georgia Tech. She was honored as an ESPN The Magazine District III University Division Academic All-District performer in both 2003 and 2004, honoring academic and athletic excellence among all Division I volleyball players from Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Virginia. She was also named Academic All-ACC in 2005 and was a Dean's List student at GT.



Following the completion of her volleyball career with the 2004 season, Steinbrecher continued competition as a student-athlete by joining the Yellow Jacket's women's basketball squad for the remainder of the 2004-05 season and the 2005-06 campaign.

Steinbrecher earned her Bachelor of Science in Business Management in December 2005. She is a native of Huntsville, Ala., and resides in Harrisonburg with husband, Casey, and son, Luke.
