DUKES OPEN 2019 CAMPAIGN AGAINST MOUNTAINEERS

- JMU opens its 48th season of football on Saturday, Aug. 31 when traveling to Morgantown, W.Va., to face West Virginia out the Big 12 Conference.
- Kickoff is set for 2 p.m. at Milan Puskar Stadium and will be televised on AT&T SportsNet Pittsburgh. Pregame coverage on the JMU Sprint Broadcast Network begins at 1 p.m.
- Saturday marks the third meeting all-time, with WVU winning the first two matchups. The teams first met in 2004 in Morgantown, with West Virginia taking a 45-10 win. Eight years later, the two faced off at FedEx Field, home of the Washington Redskins, as WVU won 42-12.
- It also marks JMU's first meeting against a team from the Big 12 Conference.

JMU AGAINST FBS OPPONENTS

- JMU's opener is the 28th game all-time against the Football Bowl Subdivision.
- The Dukes are 6-21 in those meetings, with two wins each against squads from the ACC, American and an Independent.
- JMU has won two of its last four against the FBS, both of which coming against American Athletic Conference teams SMU in 2015 (48-45) and East Carolina in 2017 (34-14).
- JMU has captured two wins against the ACC in 11 tries, beating Virginia in 1982 (21-17) and a historic victory at Virginia Tech in 2010 (21-16).
- JMU's two other FBS wins came in back-to-back seasons with triumphs at Navy in 1989 (24-20) and 1990 (16-7).
- The Dukes have played one FBS team a year in each of the past 12 seasons, going 3-9 during that span.

JMU IN SEASON OPENERS

- JMU is 25-21-1 all-time in season openers dating back to the 1972 inaugural season.
- Before last season's 24-13 setback at NC State, JMU had won three straight to open the year, which included a 34-14 win at FBS foe ECU in 2017's first outing.
- The past six season-opening defeats have come at the hands of FBS programs, as JMU has not lost an opener to an FCS team since 2002.

CIGNETTI BACK IN MORGANTOWN

- Game one for JMU Head Coach Curt Cignetti is a special one, as he returns to his alma mater for the opener against WVU.
- He was a member of the Mountaineer football team from 1979-82. Cignetti graduated in 1982, earning his bachelor's degree in business administration.
- Cignetti's father, Frank Sr., was also at WVU from 1970-79, serving as the head coach for his final four seasons.

SCOUTING WEST VIRGINIA

- The Mountaineers are coming off an 8-4 record last season, finishing tied for third in the Big 12 with a 6-3 conference mark.
- WVU averaged 40.3 points while allowing 27.2 to foes.
- It returns 40 lettermen and 13 starters, including four on offense, five on defense and four specialists.
- WVU was picked to finish 8th in the Big 12 in 2019.
- The offense will be led Oklahoma transfer quarterback Austin Kendall, who was named the starter. He's played in eight career games, including six last season.
- Running back Kennedy McKoy has rushed for over 1,800 yards in his career with 19 touchdowns.
- Offensive lineman Colton McKivitz was also named Preseason All-Big 12 and tight end Jovana Haskins was named to the Mackey Award Watch List, which honors the country's best tight end.
- Defensively, WVU returns two players who had at least 50 tackles last year in Josh Norwood (64 tkl, 11 pbu) and JoVanni Stewart (54 tkl, 4.0 sacks).
- WVU is led by first-year head coach Neal Brown, who spent the last four years at Troy, going 35-16. He's one of six FBS coaches to win 10+ games in each of the past three seasons. He was named Sun Belt Coach of the Year after guiding the Trojans to the 2017 conference title.

LAST TIME JMU & WVU MET

- JMU and West Virginia last met on Sept. 15, 2012 at FedEx Field in Landover, Md., with the Mountaineers coming away with a 42-12 win.
- WVU scored touchdowns on each of its first four possessions, including three touchdown passes from Geno Smith.
- Jauan Latney notched JMU's lone touchdown, scoring on a 20-yard rush in the fourth quarter, and the Dukes also forced WVU into a safety in the third quarter.

DUKES OPEN SEASON AT #2

- JMU opens 2019 ranking second in the STATS FCS Top 25 after receiving 14 first-place votes.
- Defending champion North Dakota State took home the top spot. Following JMU were #3 South Dakota State, #4 Eastern Washington and #5 UC Davis.
- Five CAA teams were ranked. In addition to JMU, Maine (#7), Towson (#11), Elon (#21) and Delaware (#22) were also ranked.
- The Dukes also ranked #2 in the AFCA Coaches Top 25 and #1 in the HERO Sports FCS Top 25.

- A total of seven JMU players were named Preseason All-Americans.

ROBINSON UP FOR THE BUCHANAN

- For the second straight season, Rashad Robinson was one of 25 athletes selected in the preseason to the STATS FCS Buck Buchanan Watch List.
- The award honors the top defensive player in the FCS.
- Robinson missed the entire 2018 season due to a foot injury, but came off an All-American campaign in 2017, in which he was third nationally with seven interceptions.
- Two former Dukes have won the award in Arthur Moats (2009) and Derrick Lloyd (2001).

O'KELLY ON PUNTER WATCH LIST

- Harry O'Kelly was one of 28 FCS punters selected to the preseason watch list for FCS Punter of the Year.
- O'Kelly is a two-time Second Team All-CAA selection, averaging 40.1 yards per punt over his first two seasons at JMU.
- Last year, he had a 38.7 punt average while turning in a 41.3 punt average in 2017. He has 49 career punts inside the 20 and 12 over 50 yards.

DINUCCI ON TO CFPA WATCH LIST

- Ben DiNucci was one of 40 players named to the CFPA FCS National Performer of the Year Watch List.
- The winner is selected exclusively based upon objective scientific rankings of the extent to which individual players increase the overall effectiveness of their teams.
- DiNucci, a Third-Team All-CAA selection last season, passed for 2,275 yards and 16 touchdowns while ranking third nationally with a 68.3% completion percentage. He also rushed for 433 yards and a team-high nine touchdowns.

JMU PICKED TO RECLAIM CAA

- JMU is the overwhelming favorite to win the CAA Football title in 2019. The Dukes received 20 of 24 first-place votes.
- Following them were #2 Towson and #3 Maine.
- JMU finished 9-4 last season and was 6-2 in the CAA to finish second. It advanced to the FCS Playoffs for a program-record fourth-straight season in 2018, reaching the Second Round.
- JMU returns 19 starters (9 offense, 10 defense) while also bringing back All-American Rashad Robinson, who missed last year to an injury.

Curt Cignetti became the eighth head coach in JMU football history on December 14, 2018.

Cignetti has climbed the ladder throughout a 36-year football coaching career that has included multiple Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) stops and a 67-26 record (.720) in eight years as a head coach, six at NCAA Division II Indiana University of Pennsylvania followed by the last two at Elon.

Most recently, Cignetti paced the sidelines as head coach at Elon, amassing a 14-9 record in two seasons after inheriting a program that went 12-45 in the previous five campaigns. The Phoenix qualified for the FCS Playoffs in both 2017 (8-4) and 2018 (6-5) to attain just the second and third Division I playoff appearances in program history (2009).

The Phoenix achieved a six-win turnaround in Cignetti's first season, going 8-4 after a 2-9 ledger the year prior. Cignetti was named Colonial Athletic Association Coach of the Year as Elon finished second in the CAA, at 6-2, dropped a tough 28-27 decision to Furman in the First Round of the FCS Playoffs and finished 20th in the national rankings.

In 2018, Elon went 6-4 in the regular season before dropping a 19-7 decision at #12 Wofford in the playoffs to finish 6-5. Elon's other losses came to FBS South Florida and

against three CAA teams that qualified for the playoffs. All three losses also came after injuries impacted key performers at quarterback and running back. Elon's season was highlighted by the ninth-ranked Phoenix winning at No. 2 JMU 27-24 in October to achieve the program's first-ever win over an FCS top-five opponent and becoming the first CAA team to beat the Dukes following a streak of 22 straight JMU wins over league foes.

Walking in the footsteps where his father coached for 20 years, Cignetti earned his first head coaching job at IUP and went 53-17 in six seasons with three appearances in the Division II playoffs and four top-25 finishes in the national rankings. The Crimson Hawks went 33-11 in the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference after going 4-10 in the two seasons prior to Cignetti's arrival. IUP was 4-3 in its three NCAA appearances during his tenure and finished as high as 12th in the 2016 final rankings.

An offensive-minded assistant coach at the FBS level for 27 seasons, Cignetti was an original member of Nick Saban's first coaching staff at Alabama, filling the role of recruiting coordinator and wide receivers coach for 2007 through 2010. He was part of a staff that returned the Crimson Tide to national prominence, going 12-2 in their second season in 2008 while Cignetti concurrently compiled the nation's top-ranked recruiting class. Alabama went undefeated as national champions the following season in 2009, the only undefeated final record during Saban's run in Tuscaloosa, pending the conclusion of the 2018 campaign. Alabama went 10-3 in Cignetti's final season before he earned his first head coaching job at IUP.

Cignetti joined the staff at Alabama after spending seven seasons (2000-06) as the recruiting coordinator at North Carolina State while also coaching tight ends from 2000-02 and 2005-06 and quarterbacks during the 2003 and 2004 campaigns. NC State qualified for five bowl

games during that time, including the 2002 Gator Bowl, when the team set a school record with 11 victories. One of his last recruits before moving to Alabama was quarterback Russell Wilson, who played at NC State before moving on to Wisconsin as a senior.

The first recruiting coordinator role for Cignetti came during a seven-year stint (1993-99) at Pittsburgh. He also coached the Panthers' tight ends and quarterbacks at various times under College Football Hall of Fame head coach Johnny Majors. Cignetti began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Pitt during the 1983 and 1984 seasons and was part of the team's Fiesta Bowl participant his first year. He coached quarterbacks and receivers at Davidson in 1985 and was the quarterbacks coach at Rice (1986-88) and Temple (1989-92).

A quarterback letter winner at West Virginia, Cignetti is a 1982 graduate of WVU with a bachelor's degree in business administration. He is married to the former Manette Lawer. Curt and Manette have three children: Curtis John, Carly Ann and Natalie Elise, who was an honorable mention All-American in volleyball at IUP.

The sport of football runs deep in the Cignetti family. His father, Frank Cignetti, is a member of the College Football Hall of Fame after playing at IUP and compiling a coaching record of 199-77-1 at West Virginia (1976-79) and IUP (1986-2005). The field at IUP is named in his honor (Frank Cignetti Field @ George P. Miller Stadium). Nick Saban coached under Frank Cignetti before later employing Curt Cignetti at Alabama. Curt's younger brother, Frank, Jr., was most recently the quarterbacks coach for the Green Bay Packers and has also held positions with the Giants, Rams, 49ers, Saints and Chiefs.
