## FOR THE THRONE: JMU BEGINS TITLE DEFENSE AGAINST STONY BROOK

- James Madison, the defending national champions, opens NCAA Championship play with a first-round bout against 15th-ranked Stony Brook on Friday in College Park, Md.
- The opening draw is set for 4 p.m. at Capital One Field at Maryland Stadium.
- This marks the first-ever meeting between the two teams.
- The 2019 JMU lacrosse season is presented by O'Neill's Grill.

## JMU HISTORY IN NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

- The Dukes are making their 16th appearance in the NCAA postseason, holding a 12-14 record.
- This marks the fifth straight NCAA Championship appearance, which is just the second time in team history the Dukes have gone to the postseason in five straight years (1997-01).
- JMU is the defending national champion, going 22-1 last season en route to winning the program's first national title with a 16-15 win against Boston College.
- The Dukes also beat Virginia (15-12) in the second round, Florida (11-8) in the quarterfinals and North Carolina (15-12) in the national semifinals before holding off BC for the title.
- JMU is 8-3 in games played at home, to go with a 1-8 road record and 3-3 neutral-site mark.
- Should JMU advance, it will mark its third NCAA Tournament meeting with Maryland, as the Terrapins won in 1998 and 2001.

## BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK CAA CHAMPS!

- JMU's third straight CAA tournament title was never in doubt, as it rolled to double-digit victories in both the semifinals and title game, cruising past Elon (16-5) and Hofstra (13-3) to win the 2019 CAA Championship.
- The Dukes won three straight CAA Championships crowns for the first time in program history and for the second time in the league's history.
- It was also JMU's 12th CAA tournament championship, which leads all conference teams.
- The Dukes set a CAA Championship record for fewest goals allowed in a CAA title game, and it was the program's largest margin of victory in a championship final.

## MCDANIEL NAMED MOP OF CAA CHAMPIONSHIP

- Following JMU's tournament title, Maddie McDaniel was voted CAA Championship Most Outstanding Performer after turning in a pair of four-goal outings and averaging 8.0 draw controls per game.
- It's the third straight championship that JMU's draw specialist has won the MOP, as Haley Warden won the award both in 2017 and 2018.
- Joining McDaniel on the All-Tournament Team were Hanna Haven (5g, 3a), Caroline Sdanowich (6ct, 6dc) and Molly Dougherty (17sv, 4.0 GAA, .680 sv%, 4gb).

**SCOUTING STONY BROOK**

- The Seawolves enter the NCAA Championship with a 15-4 record, riding an 11-game win streak after capturing the America East title.
- Stony Brook averages 15.37 goals per game while allowing 7.42 to its foes, which is third nationally. Its +7.95 scoring margin is fourth among all NCAA Division I schools.
- SBU also leads the country in free-position percentage (.538), third in fewest turnovers (12.21) and eighth in assists (8.0).
- Ally Kennedy ranks sixth in the NCAA in goals per game (4.21), having scored 80 on the year. She is also 10th in free-position goals (1.32) and 11th in free-position percentage (.610).
- Anna Tesoriero is third nationally in goals against average (7.59).
- Joe Spallina is in his eighth year at the helm, holding a 138-25 record. He's guided SBU to back-to-back NCAA quarterfinal appearances.
- Before Stony Brook, he led powerhouse Adelphi to three straight D2 national titles and has a career 211-27 record in 12 seasons.

**VAN DYKE FACES FORMER TEAM**

- First-year assistant coach Dorrien Van Dyke coaches in her first career NCAA Championship game against the school she graduated from.
- Van Dyke was a standout midfielder for the Seawolves from 2014-17.
- She's one of SBU's all-time leading scorers, finishing her career as the school's second-leading goal scorer (195). She was also sixth in assists (81) and third in points (266).
- Van Dyke was a three-time First Team All-Region and four-time First Team All-America East pick and a 2017 nominee for the Tewaaraton Award.
- She helped Stony Brook to four straight conference titles and NCAA berths, including the program's first quarterfinal appearance during her senior season in 2017.

**FIRST AMERICA EAST FOE IN A WHILE**

- JMU rarely sees America East teams, as Friday marks the first time the Dukes have faced one in the NCAA Championship.
- It's also the first time in 18 years JMU will play an America East team when it faced Delaware and Boston University back in 2001.
- The majority of JMU's games against the league are versus Towson and Delaware before they joined the CAA in 2002.
- The Dukes are 10-1 all-time vs. the America East.

**WHAT AWAITS THE VICTOR**

- The winner of Friday's first round faces top-seeded Maryland in Sunday's second round.
- The Terrapins are 18-1 on the year, with their lone loss coming to Northwestern in the Big Ten title game last weekend.
- It's the seventh straight year Maryland has claimed the No. 1 seed and the 30th straight NCAA Championship appearance.

**MCDANIEL SETS SEASON DRAWS RECORD**

- Maddie McDaniel became the JMU single-season record holder for most draw controls on May 3 during the CAA semifinals.
- She surpassed Haley Warden's 2018 record of 108 draw controls, which was also the CAA single-season record.
- She needed seven in the semifinal to take the top spot and won nine in JMU's 16-5 win over Elon. In the title game she added seven more.
- Through 19 games, McDaniel has won a JMU-record 118 draw controls.
- Though she has passed Warden's CAA record, she trails Hofstra's Darcie Smith, who has 121 this season.

**WINNINGEST SENIOR CLASS**

- JMU's 2019 senior class has won more games than any other class before them, amassing a 62-21 record.
- With their win in the CAA championship game, the 2019 group passed the 2018 seniors, who put together a 61-23 record during their careers.
- JMU's 2019 seniors were part of last year's first national-championship team, has made it to the NCAA tournament every season and has won a program-record three straight CAA tournament titles.
- In the history of the team, seven classes have won at least 50 games over their careers.

- Caroline Sdanowich was honored as one of the top-25 women's collegiate players, as she was named a Tewaaraton Award nominee.
- She is the lone CAA player on the list.
- It's the second straight year the Dukes have a top-25 nominee, as both Kristen Gaudian and Haley Warden earned spots last season. Gaudian eventually went on to be one of the program's three all-time finalists.
