BIG MATCHUP THIS SATURDAY FOR FAMILY WEEKEND

- Coming off a thrilling road victory, James Madison returns home for game #5 of the 50th season on Saturday, Oct. 9 when it hosts #11 Villanova.
- Kickoff from Bridgeforth Stadium is set for 2 p.m. and will be televised on NBC Sports Washington while being streamed on FloFootball.
- JMU is also welcoming parents to town, as it hosts Villanova for the second straight time on Family Weekend.
- Pregame radio coverage on the Morris Insurance & Financial JMU Radio Network begins at 1 p.m.
- Saturday's game is sponsored by University Outpost and the JMU football season is presented by CarMax.

BREAKING DOWN THE SERIES

- Saturday marks the 29th meeting all-time between the teams, with JMU leading 17-11 in a series dating back to the 1993 season - JMU's first in the CAA.
- JMU has won five straight matchups against the Wildcats since 2015, with the past four wins all coming by double-digit margins.
- In recent memory, JMU's wins in 2015 and 2016 served as great importance, as 2015 clinched a share of the CAA championship and the 2016 triumph won the league outright for the Dukes.
- JMU is 10-4 all-time vs. Villanova at Bridgeforth Stadium, having won the previous five in Harrisonburg.
- Villanova's last win at JMU came back on Oct. 17, 2009 - a 27-0 Wildcats win, which was the last time a team shut out JMU. VU also went on to win the national title that year.
- Last time the teams met, JMU forced four turnovers and scored 21 points in the fourth quarter alone to rally past Villanova for a 38-24 victory.

DUKES FEND OFF UNH

- Winning in Durham, N.H., has never been easy for the Dukes and Saturday was no different.
- JMU escaped #25 UNH with a 23-21 comeback win after Kris Thornton scored the second of his two touchdowns midway through the fourth and Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey registered his first career interception with 1:45 to play.
- UNH forced JMU into three turnovers, two of which were returned for touchdowns, but the Dukes held the Wildcats to just 162 total yards.
- Cole Johnson threw for 273 yards and three touchdowns and was just one completion off the JMU single-game record, at 33.

TUCKER-DORSEY HONORED BY CAA

- After making the play of the day at New Hampshire, linebacker Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey was named CAA Co-Defensive Player of the Week.
- Tucker-Dorsey intercepted his first career pass with 1:45 left and added five tackles and a half TFL in the win.

COLE MOVING UP JMU'S TOP 10'S

- Through four starts, Cole Johnson ranks top 15 nationally in eight statistical categories.
- Among those have him ranking second in pass efficiency (180.0), third in completion percentage (73.8), fourth in point responsibility (22.5) and fifth in passing touchdowns (14).
- In addition to his impressive start, he's also on the rise on JMU's career top-10 lists.
- Entering Saturday, Johnson ranks 9th at JMU in career passing touchdowns (31), passing yards (3,859) and completions (292).
- He's also approaching the top-10 list for pass attempts and total offense.

DEFENSE KEEPS ROLLING

- JMU's defense continued its hot start to the season, as it ranks top five nationally in four categories.
- The Dukes are second in the FCS in total defense (217.3) and rushing defense (33.0).
- They are also fourth in both third-down defense (25%) and tackles for loss (9.2).
- JMU started off the 2021 season with a bang, setting a program record for fewest rushing yards allowed in a game (-57).
- JMU has allowed just 132 total rushing yards this season, conceding 1.1 yard per carry.
- While the Dukes average 6.8 yards per snap, the defense has allowed just 3.4 yards per play this season.

DUKES VS. WILDCATS - PT. 3

- Saturday marks the third straight game JMU has faced off against a ranked Wildcat team, as it looks for the season sweep of that mascot.
- The Dukes opened the three-game Wildcat stretch with a 37-24 win at #9 Weber State on Sept. 18 in Ogden, Utah.
- Just last week on Oct. 2, the Dukes held off #25 New Hampshire, 23-21.
- This Saturday will be round three, as it hosts #11 Villanova at Bridgeforth Stadium.
- Since 2019, JMU has won five straight against the Wildcats - with two wins against UNH and Weber and one against Villanova.
- New Hampshire was the last Wildcat team to best the Dukes in a 35-24 win on Nov. 3, 2018.

WHAT'S ON DECK

- JMU hits the road next week on Saturday, Oct. 16 when it treks to Richmond to take on the Spiders.
- Kickoff is set for 2 p.m. at Robins Stadium and will be televised on NBC Sports Washington.
- It will be the 39th meeting all-time, with JMU leading 20-18.

- JMU opened the month with a 23-21 road win at #25 New Hampshire and hosts #11 Villanova this weekend for Family Weekend.
- The next two weeks has JMU traveling to Richmond (receiving votes) and #9 Delaware before returning home to host Elon (receiving votes).
- The first four games feature teams who were predicted to finish #2 through #5 behind preseason favorite JMU.
- It also includes back-to-back games against teams coming off a bye in Villanova and Richmond.

CELEBRATING 50 SEASONS

- James Madison University began sponsoring football in 1972, as this fall marks the 50th season for the Dukes.
- JMU will celebrate the 50th all season long, honoring specific decades at each home game.
- This Saturday, the Dukes will honor the 1990's.
- The previously recognized the 1970's against Morehead State and 1980's against Maine.
- JMU also recognized the 1972 team and remembered Dr. Challance McMillin, the first coach in program history, who passed away in 2020.
- Other content, such as video features, alumni interviews, Throwback Thursdays and On This Date will highlight the history of JMU football.
- JMU has won two national championships, nine conference titles and has made 17 postseason appearance.
- All-time JMU is 342-218-4 for a .610 win %.

- JMU's success from year to year has come to be expected, as the Dukes have secured at least a .500 record or better for a league-best 18 straight seasons.
- JMU also produced its 16th winning season during the timeframe last spring, the only team in the CAA to achieve the feat.
- The Dukes have now secured a winning record in 31 of their first 49 seasons since beginning football in 1972.
- JMU tallied nine wins in a program-record five consecutive seasons from 2015-19.

2021 #NFLDUKES

- A total of 11 former JMU football standouts are currently affiliated with NFL franchises, with eight on rosters and three coaching.
- Five Dukes made 53-man rosters while two more are on practice squads and one is on injured reserve.
- Three JMU stars are with the world-champion Tampa Bay Buccaneers. Aaron Stinnie and Josh Wells are on the active roster, and Earl Watford was placed on IR.
- Dean Marlowe made a new home with Detroit this season, while Daniel Brown is back with the New York Jets.
- Jimmy Moreland, who spent the past two seasons and the preseason in Washington was picked up by Houston.
- Ben DiNucci is on the practice squad with Dallas, while Ron'Dell Carter signed with Arizona's practice squad.
- Additionally, three former Dukes serve on NFL coaching staffs.
- John DeFilippo is pass game coordinator and quarterbacks coach with Chicago, Justin Rascati is offensive quality control coach with Denver and Blaine Stewart is the assistant wide receivers coach in Pittsburgh.

JMU'S SUPER BOWL CHAMPS

- Eight former Dukes have hoisted the Lombardi Trophy, dating back to 1988.
- Charles Haley ranks second in NFL history with five Super Bowl titles (1989, 1990, 1993, 1994, 1996), winning in both San Francisco and Dallas.
- Gary Clark won a pair of Super Bowls with Washington (1988, 1992), becoming the first alum to be a world champion.
- D.J. Bryant won with Baltimore (2013), followed by Rashard Davis (player) and John DeFilippo (coach) with Philadelphia (2018).
- Last season, history was made, as three Dukes won the Lombardi with Tampa Bay in Aaron Stinnie, Josh Wells and Earl Watford.
- Stinnie started at right guard, becoming the first JMU player to start the big game since Charles Haley did so in Super Bowl XXX.

JMU'S SHUTOUT HISTORY

- The Dukes turned in a shutout for the 28th time in program history against Morehead State.
- It was the seventh time JMU tallied more than 50 points while holding the opposition scoreless.
- JMU has shut out a team in four straight seasons and in five of the last six.
- The Dukes have now opened the season six times with shutout wins, joining the 1987, 1994, 1996, 2000 and 2005 openers.

FBS TRANSFERS ON ROSTER

- JMU has a total of 19 transfers on its roster in 2021, including 12 who came from FBS schools.
- Of the 19, nine are new to the Dukes this season.

DUKES IN SEASON OPENERS

- The Dukes are 27-22-1 in season openers dating back to the inaugural 1972 season.
- JMU rolled to a 68-10 win on Sept. 4 vs. Morehead State and hasn't lost to a FCS opponent to open the season since 2002.
- It was the fifth time JMU and MSU met on the opening weekend, with JMU claiming wins in 2010, 2015, 2016, 2020 and 2021 - all at JMU.
- In home openers, JMU is 39-11, which includes 19 straight home-opening victories.
- During its current 19-game win streak to open the Bridgeforth slate, JMU has outscored its opponents by an average of 49.3 to 8.8. JMU has put up more than 40 points in 15 of those wins, including 80 in the '16 opener.
- The last team to win JMU's first home game was Hampton - a 31-28 Pirate triumph on Aug. 31, 2002.

Dukes Set Multiple Records in Season-Opening Win Against MSU

HARRISONBURG, Va. – James Madison kicked off the 50th season of football in style, setting two team records while matching another in a 68-10 victory against Morehead State on Friday night at Bridgeforth Stadium.

The second-ranked Dukes limited the Eagles to an astounding -57 rushing yards, shattering the previous record of -35 against Bloomsburg in 1989. JMU also scored 51 second-half points, the most in a second half in school history and the second most in any half.

Quarterback Cole Johnson threw for a career-high five touchdowns and the Dukes had six total passing touchdowns, tying both JMU records for passing touchdowns by an individual and a team.

The Dukes out-gained MSU by nearly 500 yards, as they racked up 687 yards of total offense, the fifth most in school history. JMU rushed for 345 yards and threw for 342.

Running back Kaelon Black rushed 12 times for 100 yards, the second 100-yard game in just his third career outing. Fellow running back Latrelle Palmer also ran for 98 yards and a pair of touchdowns for his third career two-touchdown game. Peyton Rutherford finished the game strong, adding 58 yards in the fourth quarter, which included a game-long 56-yard rush.

Johnson was 19-of-28 for 298 yards with his five scores, while rookie quarterback Billy Atkins finished the game 4-of-7 for 44 yards and his first career touchdown.

The quarterback duo found four different Dukes for touchdowns in the passing game, led by Kris Thornton, who had four catches for 82 yards and a pair of scores. Antwane Wells made four grabs for 60 yards and a touchdown, Kevin Curry had three receptions for a career-best 50 yards and a touchdown while Solomon Vanhorse reeled in three passes for 39 yards and two touchdowns.

Defensively, safety Chris Chukwuneke turned in a career-high six tackles with one for loss. Safety Que Reid made five stops with an interception and a breakup, as he was one of four Dukes to produce a takeaway. Cornerbacks Greg Ross and Taurus Carroll each had an interception, while defensive lineman Abi Nwabuku-Ononji registered his first career fumble recovery.

JMU led 17-3 at the half, before turning on the jets, scoring four touchdowns in the third to extend the lead to 45-10. Palmer sparked the offense with a 47-yard touchdown on the fourth play of the second half, and the Dukes followed that with Johnson touchdown passes to Thornton and Vanhorse. In the fourth, the Dukes found the endzone four times, with three touchdowns and a safety. That included first career touchdowns for both Atkins and quarterback Patrick Bentley, who capped off the scoring with a four-yard touchdown run in the final minute.

MSU's Mark Pappas threw for 243 yards and three interceptions, finding his All-PFL receiver BJ Byrd nine times for 127 yards.

#3 Dukes Dominate Black Bears, 55-7, in CAA Opener

HARRISONBURG, Va. – #3 James Madison produced scoring production in all three phases and out-gained Maine by over 300 yards en route to a dominant 55-7 victory in its Colonial Athletic Association Football opener on Saturday at Bridgeforth Stadium.

The Dukes improved to 2-0 (1-0 CAA), while the Black Bears fell to 0-2 (0-2 CAA).

JMU was prolific in the pass game, as quarterback Cole Johnson was 25-of-30 for 379 yards and four touchdowns, which included 305 in the opening half alone.

Wide receiver Antwane Wells Jr. turned in one of the program's top receiving performances, reeling in eight receptions for 179 yards and two touchdowns, all of which were career highs.

His 179 yards was the ninth-highest receiving total in JMU history, as both of his touchdowns came on plays exceeding 50 yards.

In addition to Wells, Kris Thornton and Scott Bracey both had 71 receiving yards, with Bracey finding the end zone for the first time this season. Tight end Noah Turner also caught his first career touchdown on a 27-yard grab to open the scoring.

JMU racked up 133 rushing yards against the solid defensive front of Maine, led by Kaelon Black's 55 yards on nine carries. Latrelle Palmer rushed for 41 yards, while Lorenzo Bryant Jr. scored his first JMU touchdown in the second half.

The Dukes also got plenty of production from the defense and special teams, scoring touchdowns in both areas. Francis Meehan intercepted his first career pass on a 31-yard pick-six in the fourth quarter, while Mateo Jackson and Desmond Green blocked a third-quarter punt, with Green scooping and scoring on a 6-yard punt return for a score.

Ethan Ratke also broke the FCS all-time scoring record by a kicker while tying the FCS record for most career field goals. He tied Dan Carpenter's scoring field goals record with his 413th point and 75th career field goal with 10:59 remaining in the third. Minutes later, he broke the scoring record on a PAT following Green's blocked punt for a touchdown.

Defensively, Greg Ross and Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey each tallied seven tackles, which was a career high for Ross and season best for Tucker-Dorsey. Tucker-Dorsey also added his first career full sack and a pass breakup. Isaac Ukwu was a force up front, collecting his first two career sacks with a breakup, while Bryce Carter tacked on 1.5 TFLs.

Leading 10-0 after the first, the Johnson-to-Wells connection put together back-to-back long touchdowns, as Johnson and Wells each had a career-long, 73-yard touchdown with 9:34 remaining in the half, followed by a 51-yarder to make it 24-0 at the break.

Following Ratke's scoring-record PAT that made it 34-0, Maine got on the board on a Derek Robertson 22-yard touchdown pass to Andre Miller. JMU responded with three more touchdown drives, as Bracey and Bryant Jr. found the end zone for the first time, while Meehan capped off the game with his pick-six.

JMU Wins Big on the Road, Downs #9 Weber State, 37-24

OGDEN, Utah – Cole Johnson produced three total touchdowns and #3 James Madison used timely defensive plays en route to a 37-24 triumph at #9 Weber State on Saturday night in front of 11,222 fans at Stewart Stadium.

The Dukes improved to 3-0 on the year while the Wildcats fell to 1-2. JMU also improved to 3-0 all-time against Weber, capturing the program's first road win at a Big Sky Conference foe.

Johnson was 20-of-28 for 177 yards and two touchdowns while rushing for one more. Antwane Wells Jr. scored a pair of second-half touchdowns, as he corralled eight receptions for 76 yards. Kris Thornton was efficient, especially on third down, tallying eight catches for 57 yards.

JMU's rushing attack heated up in the second half, led by Latrele Palmer's 80 yards with a long of 46. Austin Douglas contributed a career-long 45-yard run and finished with 49 yards, while Lorenzo Bryant Jr. added 32.

Ethan Ratke drilled three field goals, setting the FCS all-time field goals record with his 76th-career make on a 44-yarder six minutes into the first quarter. He later added his 77th in the third and 78th in the fourth.

Defensively, Kelvin Azanama finished with 10 tackles and one for loss. Isaac Ukwu was a force up front with 2.0 TFLs and a sack. Bryce Carter and Mike Greene each had 1.5 tackles for loss, as Carter made seven total stops. Chris Chukwuneke and Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey also produced seven tackles.

Leading 10-3, Josh Sarratt made a game-changing play, as he picked up a fumble by the Weber quarterback and returned it 88 yards for his first JMU touchdown to put the Dukes up 17-3 with 6:38 left in the half.

After Douglas' 45-yard run in the first minute of the third, Johnson connected with Wells on his first of two touchdown tosses on a five-yard pass. Weber trimmed the lead to 24-10, but the Dukes answered with Ratke's second kick and another Johnson-to-Wells touchdown, making it 34-10 with 14:13 to play. Ratke tacked on his third field goal to extend the lead to 37-10, and WSU added a pair of touchdowns late to complete the scoring.

GAME FACTS

- It was JMU's largest margin of victory against Weber in the three-game series.
- JMU out-gained WSU 359-326 in total offense, which included a wide margin in the run game, at 182-92.
- The Dukes had a +2 turnover margin, with Sarratt's scoop-and-score and Greg Ross' third career interception.
- JMU was 5-of-13 on third down while limiting Weber State to 4-of-13. JMU was also 1-for-1 on fourth, and the Wildcats were 3-for-4.
- Ratke set the all-time field goals record after making at least one field goal in now 24 straight games. y both had 71 receiving yards, with Bracey finding the end zone for the first time this season. Tight end Noah Turner also caught his first career touchdown on a 27-yard grab to open the scoring.

#3 JMU Rallies in Fourth to Upend #25 New Hampshire, 23-21

DURHAM, N.H. -- Despite conceding a 10-point lead, #3 James Madison football used a Kris Thornton touchdown reception and a game-clinching interception by Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey in the fourth to fend off #25 New Hampshire, 23-21, on Saturday afternoon at Wildcat Stadium.

The Dukes improved to 4-0 overall and 2-0 in Colonial Athletic Association play, while the Wildcats fell to 3-2 on the year and 2-1 in league action.

UNH took a 21-17 lead heading to the fourth quarter after scoring off three JMU turnovers. Facing a third-and-long, Cole Johnson found Kris Thornton on a 30-yard touchdown with 8:20 to play, giving the Dukes a 23-21 lead.

After teams traded drives, UNH's Bret Edwards was intercepted by Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey with 1:45 to go to seal the win.

Johnson finished 33-of-44 for 273 yards and three touchdowns with an interception and fumble. Thornton made a career-best 12 receptions for 112 yards and two touchdowns, while Reggie Brown made four grabs for 37 yards and his first career touchdown. Thornton's 12 catches was the third-most in JMU single game history.

Antwane Wells Jr. also made six catches for the Dukes, and Latrelle Palmer led the charge on the ground, rushing for 57 yards. Johnson also added 37 rushing yards.

Defensively, Kelvin Azanama made a team-best nine tackles while Wayne Davis tallied eight stops. Tucker-Dorsey finished with five tackles, to go with first career interception. Bryce Carter also finished with five stops and his first JMU sack.

JMU opened the game with a 10-0 lead before a fumble gave way to a UNH 93-yard fumble return for a touchdown to make it a three-point game. The Dukes extended the lead to 17-7 right before halftime on Johnson's pass to Brown with 17 seconds to go.

UNH completely changed the complexion of the game with two more takeaways in the third. Randall Harris picked off Johnson on JMU's first offensive play of the second half for a touchdown. UNH later scored after a sack and fumble on the ensuing drive to make it 21-17 midway through the quarter.

After a crucial third-down stop in the fourth, Johnson found Thornton once again on a 30-yard touchdown pass to put the Dukes back in front for good.

GAME NOTES

- JMU out-gained UNH 432-162, including a 159-31 advantage on the ground. JMU also had a 273-131 lead through the air.
- UNH forced JMU into its first three turnovers of the season, with the first two being returned for a touchdown. All three JMU turnovers eventually resulted in all 21 points for the Wildcats.
- The Dukes were 12-of-20 on third down, while holding the Wildcats to 2-of-10. JMU also went 1-of-1 on fourth down.
- JMU dominated first downs by a 28-11 margin.
- For UNH, Edwards threw for 131 yards, one touchdown and an interception. Carlos Washington Jr. had 43 rushing yards to lead the UNH offense.
- JMU improved to 12-9 all-time against New Hampshire and 5-6 at Wildcat Stadium.
- JMU has now out-gained opponents in 21 straight games and held opponents to under 50% on third down in 12 straight.
