2 Senior Janey Goodman is just 37 kills away from breaking Lindsay Collingwood's single-season kills record of 506, which has stood for two decades.

3 Since the start of the second half of the league season, JMU has recorded six consecutive victories, the longest win streak for the Dukes over the 2016 season.

FIRST SERVE

- Heading into the final week of the 2016 regular season, JMU puts its six-match winning streak on the line with back-to-back home contests against Delaware and Towson
- The Dukes clinched a spot in the Colonial Athletic Association Tournament for the seventh consecutive season with two five-set road victories over Charleston and UNCW last week and sit just one game out of first place in the CAA standings.
- JMU begins its final home matches of the season on Friday, Nov. 11 against Delaware before hosting Towson on Saturday, Nov. 12 on "Senior Night." Both matches are slated for a 7 p.m. start. Saturday's match will feature a live audio stream available on JMUSports.com.
- The Dukes (17-10, 9-5) enter the weekend with an all-time record of 793-585 (.575) in their 48th full season of volleyball. JMU holds a 191-144 record in CAA play.
- Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher stands at 122-84 in her seventh season in Harrisonburg and is the third-winningest coach in JMU volleyball history.
- JMU's 2016 schedule features three 2015 NCAA Tournament participants.
- The Dukes roster features four seniors, two juniors, five sophomores and five freshman.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Dukes extended their winning streaking to six matches and improved to 9-5 in league play after defeating Charleston and UNCW on the road in five-set thrillers. JMU moved into a tie for second in the CAA standings and inch just one game behind conference leaders. The Dukes clinched a berth into the CAA Tournament for the seventh consecutive season.
- Janey Goodman racked up back-to-back matches with at least 30 kills, including setting a new career high of 33 against Charleston. Taylor Austin also garnered at least 30 digs in each contest, also setting a new career high of 39 at UNCW to highlight the action on the court.
- Austin and Goodman swept the CAA weekly honors for the second time this season after being named Defensive and Offensive Players of the Week, respectively.
- The wins brought Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher's tally to 122 victories as a Duke as she is just two wins away from tying Pat Sargent (124-88-7) as the second winningest coach in JMU program history.

UP NEXT

- Having clinched a spot at the 2016 CAA Tournament, the Dukes await their fate in the tightly

knotted standings. Northeastern and Charleston are locked at the top with 10-5 records as Towson and JMU sit right behind at 9-5. Hofstra ranks fifth with a 9-6 CAA record.

• First and second place in the standings will receive a bye and advance into the semifinals. The 2016 CAA Tournament begins on Friday, Nov. 18 and is hosted by UNCW in Wilmington, N.C.

SCOUTING DELAWARE

- With a 13-14 overall record and a 7-7 mark in league action, Delaware holds the sixth spot in the league standings and brings a five-match win streak into Friday's contest.
- The Blue Hens are coming off back-to-back victories over the top teams in the conference, defeating Northeastern (3-2) and Hofstra (3-1) in Newark.
- Senior Alexa Swann ranks sixth in the league with a .301 hitting percentage and has racked up 222 kills for the Blue Hens. As a squad, Delaware ranks ninth in the conference with a .184 team hitting percentage.
- Defensively, senior Taylor Hollingsworth ranks fourth in the conference with a 4.78 digs per set average with 492 total digs. Swann also is strong defensively, ranking fourth in the league with a 1.09 blocks per set mark.

A WIN OVER DELAWARE WOULD...

- Be JMU's seventh consecutive victory and 10 overall league victory.
- Be Head Coach Lauren Steinbrecher's 123rd victory.
- Be JMU's fifth straight home victory over the Blue Hens.

JMU-DELAWARE SERIES

- Friday marks the 50th all-time meeting between JMU and Delaware as the Blue Hens lead the all-time series 26-23, but JMU holds a slight advantage over the last 10 meetings with a 6-4 mark.
- The Dukes are 15-7 against Delaware inside Sinclair Gym and have won the last four contests played in Harrisonburg. Delaware last defeated the Dukes at home during the 2011 season.

LAST TIME VS. DELAWARE - OCT. 9, 2016

- Trailing 2-1, the Dukes fought from behind to force a decisive fifth set for the first time during the 2016 season, but the Dukes fell short to Delaware (25-20, 23-25, 19-25, 25-17, 17-15) inside the Bob Carpenter Center.
- Janey Goodman tallied a then season-best 29 kills while attacking at a .446 clip to lead the offense while Bryn Recker and Briley Brind'Amour joined her

in double figures with 15 and 10 kills, respectively. Recker added 20 digs to pick up her second double-double of the season.

• Four Dukes finished with double-digit digs including Recker. Austin led JMU with 33, one shy of her then career high. Jacqui Koebel dished out a career-best 19 digs. Tilbe Yaglioglu garnered 10 to go along with a career-high 36 assists to be the second Duke in the match with a double-double.

SCOUTING TOWSON

• Winning its last three matches, Towson has improved to 22-7 overall with a 9-5 mark in league action and is tied with JMU for second in the CAA standings. The top six teams qualify for the 2016 CAA Tournament hosted in Wilmington on Nov. 18-20.

• The Tigers will face William & Mary in Williamsburg on Friday, Nov. 11 before facing the Dukes in the regular season finale on Saturday.

• As a team, Towson leads the league in hitting percentage (.252), assists (13.48 per set), kills (14.27 per set and service aces (1.64 per set).

• Two Tigers rank in the top 10 in the league in kills per set as senior Jessica Lewis sits second behind JMU's Janey Goodman with a 3.90 kills per set average. Sophomore Jocelyn Kuilan ranks seventh with a 3.01 per set average.

A WIN OVER TOWSON WOULD...

• Be JMU's first "Senior Night" victory since the Dukes topped Hofstra (3-1) on Nov. 13, 2010.

JMU-TOWSON SERIES

• Saturday is the 48th meeting between JMU and Towson. The Tigers lead the all-time series 22-27, but JMU holds a slight advantage at home with a 13-12 record over Towson.

• The Tigers have won seven of the last 10 meetings and have swept the Dukes in five of those seven victories.

LAST TIME VS. TOWSON - OCT. 7, 2016

• Janey Goodman racked up a match-high 15 kills, but Towson swept the Dukes (18-25, 16-25, 19-25) inside SECU Arena.

• Freshmen Kelly Vahos and M'Kaela White added five and three kills, respectively, while Tilbe Yaglioglu garnered a match-high 17 assists and added seven digs.

• Taylor Austin headed the defense with 14 digs as Taylor Gail led the Dukes at the net with four blocks.

GOODMAN NAMED FINALIST FOR SENIOR CLASS**AWARD**

• Right side hitter Janey Goodman was selected as one of 30 candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award.

• To be eligible, a student-athlete must be classified as a NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

• The 30 candidates will be narrowed down to 10 finalists later this season with those names being placed on the official ballot. The winner will be selected through a combination of media, coaches and fan voting and will be announced at the 2016 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship in December.

BLOCK PARTY

• The Dukes have been dominate at the net all season and have strung together double-digit blocks in 16 of JMU's 27 matches this season.

• James Madison is out-blocking opponents, 250.5 to 152.5, this season and are averaging 2.51 blocks per set - good for second in the league.

• Sophomore middle blocker Taylor Gail leads JMU with 119.0 total blocks with a 1.25 blocks per set average to rank second in the conference while senior middle blocker Kelly Robertson ranks fifth with a 1.05 blocks per set mark.

FRESHMAN CONTRIBUTIONS

• Freshman Briley Brind'Amour has appeared in all 27 of the Dukes matches this season, seeing action in 83 sets. She is averaging 2.01 kills per set, ranking third on the squad with 167 total kills, while adding 31 blocks.

• Setter Sarah Martin has garnered five double-doubles this season, while ranking second on the squad with a 6.01 assists per set average. Dishing out 481 total helpers this season, Martin has helped guide the Dukes to a .231 hitting percentage, good for third in the league.

• Defensive specialist Sarah Driscoll, middle blocker M'Kaela White and redshirt outside hitter Kelly Vahos have also come off the bench to provide depth for JMU.

ALL-TOURNAMENT ACCOLADES

• The Dukes have been a staple on the All-Tournament team in all four of James Madison's nonconference tournaments.

• Senior Janey Goodman earned All-Tournament honors in all four of the Dukes' nonconference tournaments, including picking up Most Valuable Player accolades at the Cornell and JMU

Invitational.

- James Madison earned its second tournament sweep at the Cornell Invitational as senior Kelly Robertson and junior Taylor Austin joined Goodman with All-Tournament honors.
- The Dukes opened the season sweeping the JMU Invitational with Goodman, Robertson and sophomore Taylor Gail taking home All-Tournament team accolades.

AUSTIN'S PRESENCE IN BACK ROW

- Junior libero Taylor Austin has put together double-digit dig performances in all of her 26 appearances for James Madison this season.
- Against UNCW, Austin totaled a career-best 39 digs as the Ashburn, Va. native has recorded 20 or more digs in 14 matches this season with six 30 or more dig performances, leading the league and ranking second in the nation with a 6.05 digs per set average.
- With 1,454 career digs, Austin currently ranks

third all-time at JMU and is one of three Dukes to ever eclipse the 1,200 digs mark.

GOODMAN RISING UP CHARTS

- Senior right side hitter Janey Goodman continues to string together an impressive senior season as she leads the league in kills (4.75) and points (5.35) per set.
- Goodman has tallied double-digit kills in 24 of the Dukes' 27 matches and has recorded 20 or more kills in 10 matches this season, including two 30-plus kill performances and setting a new career-high of 33 at Charleston
- With 470 total kills thus far over her senior campaign, Goodman is just 37 away from setting a new JMU single-season record shattering a two-decade mark held by Lindsay Collingwood (506 kills in 1996) and has rocketed herself into second all-time at JMU with 1,634 career kills.
- The senior also ranks second in school history in attacks with 4,256 swings over her career.

Lauren Steinbrecher, formerly Lauren Sauer, was named volleyball head coach at James Madison on Jan. 25, 2010. She has compiled an 107-74 record going into her seventh season as head coach of the Dukes.

In her sixth season at the helm of the Dukes, Steinbrecher earned her 100th career win in a 3-1 victory over Northeastern on Oct. 9. With the program's best start since 1999 and claiming the regular season title, she was named the Colonial Athletic Association Co-Coach of the Year for the second time in her career. Under her leadership, the top-seeded Dukes (12-4) hosted the CAA Volleyball Tournament for the first time since 2002. The Dukes finished the 2015 season reaching the semifinals in the CAA Tournament where they faced #5 Charleston. JMU finished the season with a 22-8 record highlighted by a 14 game win streak for the first time since 1987.

In 2014, the team advanced to its fourth semifinal round in the CAA tournament under Steinbrecher, finishing 8-8 in conference and 17-14 overall. Janey Goodman, Lizzy Briones and Martha Stewart added to Steinbrecher's All-CAA players list.

Under her tutelage, 15 Dukes have received All-CAA honors, highlighted by first team honors for Lindsay Callahan (2010), Natalie Abel (2011) and Briones (2013). Abel also added VaSID State Player of the Year in 2011, becoming only the second player in JMU history to receive that honor. Danielle Erb was named All-CAA in all three seasons she played for Steinbrecher, becoming just the second player in school history to be named All-CAA four times.

Steinbrecher had immediate success in her first year with the Dukes, compiling a 22-8 overall record and a 10-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. Her team garnered the second-seed in the CAA tournament, their first appearance since 2007. For her efforts, she was named the CAA co-Coach of the Year as well as the Virginia Sports Information Directors (VaSID) State Coach of the Year.

The 2010 JMU volleyball team recorded the seventh-best winning percentage in school history (.733) and the fifth-best since moving to Division I in 1986. The Dukes were especially strong at home where they compiled a 13-1 mark, which tied for the second-best home mark in school history.

Steinbrecher also authored one of the best turnaround in the nation, taking over a team that went 11-19 in 2009 and guiding them to an 11-win improvement in 2010. That +11 win differential was the sixth-best turnaround in the country while the .366 improvement in winning percentage was the fourth-best in the nation.

In her second season with the Dukes, she led the team to its second consecutive 20-win season, finishing 20-11 overall. It was the first time the team posted back-to-back 20-win seasons since 1999-2000. In CAA play, Madison went 8-6 and reached the CAA tournament semifinals for the second straight year. In the quarterfinals, Madison swept Georgia State 3-0 for its first win in the CAA tournament since 2007.

JMU's third year under Steinbrecher was marred by injuries, dropping it to 13-16 overall and 5-7 in the CAA. The season was highlighted by taking a set off then-16th-ranked and national quarterfinalist Minnesota. In the CAA Championship tournament, the Dukes rallied from a 2-0 deficit to upset third-ranked Northeastern, 3-2.

Steinbrecher advanced the Dukes to the CAA tournament for the fourth straight season in 2013 after going 8-6 in CAA play to finish tied for third. It was the first time JMU advanced to four straight league tournaments since the 1997 through 2000 timeframe. The Dukes finished the regular season by winning three straight against CAA foes and four of their last five, including completing season sweeps against Hofstra and William & Mary.

Identified in 2009 by the American Volleyball Coaches Association as one of the "30 best coaches in the country under the age of 30," Steinbrecher came to JMU following three years as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Kentucky.

Steinbrecher joined UK head coach Craig Skinner's staff in the spring of 2007 and made her impact immediately, helping the Wildcats to steady improvement in each season. After a 19-12 season in 2006 prior to her arrival, Kentucky went 22-10 in 2007 followed by 26-6 with a 17-3 mark in the Southeastern Conference in 2008. In 2009, the Wildcats went 29-5 overall and 17-3 in the SEC. They advanced to the round-of-16 in the NCAA Championships and finished the year ranked 12th in the AVCA coaches poll. Steinbrecher's recruiting efforts included landing the 13th-ranked class in the country in 2009.

Prior to her time at Kentucky, Steinbrecher competed professionally for one year in Almeria, Spain, after a stellar four-year collegiate career at Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets reached the NCAA Championships all four years of her career, including trips to the quarterfinals in 2003 and the round-of-16 in 2004. Georgia Tech won a pair of Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships (2003, 04) as well as the tournament championship in 2002.

Steinbrecher was an AVCA honorable mention All-American in 2003, named All-ACC in 2002 and 2003, and became one of just two players in Yellow Jacket history to earn ACC Rookie of the Year honors in 2001. She was also ACC All-Tournament in 2003 and earned five other all-tournament accolades, including MVP of the 2003 Georgia Tech Invitational.

When she graduated, Steinbrecher ranked second in solo blocks (99), fifth in career kills (1,706), fifth in kills per set (3.60), eighth in total blocks (368) and ninth in block assists (269) on the Georgia Tech career charts. She also ranked fifth (541 in 2003) and eighth (506 in 2004) in season kill totals as well as second (38 in 2004) and fifth (34 in 2002) in season solo blocks. In 2002, she etched her name in the NCAA record books with the second-best hitting percentage in a match all-time, connecting on 17 kills in 18 swings for a .944 attack rate.



Also a stellar student, Steinbrecher was named to the ACC Honor Roll during each of her four years at Georgia Tech. She was honored as an ESPN The Magazine District III University Division Academic All-District performer in both 2003 and 2004, honoring academic and athletic excellence among all Division I volleyball players from Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Virginia. She was also named Academic All-ACC in 2005 and was a Dean's List student at GT.



Following the completion of her volleyball career with the 2004 season, Steinbrecher continued competition as a student-athlete by joining the Yellow Jacket's women's basketball squad for the remainder of the 2004-05 season and the 2005-06 campaign.

Steinbrecher earned her Bachelor of Science in Business Management in December 2005. She is a native of Huntsville, Ala., and resides in Harrisonburg with husband, Casey, and son, Luke.
