- The opening draw is set for 12:30 p.m. at Sentara Park and will be televised on NBC Sports Washington and NBC Sports Philadelphia Plus.
- This marks the 45th meeting all-time between the teams, with Maryland leading 41-3, which includes an 11-game win streak in the series.
- The 2019 JMU lacrosse season is presented by O'Neill's Grill.

#### JMU-MARYLAND SERIES BY THE NUMBERS

- The JMU-Maryland series dates back to 1974 and played for 30 straight seasons until 2003. The teams picked things back up in 2008 and have met every year since.
- The Terrapins are riding an 11-game win streak in the series, with four meetings being decided by four goals or less, including a 15-12 Maryland win last season in College Park JMU's lone loss in 2018.
- Maryland is 18-2 all-time in games played in Harrisonburg.
- The Dukes have only played four other teams more than Maryland in their history William & Mary (65), Virginia (51), Richmond (47) and Delaware (45).
- JMU last win against the Terps came back on April 5, 2003 (9-8 in College Park) and the Dukes last won a home game in the series back on April 6, 2002 (11-10).

#### VIRGNIA SNAPS JMU WIN STREAK

- Virginia used a five-goal run in the first half and three Cavaliers recorded hat tricks to upend JMU 14-9 on March 20, 2019 at Sentara Park.
- The loss ended JMU's 7-game win streak and a 19-game home win streak, dating back to March 25, 2017.
- Avery Shoemaker scored five goals with an assist while Lillie Kloak had four goals and a helper. Nora Bowen had three tallies and Sammy Mueller added five assists.
- JMU was led by Halle Duenkel, who had three goals and an assist. Hanna Haven and Charlotte Haggerty
  each scored twice and Katie Checkosky added two assists.
- Caroline Sdanowich also had a career-high eight draw controls, helping JMU win the circle battle 15-10. That marked the first time the Dukes won more draws and didn't win.
- The Dukes also failed to score on three player-up opportunities, and UVA had both a player-up and player-down goal in the second half.

#### JMU CELEBRATES 50TH ANNIVERSARY

- This weekend marks the 50th anniversary celebration of JMU lacrosse, which began 50 years ago in 1969.
- The 50th season in 2018 was capped off by the team winning the first lacrosse national championship.
- JMU has won 61 percent of its all-time games, going 485-310-3 (798 games).
- The Dukes have won 11 Colonial Athletic Association championships and has been to the NCAA Championship 15 times.
- JMU has produced 59 All-Americans, 14 CAA Players of the Year and 29 CAA major award winner. Three have also been named finalists for the Tewaaraton Award.

#### SCOUTING MARYLAND

- The Terrapins enter Sunday's matchup with a 9-0 record following a dominant 17-6 win at No. 23 Penn State this past Wednesday.
- Maryland has won four games by double digits, which includes holding both Ohio State and UMBC to just one goal.
- The Terps average 15.56 goals per game while allowing 7.33 goals to their foes.
- Jen Giles leads the team with 22 goals and 10 assists, and Kali Hartshorn has tallied 20 goals, three assists and 40 draw controls.
- Caroline Steele has scored 18 goals, while Erica Evans and Grace Griffin each have 15 scores.
- Megan Taylor has an 8.14 GAA with a .583 save percentage to lead Maryland to each win.
- Cathy Reese is in her 13th season at the helm, leading the Terrapins to four national championships, 10 championship weekends.

#### RECAPPING LAST JMU-UMD MEETING

- Last season, JMU suffered its lone defeat on March 24, 2018, falling 15-12 at Maryland.
- Kristen Gaudian had four goals, one assist and a career-high eight draws in the loss. Elena Romesburg also had three goals.
- Grace Griffin paced the Terps with four goals and one helper, and Megan Whittle had three goals and two assists.
- Maryland scored four straight to grab a 7-3 lead, but the Dukes put together three straight late in the game to make it a 14-12 game. Megan Taylor made a big stop with three minutes to play and the Terps scored at the other end to ice the game.

- Sunday's game features former high school teammates at Severn School in Maryland on opposite sidelines.
- JMU's Maddie McDaniel takes on Maryland senior attacker Caroline Steele and sophomore midfielder Brooke Robbins.
- McDaniel graduated from Severn in 2016, while Steele is a 2015 grad and Robbins is a 2017 graduate.
- McDaniel and Robbins reached the conference semis in 2016, a year in which McDaniel was team captain and a US Lacrosse All-American.

- JMU saw its seven-game win streak come to an end Wednesday, but the Dukes have seen a drastic
  improvement on the draw after a 22-5 setback in the circle in the season opener.
- Over the past eight games, JMU has a +37 margin in draw controls, led by 39 wins for Maddie McDaniel and 34 by Caroline Sdanowich.
- JMU has won 15 or more draw in five of the last seven outings.

#### THREE ON TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

- Three JMU players in Hanna Haven, Caroline Sdanowich and Molly Dougherty were named to the 2019 Tewaaraton Award Watch List.
- It marks the second straight season JMU placed three players on the initial watch list.
- The Tewaaraton Award, now in its 19th season, is presented annually to the top male and female collegiate
  lacrosse players in the United States. The selection committees are comprised of premier collegiate coaches
  and are appointed each year by the Tewaaraton Foundation.
- The Dukes were one of nine Division I programs with at least three honorees. Maryland led the country with six while Boston College and Florida also had four picks.

#### DUKES THE FAVORITE TO WIN CAA

- JMU was voted the favorite to win the Colonial Athletic Association title for a third straight season in 2019.
- The Dukes received six first-place votes and 36 points, while rival Towson was selected second with one
  first-place vote and 31 points. Elon was third, followed by Hofstra, Delaware, Drexel and William & Mary.
- JMU has won the CAA regular-season title in seven of the past nine seasons, winning five tournament championships during that span. The Dukes have claimed the regular-season crown in each of the previous three seasons, winning the tournament in 2017 and 2018.
- Six players were honored, as making the Preseason All-CAA Team were Hanna Haven, Charlotte Haggerty, Emma Johnson, Caroline Sdanowich and Molly Dougherty. Maddie McDaniel was also Honorable Mention.

#### DOUGHERTY, HAGGERTY PLAY FOR TEAM USA

- A pair of JMU sophomores were afforded the opportunity to compete with the best players in the world, as both were part of Team USA.
- Both Molly Dougherty and Charlotte Haggerty were named to the U.S. National Team's roster at the IWLCA President's Cup in Lake Buena Vista, Fla. in November.
- From there, Dougherty also earned a roster spot for the team's trip to Palo Alto, Calif., for the Spring Premiere
  at Stanford in January.
- Additionally, 2018 All-American Elena Romesburg joined Dougherty and Haggerty on Team USA back in November.
