TOP-SEED DUKES FACE OFF WITH ELON IN CAA SEMIFINALS

- JMU begins postseason play on Friday, as it hosts Elon in the CAA Championship semifinals.
- The opening draw is set for 4 p.m. at Sentara Park.
- · This marks the seventh meeting all-time between the teams and the second in the CAA Championship
- The 2019 JMU lacrosse season is presented by O'Neill's Grill.

JMU HISTORY IN CAA CHAMPIONSHIP

- JMU is making its 25th appearance in the CAA Championship since joining the league in 1992.
- The Dukes are 37-13 (.740) all-time in the CAA postseason, claiming a conference-best 11 tournament titles. That included them winning the last two tournament crowns.
- JMU has been either the No. 1 or No. 2 seed in each of the last 10 seasons, including the No. 1 seed in five including a program-record four straight tournaments.
- The program is 15-3 when holding the No. 1 seed, and the Dukes have advanced to the title game in eight of nine appearances as the top seed.
- This is the sixth time JMU has hosted the CAA Championship. The Dukes have won the title in four of the five times it previously served as the host.
- By virtue of winning the outright regular-season title, JMU will also host the 2020 Championship next year
- Breaking down JMU's records against the tournament field, the Dukes are 1-0 against Elon, 4-3 against Towson and 4-2 against Hofstra.

SDANOWICH, DOUGHERTY, KLAES-BAWCOMBE HEADLINE CAA AWARDS

- JMU reeled in three major CAA yearly awards and nine total players were recognized on the 2019 CAA allconference team in a vote by the league's seven head coaches.
- Caroline Sdanowich was voted CAA Defensive Player of the Year, Molly Dougherty was tabbed CAA Goalkeeper of the Year and Head Coach Shelley Klaes-Bawcombe was named Coach of the Year.
- It's the second straight year a JMU player was named the league's top defender. Dougherty was the winner
 of the inaugural goalkeeping award. For Klaes-Bawcombe, it's her fourth straight Coach of the Year award
 and the fifth during her tenure at JMU.
- · Joining Sdanowich and Dougherty on the All-CAA First Team were Hanna Haven and Maddie McDaniel.
- Taking home Second Team All-CAA honors were Logan Brennan, Kelsey Reed and Emma Johnson. Earning All-Rookie Team accolades were the JMU pair of Lizzy Fox and Rachel Matey.
- JMU led all teams with seven all-conference selections and nine total honorees.

SCOUTING ELON

- The Phoenix enters Friday's CAA semifinal with a 6-11 record after earning the No. 4 seed with a 3-3 conference record.
- Elon averages 9.24 goals per game while allowing 12.29 to its foes.
- The Phoenix rank last in both scoring offense and scoring defense.
- Elon had a pair of Second Team All-CAA honorees in midfielder Quinn Daly and defender Shannon Horan.
- Midfielder Kaley Thompson was also voted CAA Rookie of the Year.
- Mae McGlynn leads the team with 40 goals, while Thompson is second with 31 goals and seven assists.
- Josh Hexter is in his seventh season at the helm, holding a 49-53 record. He guided Elon to the 2018 NCAA Championship.
- He is also 121-95 for his career, as he was previously head coach at Bridgewater State before an eight-year stint on the staff at Duke.

JMU-ELON SERIES BY THE NUMBERS

- JMU and Elon have met six times previously, with the first meeting coming back in 2015 when Elon joined the CAA.
- The Dukes lead the all-time series 6-0. That includes a 3-0 mark at home, with a 16-8 win back on April 19 in Harrisonburg.
- JMU has won five of the six games by at least eight goals and two by double digits. Last season, JMU turned in its second-largest win against Elon, with a 15-3 win on the road.
- Elon came within two goals of JMU back in 2016, which is the closest margin in the series.
- Over the six games, JMU has averaged wins by a margin of 15.2 to 5.8.
- The teams have meet in the CAA Championship once before, as the Dukes beat the Phoenix 15-7 in the 2017 title game in Towson, Md.

RECAPPING LAST JMU-ELON MEETING

- Back on April 19 2019, JMU used a big first-half run and 10 different scorers to upend Elon, 16-8.
- Hanna Haven had six points on four goals and two assists. Katie Checkosky had a career-best five points on a goal and career-high four assists.
- Maddie McDaniel won 11 draw controls, which was the second highest total in JMU singlegame history.
- Caroline Sdanowich had three caused turnovers.
- JMU nearly doubled shots by a 37-19 margin.
 The Dukes won all three hustle-stat categories, with leads in draws (18-8), caused turnovers (12-3) and ground balls (15-9).

DUKES TOP-10 IN BOTH POLLS

- James Madison enters the postseason in the top 10, ranking 10th in the IWLCA Division I Coaches Poll and ninth in the Inside Lacrosse Women DI Media Poll.
- The Dukes held strong in the media poll but fell a spot to round out the top 10 by the coaches.
- JMU is the lone CAA team to be ranked, as Hofstra is receiving votes from the media.
- Maryland took over the top spot in both major polls this week. Boston College is second in the coaches poll, and North Carolina is second in the media poll. Syracuse is fourth and Northwestern in fifth in both polls.

HISTORY AS REGULAR-SEASON CHAMPS

- JMU clinched the outright regular-season title for the third straight season and claimed at least a share for the fourth consecutive year.
- The Dukes have won eight CAA regular-season crowns since the 2010 season and 13 total since joining the CAA in 1992.
- JMU's 6-0 CAA record this season marked the sixth season the Dukes went unbeaten in conference play.
- This is also JMU's 10th time as the CAA's top seed for the CAA Women's Lacrosse Championship.

WHAT LIES AHEAD

- JMU is a win away from playing for its 12th CAA Championship tournament title, as it seeks a program-record three straight crowns.
- JMU has played in the past five CAA title games, winning in 2015, 2017 and 2018.
- The winner of #1 JMU and #4 Elon will meet the victor in the second semifinal, featuring #2 Towson and #3 Hofstra.
- Game time for Sunday's title bout is set for noon.

2019 SENIOR CLASS A WIN AWAY

- JMU 2019 senior class is currently the secondwinningest class in the program's 51-season history, amassing a 60-21 record.
- That is just one win shy of the record, set by last year's seniors, who went 61-23.
- Should the Dukes win the CAA tournament title, it will set the new wins record by a senior class.
- JMU's 2019 seniors were part of last year's first national-championship team, has made it to the NCAA tournament every season and has won back-to-back CAA tourney championships.

JMU CELEBRATED 50TH ANNIVERSARY

- March 23-24 marked the 50th anniversary celebration of JMU lacrosse, which began in 1969.
- The 50th season in 2018 was capped off by the team winning the first lacrosse national championship.
- The Dukes have won 11 Colonial Athletic Association championships and has been to the NCAA Championship 15 times.
- JMU has produced 59 All-Americans, 14 CAA Players of the Year and 29 CAA major award winner. Three have also been named finalists for the Tewaaraton Award.

SDANOWICH A TEWAARATON NOMINEE

- Caroline Sdanowich was honored as one of the top-25 women's collegiate players, as she was named a Tewaaraton Award nominee.
- · She is the lone CAA player on the list.
- · It's the second straight year the Dukes have a top-25 nominee, as both Kristen Gaudian and Haley Warden earned spots last season. Gaudian eventually went on to be one of the program's three all-time finalists.
- Sdanowich is JMU's first true defender to make the top-25 nominee list for the Tewaaraton.
- Earlier this season, she, along with Hanna Haven and Molly Dougherty were recognized on the Tewaaraton Award Watch List.
- The Tewaaraton Award, now in its 19th season, is presented annually to the top male and female collegiate lacrosse players in the United States.
- · The selection committees are comprised of premier collegiate coaches and are appointed each year by the Tewaaraton Foundation.

SDANOWICH DRAFTED BY WPLL BRAVE

- Caroline Sdanowich became JMU's first defensive player to be drafted into the Women's Professional Lacrosse League, as she was selected in the fourth round and with the 19th overall pick by the Brave.
- She joins former JMU teammate Kristen Gaudian on a team coached by Towson Head Coach Sonia Lamonica.
- JMU now has five players in the WPLL, as the trio of Elena Romesburg, Haley Warden and Katie Kerrigan play for the WPLL Pride.

DOUGHERTY, HAGGERTY PLAY FOR TEAM USA

- · A pair of JMU sophomores were afforded the opportunity to compete with the best players in the world, as both were part of Team USA.
- · Both Molly Dougherty and Charlotte Haggerty were named to the U.S. National Team's roster at the IWLCA President's Cup in Lake Buena Vista, Fla. in November.
- · From there, Dougherty also earned a roster spot for the team's trip to Palo Alto, Calif., for the Spring Premiere at Stanford in January.
- Additionally, 2018 All-American Elena Romesburg joined Dougherty and Haggerty on Team USA back in November.
