DUKES HOST EAGLES TO OPEN 2020-21 CAMPAIGN

- JMU opens its 49th season of football and its first in the spring when it plays host to Morehead State on Saturday, Feb. 20.
- Kickoff is set for noon at Bridgeforth Stadium and will be televised regionally on NBC Sports Washington. It will also be streamed on FloFootball (\$).
- Pregame radio coverage on the JMU Glo Fiber Radio Network begins an hour prior to kick, at 11 a.m.
- JMU's 2020-21 season is sponsored by CarMax and the home opener is presented by United Bank.

JMU IN SEASON AND HOME OPENERS

- The Dukes are 25-22-1 all-time in season openers dating back to the 1972 inaugural season.
- JMU has fallen in its last two season-opening matchups, both to FBS Power 5 programs. It fell 20-13 in 2019 at West Virginia and 24-13 in 2018 at NC State.
- JMU has not lost an opener to an FCS team since 2002.
- It's the fourth time JMU and MSU open the season against each other, with previous openers occurring in 2010, 2015 and 2016 - all at Bridgeforth Stadium.
- In home openers, JMU is 37-11, which includes a string of 17 straight home-opening triumphs.
- During the home-opening win streak, JMU outscored its opponent by an average of 48.1 to 9.4 (818-159). JMU has put up more than 40 points in 13 of those wins, including 80 in the 2016 opener against Morehead and 73 in 2018 versus JMU's second opponent, Robert Morris.
- The last team to win in JMU's first home game was Hampton in a 31-28 victory back on Aug. 31, 2002.
- Additionally, JMU has also won 27 of its last 28 home openers.

BREAKING DOWN JMU VS. MOREHEAD STATE

- Saturday's opener marks the 10th meeting all-time between the teams, with JMU holding a 7-2 series lead.
- JMU has won four straight against MSU and is 6-0 in games played at Bridgeforth Stadium.
- The series began in the late 70's, with the teams playing six times between 1979 and 1987. It picked back up in 2010, as they met three times in the past decade.
- JMU has outscored Morehead by an average of 39.9 to 13.8 (359-124) and has tallied no less than 44 points during the four-game win streak. That includes an 80-point performance in the 2016 opener, which is the second-most points in JMU single-game history.
- The Eagles last beat JMU on Sept. 13, 1986 - a 27-24 victory in Morehead, Ky.
- JMU and MSU also have contracts to play in Harrisonburg during the 2021 and 2023 seasons.

JMU ACTIVE STREAKS

- 12 straight wins at Bridgeforth Stadium
- 16 straight home non-conference wins
- Out-gained opponents in 9 straight games
- Converted on 14 straight 4th-down attempts

LAST TIME JMU AND MSU MET

- JMU and Morehead State last met on Sept. 3, 2016, with the Dukes rolling to an 80-7 win at Bridgeforth Stadium.
- It was the first time JMU cracked the 80-point mark and still stands the second-most points in the program's single-game history.
- JMU produced points on its first 11 possessions and gained 607 total yards on 498 rushing yards and 109 passing.
- Bryan Schor rushed for 129 yards and three touchdowns while throwing for another 109.
- Three Dukes rushed for 100 yards in the win.

DUKES 4TH IN PAIR OF POLLS

- Though the primary media and coaches polls have not been released, JMU was ranked fourth in both the HERO Sports FCS Top 25 and Athlon Sports FCS Top 25.
- JMU finished the 2019 season with a 14-2 record, won the CAA outright title and advanced to the national championship game for the third time in four seasons.
- The Dukes led CAA six CAA teams in the HERO Sports poll and five by Athlon Sports.

PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

- Liam Fornadel and Mike Greene were both named Preseason All-Americans ahead of the 2020-21 season.
- Fornadel and Greene were both named Athlon Sports Preseason All-Americans, while Fornadel was also honored by HERO Sports.
- Fornadel was an All-American last season and voted Touchdown Club of Richmond Offensive Lineman of the Year.
- Greene was Third Team All-CAA a year ago and led all CAA interior defensive lineman in sacks.

DUKES TO HONOR COACH MAC

- JMU will honor Challance McMillin with "Coach Mac" front bumper decals on every helmet during the spring football season.
- The first head coach and a founding father of JMU football, Coach Mac passed away on March 8, 2020, at the age of 77.
- McMillin launched JMU football from the ground up in 1972 and led the program for its first 13 seasons (1972-84).
- He also started JMU's cross country and track & field programs, and was inducted into the JMU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1994.

RATKE THIRD IN CAA HISTORY

- Ethan Ratke is already JMU's all-time leader in made field goals and now sets his sights on the CAA record.
- He's currently third with 58 field goals.
- Ratke needs one field goal to tie William & Mary's Greg Kuehn (2002-05) for second all-time.
- Towson's Aidan O'Neill (2016-19) leads the CAA with 64 career field goals.
- Ratke is tied for 22nd in FCS history in career field goals, needing one to crack the top 20.

FBS TRANSFERS

- Since the end of the 2019 season, Cignetti has added seven FBS transfers to the roster.
- Joining the Dukes are Scott Bracey (WR - Duke), Mason Cholewa (DL, UCF), Stanley Hubbard (OL, UConn), Jebriel Murray (S, Navy), Abi Nwabuoku-Onkonji (DL, Minnesota), Greg Ross (CB, North Carolina) and Noah Turner (TE, North Carolina).
- With their addition, JMU has 10 transfers previously from the FBS ranks.

NEW HIRES FOR 2020-21

- JMU has made four new hires to the coaching staff since the 2019 national championship.
- Joining the Dukes in 2020-21 are Eddie Whitley Jr. (safeties), Marcus Hall-Oliver (defensive tackles), John Miller (running backs) and Derek Owings (strength & conditioning).
- Whitley comes from Bridgewater College, where he spent three seasons as secondary coach.
- Hall-Oliver was most recently at Indiana as a defensive grad assistant with the defensive line.
- Miller, a 2018 graduate of JMU, returns home after a two-season stint at Texas as offensive quality control coach.
- Owings leads the strength & conditioning unit after two years at Texas Tech.

HETHERMAN ON 35 UNDER 35

- Defensive Coordinator Corey Hetherman was named to the AFCA 35 Under 35 Coaches Leadership Institute.
- In 2019, Hetherman guided one of the country's top defenses, leading the FCS in total defense (270.2) and first-down defense (14.56).
- JMU also ranked third in rushing defense (74.8), third-down defense (30%) and scoring defense (15.7), fifth in TFLs (8.5), sixth in pass efficiency (111.83) and seventh in interceptions (17).
- He also coached two defensive ends to All-America status in Ron'Dell Carter and John Daka, who became JMU's first pair to be Buck Buchanan Award finalists in the same year.

THREE DUKES WIN SUPER BOWL

- Former Dukes Aaron Stinnie ('17), Josh Wells ('13) and Earl Watford ('12) won Super Bowl LV with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers.
- It was the first time JMU had multiple players win the same Super Bowl.
- Stinnie was starting right guard for the Tampa offense, Wells was backup right tackle and Watford served on the practice squad.
- The JMU trio joined Charles Haley (5), Gary Clark (2), D.J. Bryant, Rashard Davis and John DeFilippo as Dukes who've won the Super Bowl.

JMU AGAINST THE COMMONWEALTH

- The Dukes have faced 15 teams from the Commonwealth since beginning football in 1972.
- In 150 games, JMU has racked up an 89-61 record against teams from around the state.
- The Dukes have played William & Mary (25-17) more than any other state team, at 42 games, and have faced Richmond (19-18) 37 times and Liberty (12-6) on 18 occasions.
