DUKES OPEN CAA PLAY AT ELON SATURDAY

- JMU hits the road for the first time this season in week three when it travels to Elon on Saturday, March 6.
- Kickoff is set for 1:30 p.m. at Rhodes Stadium and will be streamed on FloFootball (\$).
- Pregame radio coverage on the JMU Glo Fiber Radio Network begins an hour prior to kick, at 12:30 p.m.
- JMU's 2020-21 season is sponsored by CarMax.

BREAKING DOWN JMU VS. ELON

- Saturday marks the ninth meeting all-time between the teams, with JMU leading 7-1.
- That includes a 3-0 record at Rhodes Stadium. JMU's three victories at Elon have come by an average of 42.3 to 4.3, having allowed just 13 points to the Phoenix on their home field.
- In the history of the series, JMU has outscored Elon by an average of 41.75 to 14.25 (334-114) and has tallied more than 50 points on three occasions.
- Elon's lone victory came back on Oct. 6, 2018 - a 27-24 win in Harrisonburg - when Curt Cignetti was head coach for the Phoenix.
- The two will also end the regular season at Bridgeforth Stadium on April 10.

BACK ON TOP OF THE POLLS

- Following a wild week two, in which four top-10 teams lost, including the #1 and #3 squads, JMU assumed the top slot in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25.
- It's the first time since the final regular season poll of 2017 that JMU has been ranked #1.
- JMU was ranked #1 from the final 2016 poll all throughout the 2017 season until the final poll that year.
- The Dukes are one of two CAA teams in the top five, as Villanova, which opens the season this week, is #5.
- Weber State is ranked second, Northern Iowa is third and North Dakota is fourth. Defending champion North Dakota State dropped five spots to sixth.

CLEAN SWEEP IN THE CAA

- JMU won all four CAA Football weekly awards following its 36-16 win vs. Robert Morris.
- Kris Thornton was named CAA Offensive Player of the Week after making five catches for 65 yards and a touchdown, reaching the endzone for the second straight week.
- MJ Hampton was tabbed Defensive Player of the Week after tying his career high with seven tackles, to go with 1.5 tackles for loss, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery.
- Harry O'Kelly averaged 48.5 yards per punt, pinning RMU inside the 20 all four times, including once and the one and another at the two to garner Special Teams Player of the Week.
- Antwane Wells was Rookie of the Week after recording two catches for 29 yards and his first career touchdown.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

- Back on Sept. 28, 2019, the Dukes piled up 336 rushing yards to roll to a 45-10 win at Elon.
- Four players had at least 50 rushing yards, led by Jawon Hamilton's 81 yards and a touchdown.
- Latrele Palmer had 78 yards and two scores, Solomon Vanhorne tallied 63 and a pair of TDs and Percy Agyei-Obese added 59.
- Of JMU's 56 rushes, none were for negative gain.
- Elon struck on its opening drive, but was limited to just 152 more yards on its final 11 drives. That included the Phoenix rushing for only 33 yards.
- Down 7-0, JMU would score the next 38 points.

A FAMILIAR PLACE FOR CIGNETTI

- Curt Cignetti makes his second return trip to his former school, where he spent the 2017 and 2018 seasons leading the Phoenix.
- He guided Elon to a 14-9 record and back-to-back playoff appearances for the first time in school history.
- Cignetti was also named 2017 CAA Coach of the Year in his first year at the helm.

JMU IN CAA OPENERS

- JMU is in its 28th season as a member of CAA Football this Saturday.
- The Dukes are 19-8 in conference openers.
- JMU has won five straight CAA openers, with Villanova being the last team to spoil a CAA opener for the Dukes in 2014.
- It's also the second straight year JMU and Elon open CAA play against each other at Rhodes.
- The Dukes joined the CAA (formerly the Atlantic 10 and Yankee Conference) in 1993.

DUKES SHUT OUT RMU IN SECOND HALF

- JMU overcame a slow start, reeling off 27 unanswered points to down Robert Morris 36-16.
- The Dukes held RMU scoreless in the second half and limited the visitors to 24 yards and 1.0 yard per play over the final 30 minutes.
- Kelvin Azanama and Wayne Davis each had career highs of eight tackles, while MJ Hampton made seven stops with 1.5 for loss and a key forced fumble and recovery in the third quarter.
- Percy Agyei-Obese rushed for 55 yards and two touchdowns, while Jawon Hamilton led all players with 74 rushing yards and 8.2 per carry.

JMU ACTIVE STREAKS

- 14 straight wins at Bridgeforth Stadium
- 18 straight home non-conference wins
- Out-gained opponents in 11 straight games
- Ethan Ratke 15 straight games with a field goal

RATKE 2ND IN CAA HISTORY

- Ethan Ratke moved into second place in CAA history after a pair of field goals in week two.
- He now has 61 career field goals, passing William & Mary's Greg Kuehn (2002-05) who had 59.
- Aidan O'Neill (2016-19) of Towson is the all-time leader with 64 career field goals.
- Ratke also rose into a tie for 14th in FCS history, matching Weber State's Trey Tuttle (2017-19).
- His 10 points against RMU also moved him into 19th place in FCS scoring with 339 career points.

- Percy Agyei-Obese is quickly approaching several career top 10s for JMU:
- 24 rushing TD - needs 1 to tie for 10th

- 355 rush attempts - needs 94 for 10th
- 1,828 rushing yards - needs 495 for 10th

JMU'S SHUTOUT HISTORY

- The Dukes turned in a shutout for the 28th time in program history in week one vs. Morehead St.
- It was the seventh time JMU tallied more than 50 points while holding the opposition scoreless.
- JMU has shut out a team in four straight seasons and in five of the last six.
- The Dukes have now opened the season six times with shutout wins, joining the 1987, 1994, 1996, 2000 and 2005 openers.

PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

- Liam Fornadel and Mike Greene were both named Preseason All-Americans ahead of the 2020-21 season.
- Fornadel and Greene were both named Athlon Sports Preseason All-Americans, while Fornadel was also honored by HERO Sports.
- Fornadel was an All-American last season and voted Touchdown Club of Richmond Offensive Lineman of the Year.
- Greene was Third Team All-CAA a year ago and led all CAA interior defensive lineman in sacks.

DUKES HONORING COACH MAC

- JMU will honor Challace McMillin with "Coach Mac" front bumper decals on every helmet during the spring football season.
- The first head coach and a founding father of JMU football, Coach Mac passed away on March 8, 2020, at the age of 77.
- McMillin launched JMU football from the ground up in 1972 and led the program for its first 13 seasons (1972-84).
- He also started JMU's cross country and track & field programs, and was inducted into the JMU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1994.

JMU Shuts Out Morehead State, 52-0, in 2020-21 Opener

HARRISONBURG, Va. – Fourth-ranked James Madison football ran all over Zane Showker Field, accumulating more than 350 rushing yards and six scores on the ground, en route to a 52-0 season-opening victory against Morehead State on Saturday afternoon at Bridgeforth Stadium.

The Dukes moved to 1-0, playing in the program's first-ever, regular-season spring game, while the Eagles fell to 0-1. JMU moved to 8-2 all-time against MSU, having now won five straight in the series.

JMU dominated the ground game, rushing for 369 yards. Four different backs ran for more than 60 yards and scored touchdowns. Percy Agyei-Obese tallied a game-high 116 yards and a touchdown, Solomon Vanhorse had 82 yards and a score on just five carries, while both Latrelle Palmer (90) and Jawon Hamilton (68) found the endzone twice.

Cole Johnson was 10-of-14 for 147 yards and a touchdown, connecting on a 52-yard pass to Kris Thornton for his first passing score of the year. Thornton finished the game with three catches for a game-high 90 yards and the score. JMU's quarterbacks found 10 different pass catchers in the game.

Defensively, Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey led the way with a team- and career-high eight tackles with a tackle for loss. Mike Greene tallied five tackles with a pair for loss and a sack. Wayne Davis and Que Reid each nabbed interceptions, leading to a +1 turnover ratio. Three other Dukes recorded sacks in Mateo Jackson, Mikail Kamara and Sean Johns.

JMU opened each half with the hot hand on offense, scoring touchdowns on its first three drives while opening the second half with three touchdowns and a field goal. Morehead State was forced into six three-and-outs by JMU's defense.

GAME FACTS

- Today marked the JMU's 28th shutout in program history, as it has blanked an opponent in four straight seasons.
- JMU out-gained Morehead State, 556-98 on the afternoon.
- The rushing differential was massive, as JMU ran for 386 yards, as opposed to MSU's negative six. It also had 6.4 yards per carry, holding MSU to -0.2 per run.
- The Dukes went 9-for-13 on third down while holding the Eagles to a 5-of-16 clip.
- JMU made 12 tackles for loss, while MSU tallied three.
- The Dukes scored on all six red-zone trips while MSU never made it inside the JMU 20.
- JMU also thwarted MSU's only real scoring chance on a Tony Thurston blocked field goal.
- Morehead State was led by DeAndre Clayton, who came in to throw 7-of-9 for 71 passing yards and an interception.

RATKE TOP 20 IN FCS HISTORY

- Ethan Ratke's fourth-quarter field goal was the 59th of his career, which ties him for second all-time in CAA history.
- He's tied with William & Mary's Greg Kuehn (2002-05).
- Ratke also moved into the FCS top 20, as he's tied for 16th in career field goals.

#2 Dukes Pull Away in Second Half for Win Over Robert Morris

HARRISONBURG, Va. – Second-ranked James Madison reeled off 27 unanswered points and clamped down defensively, holding Robert Morris scoreless in the second half, en route to a 36-16 non-conference football victory on Saturday afternoon at Bridgeforth Stadium.

The Dukes improved to 2-0 while the Colonials fell to 0-1. JMU also moved to 2-0 in the all-time series.

After allowing 163 yards and 4.4 per play in the first half, JMU's defense took over, allowing just 24 second-half yards, as RMU mustered just a single yard per snap over the final 30 minutes.

The Dukes tied the game just before halftime and tacked on another score to take the lead, at 23-16 with 10:41 to play in the third. JMU would go on to score on four of six drives to open the second half to pull away.

Percy Agyei-Obese ran for 55 yards and two touchdowns, while Jawon Hamilton led all players with 74 rushing yards, averaging 8.2 per carry. Kris Thornton found the endzone once again this week, reeling in five catches for 65 yards and a score. Antwane Wells Jr. also caught his first career touchdown, which tied the game just before the half. Cole Johnson was 17-of-24 for 198 yards, two touchdowns and three interceptions.

Defensively, Kelvin Azanama and Wayne Davis led the Dukes with eight tackles apiece. It was a career high for Azanama, while Davis matched his career best. MJ Hampton was active all over the field, accruing seven tackles with a career-high 1.5 for loss, while also forcing and recovering a key fumble in the second half. JMU transfers Abi Nwabuoku-Onkonji and Mason Cholewa each turned in their first sacks at JMU as part of the stout effort in the second half.

GAME FACTS

- JMU out-gained Robert Morris 394 to 187, which included a dominant 209 to 24 margin in the second half.
- The Dukes limited RMU to just 22 rushing yards and 0.7 per carry. Through two games, JMU has conceded 16 total rushing yards after Morehead State had -6 in week one.
- JMU allowed just one third-down conversion, as RMU went 1-for-13. The Dukes were 4-of-11 on third-down tries.
- Harry O'Kelly shined on special teams, averaging 48.5 yards on his four punts, which included pinning the Colonials inside the 2-yard line twice. All four of his punts were inside the 20. His first punt, downed at the one, led to an eventual safety.
- The teams were perfect in the red zone, as JMU was 4-for-4 (2 TD) and RMU was 2-for-2 (1 TD).
- For RMU, George Martin threw for 165 yards and a touchdown, with D'Andre Hicks making eight catches for 67 yards. Aniello Buzzacco led all players with 15 tackles.
