DUKES BEGIN FINAL REGULAR-SEASON WEEK AGAINST ELON

- JMU returns home for the final regular-season stretch on Friday when it takes on Elon. This is JMU's
 penultimate game of the regular season.
- The opening draw is set for 5 p.m. at Sentara Park.
- This marks the sixth installment of the series, with JMU holding a perfect 5-0 record.
- The 2019 JMU lacrosse season is presented by O'Neill's Grill.

JMU-ELON SERIES BY THE NUMBERS

- JMU and Elon have met five times previously, with the first meeting coming back in 2015 when Elon joined the Colonial Athletic Association.
- The Dukes lead the all-time series 5-0, including a 2-0 mark at home.
- JMU has won of the five games by at least eight goals and two by double digits. Last season, JMU turned in its second-largest win against Elon, with a 15-3 win on the road.
- Elon came within two goals of JMU back in 2016 the closest margin in the series.
- Over the five games, JMU has averaged wins by a margin of 15.0 to 5.4.

CAA PICTURE ENTERING THE WEEK

- · Following the second week of conference play, JMU holds a game-and-a-half lead for first place, at 4-0.
- Hofstra and Towson, which meet on Friday, are in a tie for second place at 2-1. Elon is fourth at 2-2.
- Rounding out the league are Drexel at 1-2, William & Mary at 1-3 and Delaware at 0-3.
- The top-four teams at the end of the regular season advance to the CAA Women's Lacrosse Championship, which JMU will host on May 3 and 5.
- With a win on Friday, JMU will clinch the top seed for the CAA Championship and at least a share of the CAA regular-season title.

DOUGHERTY REPEATS AS CAA'S TOP DEFENDER

- For the second straight week, Molly Dougherty is the CAA Defensive Player of the Week.
- She tallied 18 saves with a .545 save percentage and 7.57 goals against average in JMU's two road wins at Drexel and Hofstra to keep the Dukes atop the CAA standings.
- Her week was highlighted by Sunday's performance at Hofstra, as she made 16 saves with a .667 save percentage against the league's top scoring offense.

- Maddie McDaniel fired home the gamewinning goal 2:55 into double overtime to lift JMU to a 9-8 victory at Hofstra.
- JMU trailed 7-5 late before a 3-0 run gave the Dukes an 8-7 lead with 4:04 to play. Hofstra tied it with 26 seconds left to force overtime.
- Hanna Haven, who assisted on the gamewinner, had a game-high five points on two goals and three assists.
- McDaniel and Katie Checkosky each scored twice, and Logan Brennan tallied a goal and two assists.
- Molly Dougherty turned away 67% of Hofstra's shots, making 16 saves for the second-highest saves total of her career.

- · March 23-24 marked the 50th anniversary celebration of JMU lacrosse, which began in 1969.
- The 50th season in 2018 was capped off by the team winning the first lacrosse national championship.
- The Dukes have won 11 Colonial Athletic Association championships and has been to the NCAA Championship 15 times.
- JMU has produced 59 All-Americans, 14 CAA Players of the Year and 29 CAA major award winner. Three have also been named finalists for the Tewaaraton Award.

THREE ON TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

- Three JMU players in Hanna Haven, Caroline Sdanowich and Molly Dougherty were named to the 2019 Tewaaraton Award Watch List.
- · It marks the second straight season JMU placed three players on the initial watch list.
- The Tewaaraton Award, now in its 19th season, is presented annually to the top male and female collegiate lacrosse players in the United States. The selection committees are comprised of premier collegiate coaches and are appointed each year by the Tewaaraton Foundation.
- · The Dukes were one of nine Division I programs with at least three honorees. Maryland led the country with six while Boston College and Florida also had four picks.
