DUKES RETURN TO GRIDIRON IN WILLIAMSBURG

- JMU returns to action after back-to-back postponements on Saturday, March 27 at William & Mary.
- Kickoff is set for 1 p.m. at Zable Stadium and will be streamed on FloFootball (\$).
- · Pregame radio coverage on the JMU Glo Fiber Radio Network begins an hour prior to kick, at noon.
- JMU's 2020-21 season is sponsored by CarMax.

BREAKING DOWN JMU VS. WILLIAM & MARY

- Saturday marks the 43rd meeting all-time between the teams, with JMU leading 25-17.
- The series began in 1978, and JMU has not faced a team more than the Tribe. The programs have faced off in all but one season over the past 42 years.
- JMU has won four straight against W&M since 2016.
- All-time, JMU has outscored William & Mary, 1,093 to 974, averaging wins by a 26.0 to 23.2 margin.
- During the current four-game win streak, JMU has averaged victories by 41.5 to 11.0.
- That includes a 38-10 win at W&M back on Oct. 19, 2019 the last time the teams met.
- The Dukes are 11-12 in games played at Zable Stadium.

DUKES #1 FOR FOURTH STRAIGHT WEEK

- Despite not playing a game since March 6, JMU maintained its #1 ranking, as it led the way for the fourth straight week in Monday's Stats Perform FCS Top 25.
- JMU received 29 of 40 first-place votes, up one vote from a week ago.
- Joining the Dukes in the top five were #2 North Dakota State, #3 Weber State, #4 South Dakota State and #5 Sam Houston State.
- All five teams earned first-place votes, as NDSU claimed six, Weber State and SDSU each had two and Sam Houston collected one.
- JMU was one of seven CAA teams to be ranked. Other league teams in the top 25 were #11 Delaware, #16
 Villanova, #18 Rhode Island, #21 Richmond, #24 New Hampshire and #25 Maine. Albany also received votes.

DEFENSE PROVING DOMINANT AGAIN

- JMU's defense ranks as one of the nation's best, as it's top-10 in rushing defense (3rd 31.0), total defense (4th 163.7), scoring defense (6th 11.0) and tackles for loss (9.3).
- · The second-half numbers have been staggering, which includes not allowing a single point in the second half.
- In second halves vs. Morehead State, Robert Morris and Elon, JMU has allowed just nine first downs, -29 rushing yards, 118 passing yards, 89 total yards and 3-for-19 on third down.
- In fourth quarters, the numbers are wild, giving up just three first downs, -32 rushing yards, 22 passing yards, -10 total yards and a 0-for-7 clip on third down.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

- Back on Oct. 19, 2019, JMU limited William & Mary to only 194 yards en route to a 38-10 win in Williamsburg.
- Ron'Dell Carter had 10 tackles with 6.0 tackles for loss and a sack, Eight Dukes had at least a full TFL, as Mike Greene added 1.5 sacks.
- Ben DiNucci threw for 250 yards and two touchdowns, with Brandon Polk reeling in seven catches for 77 yards and a score.
- JMU forced W&M into three interceptions, producing 14 points off turnovers.
- The defense also tallied four sacks and a seasonhigh 15 tackles for loss.
- JMU out-gained the Tribe 376-194 and used a 21-point surge in the first half to lead for the majority of the game.

DUKES STORM BACK TO BEAT ELON

- JMU overcame a 14-point halftime deficit, scoring the final 17 to rally past Elon, 20-17, in the CAA opener back on March 6.
- The Dukes limited Elon to just 36 yards in the second half, including four in the fourth quarter.
- Trailing 17-6 into the fourth quarter, the Dukes put together back-to-back touchdown drives with a huge special-teams play in between.
- Gage Moloney threw an 18-yard touchdown to Antwane Wells Jr. to trim the Elon lead to 17-13.
- After an MJ Hampton blocked punt, JMU converted a fourth down, setting up Percy Agyei-Obese's eight-yard score with 7:27 left.
- Agyei-Obese ran for a career-high 132 yards and a score, averaging 6.9 per carry.
- Mike Greene was a force on defense, making 3.5 tackles for loss and a sack.

JMU ACTIVE STREAKS

- 14 straight wins at Bridgeforth Stadium
- 14 consecutive regular-season wins
- 10 straight CAA wins
- 11 straight wins vs. CAA teams, including playoffs
- Out-gained opponents in 12 straight games
- Ethan Ratke 16 straight games with a field goal

RATKE NEARS CAA FG RECORD

- Ethan Ratke is nearing conference history, as he needs just field goal to tie the CAA record for career field goals and two to break the record.
- Towson's Aidan O'Neill (2016-19) made 64 in his career to set the current mark.
- Ratke also ranks 13th in FCS history in career field goals and needs one to break the top 10.
- The FCS record sits at 75 field goals, set by Montana's Dan Carpenter (2004-07).
- He's also the CAA all-time leader in career scoring by a kicker, at 347. That mark is also 18th in FCS history.

- 1,960 rushing yards needs 363 for 10th

JMU'S SHUTOUT HISTORY

- The Dukes turned in a shutout for the 28th time in program history against Morehead State.
- It was the seventh time JMU tallied more than 50 points while holding the opposition scoreless.
- JMU has shut out a team in four straight seasons and in five of the last six.
- The Dukes have now opened the season six times with shutout wins, joining the 1987, 1994, 1996, 2000 and 2005 openers.

- JMU's home games against William & Mary on March 13 and Richmond on March 20 were postponed due to CoVID-19 related protocols within the JMU program.

JMU Shuts Out Morehead State, 52-0, in 2020-21 Opener

HARRISONBURG, Va. – Fourth-ranked James Madison football ran all over Zane Showker Field, accumulating more than 350 rushing yards and six scores on the ground, en route to a 52-0 season-opening victory against Morehead State on Saturday afternoon at Bridgeforth Stadium.

The Dukes moved to 1-0, playing in the program's first-ever, regular-season spring game, while the Eagles fell to 0-1. JMU moved to 8-2 all-time against MSU, having now won five straight in the series.

JMU dominated the ground game, rushing for 369 yards. Four different backs ran for more than 60 yards and scored touchdowns. Percy Agyei-Obese tallied a game-high 116 yards and a touchdown, Solomon Vanhorse had 82 yards and a score on just five carries, while both Latrele Palmer (90) and Jawon Hamilton (68) found the endzone twice.

Cole Johnson was 10-of-14 for 147 yards and a touchdown, connecting on a 52-yard pass to Kris Thornton for his first passing score of the year. Thornton finished the game with three catches for a game-high 90 yards and the score. JMU's quarterbacks found 10 different pass catchers in the game.

Defensively, Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey led the way with a team- and career-high

eight tackles with a tackle for loss. Mike Greene tallied five tackles with a pair for loss and a sack. Wayne Davis and Que Reid each nabbed interceptions, leading to a +1 turnover ratio. Three other Dukes recorded sacks in Mateo Jackson, Mikail Kamara and Sean Johns.

JMU opened each half with the hot hand on offense, scoring touchdowns on its first three drives while opening the second half with three touchdowns and a field goal. Morehead State was forced into six three-and-outs by JMU's defense.

GAME FACTS

- · Today marked the JMU's 28th shutout in program history, as it has blanked an opponent in four straight seasons.
- JMU out-gained Morehead State, 556-98 on the afternoon.
- The rushing differential was massive, as JMU ran for 386 yards, as opposed to MSU's negative six. It also had 6.4 yards per carry, holding MSU to -0.2 per run.
- The Dukes went 9-for-13 on third down while holding the Eagles to a 5-of-16 clip.
- JMU made 12 tackles for loss, while MSU tallied three.
- The Dukes scored on all six red-zone trips while MSU never made it inside the JMU 20.
- JMU also thwarted MSU's only real scoring chance on a Tony Thurston blocked field goal.
- Morehead State was led by DeAndre Clayton, who came in to throw 7-of-9 for 71 passing yards and an interception.

RATKE TOP 20 IN FCS HISTORY

- Ethan Ratke's fourth-quarter field goal was the 59th of his career, which ties him for second all-time in CAA history.
- He's tied with William & Mary's Greg Kuehn (2002-05).
- Ratke also moved into the FCS top 20, as he's tied for 16th in career field goals.

#2 Dukes Pull Away in Second Half for Win Over Robert Morris

HARRISONBURG, Va. – Second-ranked James Madison reeled off 27 unanswered points and clamped down defensively, holding Robert Morris scoreless in the second half, en route to a 36-16 non-conference football victory on Saturday afternoon at Bridgeforth Stadium.

The Dukes improved to 2-0 while the Colonials fell to 0-1. JMU also moved to 2-0 in the all-time series.

After allowing 163 yards and 4.4 per play in the first half, JMU's defense took over, allowing just 24 second-half yards, as RMU mustered just a single yard per snap over the final 30 minutes.

The Dukes tied the game just before halftime and tacked on another score to take the lead, at 23-16 with 10:41 to play in the third. JMU would go on to score on four of six drives to open the second half to pull away.

Percy Agyei-Obese ran for 55 yards and two touchdowns, while Jawon Hamilton

led all players with 74 rushing yards, averaging 8.2 per carry. Kris Thornton found the endzone once again this week, reeling in five catches for 65 yards and a score. Antwane Wells Jr. also caught his first career touchdown, which tied the game just before the half. Cole Johnson was 17-of-24 for 198 yards, two touchdowns and three interceptions.

Defensively, Kelvin Azanama and Wayne Davis led the Dukes with eight tackles apiece. It was a career high for Azanama, while Davis matched his career best. MJ Hampton was active all over the field, accruing seven tackles with a career-high 1.5 for loss, while also forcing and recovering a key fumble in the second half. JMU transfers Abi Nwabuoku-Okonji and Mason Cholewa each turned in their first sacks at JMU as part of the stout effort in the second half.

GAME FACTS

- JMU out-gained Robert Morris 394 to 187, which included a dominant 209 to 24 margin in the second half.
- The Dukes limited RMU to just 22 rushing yards and 0.7 per carry. Through two games, JMU has conceded 16 total rushing yards after Morehead State had -6 in week one.
- JMU allowed just one third-down conversion, as RMU went 1-for-13. The Dukes were 4-of-11 on third-down tries.
- Harry O'Kelly shined on special teams, averaging 48.5 yards on his four punts, which included pinning the Colonials inside the 2-yard line twice. All four of his
 punts were inside the 20. His first punt, downed at the one, led to an eventual safety.
- The teams were perfect in the red zone, as JMU was 4-for-4 (2 TD) and RMU was 2-for-2 (1 TD).
- For RMU, George Martin threw for 165 yards and a touchdown, with D'Andre Hicks making eight catches for 67 yards. Aniello Buzzacco led all players with 15 tackles.

Dukes Storm Back to Upend Elon 20-17 in CAA Opener

ELON, N.C. – James Madison overcame a 14-point halftime deficit, scoring the final 17 points of the game, to rally past Elon, 20-17, in the Colonial Athletic Association football opener for both teams on Saturday afternoon at Rhodes Stadium.

The #1 Dukes improved to 3-0 (1-0 CAA) while the Phoenix dropped to 1-2 (0-1 CAA). JMU also moved to 8-1 in the all-time series with Elon.

After falling behind 17-3 at halftime, the Dukes never allowed Elon to score again, limiting the hosts to just 36 second-half yards with a pair of first downs. Trailing 17-6 into the fourth quarter, the Dukes put together back-to-back touchdown drives with a huge special-teams play in between.

Inserting Gage Moloney at quarterback, he capped off a 13-play, 79-yard drive with an 18-yard touchdown to Antwane Wells Jr. to trim the deficit to 17-13 with 12:22 to go. On the ensuing possession, MJ Hampton blocked Hunter Stephenson's punt, setting up the Dukes at the Elon 33.

Seven plays later, Percy Agyei-Obese rushed to the endzone untouched from eight yards out to give JMU its first lead with 7:27 to go. After another three-and-out, JMU ran out the final 5:59 with an 11-play drive.

Agyei-Obese rushed for a career-high 132 yards and a score, averaging 6.9 per carry. Jawon Hamilton also ran for 63 yards, as the Dukes held a 231-77 advantage on the ground.

Cole Johnson was 9-of-16 for 107 yards and an interception, while Moloney finished the game 3-of-6 for 46 yards and a score. Kris Thornton had three catches for 53 yards, Scott Bracey had a game-high four grabs for 41 yards and Wells had two catches with his score.

Defensively, Kelvin Azanama had a game-high eight tackles with three hurries, and Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey made seven stops. Mike Greene was a force up front, with 3.5 tackles for loss, a career-high, and a sack. In his first career start James Carpenter had five tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss and a half sack. Wesley McCormick also registered his first career interception in the second half.
