**1** For the first time since 1999, James Madison won the CAA regular-season title outright and earned back-to-back regular-season championships since the 1999 and 1998 seasons. The Dukes earn the right to host the 2017 CAA Championship in Harrisonburg.

**2** For the first time since 2002, the Dukes are playing in the CAA Championship final and are searching for their first tournament title since 2000. Lauren Steinbrecher has led the Dukes to the CAA Tournament in all seven seasons at the helm.

**3** JMU is boasting two CAA major award winners on the roster. Senior Janey Goodman was named CAA Player of the Year for the second consecutive season while junior Taylor Austin became just the second Duke to earn CAA Defensive Specialist of the Year.

**FIRST SERVE**

- James Madison will play in the 2016 CAA Championship match for the first time since 2002 and is searching for its first conference title since the 2000 season as the Dukes face No. 6 Delaware Sunday at noon. Saturday's match will be streamed live on CAA.tv and will be aired on the American Sports Network.
- Winning the regular-season title for the second consecutive season, JMU has earned back-to-back regular season titles since the 1998 and 1999 seasons and has won the regular-season championship outright for the first time since 1999.
- The last time JMU played in the championship final, the Dukes suffered a 3-2 loss at the hands of George Mason in 2002. JMU last won the tournament during the 2000 season after sweep of George Mason.
- The Dukes (20-10, 11-5) enter the tournament with an all-time record of 796-585 (.576) in their 48th full season of volleyball. JMU holds a 193-144 record in CAA play.
- Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher stands at 125-84 in her seventh season in Harrisonburg and is the second-winningest coach in JMU volleyball history.
- JMU's 2016 schedule features three 2015 NCAA Tournament participants.
- The Dukes roster features four seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and five freshman.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Player of the Year Janey Goodman set a new single-season program record for total kills and had a team-high 10 as top-seeded James Madison advanced to the CAA Volleyball Championship title game for the first time since 2002 with a 3-0 sweep of fifth-seeded Towson.
- The Dukes won their ninth straight match overall and is searching for the program's first conference trophy since 2000.
- Sophomore Bryn Recker had nine kills and 15 digs and redshirt freshman Kelly Vahos added eight kills off the bench in the victory.
- Goodman brought her single-season total to 513 which breaks a two-decade-old record set by Lindsay Collingwood of 506 set in 1996 as the program's most kills over a single-season.
- JMU out-blocked Towson 14.0 to 3.0 in the contest as senior middle blocker Kelly Robertson paced the way with seven total.

**UP NEXT**

The NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship bracket will be announced on Sunday, November 27 as the 2016 Selection Show will air at 9 p.m. on ESPNU. The First and Second rounds of competition will begin on December 1.

**SCOUTING DELAWARE**

- With back-to-back upset victories to earn a berth into the CAA Championship final, sixth-seeded Delaware holds a 16-15 overall record and closed the regular season with an 8-8 mark in conference play. The Blue Hens upset No. 2 Charleston in five sets during semifinal action to advance to Sunday's championship.
- Three Blue Hens garnered double-doubles in Delaware's upset victory over the Cougars. Senior Autumn Jenkins had 15 kills and 11 digs, while freshman Maria Bellinger had 13 kills and 14 digs. Senior Erin Layne had a match-high 56 assists and contributed 12 digs in the win. Graduate student Alexa Swann hit at a .566 percentage on 18 kills on 27 attempts with just three errors.
- Two Blue Hens earned All-Colonial Athletic Association honors as seniors Autumn Jenkins and Alexa Swann were each named to the Second team. Freshman Maria Bellinger earned CAA All-Rookie honors.
- Jenkins entered the tournament with 301 kills and 352 digs and had posted 17 double-doubles this season. She was tied for sixth in the CAA with a team-leading 29 service aces.
- Swann led the team and ranked sixth in the conference with a .298 attacking percentage entering the weekend. She also paced the squad and ranked fourth in the league with a 1.05 blocks average.
- Bellinger led Delaware entering the tournament with 307 kill for a 2.77 kills per set average. She also ranked fourth on the squad with 154 digs and third with 44 blocks.

**JMU-DELAWARE SERIES**

## LAST TIME VS. DELAWARE - NOV. 11, 2016

• Snapping Delaware's five-match win streak, James Madison tallied its seven consecutive victory by topping the Blue Hens in four sets (25-18, 25-13, 22-25, 25-22) Friday Evening inside Sinclair Gym.

•Four Dukes garnered double-digit kills led by senior right side hitter Janey Goodman's 16. Sophomore outside hitter Bryn Recker and senior outside hitter Kate Whitmire each added 11 while freshman outside hitter chipped in 10 kills on 16 swings for a team-best .562 hitting percentage.

• Setters Sarah Martin and Tilbe Yaglioglu each tallied double-doubles as Martin tallied 24 assists with 12 digs and Yaglioglu added 22 helpers with 11 digs.

• Defensively, JMU garnered right blocks led by senior middle blocker Kelly Robertson's five block assists. Junior libero Taylor Ausitn posted 26 digs to average 6.50 per set.

## FRESHMAN CONTRIBUTIONS

•Freshman Briley Brind'Amour has appeared in 29 of the Dukes' 30 matches this season, seeing action in 89 sets. She is averaging 2.00 kills per set, ranking third on the squad with 178 total kills, while adding 34 blocks.

•Setter Sarah Martin has garnered seven double-doubles this season, while ranking second on the squad with a 5.84 assists per set average. Dishing out 537 total helpers this season, Martin has helped guide the Dukes to a .235 hitting percentage, good for second in the league.

•Defensive specialist Sarah Driscoll, middle blocker M'Kaela White and redshirt outside hitter Kelly Vahos have also come off the bench to provide depth for JMU.

## ALL-TOURNAMENT ACCOLADES

• The Dukes have been a staple on the All-Tournament team in all four of James Madison's nonconference tournaments.

• Senior Janey Goodman earned All-Tournament honors in all four of the Dukes' nonconference tournaments, including picking up Most Valuable Player accolades at the Cornell and JMU Invitational.

• James Madison earned its second tournament sweep at the Cornell Invitational as senior Kelly Robertson and junior Taylor Austin joined Goodman with All-Tournament honors.

• The Dukes opened the season sweeping the JMU Invitational with Goodman, Robertson and sophomore Taylor Gail taking home All-Tournament team accolades.

## AUSTIN'S PRESENCE IN BACK ROW

• Junior libero Taylor Austin has put together double-digit dig performances in all of her 29 appearances for James Madison this season.

• Against UNCW, Austin totaled a career-best 39 digs as the Ashburn, Va. native has recorded 20 or more digs in 16 matches this season with six 30 or more dig performances, leading the league and ranking second in the nation with a 5.94 digs per set average.

• With 1,515 career digs, Austin currently ranks third all-time at JMU and is one of three Dukes to ever eclipse the 1,500 digs mark.

## GOODMAN RISING UP CHARTS

• Senior right side hitter Janey Goodman continues to string together an impressive senior season as she leads the league in kills (4.62) and points (5.22) per set.

## GOODMAN NAMED FINALIST FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

• Right side hitter Janey Goodman was selected as one of 30 candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award.

•To be eligible, a student-athlete must be classified as a NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

•The 30 candidates will be narrowed down to 10 finalists later this season with those names being placed on the official ballot. The winner will be selected through a combinatin of media, coaches and fan voting and will be announced at the 2016 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship in December.

## BLOCK PARTY

• The Dukes have been dominate at the net all season and have strung together double-digit blocks in 18 of JMU's 30 matches this season.

• James Madison is out-blocking opponents, 287.5 to 170.0, this season and are averaging 2.57 blocks per set - good for second in the league.

•Sophomore middle blocker Taylor Gail leads JMU with 134.0 total blocks with a 1.26 blocks per set average to rank second in the conference while senior middle blocker Kelly Robertson ranks fourth with a 1.09 blocks per set mark.

- Goodman has tallied double-digit kills in 27 of the Dukes' 30 matches and has recorded 20 or more kills in 10 matches this season, including two 30-plus kill performances and setting a new career-high of 33 at Charleston
- With 513 total kills thus far over her senior campaign, Goodman shattered a two-decade-old program record for the most kills in a single season that was set in 1996 by Lindsay Collingwood.
- It's the third single-season record that Goodman has broken this season as she also holds the top single-season marks for kills per set and total attempts (1,258).
- The Powhatan, Va. native has rocketed herself into second all-time at JMU with 1,677 career kills and also ranks second in school history in attacks with 4,372 swings over her career.

## JMU TAKES HOME MAJOR END-OF-SEASON AWARDS

- On the eve of the 2016 CAA Championship, the league office announced the end-of-year awards as voted on by the conference's coaches. A Duke duo earned two of the biggest individual awards of the year.
- For the second consecutive season, senior Janey Goodman was selected as the CAA Player of the Year, becoming the first back-to-back honoree since George Mason's Aline Pereira accomplished the feat in 2001 and 2002.
- Taylor Austn became just the second Duke in program history to ever be recognized as the CAA Defensive Specialist of the Year. The last Duke to earn the honor was Jena Pierson in 2006.
- Both Austin and Goodman earned First Team All-CAA accolades, the first for Austin over her career at JMU and the third for Goodman.

Lauren Steinbrecher, formerly Lauren Sauer, was named volleyball head coach at James Madison on Jan. 25, 2010. She has compiled an 107-74 record going into her seventh season as head coach of the Dukes.

In her sixth season at the helm of the Dukes, Steinbrecher earned her 100th career win in a 3-1 victory over Northeastern on Oct. 9. With the program's best start since 1999 and claiming the regular season title, she was named the Colonial Athletic Association Co-Coach of the Year for the second time in her career. Under her leadership, the top-seeded Dukes (12-4) hosted the CAA Volleyball Tournament for the first time since 2002. The Dukes finished the 2015 season reaching the semifinals in the CAA Tournament where they faced #5 Charleston. JMU finished the season with a 22-8 record highlighted by a 14 game win streak for the first time since 1987.

In 2014, the team advanced to its fourth semifinal round in the CAA tournament under Steinbrecher, finishing 8-8 in conference and 17-14 overall. Janey Goodman, Lizzy Briones and Martha Stewart added to Steinbrecher's All-CAA players list.

Under her tutelage, 15 Dukes have received all CAA honors, highlighted by first team honors for Lindsay Callahan (2010), Natalie Abel (2011) and Briones (2013). Abel also added VaSID State Player of the Year in 2011, becoming only the second player in JMU history to receive that honor. Danielle Erb was named All-CAA in all three seasons she played for Steinbrecher, becoming just the second player in school history to be named All-CAA four times.

Steinbrecher had immediate success in her first year with the Dukes, compiling a 22-8 overall record and a 10-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. Her team garnered the second-seed in the CAA tournament, their first appearance since 2007. For her efforts, she was named the CAA co-Coach of the Year as well as the Virginia Sports Information Directors (VaSID) State Coach of the Year.

The 2010 JMU volleyball team recorded the seventh-best winning percentage in school history (.733) and the fifth-best since moving to Division I in 1986. The Dukes were especially strong at home where they compiled a 13-1 mark, which tied for the second-best home mark in school history.

Steinbrecher also authored one of the best turnarounds in the nation, taking over a team that went 11-19 in 2009 and guiding them to an 11-win improvement in 2010. That 11-win differential was the sixth-best turnaround in the country while the .366 improvement in winning percentage was the fourth-best in the nation.

In her second season with the Dukes, she led the team to its second consecutive 20-win season, finishing 20-11 overall. It was the first time the team posted back-to-back 20-win seasons since 1999-2000. In CAA play, Madison went 8-6 and reached the CAA tournament semifinals for the second straight year. In the quarterfinals, Madison swept Georgia State 3-0 for its first win in the CAA tournament since 2007.

JMU's third year under Steinbrecher was marred by injuries, dropping it to 13-16 overall and 5-7 in the CAA. The season was highlighted by taking a set off then-16th-ranked and national quarterfinalist Minnesota. In the CAA Championship tournament, the Dukes rallied from a 2-0 deficit to upset third-ranked Northeastern, 3-2.

Steinbrecher advanced the Dukes to the CAA tournament for the fourth straight season in 2013 after going 8-6 in CAA play to finish tied for third. It was the first time JMU advanced to four straight league tournaments since the 1997 through 2000 timeframe. The Dukes finished the regular season by winning three straight against CAA foes and four of their last five, including completing season sweeps against Hofstra and William & Mary.

Identified in 2009 by the American Volleyball Coaches Association as one of the "30 best coaches in the country under the age of 30," Steinbrecher came to JMU following three years as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Kentucky.

Steinbrecher joined UK head coach Craig Skinner's staff in the spring of 2007 and made her impact immediately, helping the Wildcats to steady improvement in each season. After a 19-12 season in 2006 prior to her arrival, Kentucky went 22-10 in 2007 followed by 26-6 with a 17-3 mark in the Southeastern Conference in 2008. In 2009, the Wildcats went 29-5 overall and 17-3 in the SEC. They advanced to the round-of-16 in the NCAA Championships and finished the year ranked 12th in the AVCA coaches poll. Steinbrecher's recruiting efforts included landing the 13th-ranked class in the country in 2009.

Prior to her time at Kentucky, Steinbrecher competed professionally for one year in Almeria, Spain, after a stellar four-year collegiate career at Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets reached the NCAA Championships all four years of her career, including trips to the quarterfinals in 2003 and the round-of-16 in 2004. Georgia Tech won a pair of Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships (2003, 04) as well as the tournament championship in 2002.

Steinbrecher was an AVCA honorable mention All-American in 2003, named All-ACC in 2002 and 2003, and became one of just two players in Yellow Jacket history to earn ACC Rookie of the Year honors in 2001. She was also ACC All-Tournament in 2003 and earned five other all-tournament accolades, including MVP of the 2003 Georgia Tech Invitational.

When she graduated, Steinbrecher ranked second in solo blocks (99), fifth in career kills (1,706), fifth in kills per set (3.60), eighth in total blocks (368) and ninth in block assists (269) on the Georgia Tech career charts. She also ranked fifth (541 in 2003) and eighth (506 in 2004) in season kill totals as well as second (38 in 2004) and fifth (34 in 2002) in season solo blocks. In 2002, she etched her name in the NCAA record books with the second-best hitting percentage in a match all-time, connecting on 17 kills in 18 swings for a .944 attack rate.



Also a stellar student, Steinbrecher was named to the ACC Honor Roll during each of her four years at Georgia Tech. She was honored as an ESPN The Magazine District III University Division Academic All-District performer in both 2003 and 2004, honoring academic and athletic excellence among all Division I volleyball players from Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Virginia. She was also named Academic All-ACC in 2005 and was a Dean's List student at GT.

Following the completion of her volleyball career with the 2004 season, Steinbrecher continued competition as a student-athlete by joining the Yellow Jacket's women's basketball squad for the remainder of the 2004-05 season and the 2005-06 campaign.

Steinbrecher earned her Bachelor of Science in Business Management in December 2005. She is a native of Huntsville, Ala., and resides in Harrisonburg with husband, Casey, and son, Luke.
