THREE HITS

For the first time since 1999, James Madison won the CAA regular-season title outright and earned back-to-back regular-season championships since the 1999 and 1998 seasons. The Dukes earn the right to host the 2017 CAA Championship in Harrisonburg.

Earning the No. 1 seed at the 2016 CAA Championship, the Dukes are searching for their first tournament title since 2000. Lauren Steinbrecher as led the Dukes to the CAA Tournament in all seven seasons at the helm.

JMU is boasting two CAA major award winners on the roster. Senior Janey Goodman was named CAA Player of the Year for the second consecutive season while junior Taylor Austin became just the second Duke to earn CAA Defensive Specalist of the Year.

FIRST SERVE

- James Madison opens the 2016 CAA Championship as the No. 1 seed as sees its first competition of the tournament on Saturday facing No. 5 Towson in the semifinals.
- Winning the regular-season title for the second consecutive season, JMU has earned back-toback regular season titles since the 1998 and 1999 seasons and has won the regular-season championship outright for the first time since 1999.
- •JMU opens the championship tournament on Saturday, Nov. 19 against the fifth-seeded Towson. Saturday's semifinal is slated for a 2 p.m. start and will be streamed live on CAA.tv.
- •The Dukes (19-10, 11-5) enter the tournament with an all-time record of 795-585 (.576) in their 48th full season of volleyball. JMU holds a 193-144 record in CAA play.
- •Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher stands at 124-84 in her seventh season in Harrisonburg and is tied as the second-winningest coach in JMU volleyball history.
- •JMU's 2016 schedule features three 2015 NCAA Tournament participants.
- •The Dukes roster features four seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and five freshman.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Dukes extended their winning streaking to eighth matches and won the 2016 CAA regular-season championship with victories over Delaware (3-1) and Towson (3-2) to earn the No. 1 seed at the 2016 CAA Championships, marking JMU's seventh consecutive season to earn a berth to the conference tournament.
- Trailing the Tigers 2-1, JMU completed the come-from-behind, five-set victory on Senior Night to earn the Dukes' first Senior Night victory since topping Hofstra in four sets on Nov. 13, 2010.
- •Freshman setter Sarah Martin had strong performances in both matches, recording back-to-back double-doubles and closing the weekend with 46 assists, and 24 digs. The Fort Lauderdale, Fla. native guiding JMU to a .280 team hitting percentage and earned her second CAA weekly honor as she was named Rookie of the Week.
- •The wins brought Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher's tally to 124 victories as a Duke, tying her with Pat Sargent (124-88-7) as the second winningest coach in JMU program history.

•The Dukes hope to make their first appearance in the championship match since the 2002 season. JMU last one the title in 2000.

SCOUTING TOWSON

- •Closing the regular-season with a 23-8 mark overall and a 10-6 ledger in league play, Towson earned the No. 5 seed at the 2016 CAA Tournament and swept No. 4 Hofstra in the quarterfinals to advance to Saturday's semifinal round.
- •Senior outside hitter Jessica Lewis hit .345 and added a team-high 13 kills while freshman setter Marrisa Wonders recorded her 20th double-double of the season to help Towson to the upset victory over the Pride.
- •Five Tigers earned All-Colonial Athletic Association accolades led by senior outside hitter Jessica Lewis ad sophomore right side hitter Jocelyn Kuilan, who each earned First Team honors.
- Lewis entered the CAA tournament ranking second in the league in kills per set (3.81) and points per set (4.34) while also ranking amongst the top 30 in the nation in those categories.
 Kuilan ranks as one of the best attackers in the conference, stting seventh with a .294 hitting percentage, sixth with a 3.06 kills per set average, third with a 0.34 aces per set mark and fifth with

a 3.57 points per set average.

- Be JMU's first tournament win since defeating the Tigers in the 2014 quarterfinals.
- •Advance JMU to the finals for the first time the 2002 season.
- Be Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher's 125 win, making her the second-most winningest coach in JMU history.

JMU-TOWSON SERIES

- Saturday is the 49th meeting between JMU and Towson as the Tigers lead the all-time series 27-23.
- •The programs met twice in the regular season, splitting the series. The Tigers swept the Dukes at Towson while JMU earned a five-set victory in the regular-season finale.
- •Towson has won six of the last 10 meetings, sweeping the Dukes five times over the span.
- •JMU holds a 4-2 advantage in games played at neutral sites, having topped Towson in the last

LAST TIME VS. TOWSON - OCT. 9. 2016

- Trailing 2-1, the Dukes fought from behind to force a decisive fifth set and earned its eighth consecutive victory topping Towson (22-25, 25-23, 23-25, 25-19, 25-9) on Senior Night inside Sinclair Gym to close the regular season.
- •Janey Goodman led a trip of Dukes with doubledigit kills as the senior tallied 17. Sophomore Bryn Recker added 16 with 10 digs for her fifth double-double while freshman Kelly Vahos added 11 with a career-best five blocks.
- Setters Sarah Martin and Tilbe Yaglioglu each tallied double-doubles for the second consecutive match as Martin tallied 22 assists with 12 digs and Yaglioglu added 30 helpers with 15 digs.
- JMU garnered 15 total blocks led by sophomore Taylor Gail's season-best eight. Taylor Austin rounded out the defense with 23 digs.

GOODMAN NAMED FINALIST FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

- Right side hitter Janey Goodman was selected as one of 30 candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award.
- •To be eligible, a student-athlete must be classified as a NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
 •The 30 candidates will be narrowed down to 10 finalists later this season with those names being placed on the official ballot. The winner will be selected through a combinatin of media, coaches and fan voting and will be announced at the 2016 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship in December.

BLOCK PARTY

- The Dukes have been dominate at the net all season and have strung together double-digit blocks in 17 of JMU's 29 matches this season.
- James Madison is out-blocking opponents, 273.5 to 167.5, this season and are averaging 2.51 blocks per set - good for second in the league.
- •Sophomore middle blocker Taylor Gail leads JMU with 130.0 total blocks with a 1.26 blocks per set average to rank second in the conference while senior middle blocker Kelly Robertson ranks fifth with a 1.05 blocks per set mark.

FRESHMAN CONTRIBUTIONS

•Freshman Brilev Brind'Amour has appeared in

- all 29 of the Dukes matches this season, seeing action in 89 sets. She is averaging 2.00 kills per set, ranking third on the squad with 178 total kills, while adding 34 blocks.
- •Setter Sarah Martin has garnered seven double-doubles this season, while ranking second on the squad with a 5.92 assists per set average. Dishing out 527 total helpers this season, Martin has helped guide the Dukes to a .235 hitting percentage, good for second in the league.
 •Defensive specialist Sarah Driscoll, middle blocker M'Kaela White and redshirt outside hitter Kelly Vahos have also come off the bench to provide depth for JMU.

ALL-TOURNAMENT ACCOLADES

- The Dukes have been a staple on the All-Tournament team in all four of James Madison's nonconference tournaments.
- Senior Janey Goodman earned All-Tournament honors in all four of the Dukes' nonconference tournaments, inclduing picking up Most Valuable Player accolades at the Cornell and JMU Invtitational.
- James Madison earned its second tournament sweep at the Cornell Invitational as senior Kelly Robertson and junior Taylor Austin joined Goodman with All-Tournament honors.
- The Dukes opened the season sweeping the JMU Invitational with Goodman, Robertson and sophomore Taylor Gail taking home All-Tournament team accoladess.

AUSTIN'S PRESENCE IN BACK ROW

- Junior libero Taylor Austin has put together double-digit dig performances in all of her 28 appearances for James Madison this season.
- Against UNCW, Austin totaled a career-best 39 digs as the Ashburn, Va. native has recorded 20 or more digs in 16 matches this season with six 30 or more dig performances, leading the league and ranking second in the nation with a 6.00 digs per set average.
- With 1,503 career digs, Austin currently ranks third all-time at JMU and is one of three Dukes to ever eclipse the 1,200 digs mark.

GOODMAN RISING UP CHARTS

- Senior right side hitter Janey Goodman continues to string together an impressive senior season as she leads the league in kills (4.66) and points (5.25) per set.
- Goodman has tallied double-digit kills in 26 of the Dukes' 29 matches and has recorded 20 or

more kills in 10 matches this season, including two 30-plus kill performances and setting a new career-high of 33 at Charleston

- With 503 total kills thus far over her senior campaign, Goodman is just the second Duke in program history to ever record 500 kills in a single season and she is just two kills away from setting a new JMU single-season record shattering a two-decade mark held by Lindsay Collingwood (506 kills in 1996).
- Goodman has also set new single-season marks for kills per set and total attempts (1,228).
- •The Powhatan, Va. native has rocketed herself into second all-time at JMU with 1.667 career kills and also ranks second in school history in attacks with 4,342 swings over her career.

JMU TAKES HOME MAJOR END-OF-SEASON **AWARDS**

• On the eve of the 2016 CAA Championship, the league office announced the end-of-year awards

as voted on by the conference's coaches. A Duke duo earned two of the biggest indvidiual awards of the year.

- •For the second consecutive season, senior Janev Goodman was selected as the CAA Player of the Year, becoming the first back-to-back honoree since George Mason's Aline Pereira accomplished the feat in 2001 and 2002.
- •Taylor Austn became just the second Duke in program history to ever be recognized as the CAA Defensive Specialist of the Year. The last Duke to earn the honor was Jena Pierson in 2006.
- Both Austin and Goodman earned First Team All-CAA accolades, the first for Austin over her career at JMU and the third for Goodman.

Lauren Steinbrecher, formerly Lauren Sauer, was named volleyball bead coach at James Madison on Jan. 25, 2010. Sh has compiled an 107-74 record going into her seventh season as head coach of the Dukes.

In her sixth season at the helm of the Dukes, Steinbrecher earned her 100th career win in a 3-1 victory over Northeastern on Oct. 9. With the program's best start since 1999 and claiming the regular season title, she was named the Colonial Athletic Association Co-Coach of the Year for the second time in her career. Under her leadership, the top-seeded Dukes (12-4) hosted the CAA Volleyball Tournament for the first time since 2002. The Dukes finished the 2015 season reaching the semifinals in the CAA Tournament where they faced #5 Charleston. JMU finished the season with a 22-8 record highlighted by a 14 game win streak for the first time since 1987.

In 2014, the team advanced to its fourth semifinal round in the CAA tournament under Steinbrecher, finishing 8-8 in conference and 17-14 overall. Janey Goodman, Lizzy Briones and Martha Stewart added to Steinbrecher's All-CAA

Under her tutelage, 15 Dukes have received all CAA honors, highlighted by first team honors for Lindsay Callahan (2010), Natalie Åbel (2011) and Briones (2013), Abel also added VaSID State Player of the Year in 2011, becoming only the second player in JMU history to receive that honor. Danielle Erb was named All-CAA in all three seasons she yed for Steinbrecher, becoming just the second player in school history to be named All-CAA four times.

Steinbrecher had immediate success in her first year with the Dukes, compiling a 22-8 overall record and a 10-4 mart in Colonial Attletic Association play. Her team garnered the second-seed in the CAA tournament, their first appearance since 2007. For her efforts, she was named the CAA co-Coach of the Year as well as the Virginia Sports Information Directors (YASD) State Coach of the Year.

The 2010 IMU volleyball team recorded the seventh-best winning percentage in school history (,733) and the fith-best since moving to Division I in 1986. The Dukes were especially strong at home where they compiled a 13-1 mark, which tied for the second-best home mark in school history.

Steinbrecher also authored one of the best turnarounds in the nation, taking over a team that went 11-19 in 2009 and guiding them to an 11-win improvement in 2010. That +11 win differential was the sixth-best turnaround in the country while the .366 improvement in winning percentage was the fourth-best in the nation.

In her second season with the Dukes, she led the team to its second consecutive 20-win season, finishing 20-11 overall. It was the first time the team posted back-to-back 20-win seasons since 1999-2000. In CAA play, Madison vent 8-6 and reached the CAA tournament semifinals for the second straight year. In the quarterfinals, Madison swep Georgia State 3-0 for its first win in the CAA tournament since 2007.

MMUs third year under Steinbrecher was marred by injuries, dropping it to 13-16 overall and 5-7 in the CAA. The season was highlighted by taking a set off then-16th-ranked and national quarterfinalist Minnesota. In the CAA Championship tournament, the Dukes rallied from a 2-0 deficit to upset third-ranked Northeastern, 3-2.

Steinbrecher advanced the Dukes to the CAA tournament for the fourth straight season in 2013 after going 8-6 in Ack Alp At n finish def n third. It was the first time JMI advanced to four straight leave mull 2013 drie guing o'V ill at Alp Alp At n finish def n third. It was the first time JMI advanced to four straight leavege turnaments since the 1931 through 2000 timeframe. The Dukes finished the regular season by winning three straight against CAA foes and four of their last five, including completing season sweeps against Hofstra and William & Mary.

dentified in 2009 by the American Volleyball Coaches Association as one of the "30 best coaches in the country under the age of 30," Steinbrecher came to JMU following three years as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Kentucky.

Steinbrecher joined UK head coach Craig Skinner's staff in the spring of 2007 and made her impact immediately, helping the Wildcats to steady improvement in each season. After a 19-12 season in 2006 prior to her arrival, Kentucky went 22-10 in 2007 followed by 26-6 with a 17-3 mark in the Southeastern Conference in 2008. In 2009, the Wildcats went 29-5 overall and 17-3 in the SEC. They advanced to the round-of-16 in the NCAA Championships and finished the year ranked 12th in the AVCA coaches poll. Steinbrecher's recruiting efforts included landing the 13th-ranked class in the country in 2009.

Prior to her time at Kentucky, Steinbrecher competed professionally for one year in Almeria, Spain, after a stellar four-year collegiate career at Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets reached the NCAA Championships all four years of her career, including trips to the quarterfinals in 2003 and the round-of-16 in 2004. Georgia Tech won a pair of Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships (2003, 04) as well as the tournament championship in 2002.

Steinbrecher was an AVCA honorable mention All-American in 2003, named All-ACC in 2002 and 2003, and becam une of just two players in Yellow lacket history to earn ACC Rookie of the Year honors in 2001. She was also ACC All-Tournament in 2003 and earned five other all-tournament accolades, including MVP of the 2003 Georgia Tech

When she graduated, Steinbrecher ranked second in solo blocks (99), fifth in career kills (1,706), fifth in kills per set (3.60), eighth in total blocks (388) and ninth in block assists (269) on the Georgia Tech career charts. She also ranked iffith (541 in 2003) and eighth (506 in 2004) in season kill totals as well as second (38 in 2004) and fifth (34 in 2002) in season solo blocks. In 2002, she etched her ranne in the NCDA record books with the second-best hitting. rcentáge in a match all-time, connecting on 17 kills in 18 swings for a .944 attack rate.

Also a stellar student, Steinbrecher was named to the ACC Honor Roll during each of her four years at Georgia Tech. She was honored as an ESPN The Magazine District III University Division Academic All-District performer in both 2003 and 2004, honoring academic and athletic excellence among all Division I volleyfall players from Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Virginia. She was also named Academic All-ACC in 2005 and was a Dean's List student at GT.

Following the completion of her volleyball career with the 2004 season, Steinbrecher continued competition as a student-athlete by joining the Yellow Jacket's women's basketball squad for the remainder of the 2004-05 season and the 2005-06 campaign.

Steinbrecher earned her Bachelor of Science in Business Management in December 2005. She is a native of Huntsville, Ala., and resides in Harrisonburg with husband, Casey, and son, Luke.
