

Winnng the CAA regular-season and tournament title in the same season for the first time since 1999. James Madison is making its third NCAA Tournament appearance since moving to Division I in 1986.

The Dukes are searching for their first NCAA Tournament win having been swept by Penn State (2000) and San Diego State (1999) in JMU's two previous appearances. The Dukes bring a 10-match win streak into Friday's contest.

JMU is boasting two CAA maior award winners on the roster. Senior Janey Goodman was named CAA Player of the Year for the second consecutive season while junior Taylor Austin became just the second Duke to earn CAA Defensive Specalist of the Year.

2016 JAMES MADISON VOLLEYBALL

FIRST SERVE

- James Madison makes its third NCAA Tournament appearance since moving to Division I in 1986 and its first appearance in the Big Dance since 2000 when JMU faces Sun Belt Champion Coastal Carolina in Chapel Hill on Friday, Dec. 2 at 4:30 p.m. Friday's match will be stream live on ESPN3 and the WatchESPN app
- •The winner of Friday's contest will face either No. 7 North Carolina or High Point on Saturday at 6 p.m. in second round competition.
- The Dukes earned the Colonial Athletic Association's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament after sweeping No. 6 Delware in the championship finale to earn the Dukes' fourth overall CAA championship and their first since 2000.
- Winning the regular-season championship for the second consecutive season, JMU has won both the regular-season and tournament title in the same season for the first time since the 1999 season.
- •The Dukes (21-10, 11-5) enter the NCAA tournament with an all-time record of 797-585 (.577) in their 48th full season of volleyball. JMU holds a 193-144 record in CAA play.
- •Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher stands at 126-84 in her seventh season in Harrisonburg and is the second-winningest coach in JMU volleyball history. She is making her first NCAA appearance as a head coach having made four appearances as a student-athlete at Georgia Tech.
- •JMU's 2016 schedule features three 2015 NCAA Tournament participants.
- •The Dukes roster features four seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and five freshman.

LAST TIME OUT

- With a come-from-behind victory in the second set, James Madison volleyball earned its first CAA Championship title since 2000 as the Dukes swept No. 6 Delaware (25-18, 26-24, 25-20) inside Hanover Hall in Wilmington, N.C.
- •The Dukes were evenly matches offensively as sophomore Bryn Recker led the offense with 13 kills on 24 swings for a .485 hitting percentage while adding eight digs, three aces and two blocks. CAA Player of the Year Janey Goodman added 10 kills while senior Kate Whitmire chipped in nine. Recker and Whitmire earned All-Championship team honors while Goodman was named Championship MVP.
- •Defensively, JMU tallied 11.0 total blocks led by sophomore Taylor Gail's 11. Junior Taylor Austin garnered a match-high 15 digs.

•After cruising to a first-set victory, JMU trailed by four points on two separate occasions in the second set. Goodman led a late comeback, scoring the final four points to set JMU up with a 2-0 lead. Goodman hammered home the final kill of the match to send JMU to its first NCAA Tournament in 16 seasons.

UP NEXT

 The winner of Friday's first round match between James Madison and Coastal Carolina will face either High Point or No. 7 North Carolina on Saturday, Dec. 2 inside Carmichael Arena. First serve is scheduled for 6 p.m.

SCOUTING COASTAL CAROLINA

- The Chanticleers enter Friday's first round with a 27-4 overall record and a 15-1 mark in the Sun Belt Conference, winning the tournament title and the SBC's automatic bid. Coastal has won its last 17 matches. The streak began on Sept. 30.
- Coastal earned its third consecutive NCAA
 postseason berth, a program record, after downing
 top-seeded Arkansas State in the championship
 match. The Chanticleers are making their sixth
 NCAA postseason appearance in program history
 and have played their last three NCAA regional
 matches inside Carmichael Arena.
- Three Chanticleers were honored with All-Sun Belt Conference accolades this season, including Player of the Year Leah Hardeman and Newcomer of the Year Tahleia Bishop.
- Hardeman is the Chanticleers top attackers in the Sun Belt ranking second with 3.77 kills per set average. She has totaled 388 kills on 922 attempts for a .297 attacking percentage this season. Hardeman is a dominate server with 32 service aces to average 0.31 per set, fourth-best in the conference. Defensively, she ranks second on the team with 478 digs, tallying 12 double-doubles this season, and has added 49 total blocks. Bishop, a senior playing her first as a Chanticleer, garnered 261 total kills for Coastal while attacking a .258 clip. A versatile player on the court, Bishop has tallied 120 digs and 41 total blocks defensively.

JMU-COASTAL SERIES

- Friday marks just the third all-tme meeting between James Madison and Coastal Carolina and is the first that has been contested outside the friendly confines of Sinclair Gym in Harrisonburg.
- JMU leads the all-time series 2-0 and have sweep Coastal in each of the previous contests (1991, 2011).
- This is the first meeting between the two programs in the NCAA Tournament.

LAST TIME VS. COASTAL - SEPT. 3. 2011

- James Madison vollevball swept Coastal Carolina (25-21, 25-19, 25-20) in the first of a Saturday doubleheader slate inside Sinclair Gym as the Dukes went on to win the Days Inn Invitational with a 3-0 record.
- Redshirt iunior Natalie Able led JMU wth 11 kills on 32 swings with just one error for a .313 hitting percentage. Kelly Maguire also added 11 kills while attacking at a .471 clip. Offensively, the Dukes out-hit the Chanticleers .204 to .309.
- The Dukes dominated at the net, out-blocking Coastal 10 to 2. Kelly Maguire led JMU with seven blocks while Kristi Richardson added four.
- •Two Dukes garnered double-digit kills to round out JMU's defensive performance as Natalie Able tallied 14 and Katie Daorai chipped in 10.

JMU'S HISTORY AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

- JMU is making its third appearance in the NCAA Tournament since moving to Division I in 1986 and the Dukes' first appearance since 2000.
- · Madison is winless in its last two tournament appearances, falling to Penn State in 2000 and Sen Diego State in 1999. Both losses came in straight sets.

JMU TAKES HOME MAJOR END-OF-SEASON **AWARDS**

- On the eve of the 2016 CAA Championship, the league office announced the end-of-year awards as voted on by the conference's coaches. A Duke duo earned two of the biggest indvidiual awards of the vear.
- •For the second consecutive season, senior Janey Goodman was selected as the CAA Player of the Year, becoming the first back-to-back honoree since George Mason's Aline Pereira accomplished the feat in 2001 and 2002.
- •Taylor Austn became just the second Duke in program history to ever be recognized as the CAA Defensive Specialist of the Year. The last Duke to

earn the honor was Jena Pierson in 2006.

- Both Austin and Goodman earned First Team All-CAA accolades, the first for Austin over her career at JMU and the third for Goodman.
- •The Duke duo was honored again on Nov. 30 as the ECAC selected the pair as its Offensive and Defensive Players of th Year.

BLOCK PARTY

- The Dukes have been dominate at the net all season and have strung together double-digit blocks in 19 of JMU's 31 matches this season.
- James Madison is out-blocking opponents, 298.5 to 173.0, this season and are averaging 2.60 blocks per set - good for second in the league.
- Sophomore middle blocker Taylor Gail leads JMU with 140.0 total blocks and a 1.28 blocks per set average to rank second in the conference while senior middle blocker Kelly Robertson ranks third with a 1.09 blocks per set mark.

GOODMAN NAMED FINALIST FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

- Right side hitter Janev Goodman was selected as one of 30 candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award.
- •To be eligible, a student-athlete must be classified as a NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- •The 30 candidates will be narrowed down to 10 finalists later this season with those names being placed on the official ballot. The winner will be selected through a combinatin of media, coaches and fan voting and will be announced at the 2016 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship in December.

FRESHMAN CONTRIBUTIONS

- •Freshman Briley Brind'Amour has appeared in 29 of the Dukes' 32 matches this season, seeing action in 89 sets. She is averaging 2.22 kills per set, ranking fourth on the squad with 178 total kills to lead all freshman, while adding 34 blocks.
- •Setter Sarah Martin has garnered seven doubledoubles this season, while ranking second on the squad with a 5.82 assists per set average. Dishing out 553 total helpers this season, Martin has guided the Dukes to a .237 hitting percentage. good for second in the league.
- •Defensive specialist Sarah Driscoll, middle blocker M'Kaela White and redshirt outside hitter Kelly Vahos have also come off the bench to provide depth for JMU.

AUSTIN'S PRESENCE IN BACK ROW

- Junior libero Taylor Austin has put together double-digit dig performances in all of her 30 appearances for James Madison this season.
- During the regular season, Austin totaled a career-best 39 digs at UNCW, and the Ashburn, Va. native has recorded 20 or more digs in 16 matches this season with six performances of 30 or more digs, leading the league and ranking second in the nation with a 5.92 digs per set average.
- With 1,530 career digs, Austin currently ranks third all-time at JMU and is one of three Dukes to ever eclipse the 1,500 digs mark. She also has garnered the second-most digs over a singleseason in school history with 663 over her junior campaign.

GOODMAN'S RECORD-BREAKING SEASON

 Senior right side hitter Janey Goodman continues to string together an impressive senior season

- as she leads the league in kills (4.59) and points (5.18) per set and was awarded the CAA's Player of the Year honor.
- Goodman has tallied double-digit kills in 28 of the Dukes' 31 matches and has recorded 20 or more kills in 10 matches this season, including two 30-plus kill outings and setting a new career-high of 33 at Charleston
- With 523 total kills thus far over her senior campaign, Goodman shattered a two-decadeold program record for the most kills in a single season that was set in 1996 by Lindsay Collingwood.
- It's the third single-season record that Goodman has broken this season as she also holds the top single-season marks for kills per set and total attempts (1,277).
- •The Powhatan, Va. native has rocketed herself into second all-time at JMU with 1,687 career kills and also ranks second in school history in attacks with 4,391 swings over her career.

Lauren Steinbrecher, formerly Lauren Sauer, was named volleyball head coach at James Madison on Jan. 25, 2010. She has compiled an 107-74 record going into her seventh season as head coach of the Dukes.

In her sixth season at the helm of the Dukes, Steinbrecher earned her 100th career win in a 3-1 victory over Northeastern on Oct. 9. With the program's best start since 1999 and claiming the regular season title, she was named the Colonial Athletic Association Co-Coach of the Year for the sesond time in her career. Under her leadership, the top-seeded Dukes (12-4) hosted the CAA Volleyball Tournament for the first time since 2002. The Dukes finished the 2015 season reaching the semifinals in the CAA Tournament where they faced #5 Charletson. IMU finished the season with a 22-8 record highlighted by a 14 game win streak for the first time since 1987.

n 2014, the team advanced to its fourth semifinal round in the CAA tournament under Steinbrecher, finishing 8-8 in conference and 17-14 overall. Janey Goodman, Lizzy Briones and Martha Stewart added to Steinbrecher's All-CAA inlavers let.

Under her tutelage, 15 Dukes have received all CAA honors, highlighted by first team honors for Lindsay Callahan (2010), Matalie Åbel (2011) and Briones (2013), Abel also addied V3x10 State Player of the Vear in 2011, becoming only the second player in JMU history to receive that honor. Danielle Erb was named AH-CAA in all three seasons she played for Steinfercher, becoming just the second player in school history to be named AH-CAA four times.

Steinbrecher had immediate success in her first year with the Dukes, compiling a 22-8 overall record and a 10-4 mark in Colonial Attletic Association play. Her team garnered the second-seed in the CAA tournament, their first appearance since 2007. For her efforts, she was named the CAA co-Coach of the Year as well as the Virginia Sports Information Directurs (VASID) State Coach of the Year.

The 2010 JMU volleyball team recorded the seventh-best winning percentage in school history (,733) and the fithbest since moving to Division I in 1986. The Dukes were especially strong at home where they compiled a 13-1 mark, which tied for the second-best home mark in school history.

Steinbrecher also authored one of the best turnarounds in the nation, taking over a team that went 11-19 in 2009 and guiding them to an 11-win improvement in 2010. That +11 win differential was the sixth-best turnaround in the country while the .366 improvement in winning percentage was the fourth-best in the nation. In her second season with the Dukes, she led the team to its second consecutive 20-win season, finishing 20-11 overall. It was the first time the team posted back-to-back 20-win seasons since 1999-2000. In CAA play, Madison

went 8-6 and reached the CAA tournament semifinals for the second straight year. In the quarterfinals, Madison swej Georgia State 3-0 for its first win in the CAA tournament since 2007.

IMUS third year under Steinbracher was marred by injuries dronoling if to 12-16 quartel and 5-7 in the CAA. The

MU's third year under Steinbrecher was marred by injuries, dropping it to 13-16 overall and 5-7 in the CAA. The season was highlighted by taking a set off then-16th-ranked and national quarterfinalist Minnesota. In the CAA Championship tournament, the Dukes rallied from a 2-0 deficit to upset third-ranked Northeastern, 3-2.

Steinbrecher advanced the Dukes to the CAA tournament for the fourth straight season in 2013 after going 8-6 in CAA play to finish the dro third. It was the first time JMU advanced to four straight leauge tournaments since the 1997 through 2000 times dramen. The Dukes thisheld the regular assean by winning three straight against CAA foes and four of their last five, including completing season sweeps against Hofstra and William & Mary.

dentified in 2009 by the American Volleyball Coaches Association as one of the "30 best coaches in the country under the age of 30," Steinbrecher came to JMU following three years as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Kentucky.

Steinbrecher joined UK head coach Craig Skinner's staff in the spring of 2007 and made her impact immediately, helping the Wildcats to steady improvement in each season. After a 19-12 season in 2006 prior to her arrival, Kentucky went 22-10 in 2007 followed by 26-6 with a 17-3 mark in the Southeastern Conference in 2008. In 2009, the Wildcats went 29-5 overall and 17-3 in the SEC. They advanced to the round-of-16 in the NCAA Championships and finished the year ranked 12th in the AVCA coaches poli. Steinbrecher's recruiting efforts included landing the 13th-ranked class in the country in 2009.

Prior to her time at Kentucky, Steinbrecher competed professionally for one year in Almeria, Spain, after a stellar four-year collegiate career at Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets reached the NCAA Championships all four years of her scareer, including trips to the quarterfinals in 2003 and the round-of-16 in 2004. Georgia Tech won a pair of Alantic Caast Conference regular-season championships (2003, 04) as well as the tournament championship in 2002.

Steinbrecher was an AVCA honorable mention All-American in 2003, named All-ACC in 2002 and 2003, and becam one of just two players in Yellow Jacket history to earn ACC Bookie of the Year honors in 2001. She was also ACC All-Tournament in 2003 and earned five other all-tournament accollades, including MVP of the 2003 Georgia Tech Invitational.

When she graduated, Steinbrecher ranked second in solo blocks (99), fifth in career kills (1,705), fifth in kills per set (3,60), eighth in total blocks (368) and ninth in block assists (269) on the Georgia Tech career charts. She also ranked fifth (341 in 2003) and eighth (560 in 2004) in season kill totals as well as second (38 in 2004) and fifth (34 in 2002) in season solo blocks. In 2002, she etched her name in the NCAR record books with the second-best hitting percentage in a match all-time, connecting on 17 kills in 18 swings for a .944 attack rate.

Also a stellar student, Steinbrecher was named to the ACC Honor Roll during each of her four years at Georgia Tech. She was honored as an ESPN The Magazine District III University Division Academic All-District performer in both 2003 and 2004, honoring academic and athletic excellence among all Division I volleyfall players from Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Virginia. She was also named Academic All-ACC in 2005 and was a Dean's List student at GT.

Following the completion of her volleyball career with the 2004 season, Steinbrecher continued competition as a shudent-athlete by joining the Yellow Jacket's women's basketball squad for the remainder of the 2004-05 season and the 2005-06 campaign.

Steinbrecher earned her Bachelor of Science in Business Management in December 2005. She is a native of Huntsville, Ala., and resides in Harrisonburg with husband, Casey, and son, Luke.
