DUKES STAY ON ROAD TO FACE NORFOLK STATE

- JMU heads east on Saturday, Sept 8 to face Norfolk State in its second straight road game to open the year.
- Kickoff is set for 6 p.m. at William "Dick" Price Stadium on either ESPN3. It's available online through WatchESPN or the ESPN app. Pregame coverage on the JMU Sprint Broadcast Network begins at 5 p.m.
- Saturday marks the second meeting between JMU and NSU after the Dukes rolled to a 75-14 win against the Spartans in the inaugural win a season ago in Harrisonburg.
- It's JMU's third game ever in Norfolk, as it looks for its first win, having lost a neutral site game to Richmond in 1985 and the only road meeting versus Old Dominion in 2011.

JMU BATTLES TOUGH IN SEASON-OPENING LOSS AT NC STATE

- JMU lost its season opener 24-13 at NC State on Sept. 1, marking the first loss to open a season in four years.
- JMU led 7-0 in the first quarter and was within four points late in the game before the Wolfpack scored a touchdown with 65 seconds to play to secure the win.
- Ben DiNucci had a FCS best 85.2 completion percentage, throwing 23-of-27 for 197 yards and a touchdown.
- He also led the team with 79 rushing yards on 14 carries (5.6 avg.).
- Riley Stapleton collected a career-high nine catches, tallying 88 receiving yards and a score.
- JMU held NC State to only 2.9 yards per rush and 83 total rushing yards, as Ron'Dell Carter led the unit with 3.0 tackles for loss and a sack.

JMU MAINTAINS #2 RANKING THIS WEEK

- The Dukes enter week two of the season with a No. 2 ranking, holding strong from its preseason ranking.
- Despite the setback, the voters kept JMU at the second spot in both major polls and one media member gave the Dukes a first-place vote.
- North Dakota State is the consensus No. 1 team, receiving all first-place votes in the Coaches' Poll and 151 of 154 from the media.
- The CAA once again has six ranked teams in both polls, which ranks first amongst all FCS conferences.

GAME NOTES

SCOUTING NORFOLK STATE

- The Spartans enter week two with a 1-0 record after downing Virginia State 34-13 last weekend.
- Aaron Savage tied a career high with 112 rushing yards with two touchdowns, and NSU used a 24-6 run in the second half to pull away.
- Norfolk State out-gained VSU 368 to 267, which included a 154 to 82 advantage in the run game.
- · NSU took advantage of four takeaways, as opposed to its one.
- Craig Rodwell was named MEAC Co-Offensive Lineman of the Week following the win.
- The Spartans finished 4-7 last season and were selected to finish sixth in the 10-team MEAC.
- Prior to the season, linebacker Nigel Chavis was named a HBCU Preseason All-American.
- · Latrell Scott is in his fourth year at NSU, holding a 13-21 record. He previously was a head coach at Virginia State and Richmond, and spent one season as an assistant at JMU, in 2012.

LATRELL NO STRANGER TO THE DUKES

- · He's coached against JMU multiple times, and even coached with the Dukes.
- Latrell Scott served as the tight ends coach at JMU for the 2012 season.
- The Dukes finished 7-4 that year with a 5-3 mark during CAA play.

RECAPPING LAST YEAR'S MEETING

- Last season, in the inaugural meeting between JMU and Norfolk State, the Dukes ran away with a convincing 75-14 win in Harrisonburg.
- JMU amassed 472 rushing yards, averaging 7.3 yards per carry.
- Trai Sharp ran for 130 yards and a touchdown on just nine touches (14.4 avg.) and Percy Agyei-Obese rushed for 103 and a score in his collegiate debut.
- Three others rushed for at least 50 yards, as Marcus Marshall led the team with a pair of rushing touchdowns.
- · The Dukes came one yard shy of the singlegame record, totaling 728 yards of offense.
- NSU was held to just 91 yards and 1.9 yard per play, marking the largest margin of total offense between two teams in JMU history.
- · It was the third time under Mike Houston that JMU had scored over 70 points.

NEW TURF INSTALLED AT NSU

- Norfolk State just had artificial turf installed at William "Dick" Price Stadium, and JMU becomes just the second opponent to play on the surface.
- · Spike Zone Pro is the hybrid turf product used for the new playing field.
- · The project replaced the existing grass field with a premium synthetic surface.

JMU AGAINST VIRGINIA SQUADS

- · The Dukes have faced 15 teams from the Commonwealth since beginning their football program in 1972.
- In 125 games, JMU has racked up an 84-61 record against teams from around the state.
- The Dukes have faced William & Mary more than any other state team, holding a 23-17 mark.
- The Dukes are also 17-18 versus Richmond and 12-6 against Liberty.

TIDEWATER TIES FOR JMU

- JMU has 12 players with ties to Norfolk and the Tidewater region.
- For Wayne Davis and Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey it will be their first game in the city since they were in high school as both played at Lake Taylor High School.
- Both Dimitri Holloway and Cardon Johnson hail from nearby Newport News.
- Three players Cole Johnson, Jamir Hudson and Amelio Moran - call Virginia Beach home, and KeShaun Moore is from Suffolk.

GAME ONE NOTES

DINUCCI EFFICIENT IN FIRST START

- Ben DiNucci was announced as the starting quarterback just hours before kickoff and had the most efficient game of his career.
- He currently leads the country with an 85.2 completion percentage after going 23-of-27 for 197 yards and a score.
- DiNucci completed his first 15 passes and found nine different receivers in the game.
- He also led the rushing attack with 79 yards, including two runs over 20 yards.

STAPLETON LEADS WAY AT RECEIVER

- Riley Stapleton made a career-best nine receptions at NC State, often times making catches in double coverage.
- He caught JMU's first touchdown of the season, a five-yard pass from Ben DiNucci.

RUSHING DEFENSE NOT MISSING A BEAT

- The defense was tremendous up front, holding NC State to just 2.9 yards per carry.
- This came with all new starters in the front seven.
- Ron'Dell Carter had a career-high 3.0 tackles for loss and a sack and linebackers Dimitri Holloway and KeShaun Moore combined for 17 tackles.

RASHAD OUT FOR THE SEASON

- · Just before kickoff, it was announced that Rashad Robinson will miss the entire season.
- He sustained a non-contact foot injury late in fall camp and underwent surgery last week.
- Robinson will redshirt and return in 2019 for his senior season.

PREDICTED TO WIN 4TH CAA TITLE IN A ROW

- Winners of three straight Colonial Athletic Association championships, including the last two outright, JMU was the overwhelming favorite to win the CAA in 2018.
- JMU received 21 of 24 first-place votes and were followed by New Hampshire (2 1st-place votes), Delaware, Stony Brook and Elon, which (1 1stplace vote).
- The Dukes are coming off a 14-1 season, advancing to the national championship for the second straight season. They achieved the program's first undefeated and untied regular season (11-0) to earn the top seed for the 2017 FCS Playoffs.
- JMU also became the CAA's first team to go 8-0 in conference play in consecutive seasons.

.500 OR BETTER 15 STRAIGHT YEARS

- JMU's success from year to year has come to be expected, as the Dukes recorded a .500 record or better for a league-best 15th consecutive season in 2017.
- JMU also produced its 13th winning season during the timeframe.
- The Dukes have now had a winning record in 28 of 46 seasons and tallied nine wins for the third straight year in 2016 - a first for the program.

Mike Houston was hired as James Madison University's seventh head football coach on January 18, 2016.

In his two seasons at the helm, he has guided the Dukes to a 28-2 overall record, with back-to-back 14-1 seasons in 2016 and 2017. The 14 wins set a program record for single-season victories. JMU set a CAA- and program-record 26-game win streak between the two seasons, which ranks second all-time in FCS history.

In his first season, Houston and the Dukes won the NCAA Division I Football Championship with a 28-14 win against Youngstown State. JMU made a return trip to the national title game in 2017, falling 17-13 to North Dakota State.

In year two at JMU, Houston led the team to its first-ever undefeated and untied regular season, going 11-0, which included its second straight 8-0 Colonial Athletic Association record to earn a second straight outright championship and a program-record third consecutive CAA title. The Dukes earned the No. 1 seed for the FCS Playoffs for just the second time and earned home playoff wins against Stony Brook (26-7), Weber State (31-28) and South Dakota State (51-16) before falling in the title game to NDSU.

The Dukes led the country in scoring defense, holding teams to just 11.1 points per game. They also paced the FCS in interceptions (31), takeaways (44) and team pass efficiency defense (83.12 rating).

JMU ranked in the top 10 nationally in 14 categories, as it was also third in total defense (252.0), turnover margin (1.47), defensive touchdowns (5) and first downs (325), fourth in punt-return defense (3.33), fifth in sacks (3.4), seventh in rushing defense (90.5), eighth in fumble recoveries (13), ninth in completion percentage (64.9%) and net punting (38.77) and 10th in passing defense (161.5), third-down defense (30.1%), punt-return average (13.0) and blocked punts (2).

Eight players were voted All-Americans in 2017, including Andrew Ankrah, who was named a Consensus All-American after being tabbed to six different All-America First Teams. Ankrah won the FCS ADA Defensive Player of the Year award and finished third for the STATS FCS Buck Buchanan Award.

Joining Ankrah on the All-America list were Aaron Stinnie, Jordan Brown, Rashad Robinson, Raven Greene, Kyre Hawkins, Jahee Jackson and Harry O'Kelly. The Dukes also had 16 All-CAA honorees, which included three players garnering top-league awards. Ankrah was voted Defensive Player of the Year, John Miller tabbed Special Teams Player of the Year and Bryan Schor became JMU's first winner of the Chuck Boone Leadership and Excellence Award.

HEAD COACH MIKE HOUSTON

Following the season, Houston was voted state coach of the year from three organizations. He was voted Touchdown Club of Richmond Bobby Ross Coach of the Year, Virginia Sports Information Directors University Division Coach of the Year and the J. Roy Rodman Award from the Norfolk Sports Club, marking the second straight season he garnered each award. The team was also presented with its second straight ECAC Lambert FCS Division Cup.

JMU finished the 2016 season with a 14-1 record, setting a program record for wins. The Dukes won their final 12 games to end the year with the longest active win streak in all of Division I. During the regular season, Houston led JMU to a perfect 8-0 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play to clinch the outright conference title. It was the second time the Dukes went unbeaten in league play and won the CAA outright.

After going 10-1 in the regular season, JMU earned the No. 4 seed for the FCS playoffs and a first-round bye. The Dukes notched convincing victories at home against New Hampshire (55-22) and previously-unbeaten Sam Houston State (65-7) before conquering five-time defending national champion North Dakota State (27-17) in the national semifinals in Fargo, N.D. The win at NDSU ended the Bison's 22-game playoff win streak and a string of 18 straight home playoff wins.

On Jan. 7, 2017, JMU completed its title run with a 28-14 triumph against Youngstown State in the national championship game at Toyota Stadium in Frisco, Texas. Khalid Abdullah was named the Most Outstanding Player for the championship, and the Dukes limited a strong run team in YSU to only all runking yard by the wife. to only 21 rushing yards in the win.

Houston reeled in numerous accolades in 2016, as he was named the American Football Coaches Association FCS National Coach of the Year. He also earned AFCA Region 1 Coach of the Year for the second straight year and was voted Colonial Athletic Association Coach of the Year, marking the fifth time in his six-year head coaching career that he was tabbed his conference's top coach. Houston reeled in a trio of state coach of the year accolades, as he was named the Bobby Ross Coach of the Year, voted VaSID Coach of the Year and was presented the J. Roy Rodman Award. He was also presented with the Bob Ford FCS Coach of the year from the Metro New York Football Writers and the Washington Metro College Coach of the Year from the DC Touchdown Club.

He coached 14 players to All-CAA status, which included Bryan Schor being named CAA Offensive Player of the Year and Rashard Davis being recognized as CAA Special Teams Player of the Year. JMU had T0 of those 14 make the All-CAA First Team, while seven of the 14 eventually became All-Americans. That list included Abdullah, Schor, Davis, Raven Greene, Mitchell Wirsch Tayle Powelds and Aaron Schmide. Kirsch, Taylor Reynolds and Aaron Stinnie.

JMU set several conference records, including marks for scoring (700), rushing offense (4,125), total offense (7,612) and first downs (380). Nationally, JMU led the FCS in winning percentage (93.3%), completion percentage (70.8%), team pass efficiency (181.69), first downs (380), defensive interceptions (21) and punt return average (26.65).

The Dukes also ranked second in scoring (46.7), fourth in third down conversions (50%), fifth in both rushing (275.0) and turnovers gained (30), sixth in fumbles lost (4), eighth in turnover margin (1.13) and 10th in turnovers lost (13). Offensively, JMU produced 18 100-yard rushing performances from it strong rushing attack, including Abdullah, who had a team-high 11 games with more than 100 yards.

Defensively, JMU saw a drastic improvement from the previous two seasons, as it ranked 17th in scoring defense (21.2) and 30th in total defense (344.3). The Dukes allowed 7.5 fewer points per game this season and nearly 60 yards fewer per

outing from 2015 to 2016. JMU forced seven more turnovers and nearly doubled its interception production, going from 11 in 2015 to a nation-leading 21 in 2016.

During conference play, JMU completed its road gauntlet with victories at Maine, New Hampshire, Richmond and Villanova. Those four teams finished second through fifth in the CAA standings and three made the postseason in UNH, UR and VU. It was JMU's first win at New Hampshire since 2006 and the first at Villanova since 2008. first at Villanova since 2008.

Possessing 10 years of collegiate coaching experience, including five as a head coach, Houston came to Harrisonburg after serving two years as head coach at The Citadel (2014-15). He led the Bulldogs to a 14-11 record in his two seasons and is the only coach in The Citadel's history to win a Southern Conference championship within his first two seasons.

In 2015, he guided the Bulldogs to the program's fourth winning season since 1995 with a 9-4 record and a share of the 2015 SoCon title. The Citadel boasted a conference-best the 2013 SOCDI title. The chader boasted a contentice best +117 scoring margin, including a +100 edge during league play, and Houston went on to be named SoCon Coach of the Year and AFCA Region 2 Coach of the Year. They also defeated Southeastern Conference member South Carolina 23-22 in the regular-season finale and advanced to the second round of the FCS playoffs after upsetting ninth-ranked Coastal Carolina. Carolina

In the first-round playoff victory, Houston's run game broke a school record with four 100-yard rushers as it piled up 524 yards on the ground, the most in a NCAA playoff game since 2012 and the second-highest in 2015 for FCS, only behind the Bulldogs' nation-best 535 rushing yards in the season opener.

The Citadel broke school records for all-purpose yards, total offense, rushing yards and interception return yards. The Bulldogs led the nation with a school-record 515 interception return yards and five interception return touchdowns. The Citadel led the Southern and ranked second nationally with 346.9 rushing yards per game, an average of 17.21 yards per completion and just 0.62 sacks allowed per game.

The Bulldogs also led the league in interceptions, tackles for loss allowed, turnovers forced, yards per rush, rushing touchdowns, punt return defense, passing touchdowns allowed, fumble recoveries, third-down defense, tackles for loss and kickoff return defense.

Prior to The Citadel, Houston was head coach at Lenoir-Rhyne, an NCAA Division II school in the South Atlantic Conference, for three seasons. He accumulated a 29-8 record at the helm and directed the Bears to three consecutive SAC championships, a stretch that included a school-record 13 wins in his final year.

Houston was named SAC Coach of the Year each season and was also the Don Hansen Super Region II Coach of the Year in 2013. In his final season at LRU, the Bears advanced to the Division II national championship game and ranked No. 2 in the final polls.

Before his elevation to head coach, Houston served as Lenoir-Rhyne's defensive coordinator and secondary coach from 2007-10. He spent the 2006 year as associate head coach and defensive coordinator at Brevard College.

Houston is a 1994 graduate of Mars Hill University, where he played tight end for the Lions and earned a bachelor's degree in biology. In 2014, Houston was inducted into the Franklin High School Athletic Hall of Fame.

He is married to the former Amanda Owen and they have two sons, Owen Michael and Reid Wilson.

Dukes Drop Opener, 24-13, at NC State

RALEIGH, N.C. - Second-ranked James Madison scored the game's first touchdown and limited NC State to only 2.9 yards per rush, but a 17-point spurt in the second quarter gave way for a 24-13 Wolfpack win on Saturday afternoon at Carter-Finley Stadium.

NCSU improved to 1-0 on the young season while the Dukes fell to 0-1, marking their first season-opening loss since the 2014 campaign at Mary-

- JMU passed for 202 yards, 197 of which came from junior Ben DiNucci, who also threw a touchdown pass in his debut with the Dukes.

- game-long 24-yard run Redshirt junior Riley Stapleton led the team with a career-high nine catches for 88 yards and a touchdown, which put JMU up 7-0 late in the
- Senior Marcus Marshall ran for 65 yards, including a long of 26 yards, while playing against his hometown team.
- The Wolfpack overcame the early deficit with three scoring plays in the second quarter, with a field goal and two passing touchdowns by Ryan Finley – the latter coming with only 18 seconds to go in the first half.
- Redshirt sophomore Ethan Ratke cut into NC State's lead with a pair of second-half field goals - both from 19 yards out - to make it 17-13 with 6:59 to play.
- NCSU answered with an 84-yard drive over 11 plays, capped off by a rushing touchdown by Reggie Gallaspy with just over a minute to go.

STARTING ON A HIGH

- Three receivers redshirt junior Mack Cullen and redshirt freshmen Josh Sims and Kyndel Dean - all made their first career catches. Sims was second for JMU with four catches for 32 yards and Cullen and Dean
- Junior Adam Smith led the Dukes with a career-high 10 tackles (7 solo) in his first start at safety, while four others produced at least seven stops. Redshirt junior Ron Dell Carter paced the defense up front, with career
- bests of seven tackles and three tackles-for-loss. He also added the team's lone sack.
- Redshirt junior Dimitri Holloway tallied nine tackles and a forced fumble in his first game since last year's opener, and redshirt freshman KeShaun Moore put together a career-high eight stops and a tackle for loss in his first career game.
- Redshirt sophomore D'Angelo Amos also registered a career-high seven tackles at safety while adding a breakup.

 Also making his first start at defensive line, sophomore Mike Greene recovered a fumble in the first quarter off the Holloway force.

 Freshman Mateo Jackson came off the bench to record five stops in his first career outing.

DINUCCI EFFICIENT IN START

- DiNucci completed a career-best 23 passes on 27 attempts (85.2%) with a touchdown after earning the starting job for the Dukes.
- He completed his first 15 passes of the game and also ran the ball 14 times a career high. His 197 passing yards was 31 shy of his career high from last season's game against Oklahoma State when he played at Pitt. DiNucci was only four yards off his career mark in rushing he had 83 last season against North Carolina.

OTHER GAME NOTES

- JMU, playing in its 47th year, is now 25-21-1 all-time in season openers. The Dukes nearly doubled NC State in the run game, out-rushing the 'Pack 163-83. NCSU had 25 first downs, to JMU's 23, and held a 392-365 total yards advantage
- Finley threw for 309 yards and two touchdowns, and Jakobi Meyers had a huge receiving game, with 14 catches for 161 yards. CJ Riley and Thayer Thomas each caught second-quarter touchdowns.
- The teams were even in yards per play, at 5.4 per snap.
- JMU won the time-of-possession battle, with the offense on the field for 31:42, and each team forced one turnover, later resulting in a touchdown.






