### **2016 JAMES MADISON VOLLEYBALL**

### **FIRST SERVE**

- Making a run in the second half of the Colonial Athletic Association season, JMU picked up its fourth consecutive victory in league play and closes out its regular-season road slate with contests at Charleston and UNCW.
- The Dukes clinched its fourth consecutive CAA victory last Friday by topping William & Mary 3-1 on the road in Williamsburg to move into fifth in the CAA standings. Just three games separate fifth through first place in the conference rankings heading into the final two weeks of regular-season play.
- •JMU begins its final road trip of the regular season on Thursday, Nov. 3 battling Charleston before facing UNCW on Saturday, Nov. 5. Both matches will be live streamed via the respective sites of the host school.
- •The Dukes (15-10, 7-5) enter the weekend with an all-time record of 791-585 (.575) in their 48th full season of volleyball. JMU holds a 189-144 record in CAA play.
- Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher stands at 120-84 in her seventh season in Harrisonburg and is the third-winningest coach in JMU volleyball history.
- •JMU's 2016 schedule features three 2015 NCAA Tournament participants.
- •The Dukes roster features four seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and five freshman.

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- The Dukes improved to 7-5 in conference play after deafting William & Mary, 3-1, in Williamsburg to sweep the Tribe over the 2016 season. The match was JMU's fourth consecutive victory in CAA play as the Dukes rank fifth in the league standings and within three games of the top spot.
- Janey Goodman tallied a match-high 18 kills and moved into second place on the Dukes' all-time career kills chart with 1,571 over her senior campaign thus far. Taylor Austin garnered 30 or more digs for the fourth time this season with 32 against the Tribe.
- •The win was the 120th of Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher's career as she is just four wins away from tying Pat Sargent (124-88-7) as the second winningest coach in JMU program history.

### **UP NEXT**

 JMU rounds out the 2016 regular season hosting Delaware and Towson over "Alumni Weekend."
 The final weekend of regular-season play begins on Friday, Nov. 11 when the Dukes take on Delaware. JMU closes the 2016 regular season against Towson on Saturday, Nov. 12 for "Senior Night." JMU will honor its four seniors and senior student assistant coach Hailey Brooks in a postmatch ceremony.

### **SCOUTING CHARLESTON**

- With a 15-9 overall record and an 8-4 mark in league action, Charleston ranks third in the league standings heading into Thursday's contest.
- •The Cougars are coming off back-to-back road losses after falling at Northeastern and Hofstra in four sets, falling from first to third in the conference standings.
- •Sophomore Allison Beckman ranks second in the league with a 10.12 assists per set average with 860 total helpers, guiding Charleston to a .180 team hitting percentage.
- •Defensively, two Cougars rank in the top ten individually in digs as sophomore McKala Rhodes sits in fourth in the league with a 4.87 per set average and sophomore Devon Rachel holds down the 10th spot with a 3.41 mark.

### A WIN OVER CHARLESTON WOULD...

- Be JMU's fourth consecutive league victory and eighth overall league victory.
- Be Lauren Steinrecher's 121st victory.
- Be JMU's second straight victory against the Cougars in Charleston
- Be the Dukes' third overall win over Charleston

### **JMU-CHARLESTON SERIES**

- Thursday marks the 12th meeting between JMU and Charleston as the Cougars lead the all-time series 9-2. Charleston holds the advantage in its home arena with a 2-1 record over JMU.
- JMU has only two victories over the Cougars
   the last was a five-set thriller in Charleston a season ago.

### LAST TIME VS. CHARLESTON - OCT. 9, 2016

- For the first time this season two Dukes recorded double-doubles, but Charleston topped JMU in four sets (26-25, 23-25, 18-25, 19-25) inside Sinclair Gym.
- •Setters Sarah Martin and Tilbe Yaglioglu each tallied double-doubles as Martin racked up 24 assists and 10 digs while Yaglioglu added 25 assists and 10 digs.
- Senior Janey Goodman headed the offense with 14 kills and six blocks. Junior Taylor Austin added 23 digs while the Dukes racked up 11 blocks for

### **SCOUTING UNCW**

- Coming off four consecutive league losses, UNCW has stumbled to 14-10 overall with a 4-8 CAA record to sit seventh in the league standings. The top six teams qualify for the 2016 CAA Tournament hosted in Wilmington on Nov. 18-20.
   The Seahawks lead the league with a 2.65 blocks per set average with a team-best 252.0 total blocks this season. Sydney Brock ranks fifth in the conference with 89.0 total and a 1.01 per set average.
- •Two Seahawks rank in the top ten individually in kills. Senior Nicole Lott sits in fourth with a 3.37 per set average while sophomore Maddy Kline ranks ninth averaging 2.99 kills per set.

### A WIN OVER UNCW WOULD...

- Sweep the season series in favor of the Dukes
- Be the seconds straight victory over the Seahawks and the second consecutive win in Wilmington.

### JMU-UNCW SERIES

- Saturday is the 58th meeting betwenn JMU and UNCW as the Dukes hold a 41-16 advantage in the all-time series history. The Seahawks have dominated the series of late, winning seven of the last 10, inclduing a string of six straight victories over JMU.
- The Dukes hold a 15-8 record in games played in Wilmington with tallying a road win in 2015.
   It was JMU's first road victory over the Seahawks since the 2010 season.

### LAST TIME VS. UNCW - OCT.7, 2016

- Powered by an impressive defensive performance, JMU topped UNCW in four sets (25-22, 22-25, 25-22, 25-23) in a back-and-forth conference series inside Sinclair Gym.
- •Junior Taylor Austin racked up a career-high 34 digs while sophomore Bryn Recker added a career-best 21 as the Dukes totaled 99.
- •JMU also added 10.0 team blocks for the third consecutive match with double-digit blocks.
- Senior Janey Goodman headed the offense with 21 kills, while senior Kate Whitmire added a season-best 13. Setter Tilbe Yaglioglu recorded 31 assists and 12 digs for her second doubledouble of the season.

### GOODMAN NAMED FINALIST FOR SENIOR

### **CLASS AWARD**

- Right side hitter Janey Goodman was selected as one of 30 candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award.
- •To be eligible, a student-athlete must be classified as a NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- •The 30 candidates will be narrowed down to 10 finalists later this season with those names being placed on the official ballot. The winner will be selected through a combinatin of media, coaches and fan voting and will be announced at the 2016 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship in December.

### **BLOCK PARTY**

- The Dukes have been dominate at the net all season and have strung together double-digit blocks in 14 of JMU's 25 matches this season.
- James Madison is out-blocking opponents,
   228.5 to 134.5, this season and are averaging
   2.54 blocks per set good for second in the league.
- •Sophomore middle blocker Taylor Gail leads JMU with 107.0 total blocks with a 1.26 blocks per set average to rank second in the conference while senior middle blocker Kelly Robertson ranks fourth with a 1.06 blocks per set mark.

### FRESHMAN CONTRIBUTIONS

- •Freshman Briley Brind'Amour has appeared in all 25 of the Dukes matches this season, seeing action in 73 sets. She is averaging 2.12 kills per set, ranking second on the squad with 155 total, while adding 27 blocks.
- •Setter Sarah Martin leads the team with five double-doubles this season, while holding a teambest 6.36 assists per set average. Dishing out 445 total helpers this season, Martin has helped guide the Dukes to a .233 hitting percentage, good for third in the league.
- •Defensive specialist Sarah Driscoll, middle blocker M'Kaela White and redshirt outside hitter Kelly Vahos have also come off the bench to provide depth for JMU.

### **ALL-TOURNAMENT ACCOLADES**

- The Dukes have been a staple on the All-Tournament team in all four of James Madison's nonconference tournaments.
- Senior Janey Goodman earned All-Tournament honors in all four of the Dukes' nonconference

tournaments, inclduing picking up Most Valuable Player accolades at the Cornell and JMU Invtitational.

- James Madison earned its second tournament sweep at the Cornell Invitational as senior Kelly Robertson and junior Taylor Austin joined Goodman with All-Tournament honors.
- The Dukes opened the season sweeping the JMU Invitational with Goodman, Robertson and sophomore Taylor Gail taking home All-Tournament team accoladess.

### **AUSTIN'S PRESENCE IN BACK ROW**

- Junior libero Taylor Austin has put together double-digit dig performances in all of her 24 appearances for James Madison this season.
- Against UNCW, Austin totaled a career-best 34 digs, becoming the first Duke to tally 30 or more digs since her then career-best performance of 31 against Northern Arizona on Aug. 28, 2015.
- The Ashburn, Va. native has recorded 20 or

more digs in 12 matches this season with four 30 or more dig performances, while leading the league and ranking second in the nation with a 5.91 digs per set average.

 With 1,381 career digs, Austin currently ranks third all-time at JMU and is one of three Dukes to ever eclipse the 1,200 digs mark.

### **GOODMAN RISING UP CHARTS**

- Senior right side hitter Janey Goodman continues to string together an impressive senior season as she leads the league in kills (4.57) and points (5.22) per set.
- Goodman has tallied double-digit kills in 22 of the Dukes' 25 matches and has recorded 20 or more kills in eight matches this season.
- With 407 total kills thus far over her senior campaign, Goodman has rocketed herself into second all-time at JMU with 1.571 career kills.
- •The senior also ranks second in school history in attacks with 4,105 swings over her career.

Lauren Steinbrecher, formerly Lauren Sauer, was named volleyball bead coach at James Madison on Jan. 25, 2010. Sh has compiled an 107-74 record going into her seventh season as head coach of the Dukes.

In her sixth season at the helm of the Dukes, Steinbrecher earned her 100th career win in a 3-1 victory over Northeastern on Oct. 9. With the program's best start since 1999 and claiming the regular season title, she was named the Colonial Athletic Association Co-Coach of the Year for the seasond time in her career. Under her leadership, the top-seeded Dukes (12-4) hosted the CAA Volleyball Tournament for the first time since 2002. The Dukes finished the 2015 season reaching the semifinals in the CAA Tournament where they faced #5 Charleston. JMU finished the season with a 22-8 record highlighted by a 14 game win streak for the first time since 1987.

1 2014, the team advanced to its fourth semifinal round in the CAA tournament under Steinbrecher, finishing 8-8 in onference and 17-14 overall. Janey Goodman, Lizzy Briones and Martha Stewart added to Steinbrecher's All-CAA

Under her tutelage, 15 Dukes have received all CAA honors, highlighted by first team honors for Lindsay Callahan (2010), Natalie Åbel (2011) and Briones (2013), Abel also added VaSID State Player of the Year in 2011, becoming only the second player in JMU history to receive that honor. Danielle Erb was named All-CAA in all three seasons she yed for Steinbrecher, becoming just the second player in school history to be named All-CAA four times.

Steinbrecher had immediate success in her first year with the Dukes, compiling a 22-8 overall record and a 10-4 mari in Colonial Athletic Association play. Her team garnered the second-seed in the CAA tournament, their first appearance since 2007. For her efforts, she was named the CAA co-Coach of the Year as well as the Virginia Sports Information Directors (YASDI) State Coach of the Year.

The 2010 JMU volleyball team recorded the seventh-best winning percentage in school history (,733) and the fifth-best since moving to Division I in 1986. The Dukes were especially strong at home where they compiled a 13-1 mark, which tied for the second-best home mark in school history.

Steinbrecher also authored one of the best turnarounds in the nation, taking over a team that went 11-19 in 2009 and guiding them to an 11-win improvement in 2010. That +11 win differential was the sixth-best turnaround in the country while the .366 improvement in winning percentage was the fourth-best in the nation.

In her second season with the Dukes, she led the team to its second consecutive 20-win season, finishing 20-11 overall. It was the first time the team posted back-to-back 20-win seasons since 1999-2000. In CAA play, Madison went 8-6 and reached the CAA tournament seminals for the second straight year. In the quarterfinals, Madison swep eorgia State 3-0 for its first win in the CAA tournament since 2007.

MMUs third year under Steinbrecher was marred by injuries, dropping it to 13-16 overall and 5-7 in the CAA. The season was highlighted by taking a set off then-16th-ranked and national quarterfinalist Minnesota. In the CAA Championship tournament, the Dukes rallied from a 2-0 deficit to upset third-ranked Northeastern, 3-2.

Steinbrecher advanced the Dukes to the CAA tournament for the fourth straight season in 2013 after going 8-6 in stemuleurie autanieeu ine books un eicher Ammalient in uit erführing von im 2013 aufe gung von in 2AA play fo finisht die fort bird. It was the first time JMU advanced to four straight leuge brumannets since the 1997 through 2000 timeframe. The Dukes finished the regular season by winning three straight against CAA foes and four of their last five, including completing season sweeps against Hofstra and William & Mary.

dentified in 2009 by the American Volleyball Coaches Association as one of the "30 best coaches in the country under the age of 30," Steinbrecher came to JMU following three years as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Kentucky.

Steinbrecher joined UK head coach Craig Skinner's staff in the spring of 2007 and made her impact immediately, helping the Wildcats to steady improvement in each season. After a 19-12 season in 2006 prior to her arrival, Kentucky went 22-10 in 2007 followed by 26-6 with a 17-3 mark in the Southeastern Conference in 2008. In 2009, the Wildcats went 29-5 overall and 17-3 in the SEC. They advanced to the round-of-16 in the NCAA Championships and finished the year ranked 12th in the AVCA coaches poll. Steinbrecher's recruiting efforts included landing the 13th-ranked class in the country in 2009.

Prior to her time at Kentucky, Steinbrecher competed professionally for one year in Almeria, Spain, after a stellar four-year collegiate career at Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets reached the NCAA Championships all four years of her career, including trips to the quarterfinals in 2003 and the round-of-16 in 2004. Georgia Tech won a pair of Atlantic loast Conference regular-season championships (2003, 04) as well as the tournament championship in 2002.

Steinbrecher was an AVCA honorable mention All-American in 2003, named All-ACC in 2002 and 2003, and becam une of just two players in Yellow backet history to earn ACC Rookle of the Year honors in 2001. She was also ACC All-Tournament in 2003 and earned five other all-tournament accolades, including MVP of the 2003 Georgia Tech

When she graduated, Steinbrecher ranked second in solo blocks (99), fifth in career kills (1,706), fifth in kills per set (3.60), eighth in total blocks (388) and ninth in block assists (269) on the Georgia Tech career charts. She also ranked iffith (541 in 2003) and eighth (506 in 2004) in season kill totals as well as second (38 in 2004) and fifth (34 in 2002) in season solo blocks. In 2002, she etched her ranne in the NCDA record books with the second-best hitting. rcentáge in a match all-time, connecting on 17 kills in 18 swings for a .944 attack rate.

Also a stellar student, Steinbrecher was named to the ACC Honor Roll during each of her four years at Georgia Tech. She was honored as an ESPN The Magazine District III University Division Academic All-District performer in both 2003 and 2004, honoring academic and athletic excellence among all Division I volleyfall players from Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Virginia. She was also named Academic All-ACC in 2005 and was a Dean's List student at GT.

Following the completion of her volleyball career with the 2004 season, Steinbresher continued competition as a student-athlete by joining the Yellow Jacket's women's basketball squad for the remainder of the 2004-05 season and the 2005-06 campaign.

Steinbrecher earned her Bachelor of Science in Business Management in December 2005. She is a native of Huntsville, Ala., and resides in Harrisonburg with husband, Casey, and son, Luke.
